Possible weak N event around 0950-1000 at 32.5 MHz.

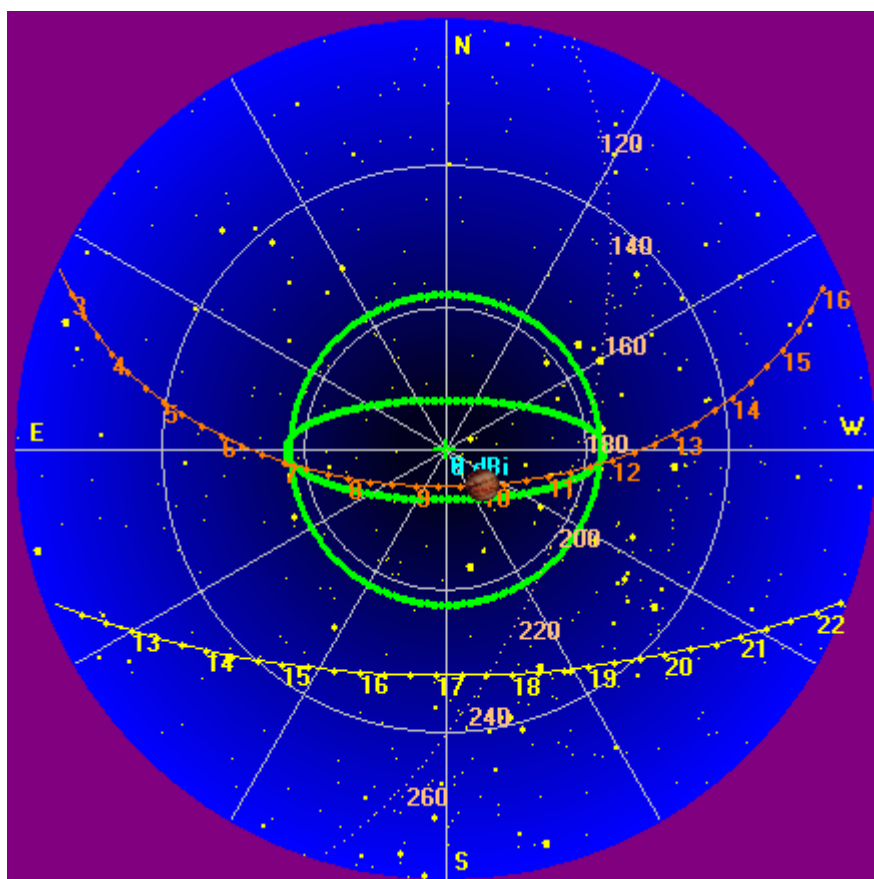
Jupiter was 13° to 18° off axis.

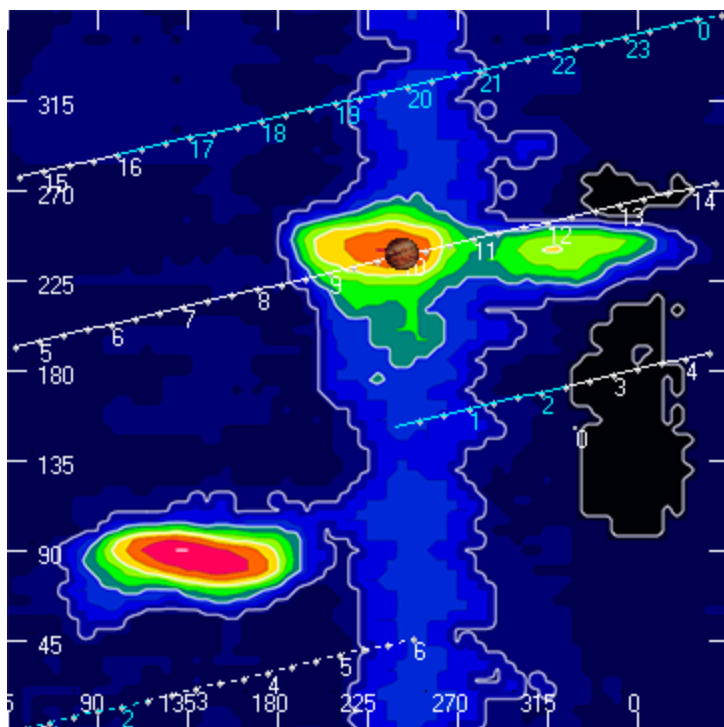
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 121°.

