Here is this morning's Io-B. Nice event, with mixed N events and S bursting. All RCP emission.

The narrow banded emission (N events) occurred between 20 and 23 MHz and appeared to be primarily narrow band S bursts.

There was some wider-banded S bursting visible between 17 and 20 MHz.

Jupiter left the Jove receivers at 20 MHz relatively untouched.

Jupiter was off axis from 34° to 18°.

Jupiter was leading the Sun by 139°.

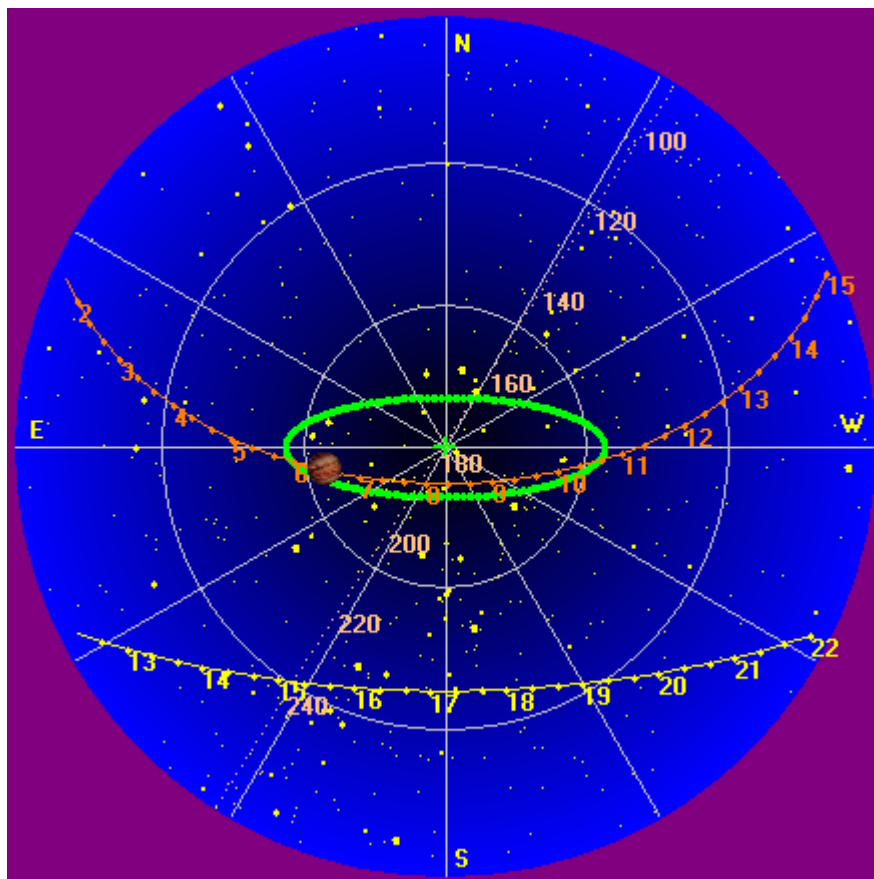
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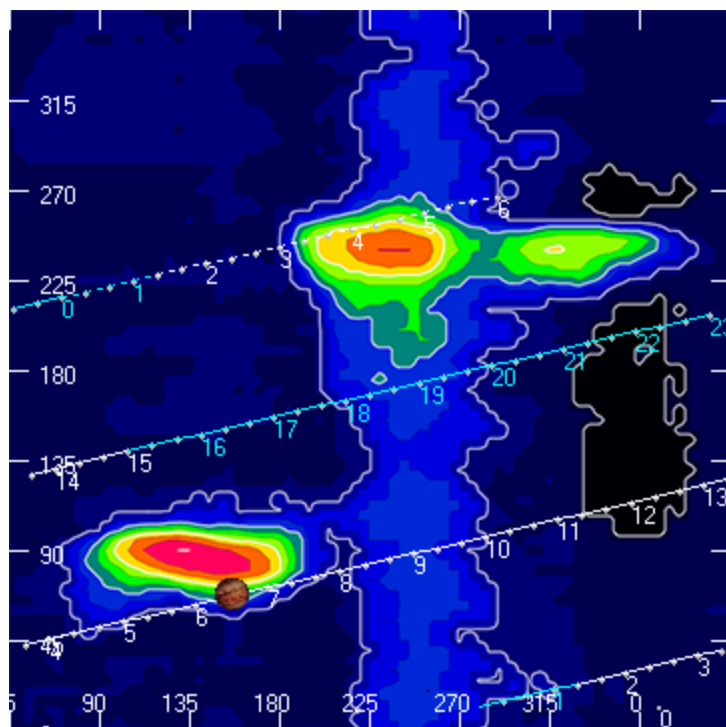

