The TFD array underwent a config change, which left the polarization temporarily reversed -- so RCP is on the bottom in these spectrograms.

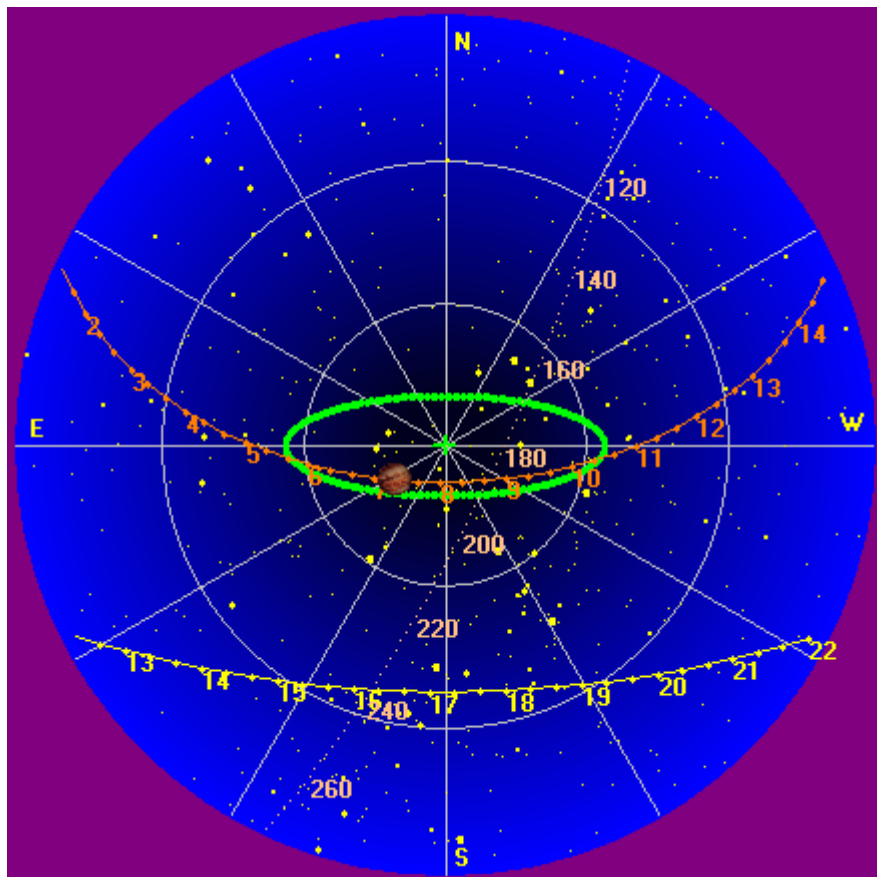
Jupiter was off axis from 23° to 10°.

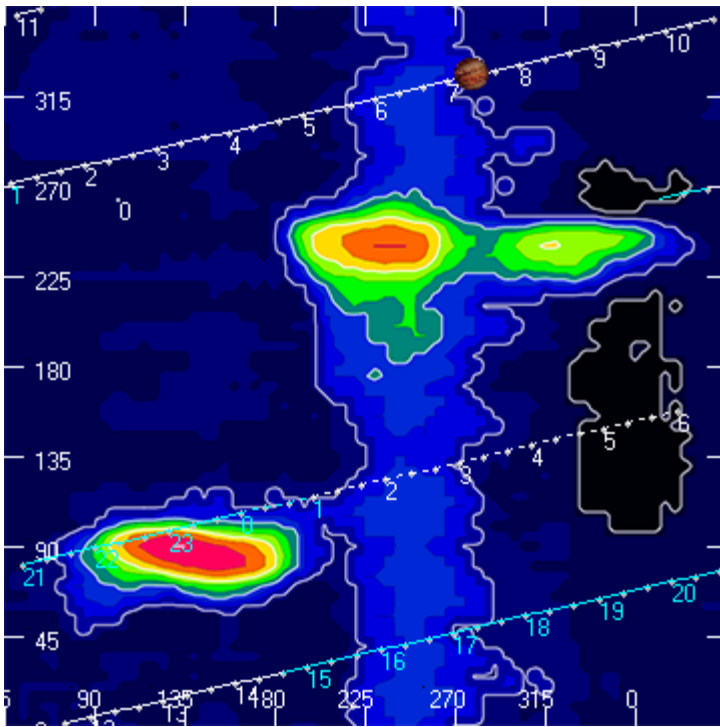
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 142°.

