I have no idea what the interference in the red trace of the strip chart is. It's not Jupiter.

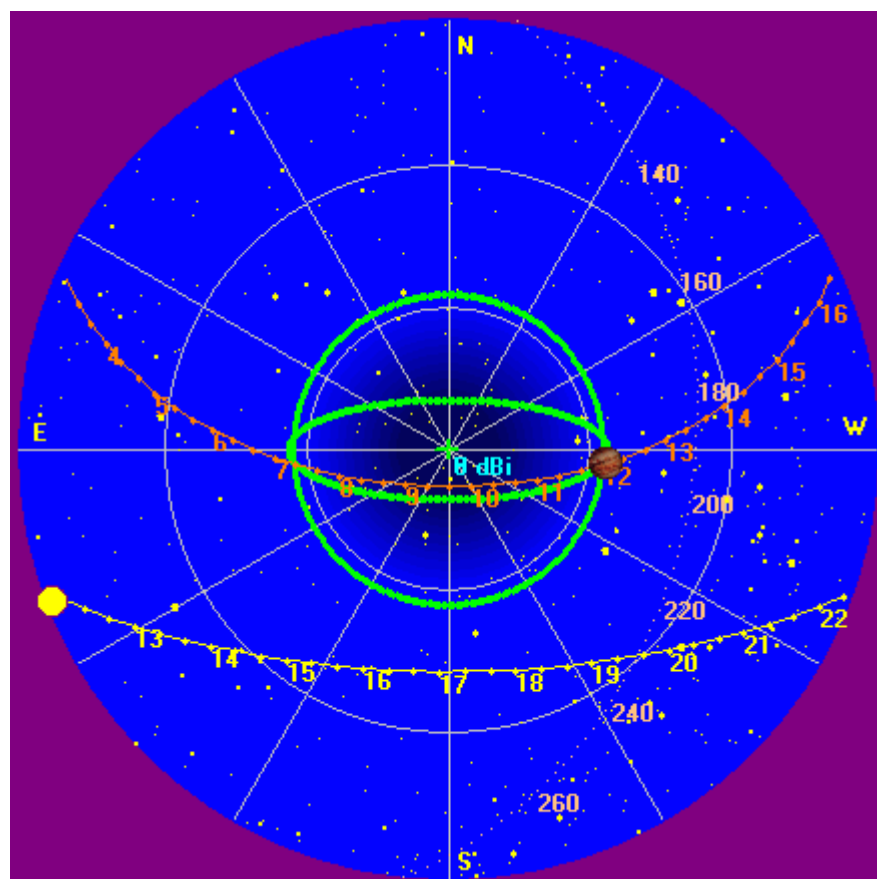
Jupiter was 28° to 37° off axis.

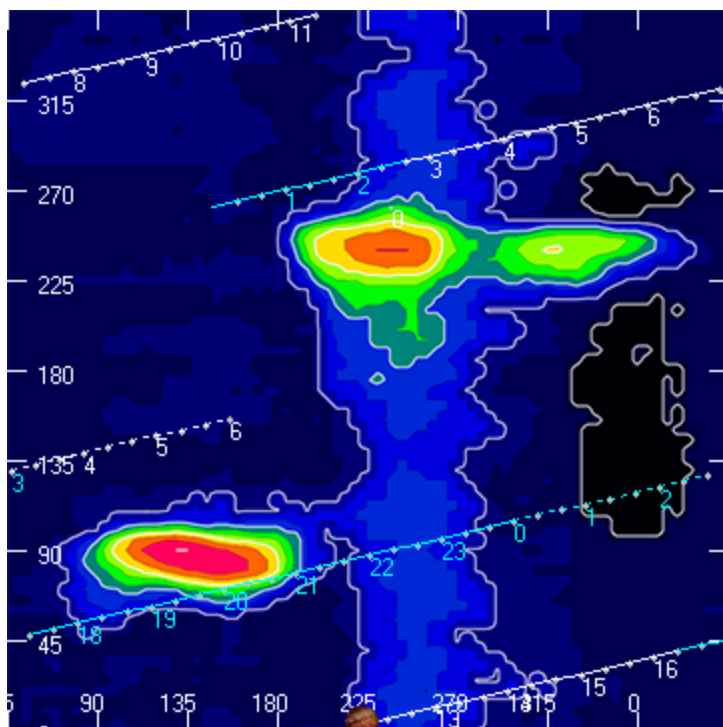
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 118°.

