Beautiful modulation lanes. Mostly RCP. Emission up to about 28 MHz or so.

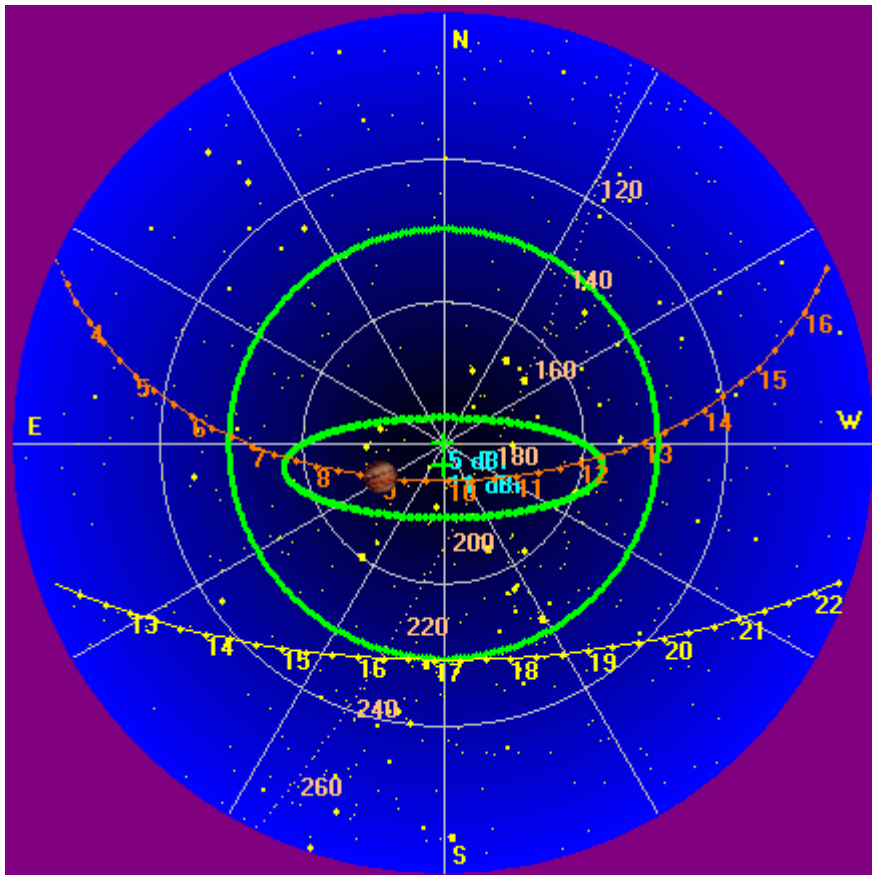
Jupiter was 13° to 33° off axis.

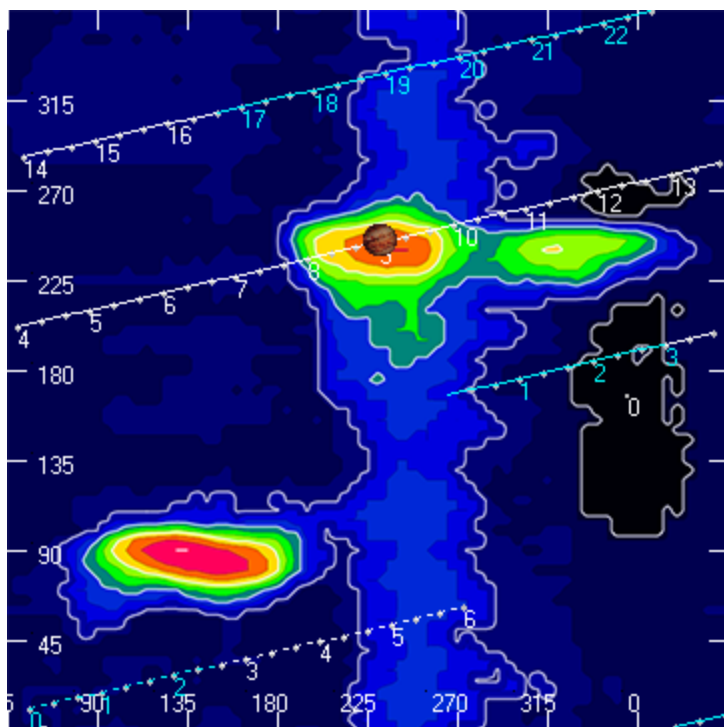
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 114°.