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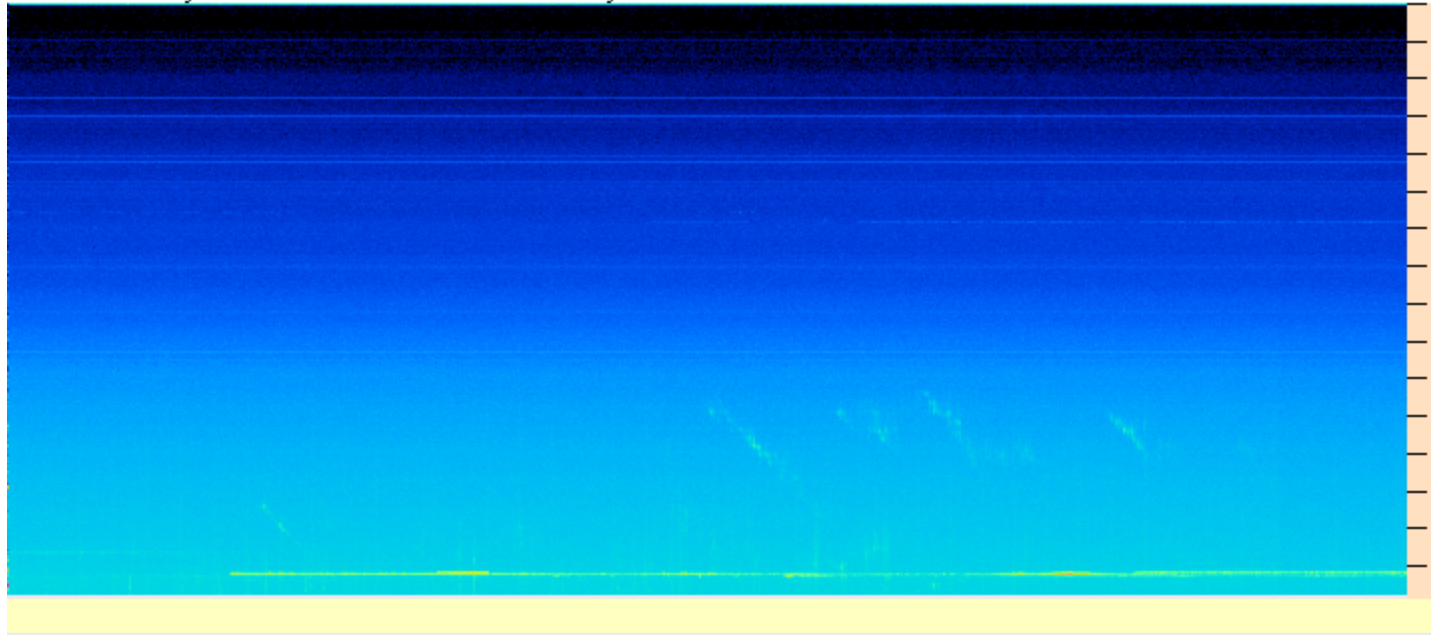