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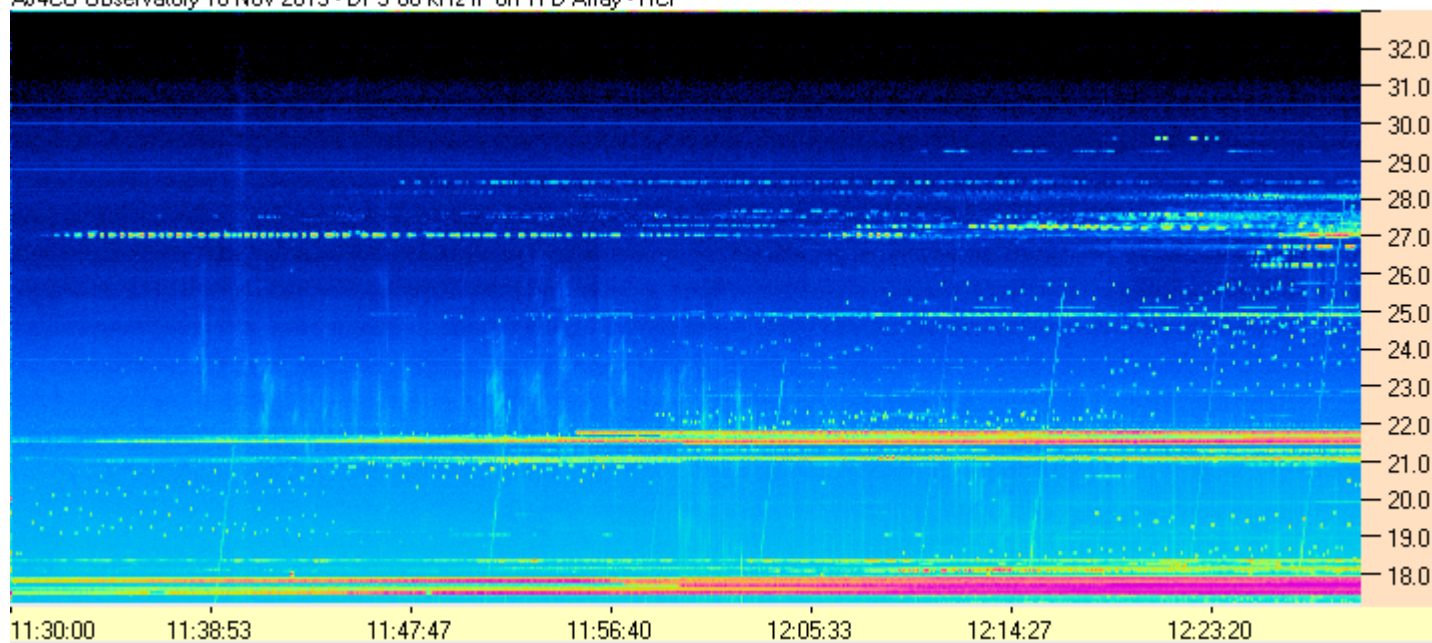