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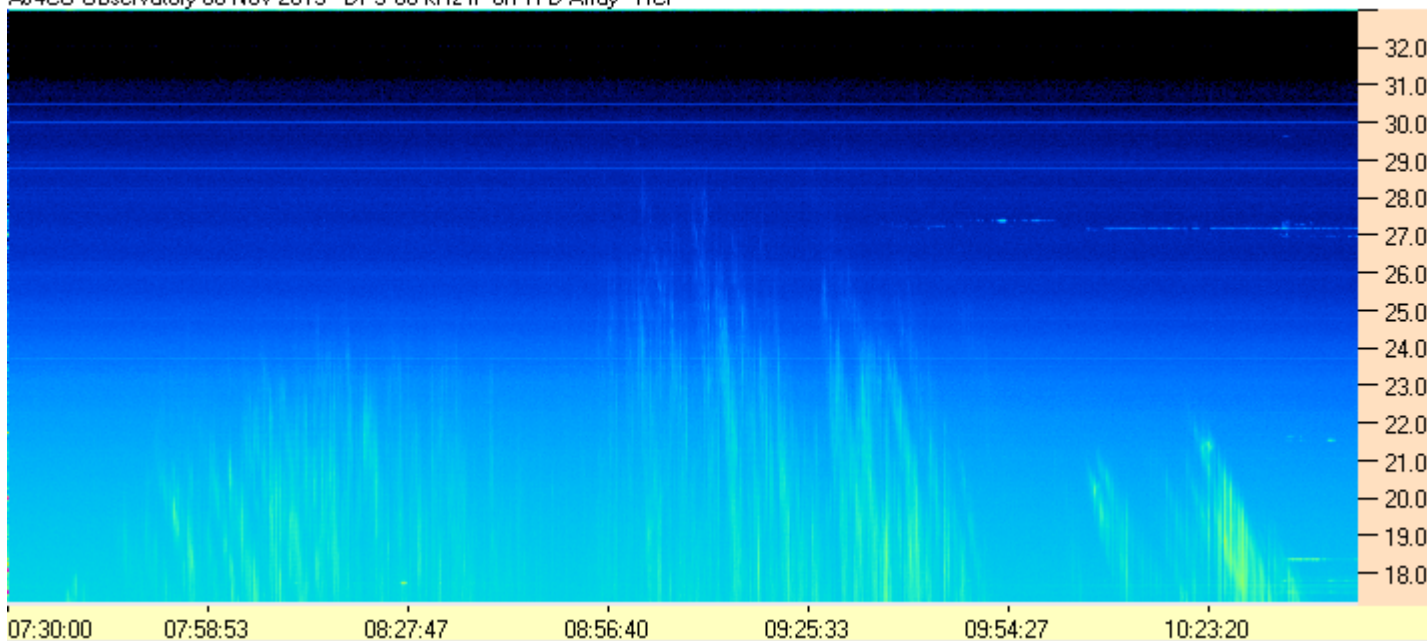

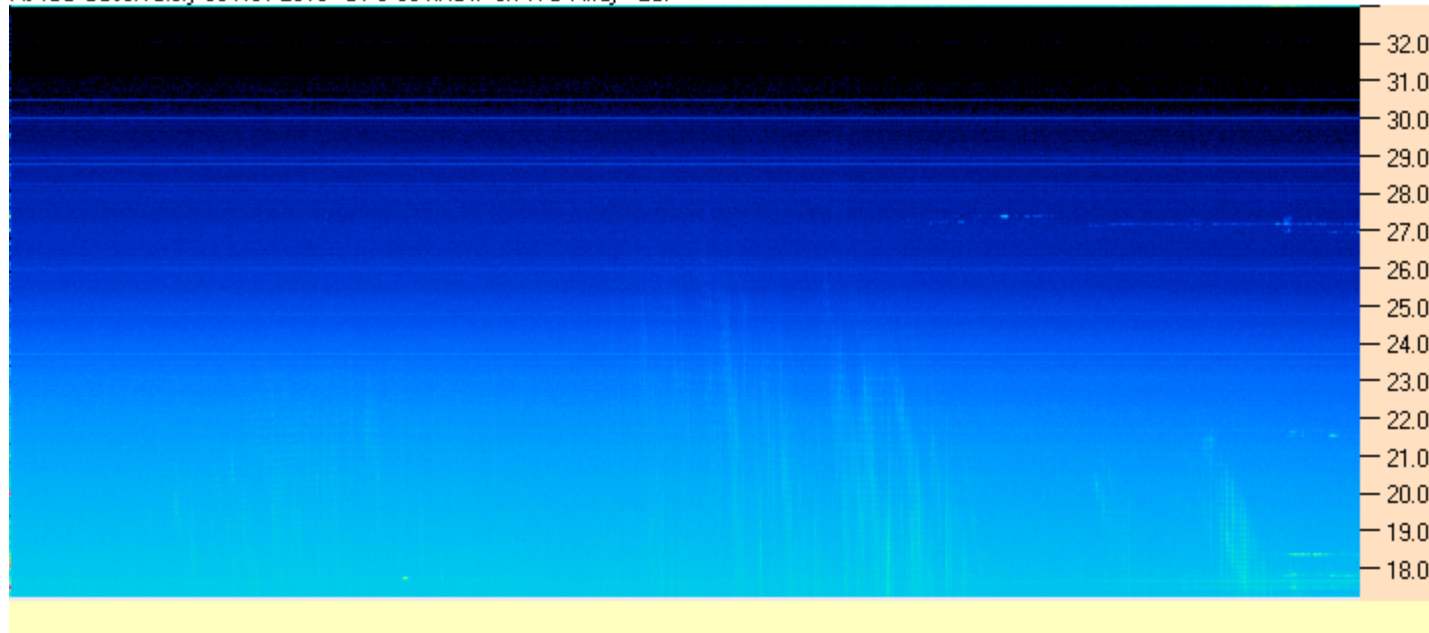




