Adding to Jim Brown's nice report, here's the non-Io-A from Thursday morning. All RCP.

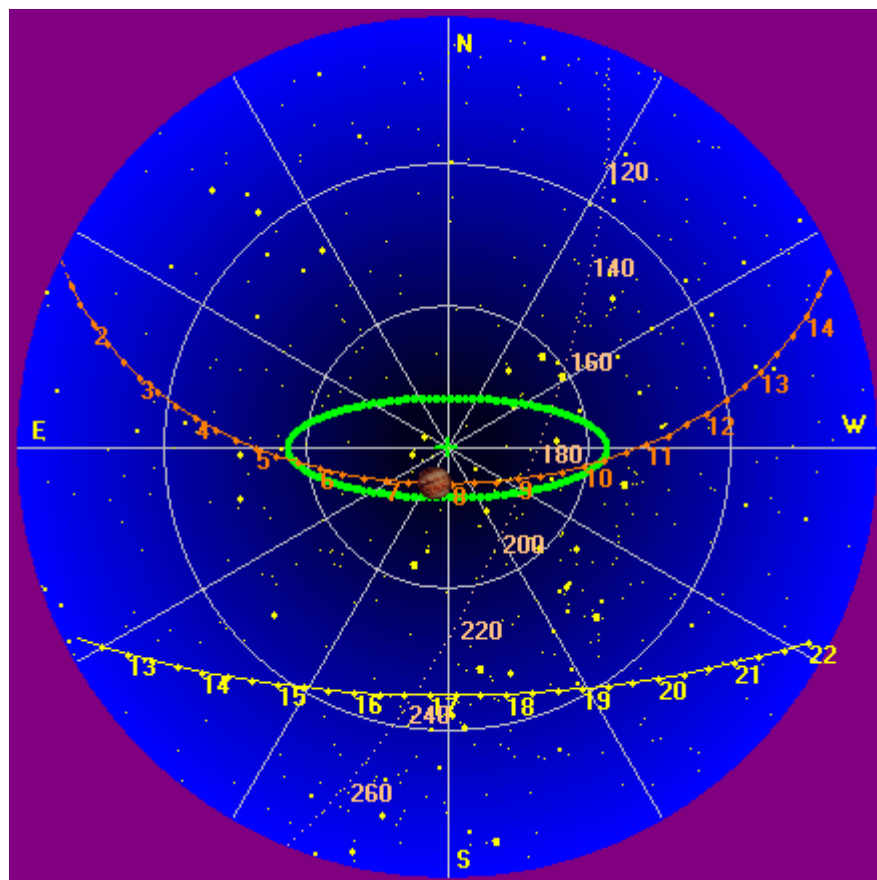
Jupiter was off axis from 11° to 8° .

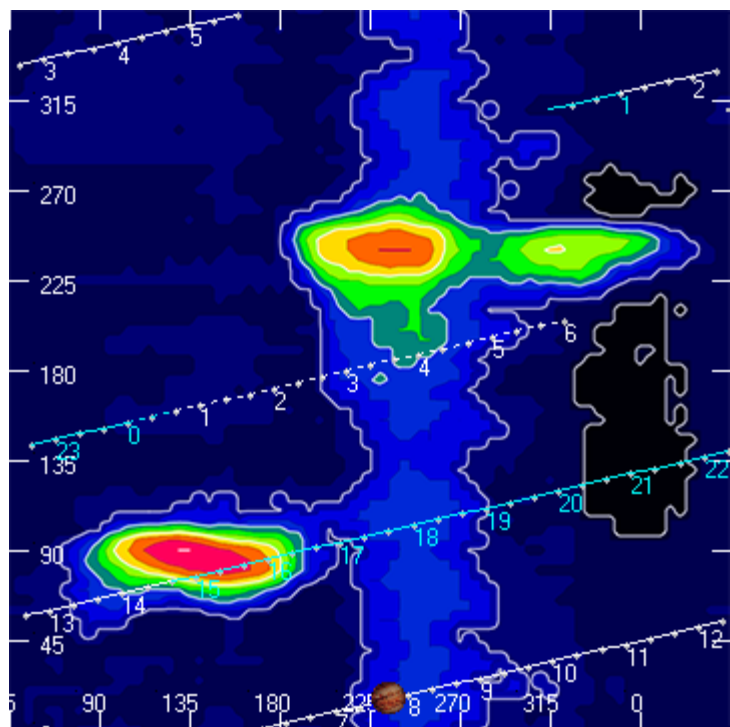
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 142° .