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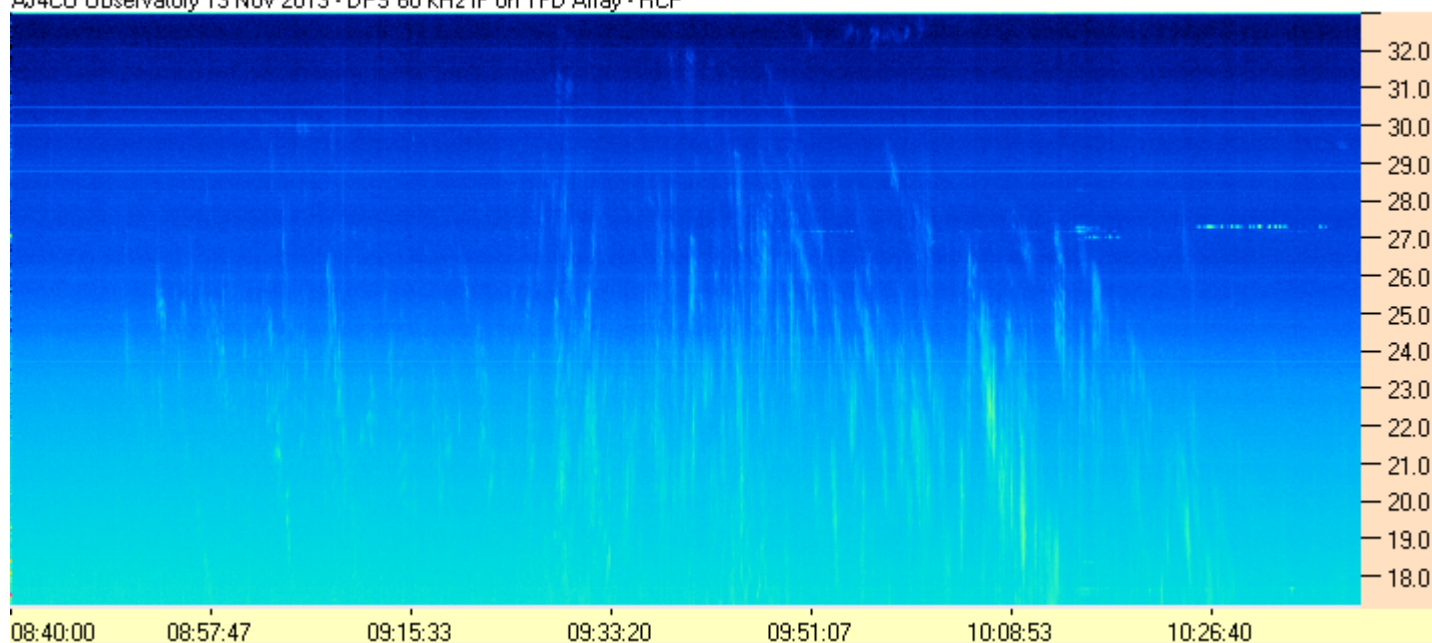