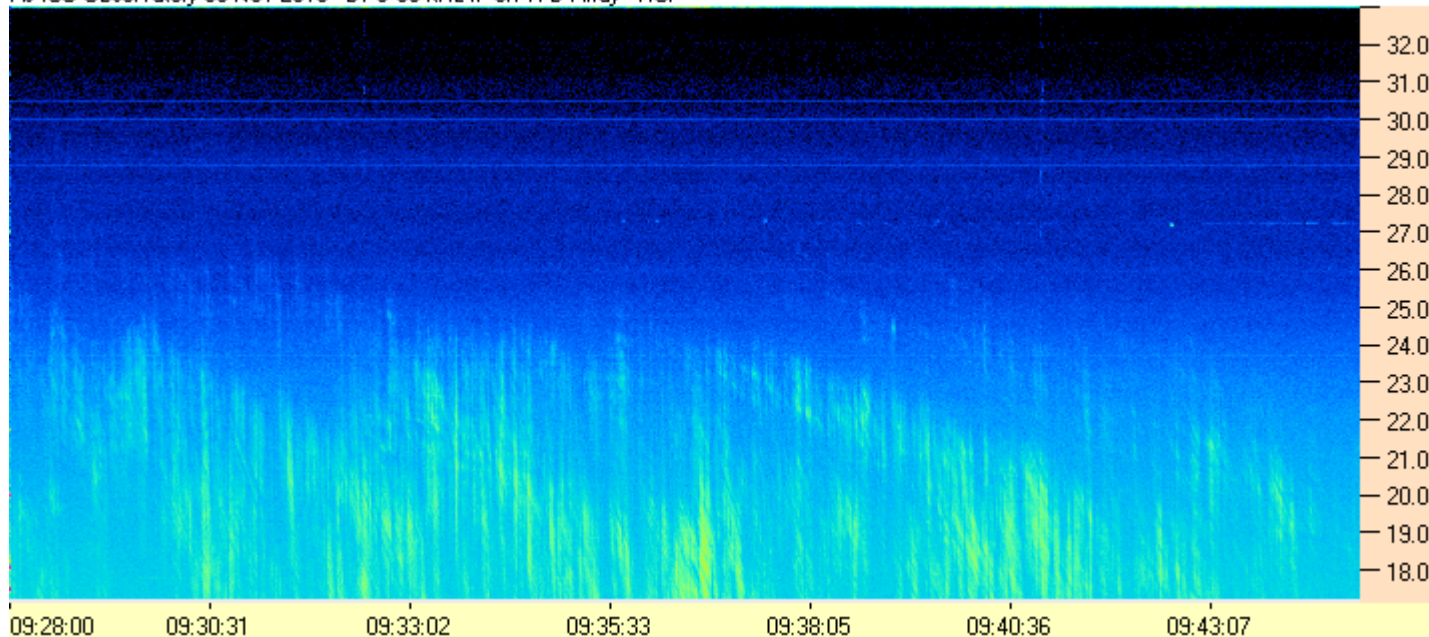
AJ400 Observatory 06 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - RCP