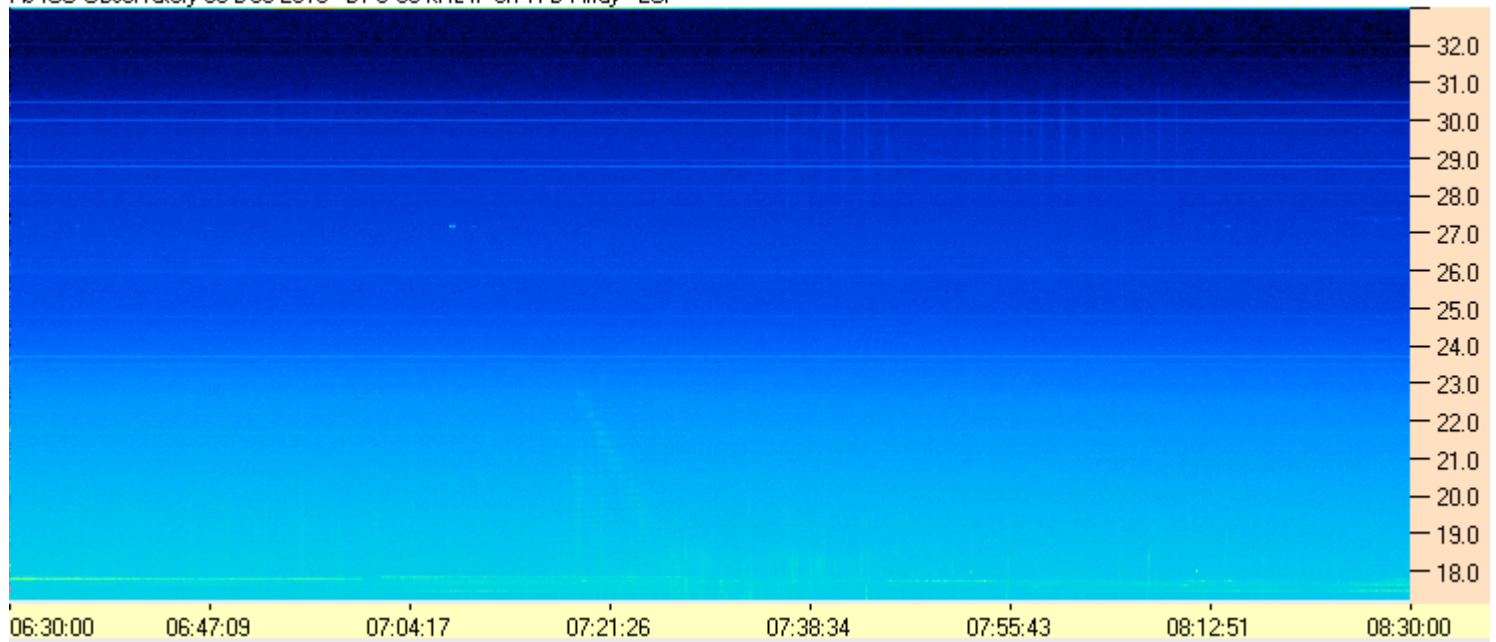

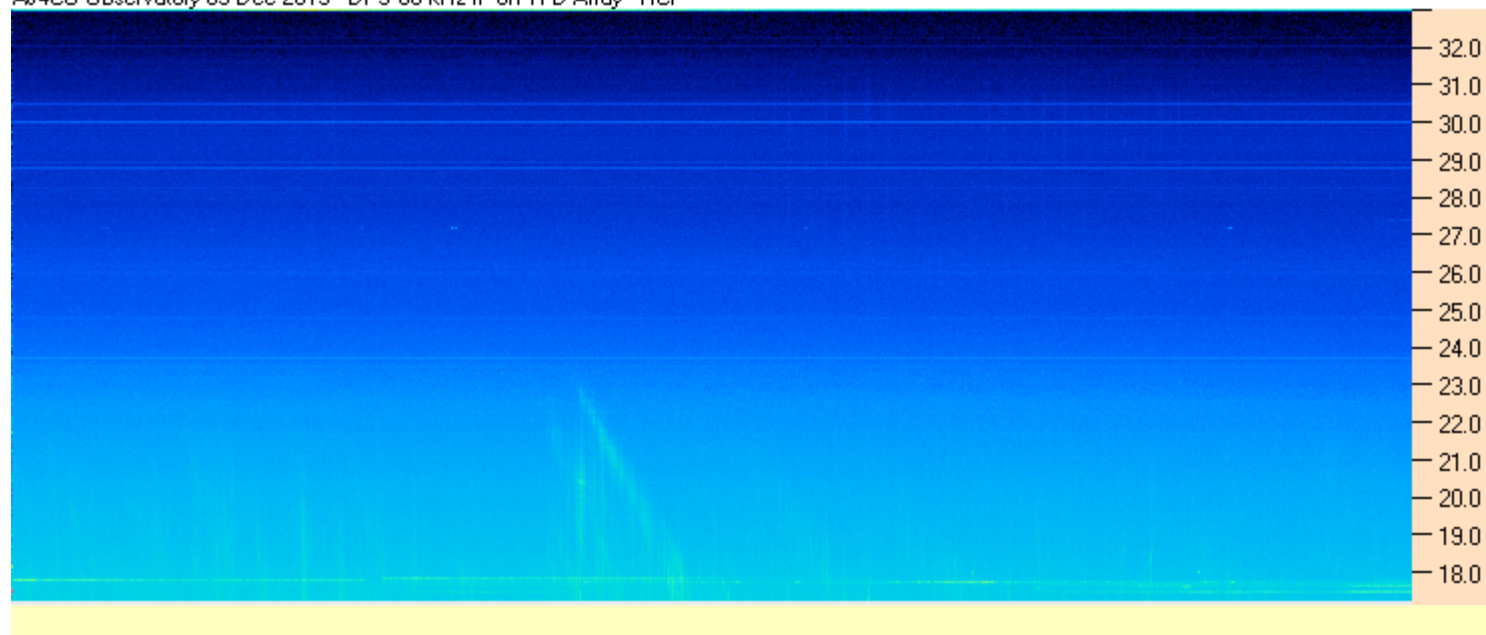




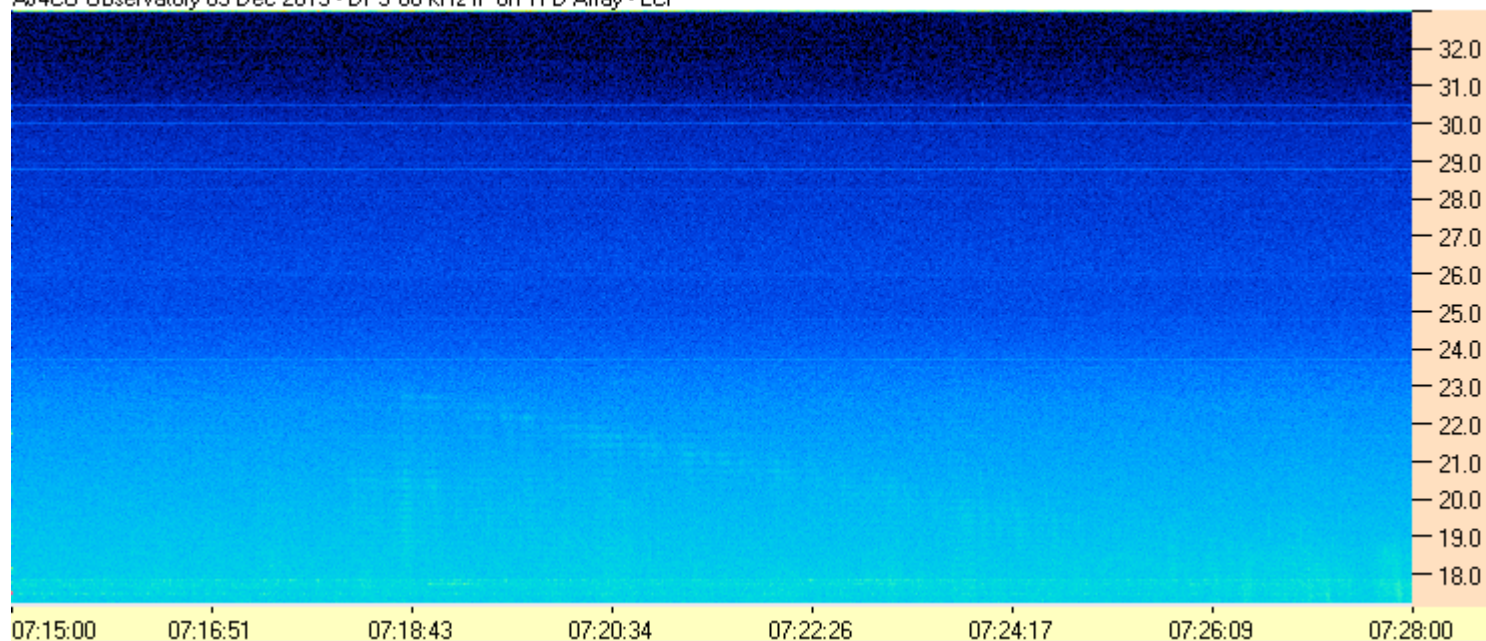
AJ4CO Observatory 03 Dec 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - LCP