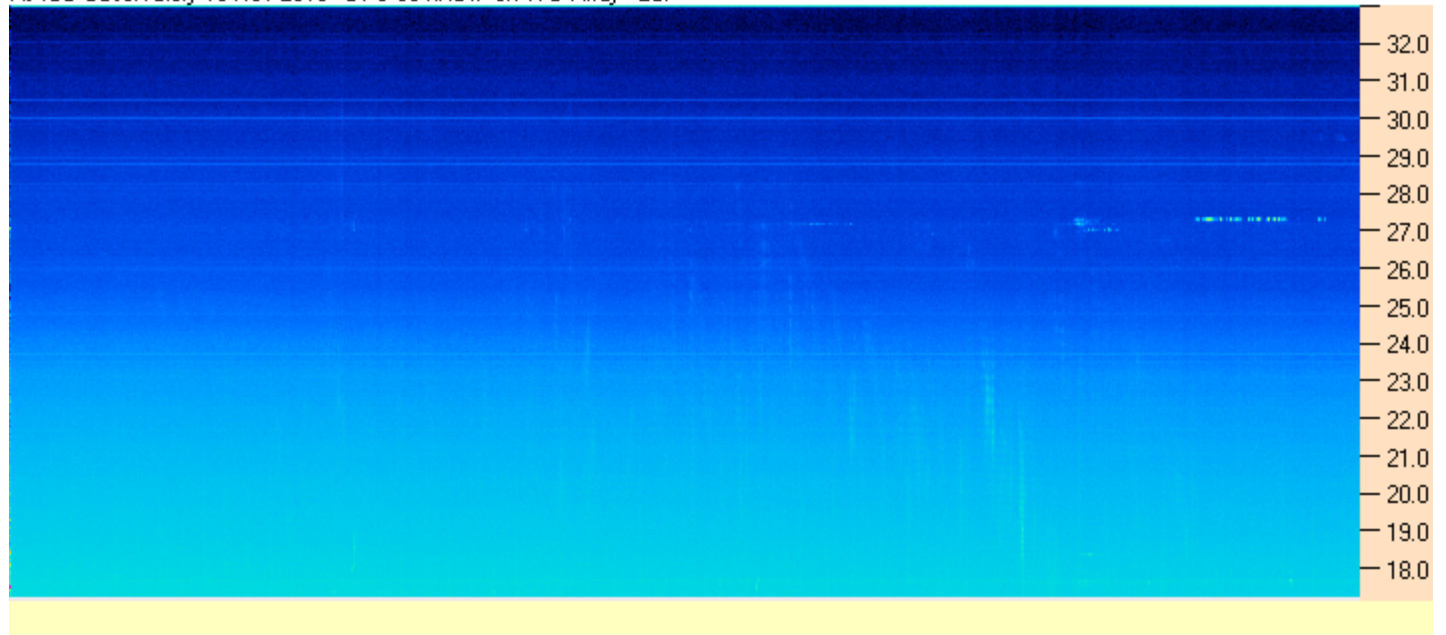




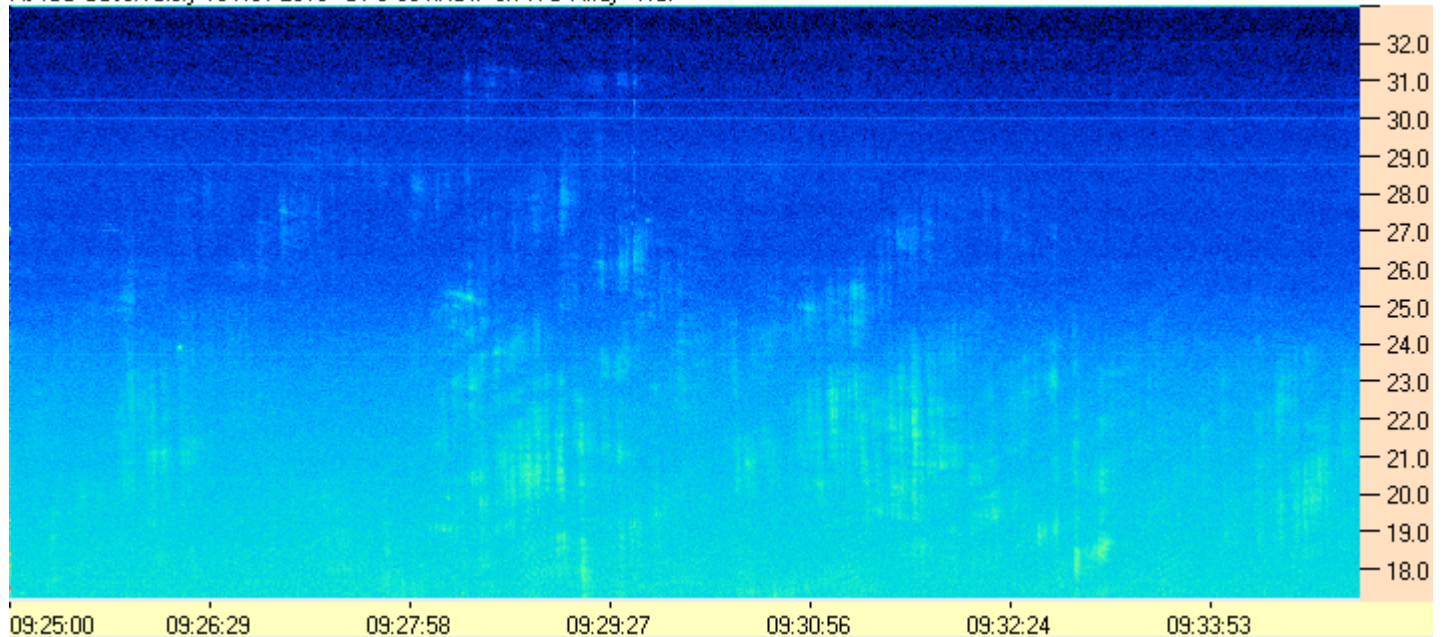
AJ4CD Observatory 13 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - RCP