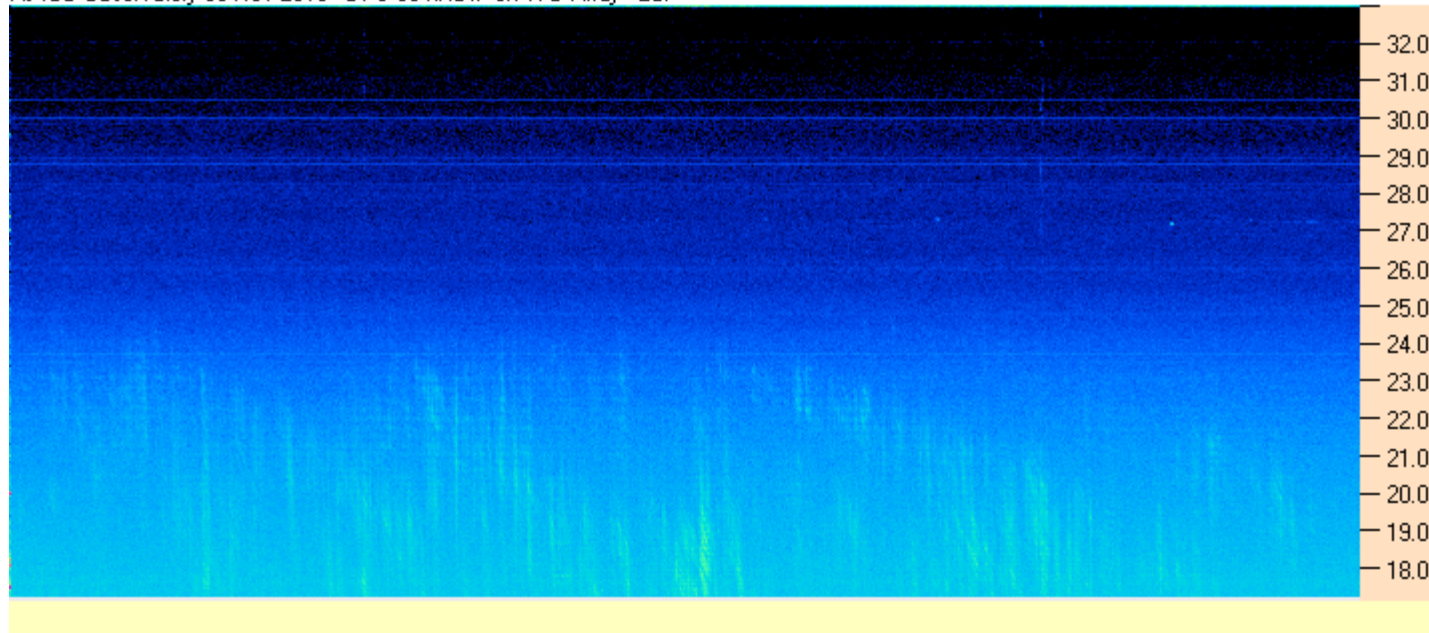
AJ4CQ Observatory 06 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - LCP



