Another very weak one; did not show up in the FS-200 or the RJ receivers.

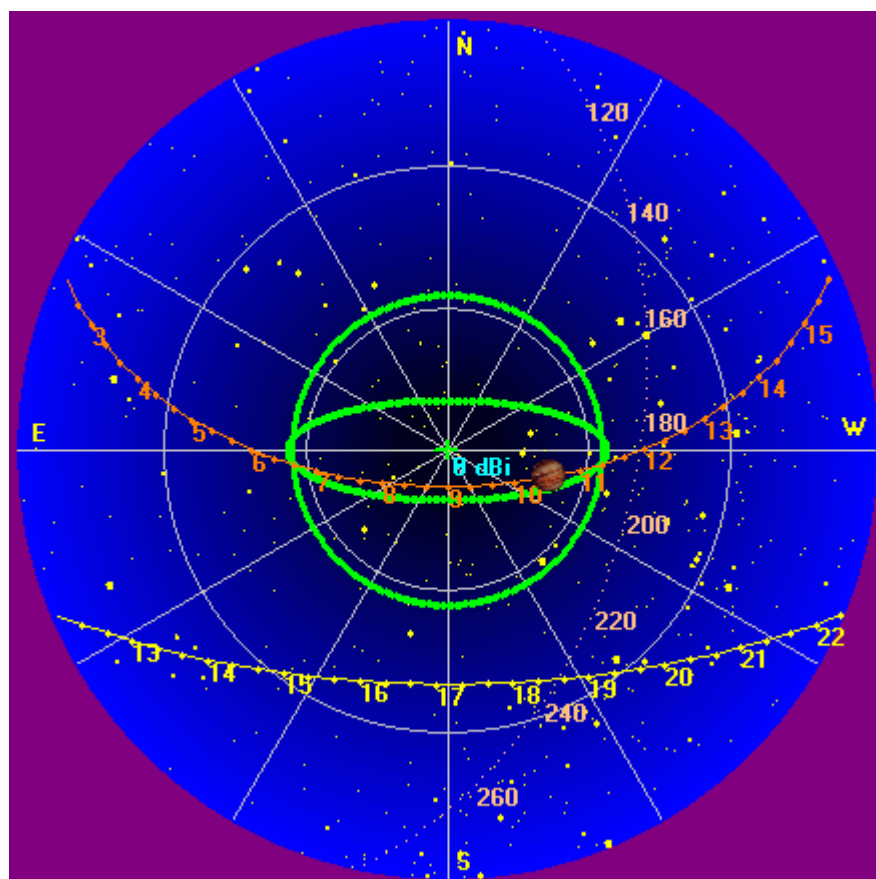
Jupiter was off axis from 10° to 35°.

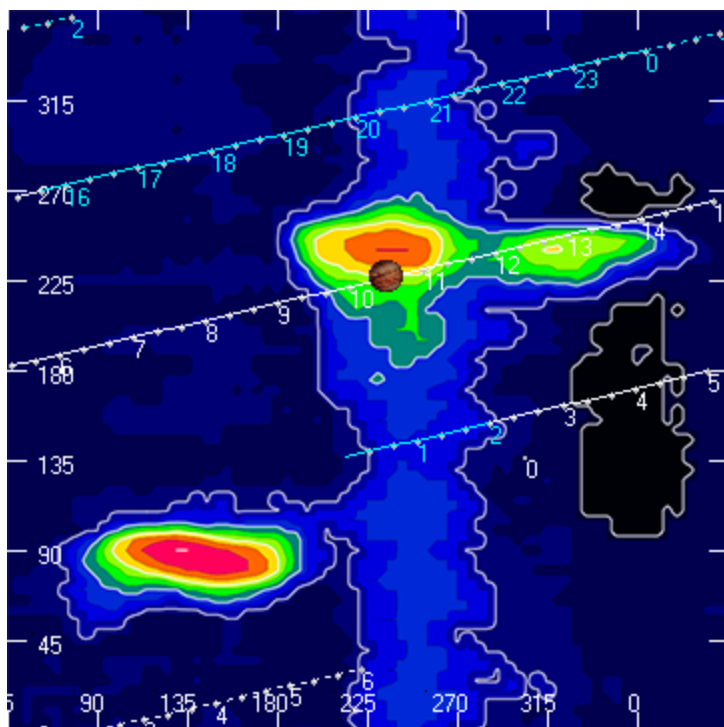
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 128°.