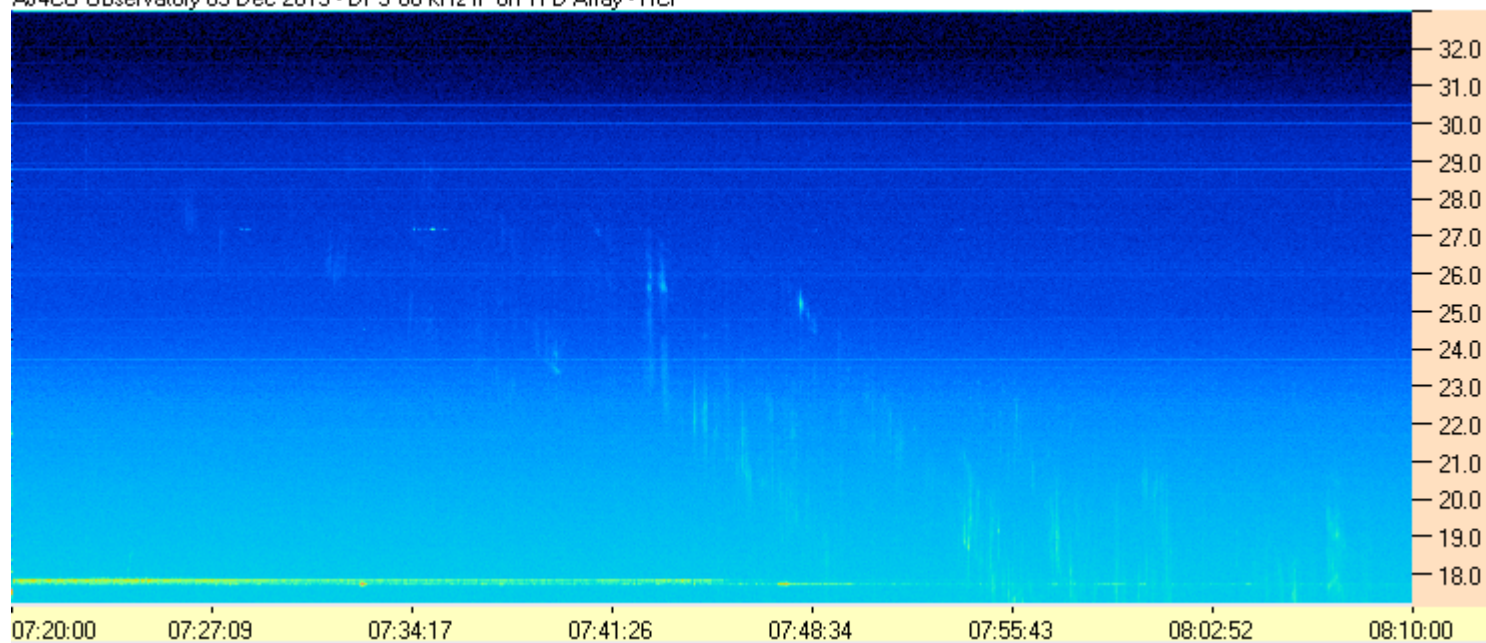

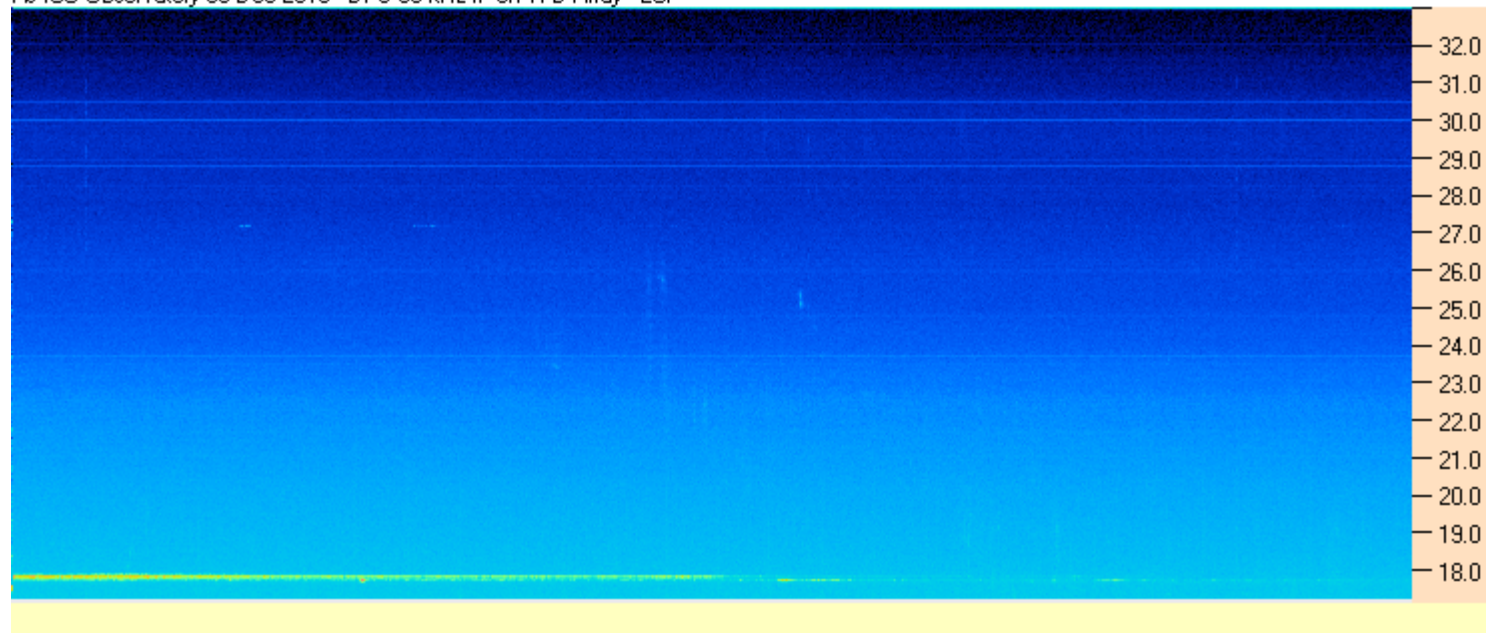