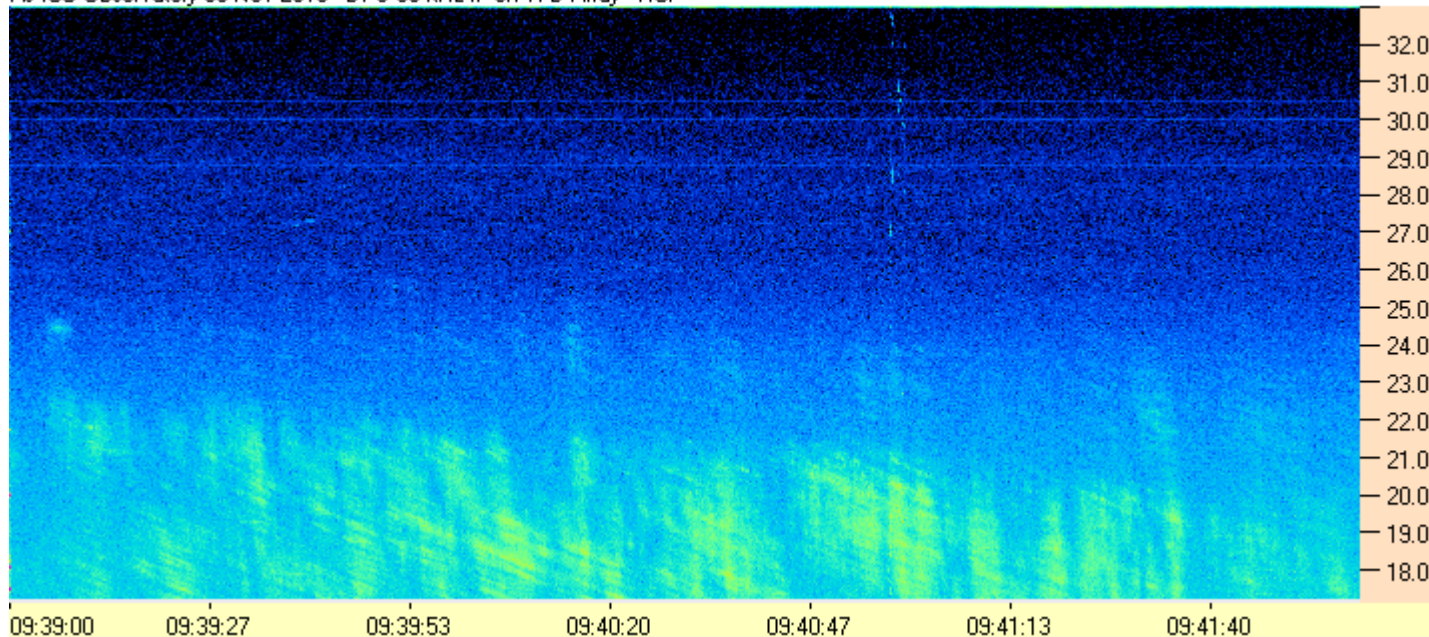

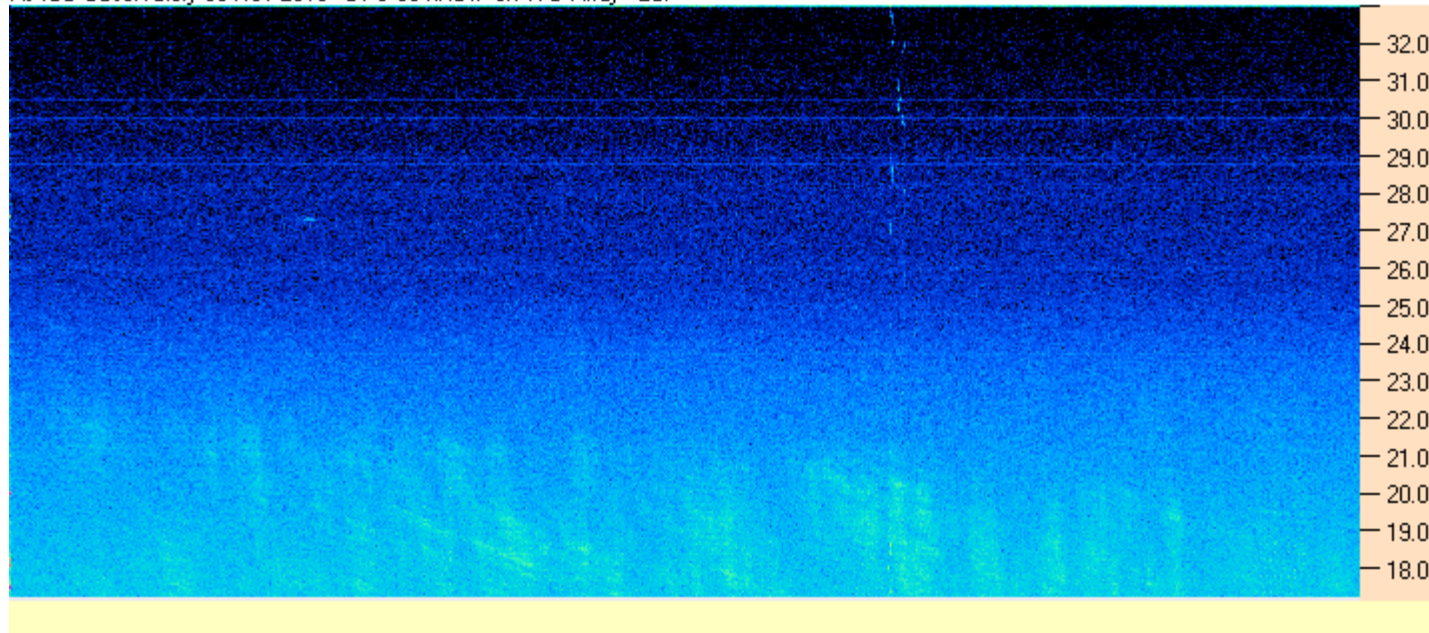
AJ400 Observatory 06 