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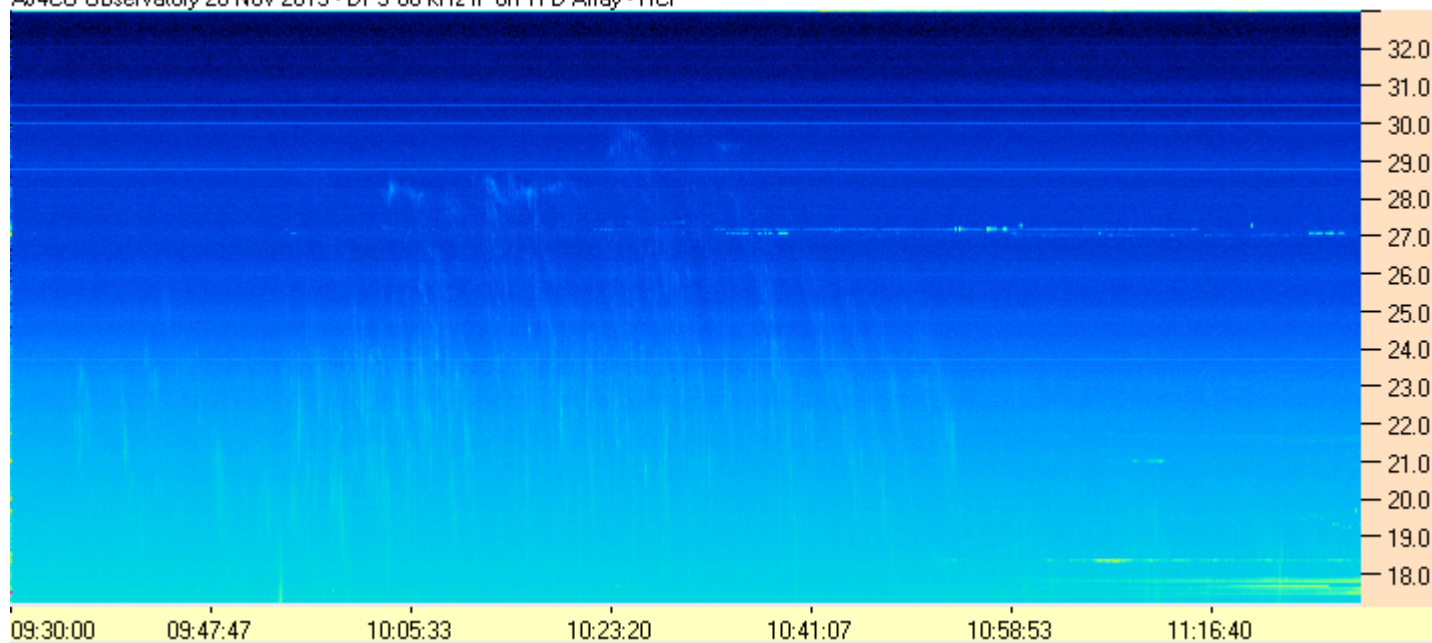