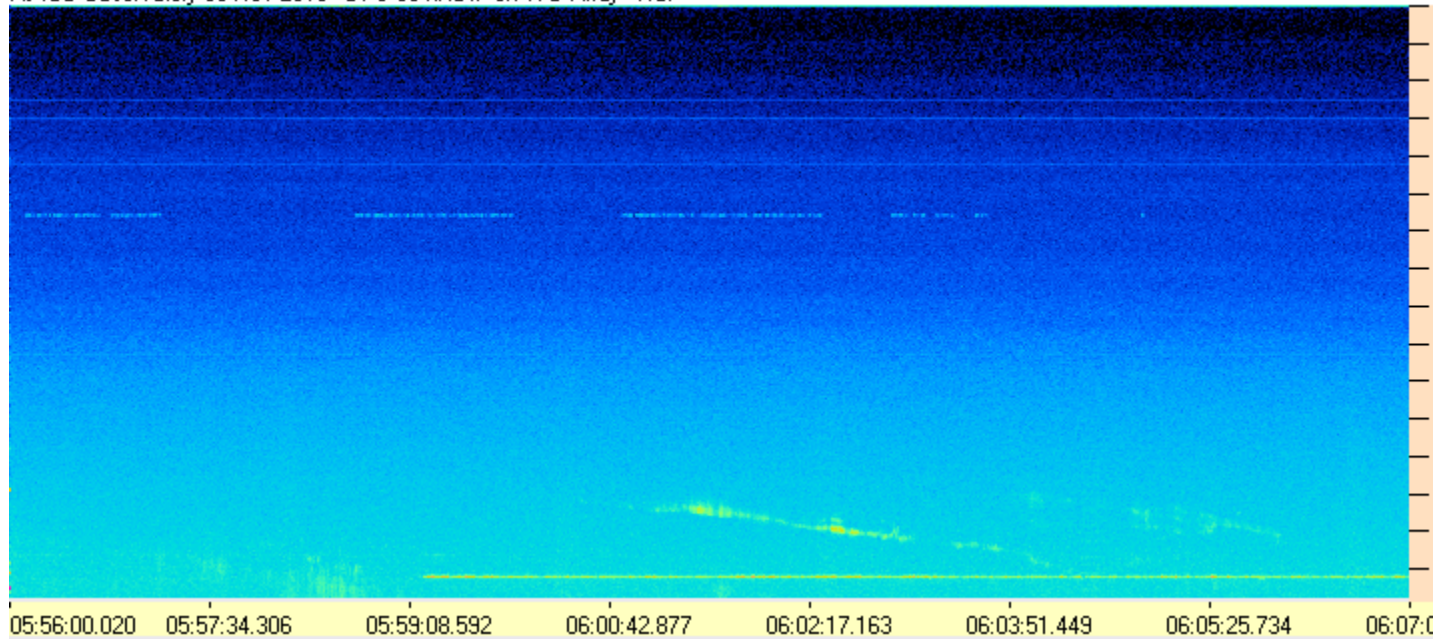
AJ4CD Observatory 30 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - RCP