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - LCP



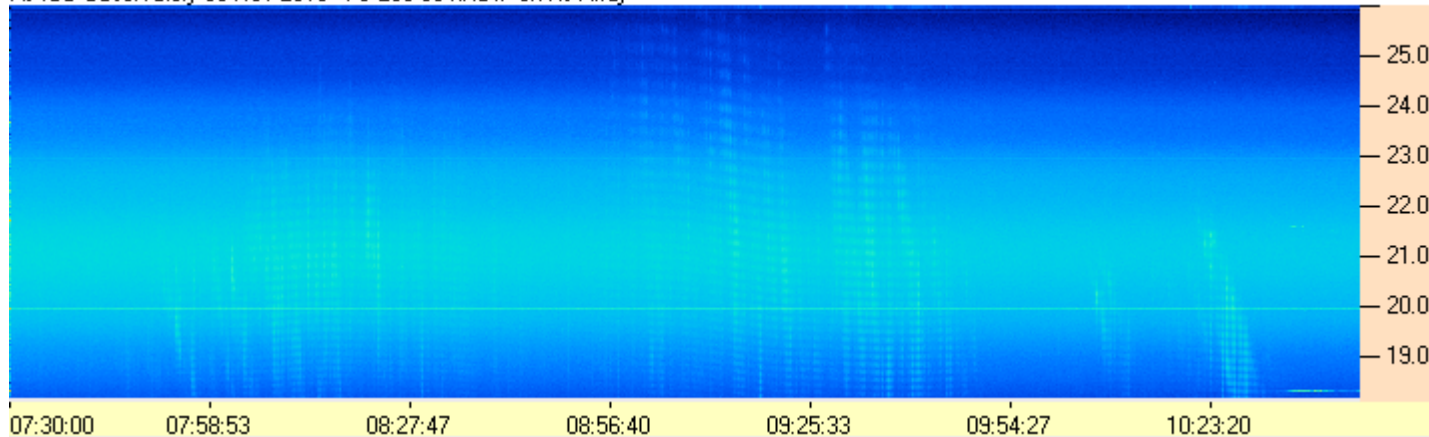

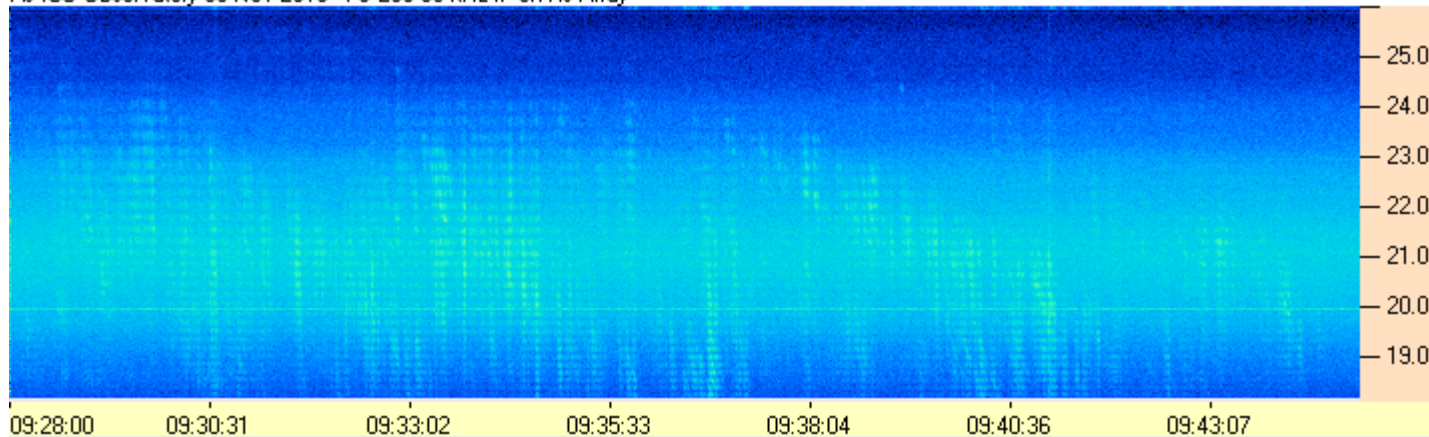
