Here is this morning's Io-B. Pretty far to the east, even for the East Coasters; hour angle from -5 to -3.

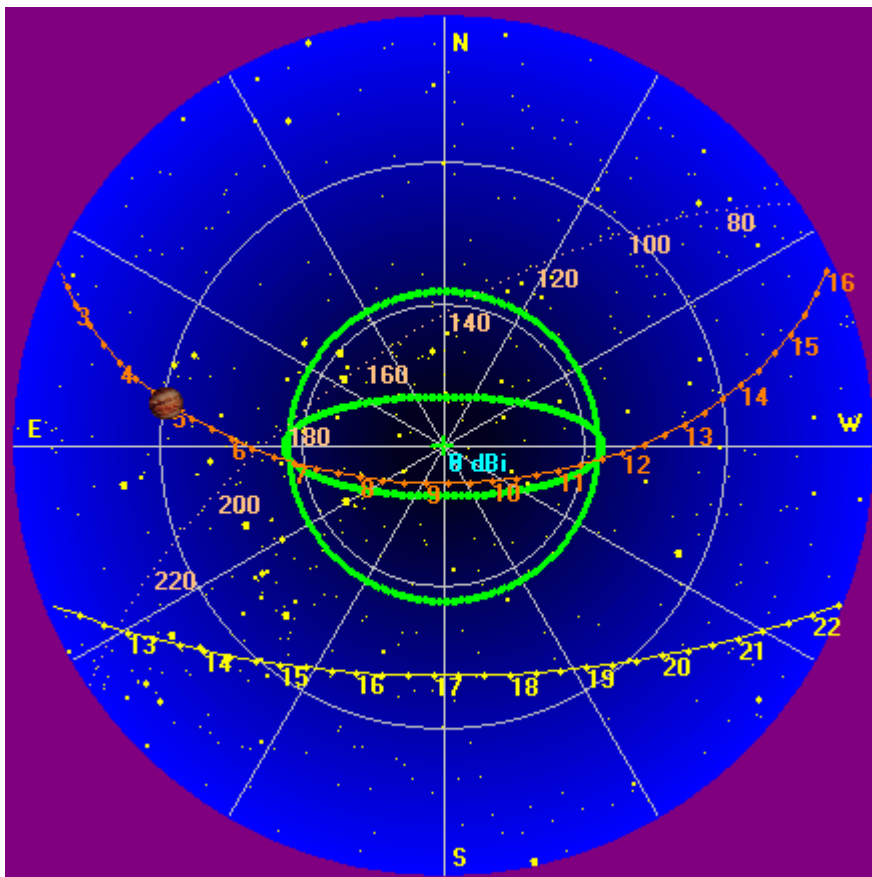
Some faint modulation lanes, but then the whole thing was faint due to being so far off axis (66° to 46°).

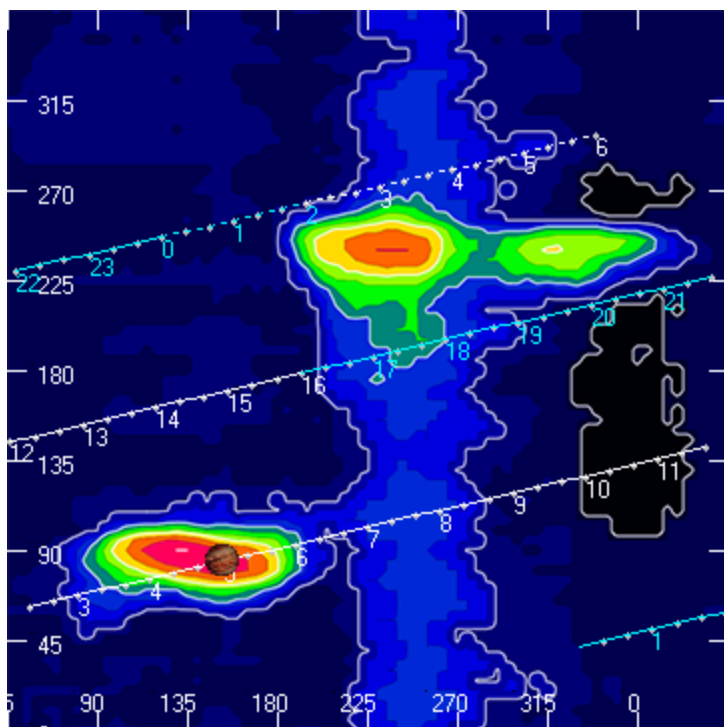
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 124° .