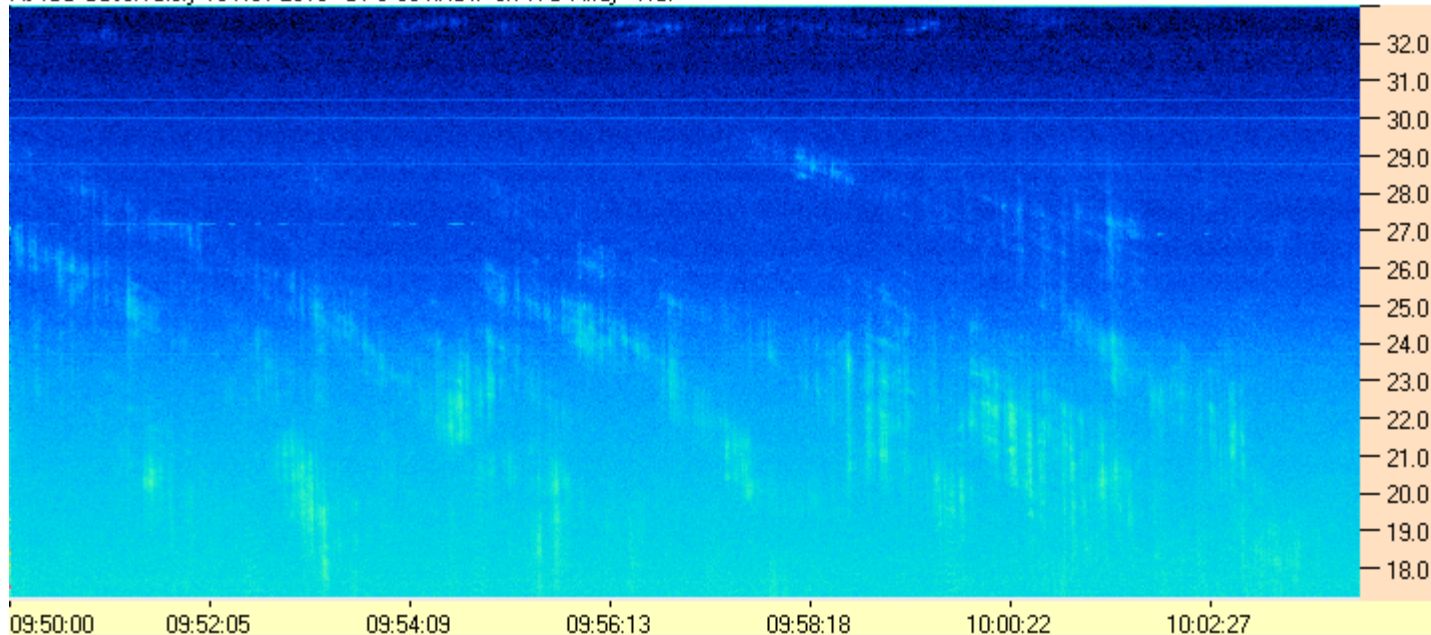
AJ400 Observatory 13 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - LCP