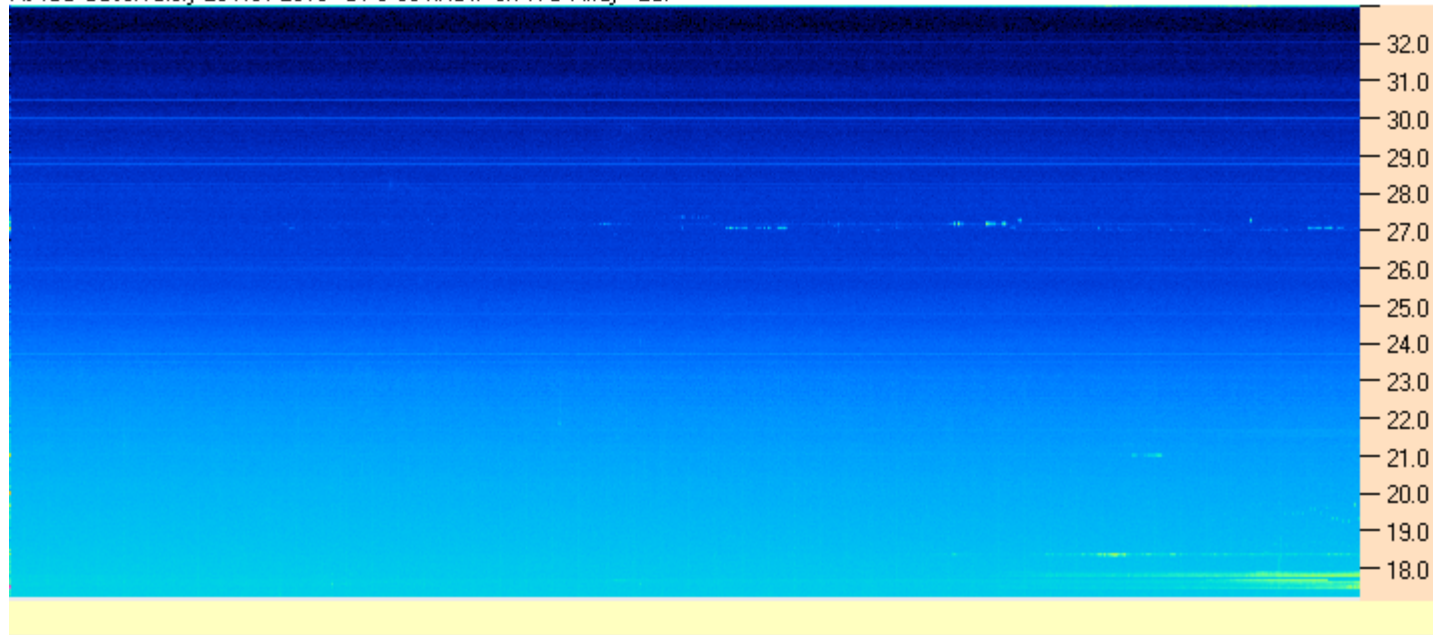




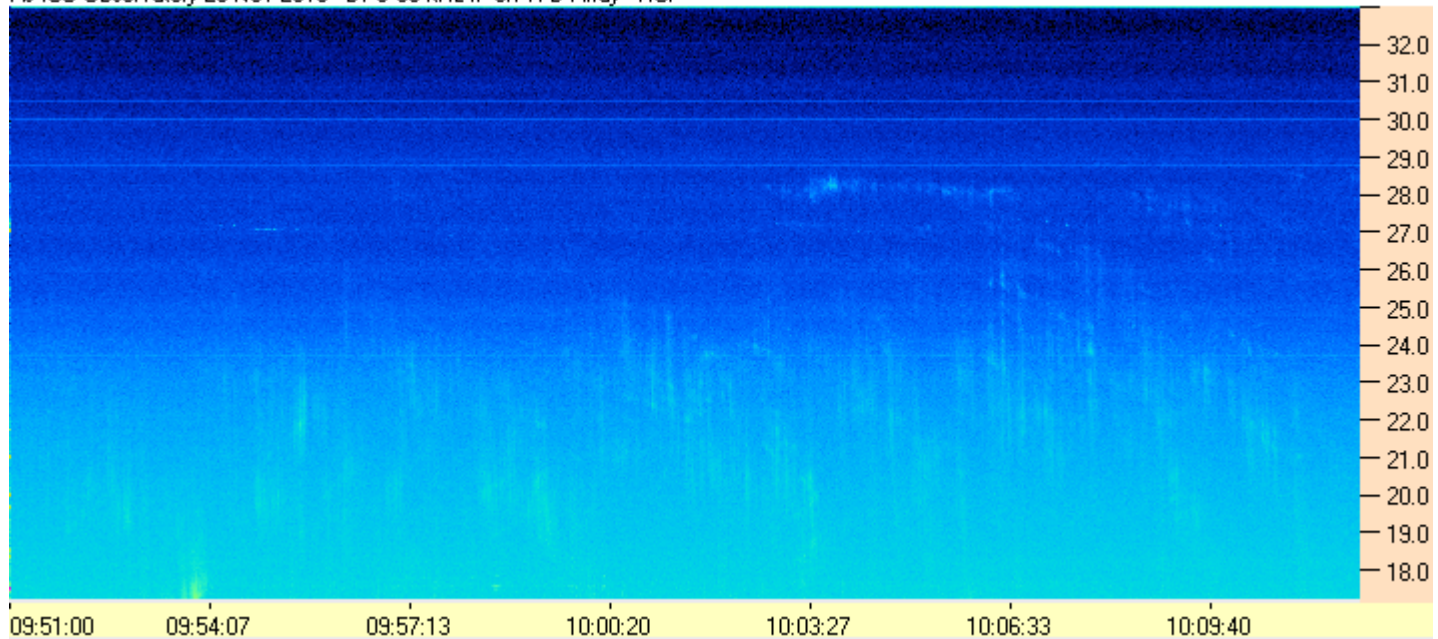
AJ400 Observatory 20 