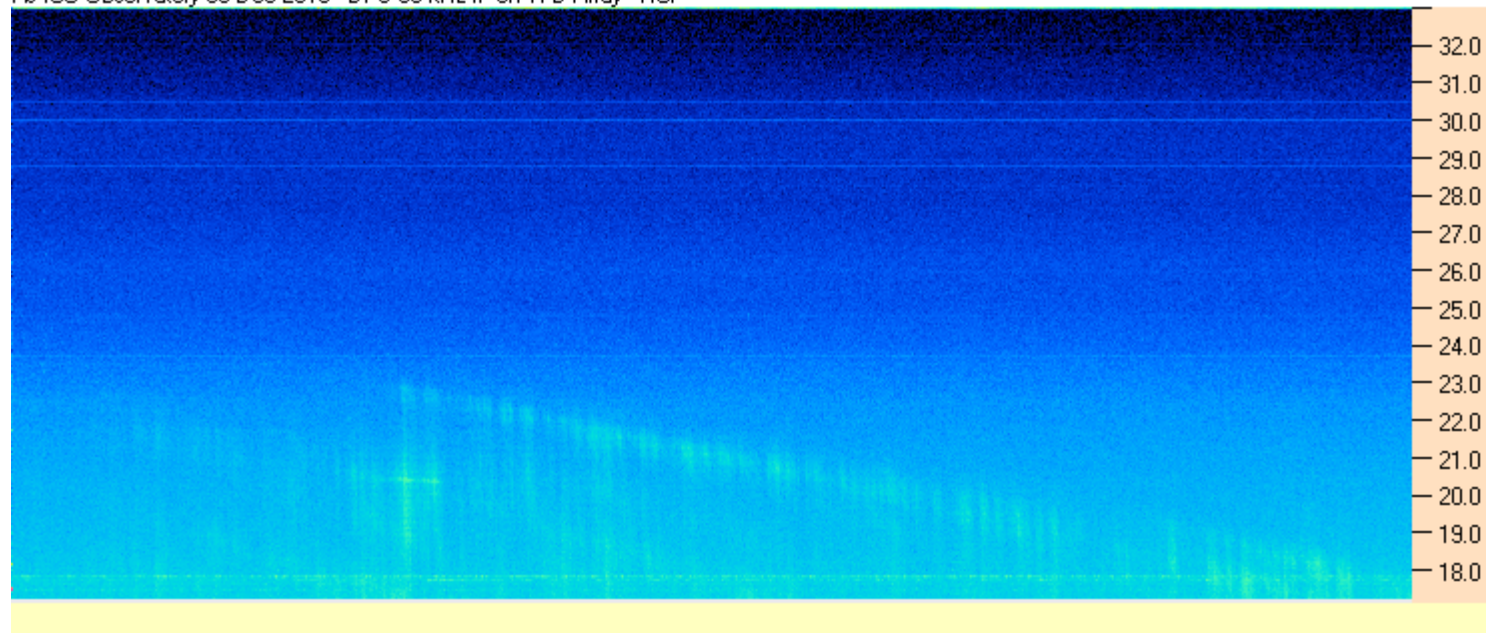
AJ4CO Observatory 03 Dec 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - RCP



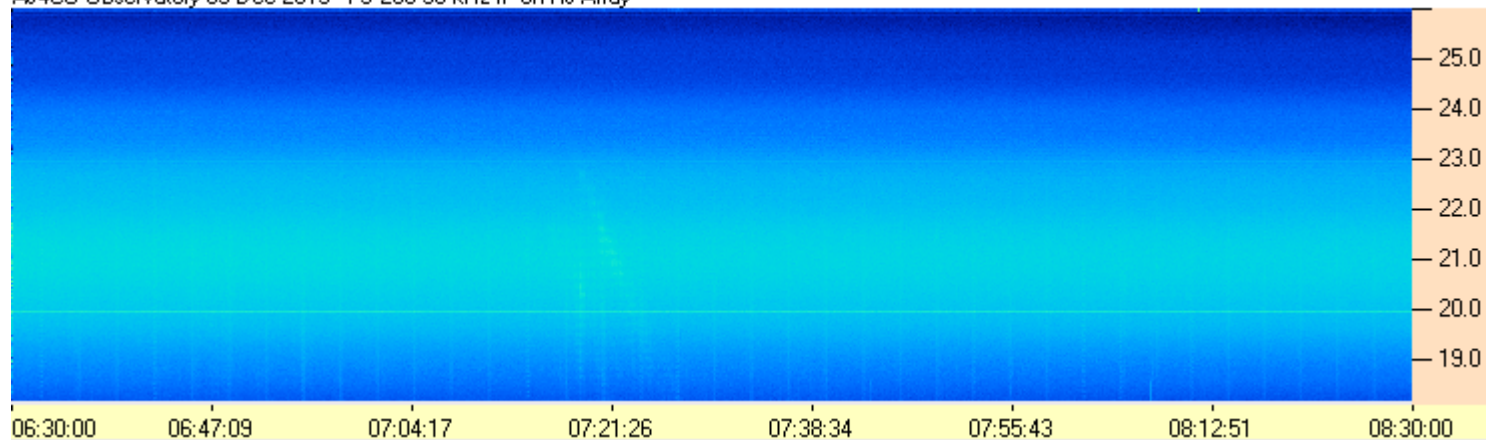