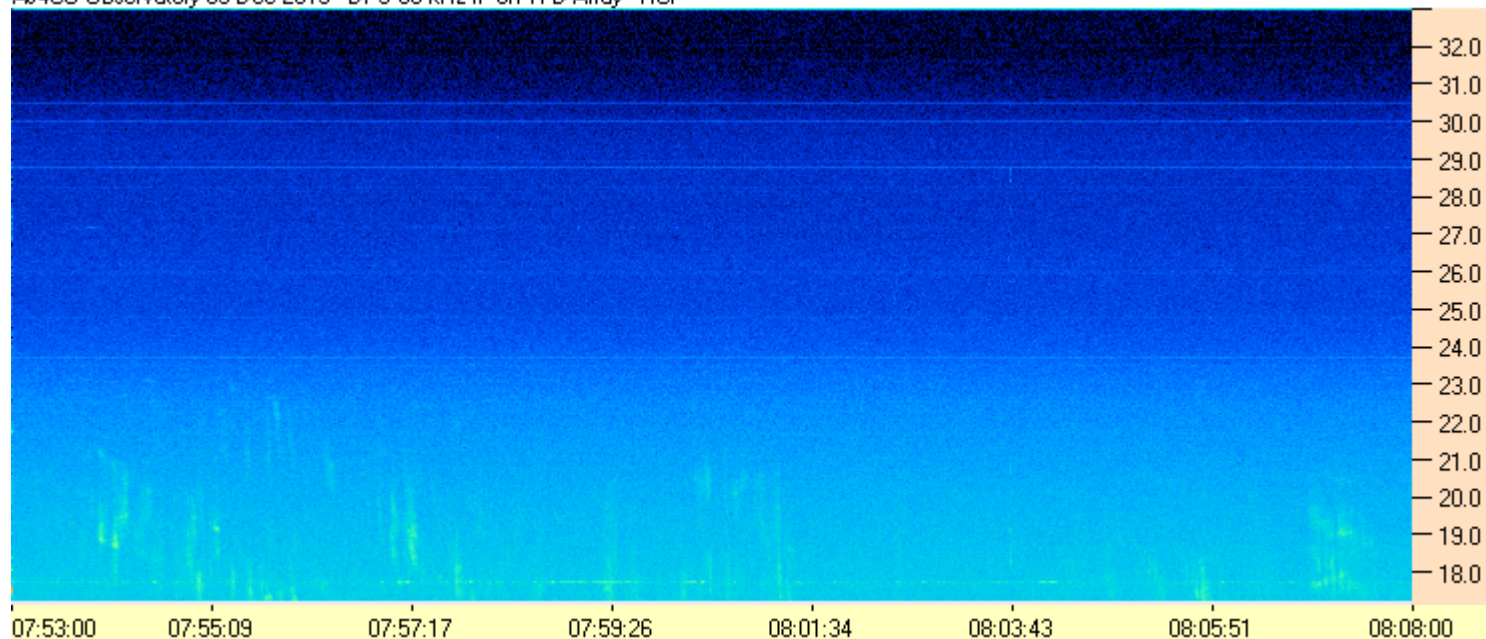
AJ4CO Observatory 05 Dec 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - RCP



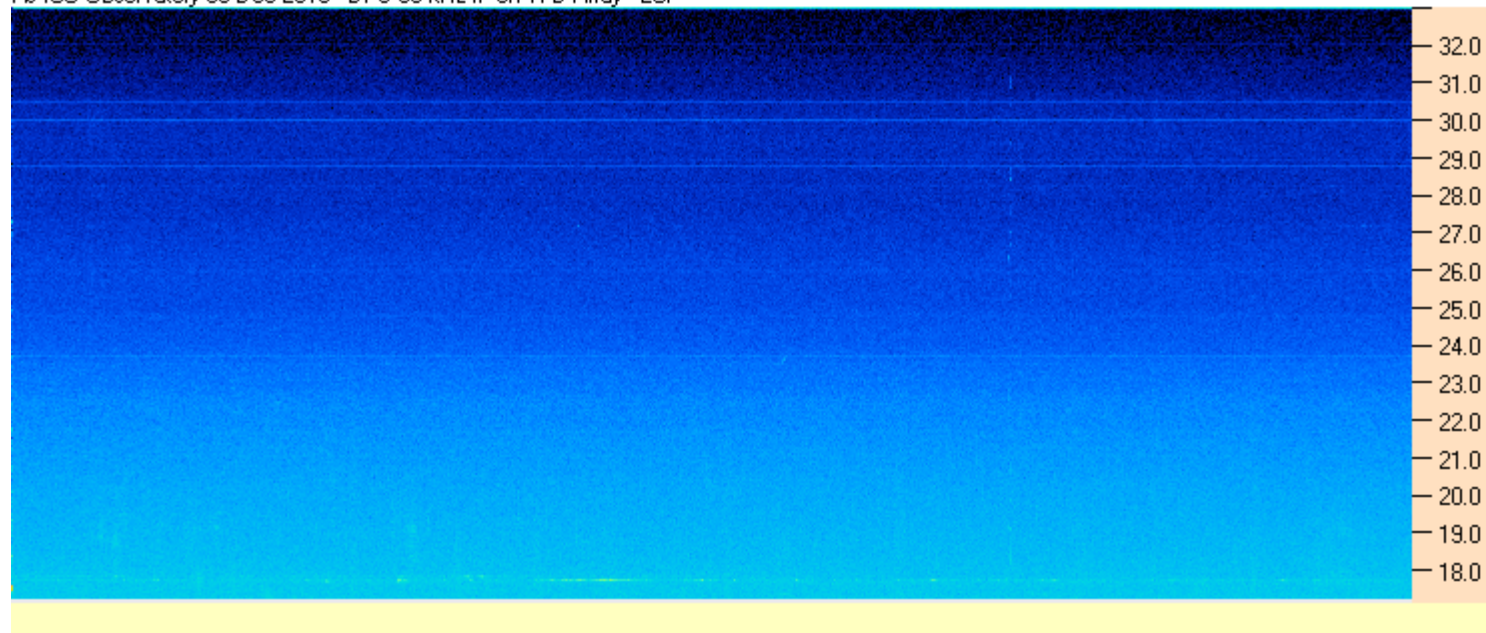
AJ4CO Observatory 05 Dec 