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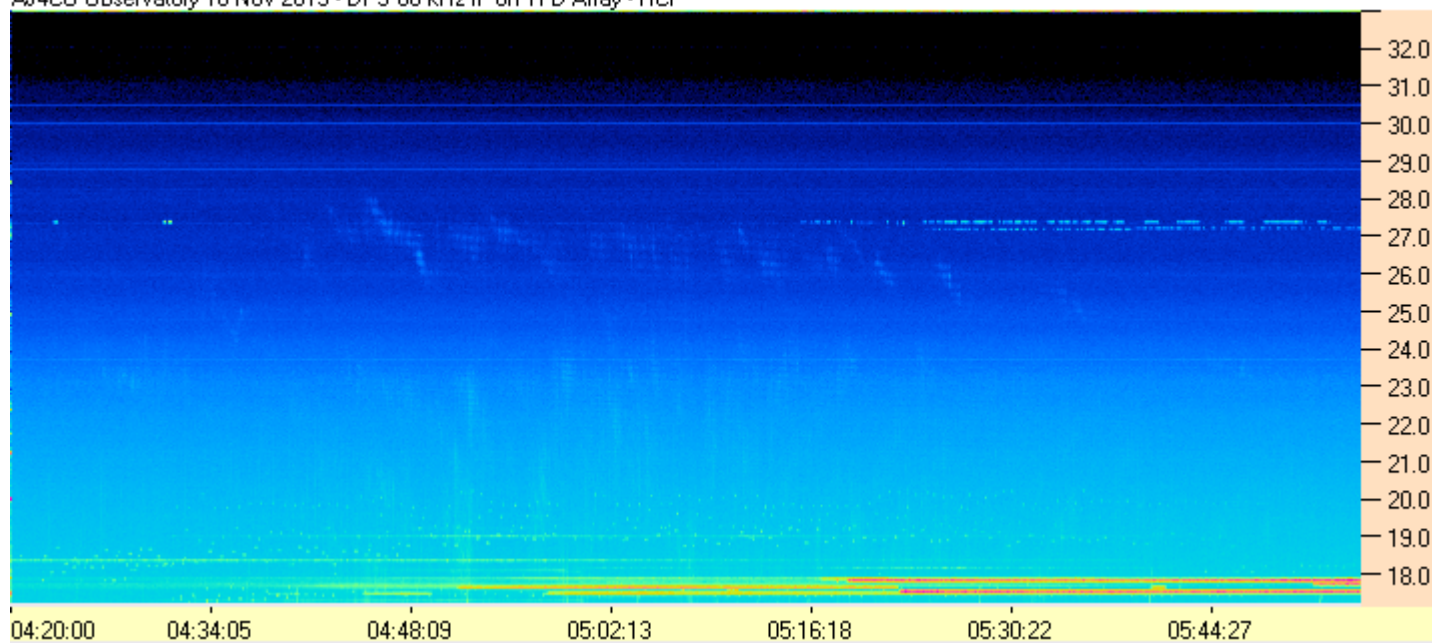