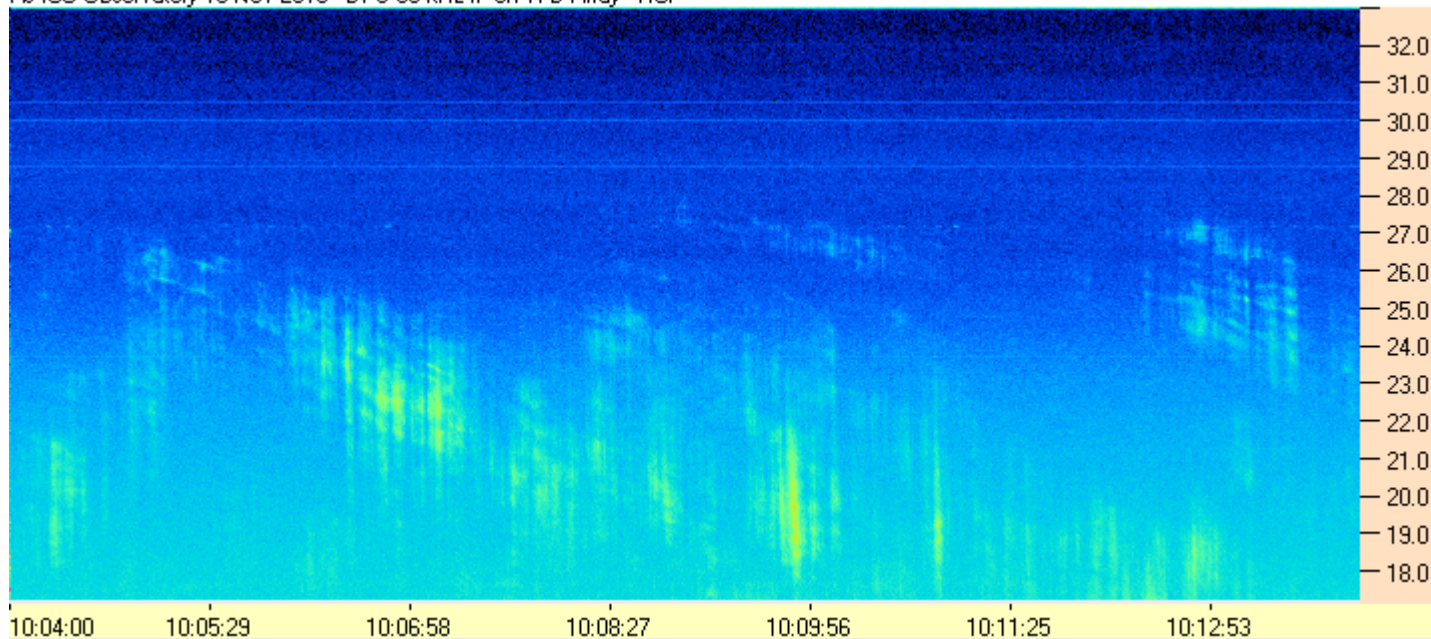

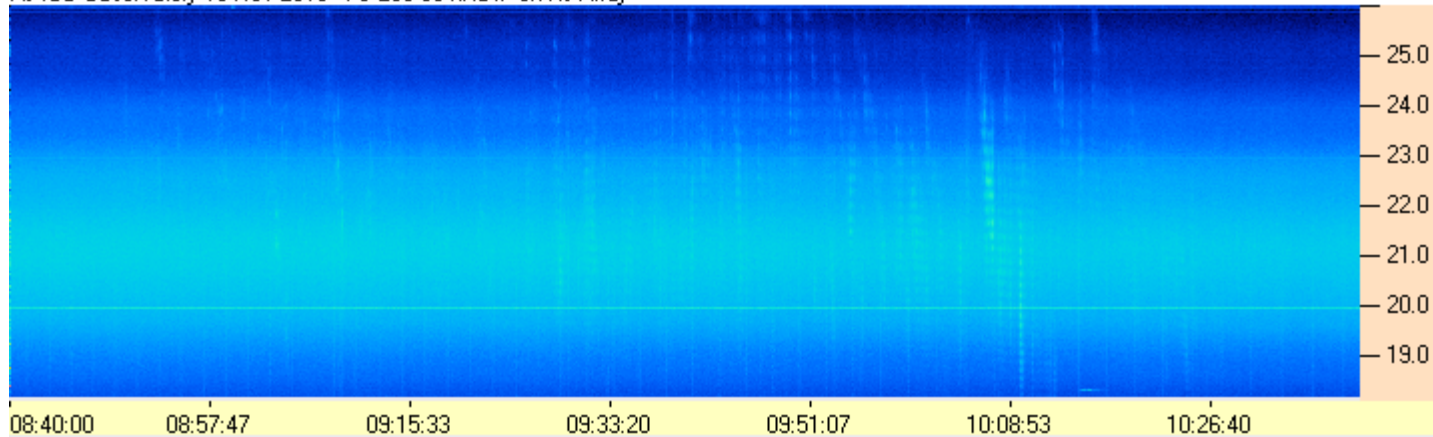

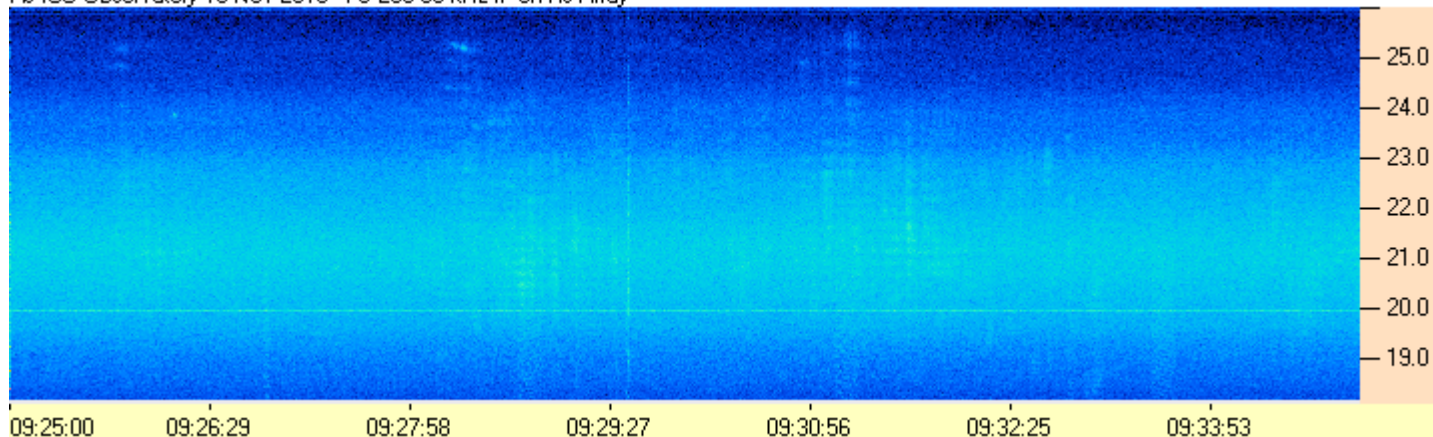