AJ400 Observatory 30 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - LCP

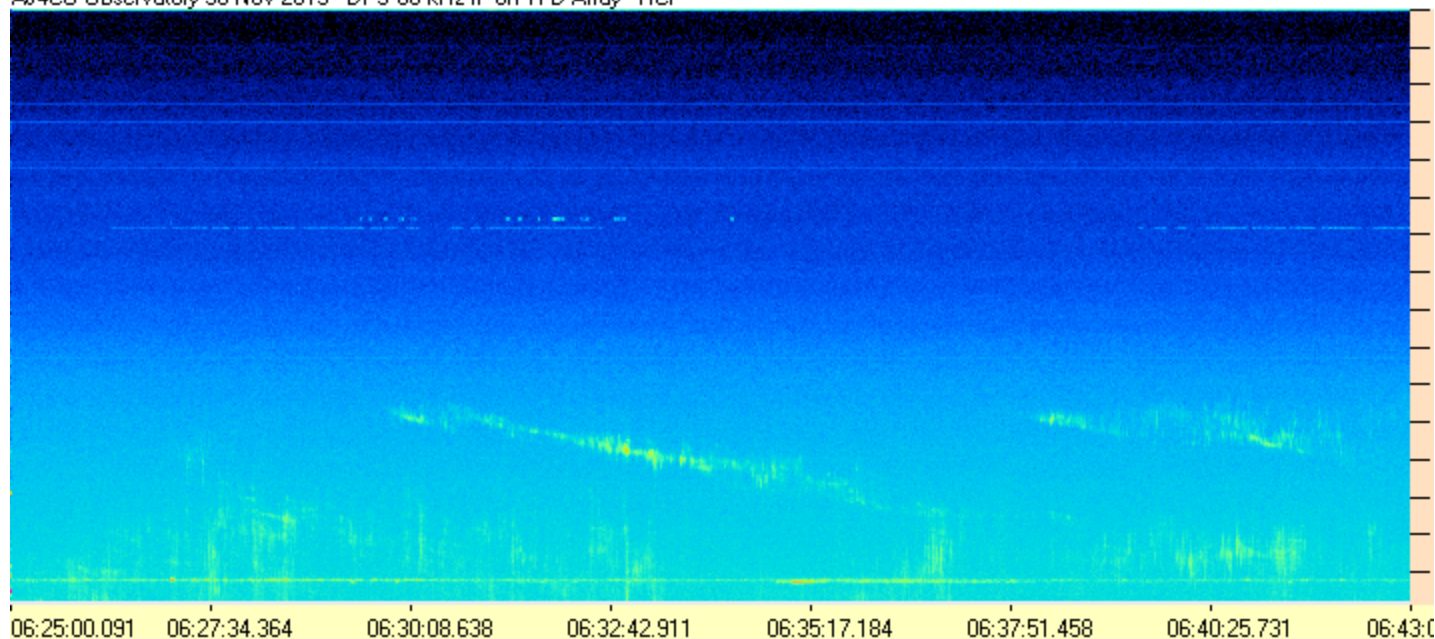