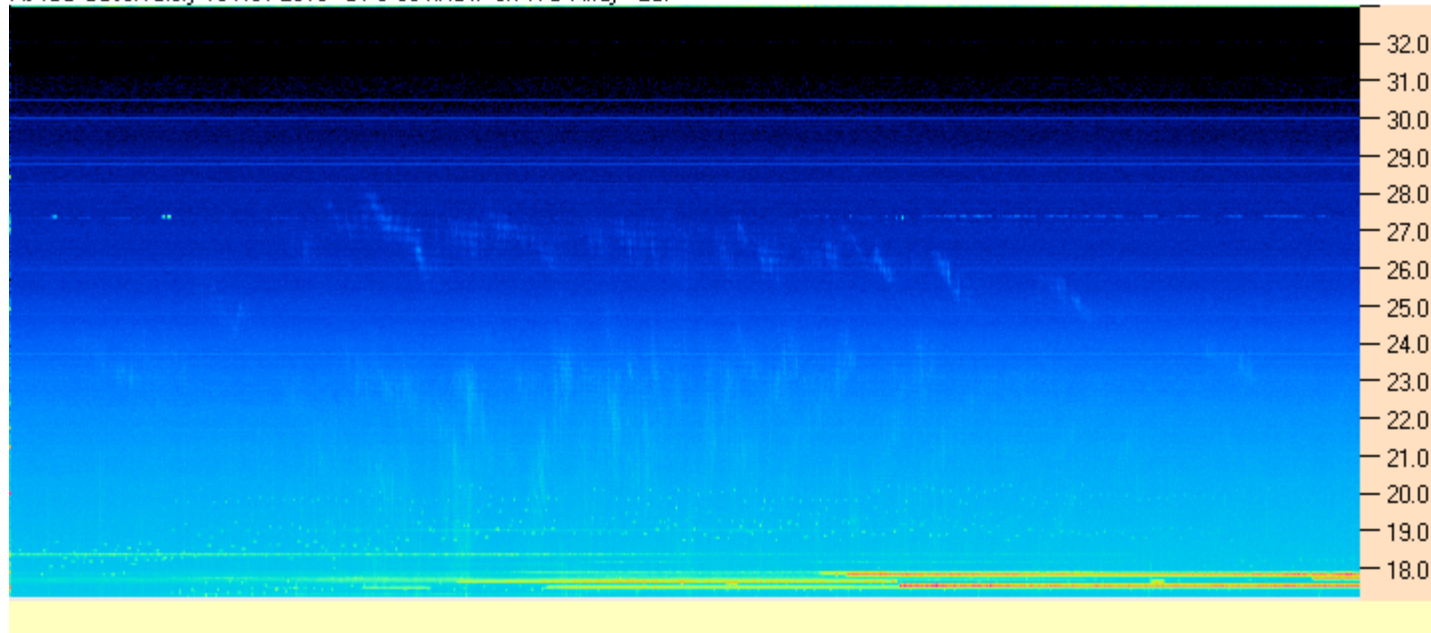




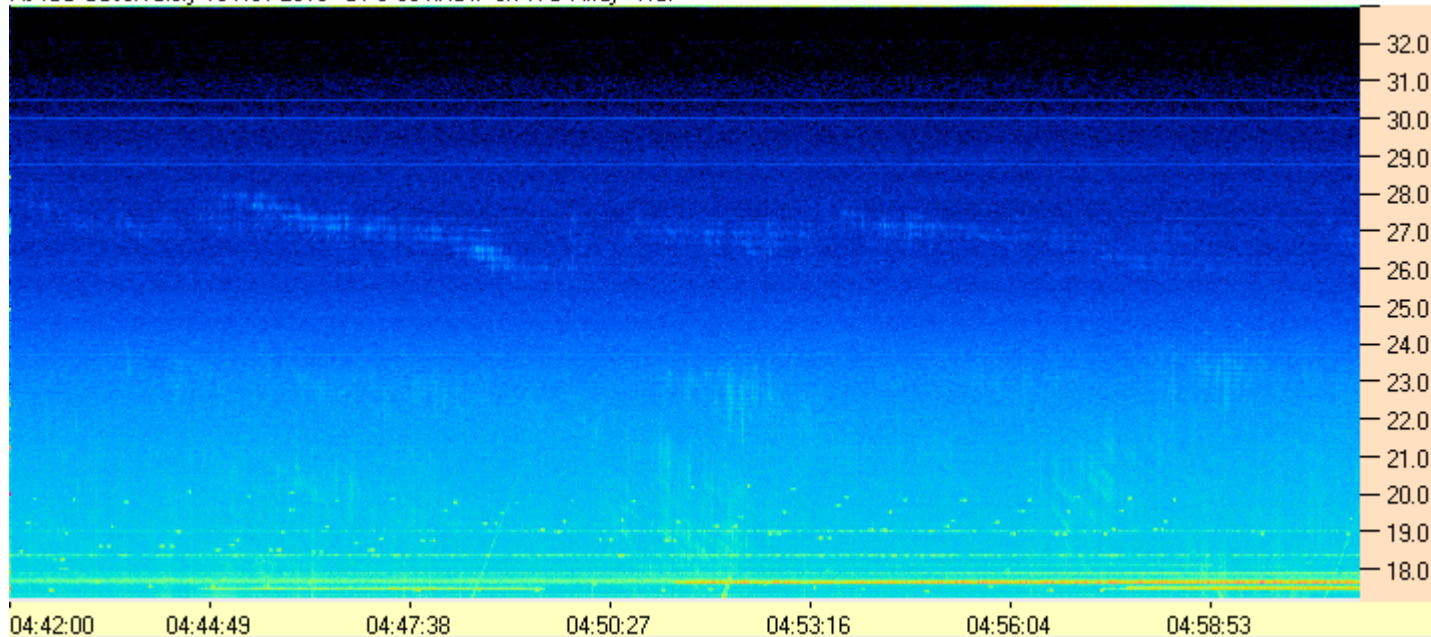
AJ4CD Observatory 16 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - RCP