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - RCP



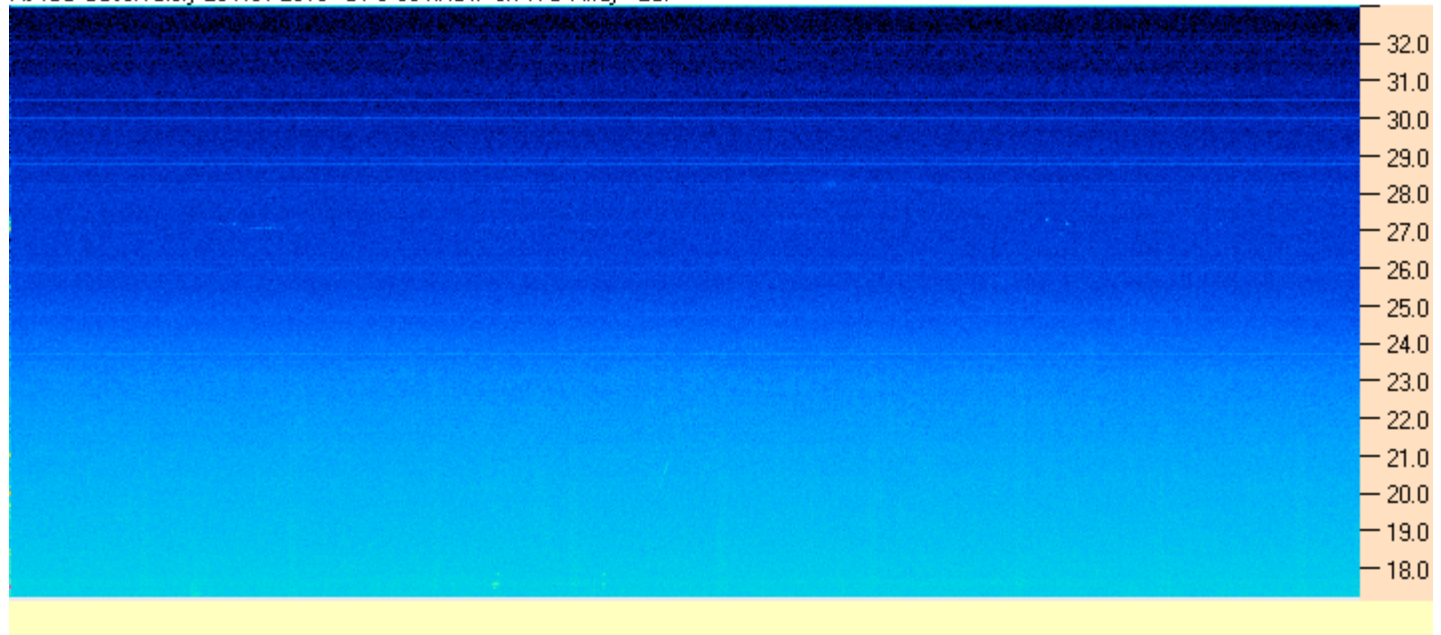
AJ4CQ Observatory 