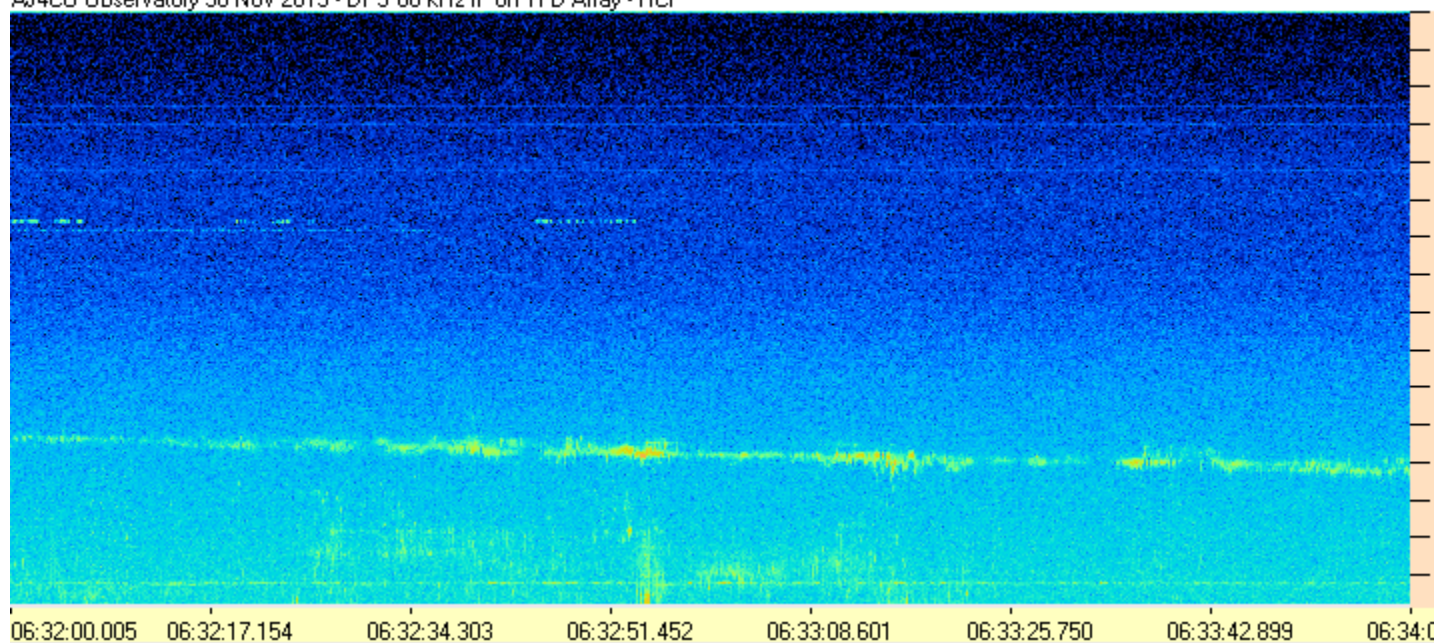

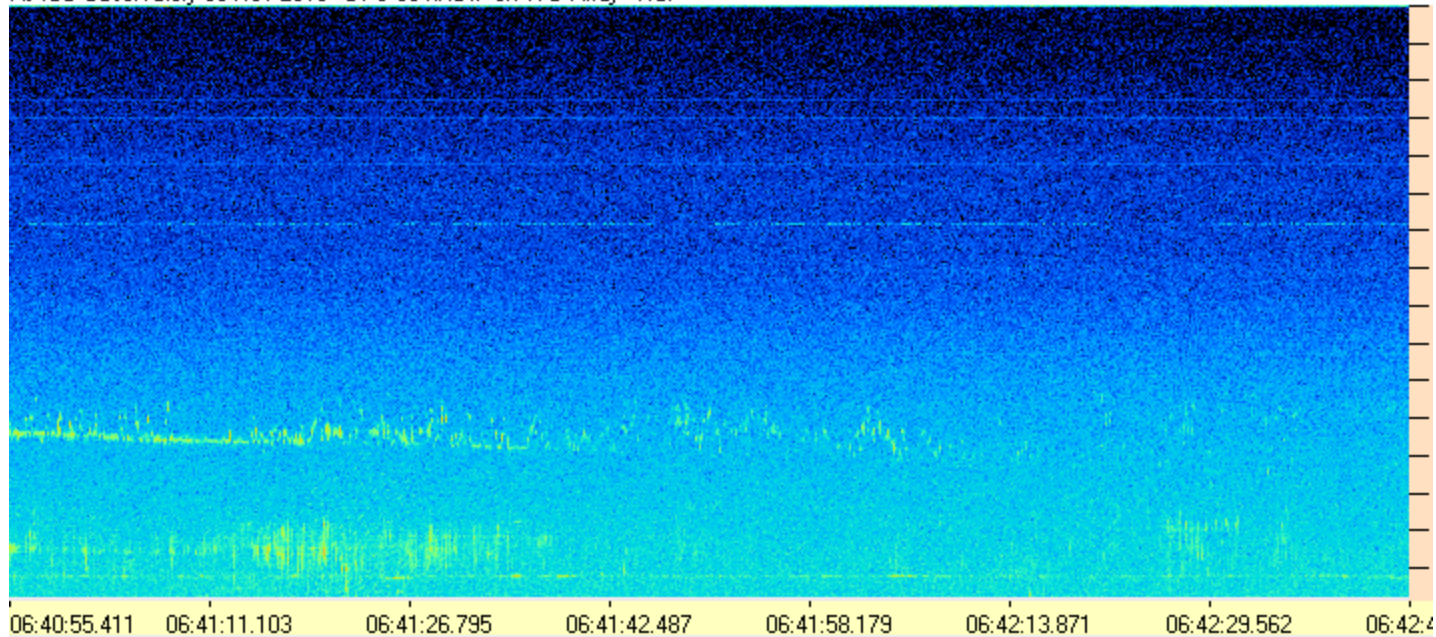

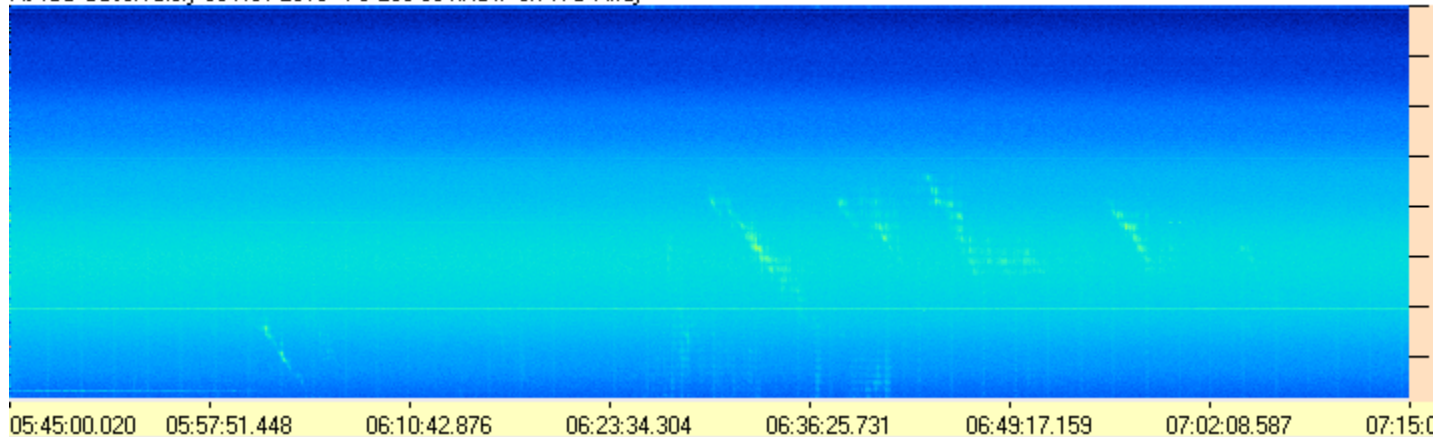