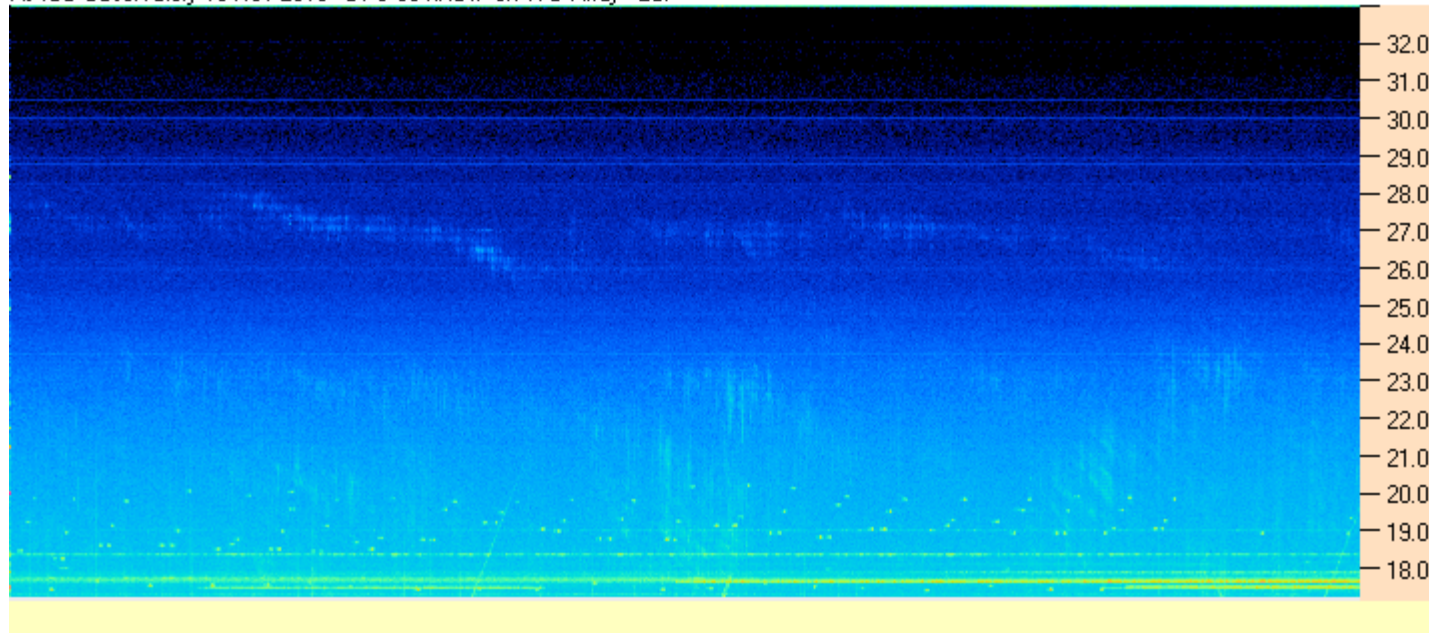
AJ400 Observatory 16 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - LCP



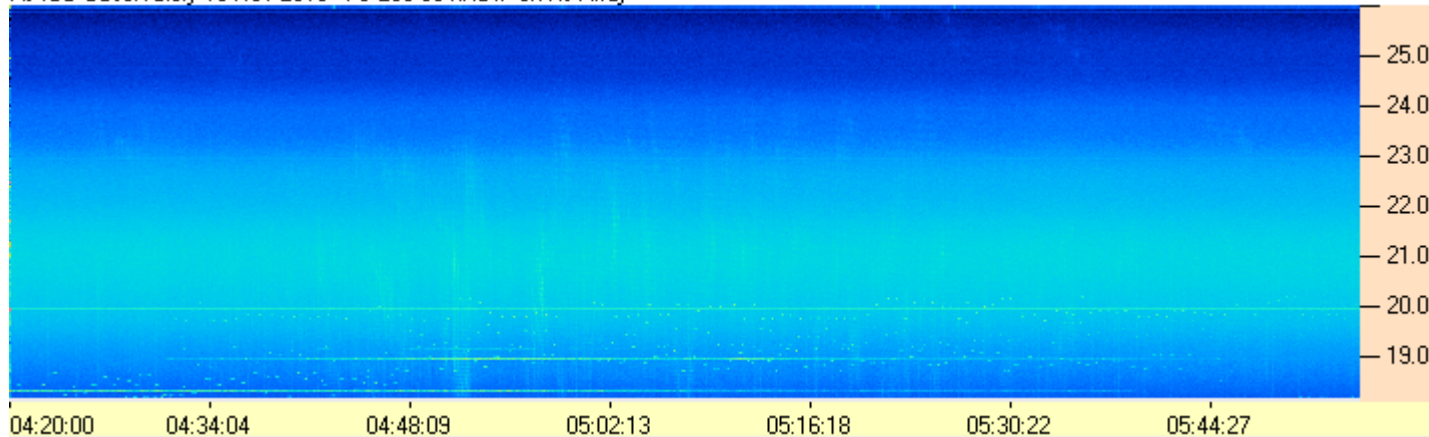
AJ400 Observatory 16 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - RCP