20 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - LCP



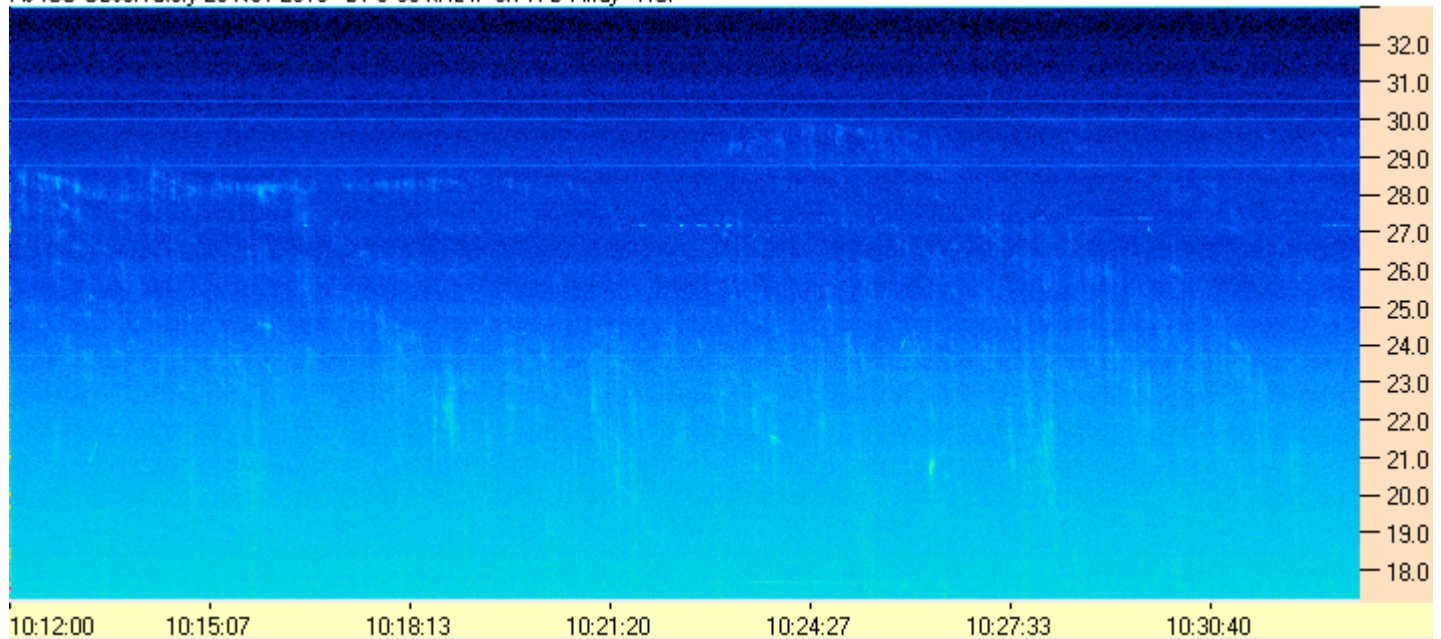