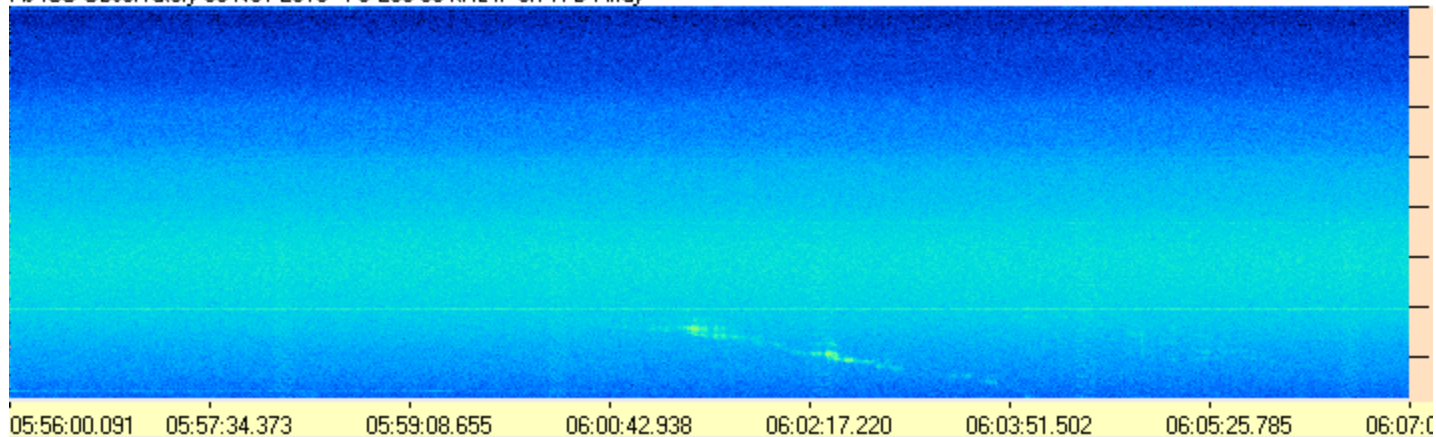
AJ4CO Observatory 30 Nov 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - RCP