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array - LCP



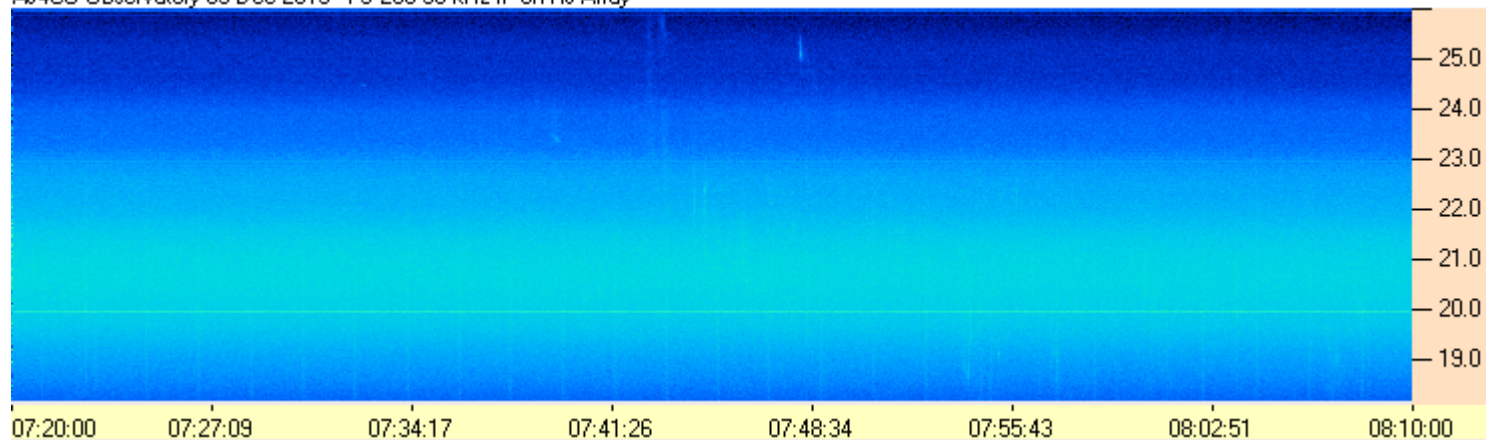