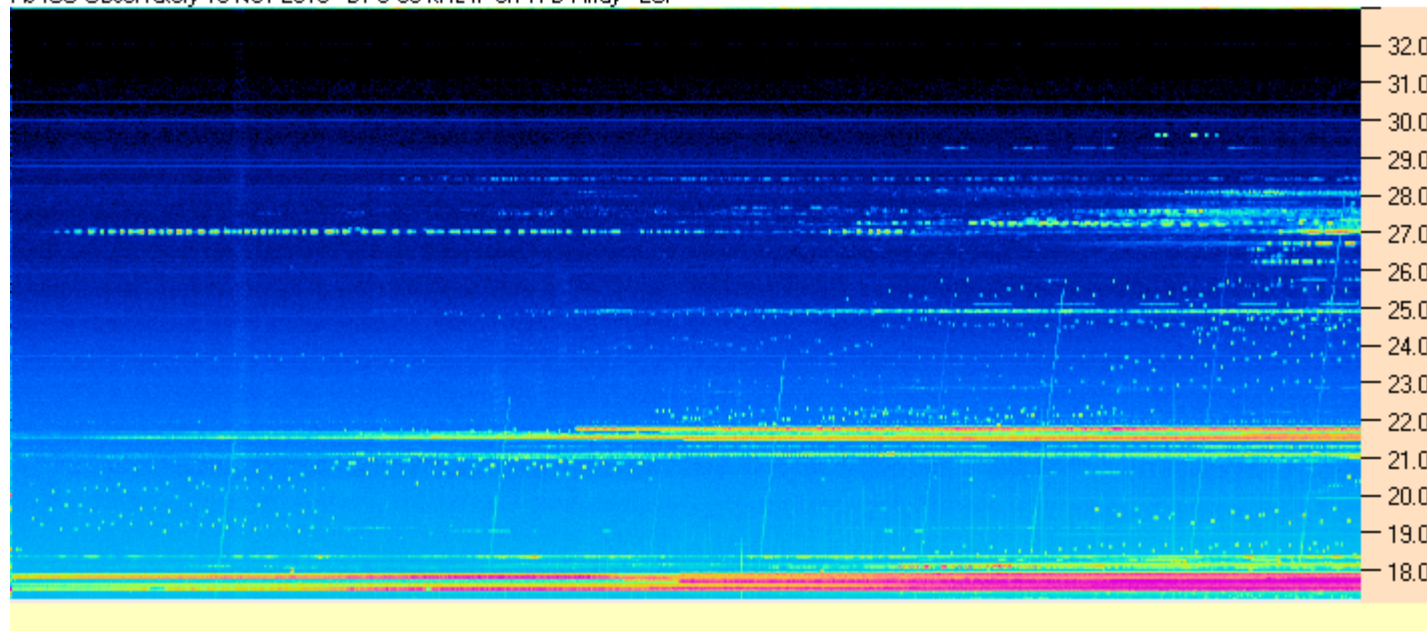




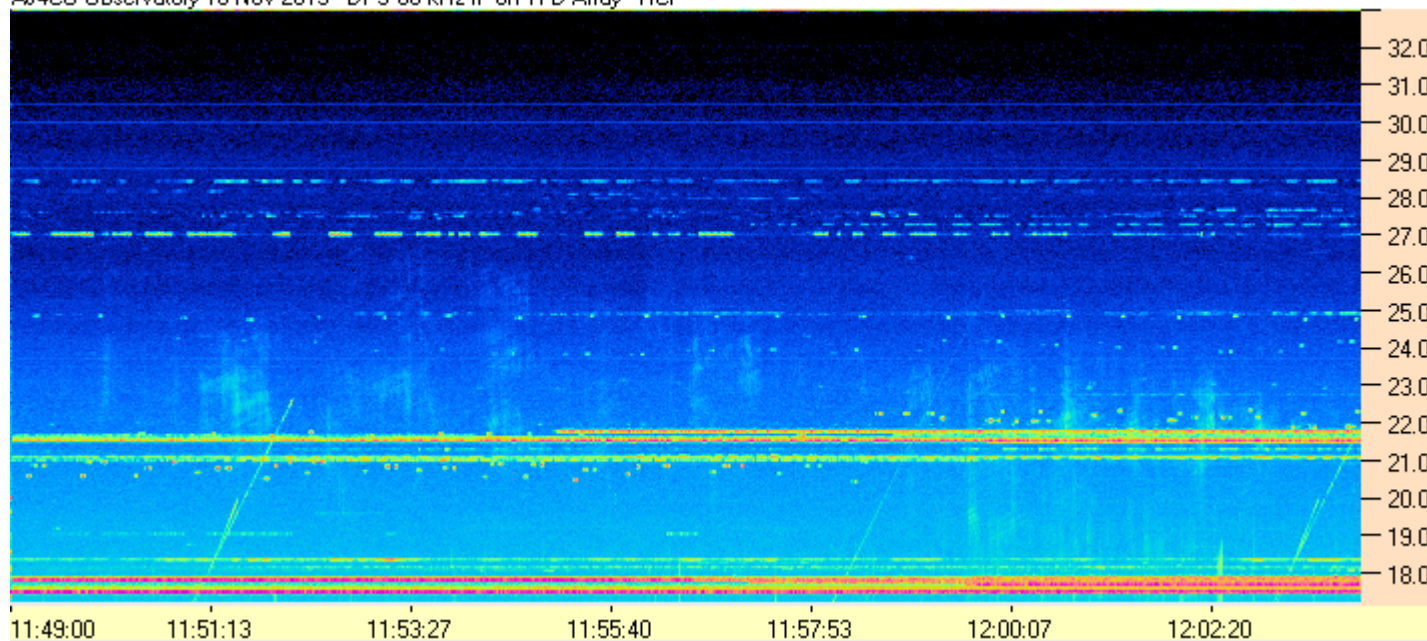
AJ4CD Observatory 10 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - RCP