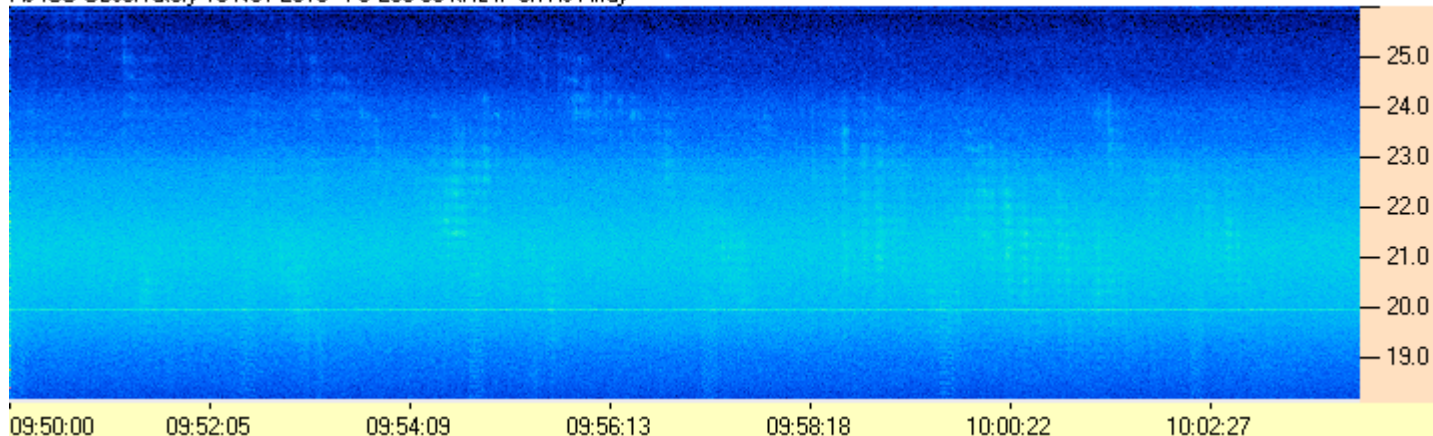
AJ4CO Observatory 13 Nov 2013 - FS-200 30 kHz IF on RJ Array



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