AJ4CO Observatory 30 Nov 2013 - FS-200 30 kHz IF on TFD Array

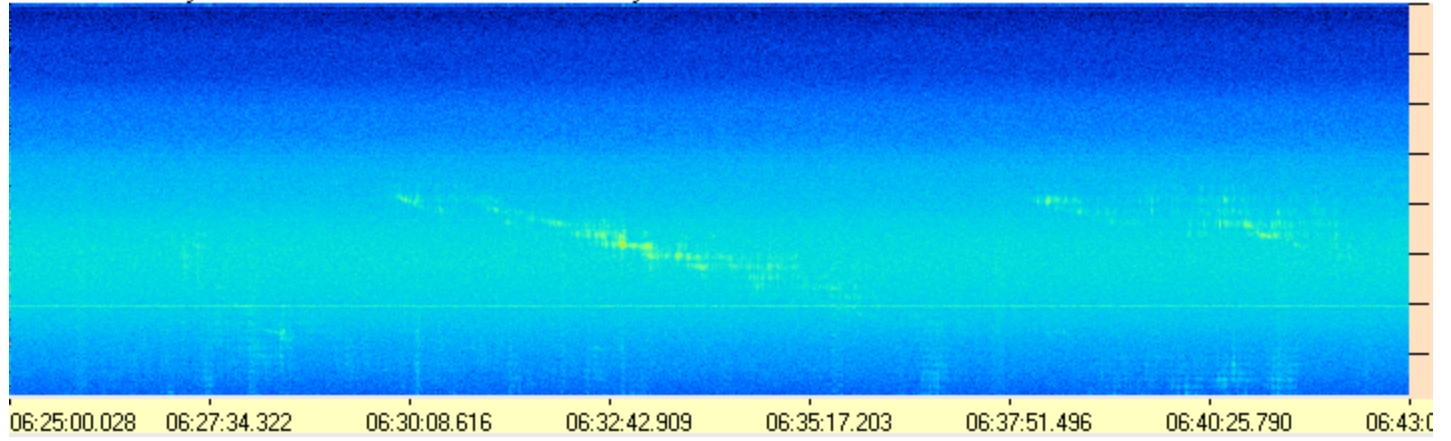

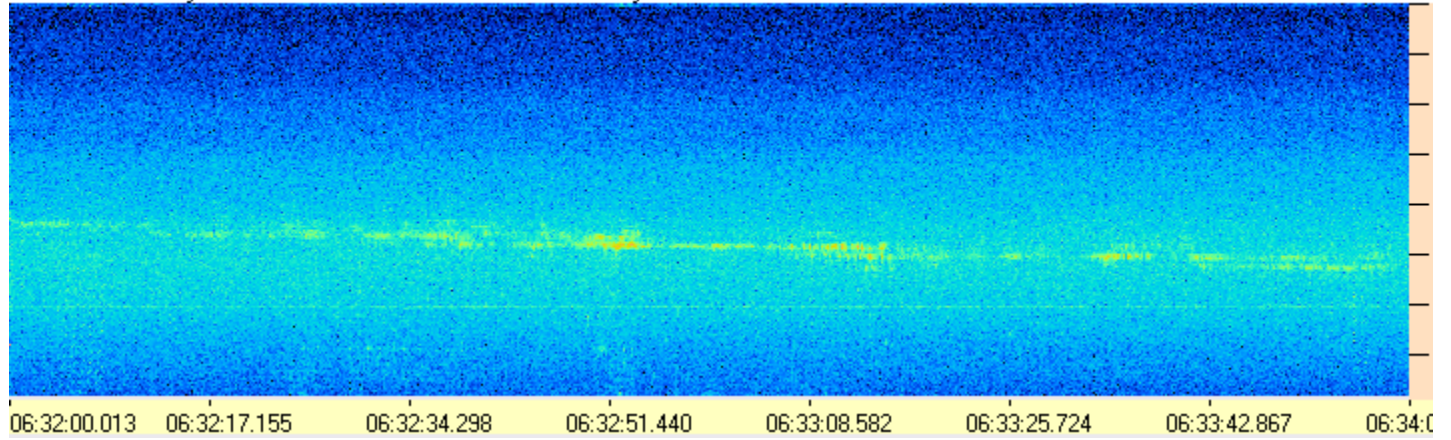