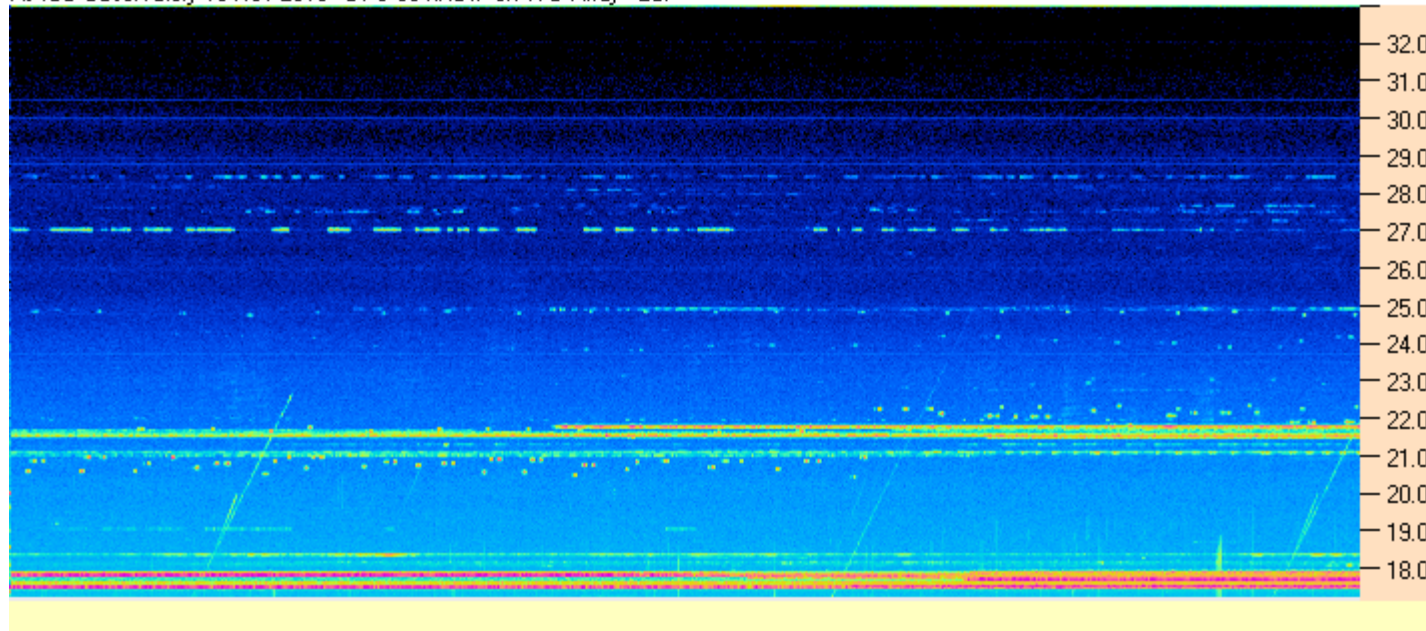
AJ400 Observatory 10 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - LCP



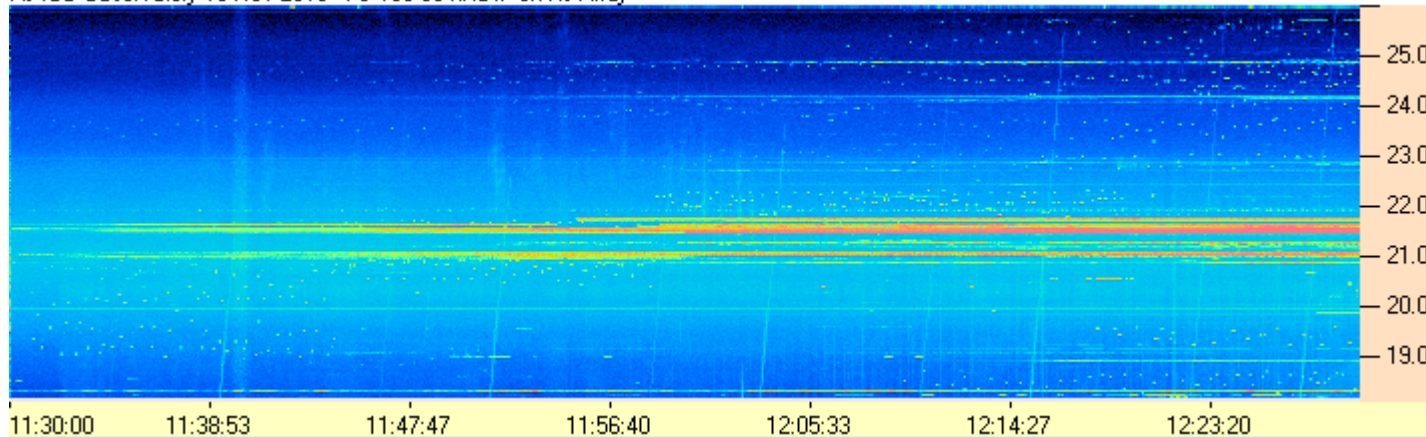
