Here's some weak non-Io-B from the 19th. RCP L bursting.from 18 to 21 MHz.

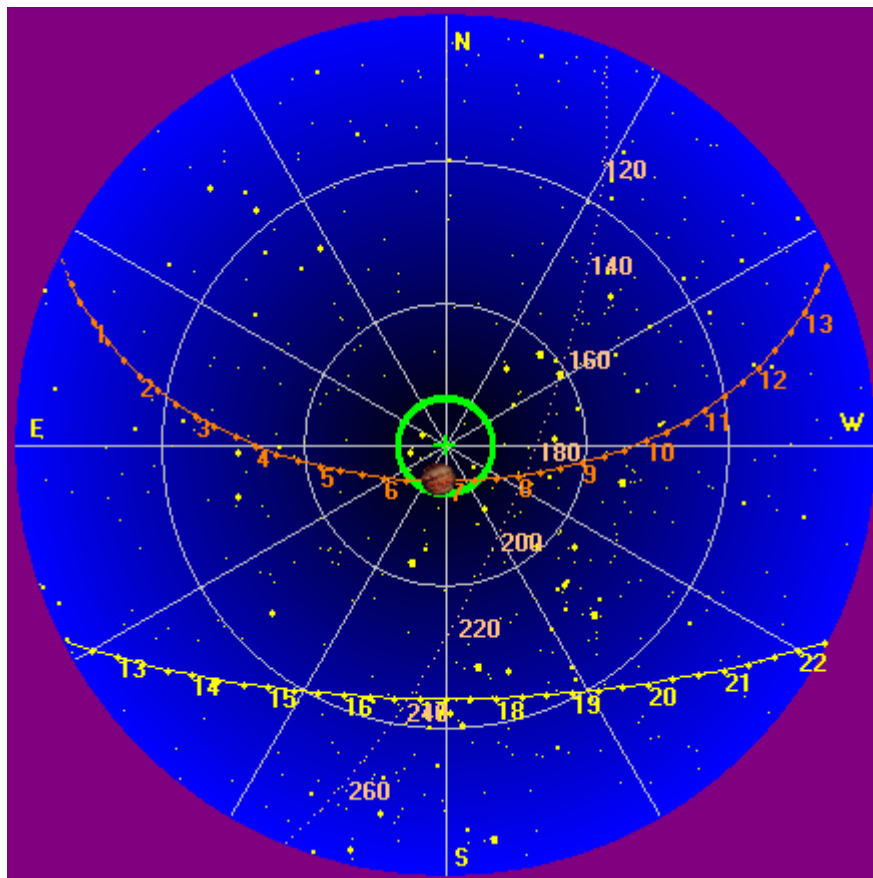
Jupiter was off axis 8° .

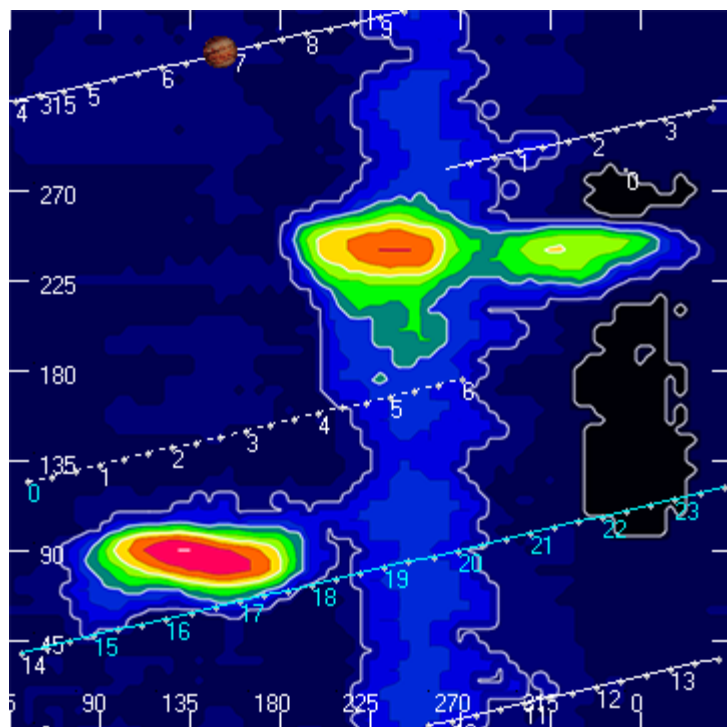
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 160° .

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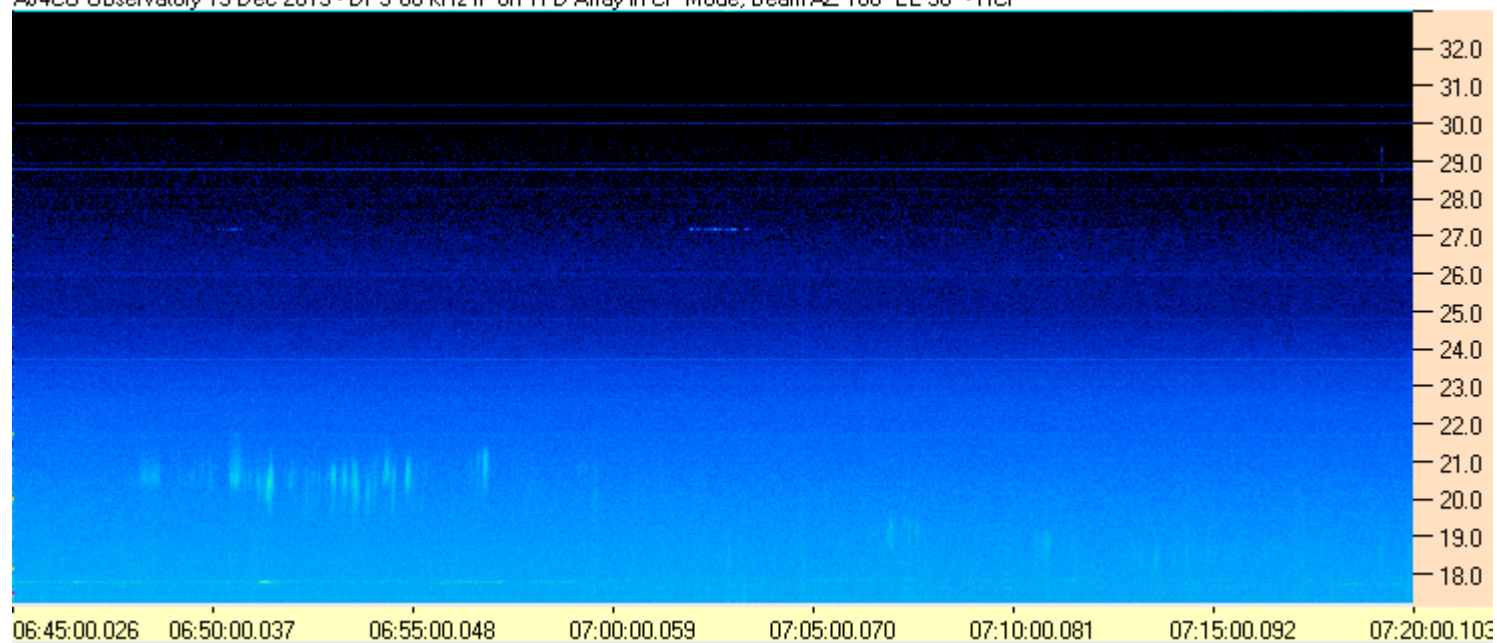

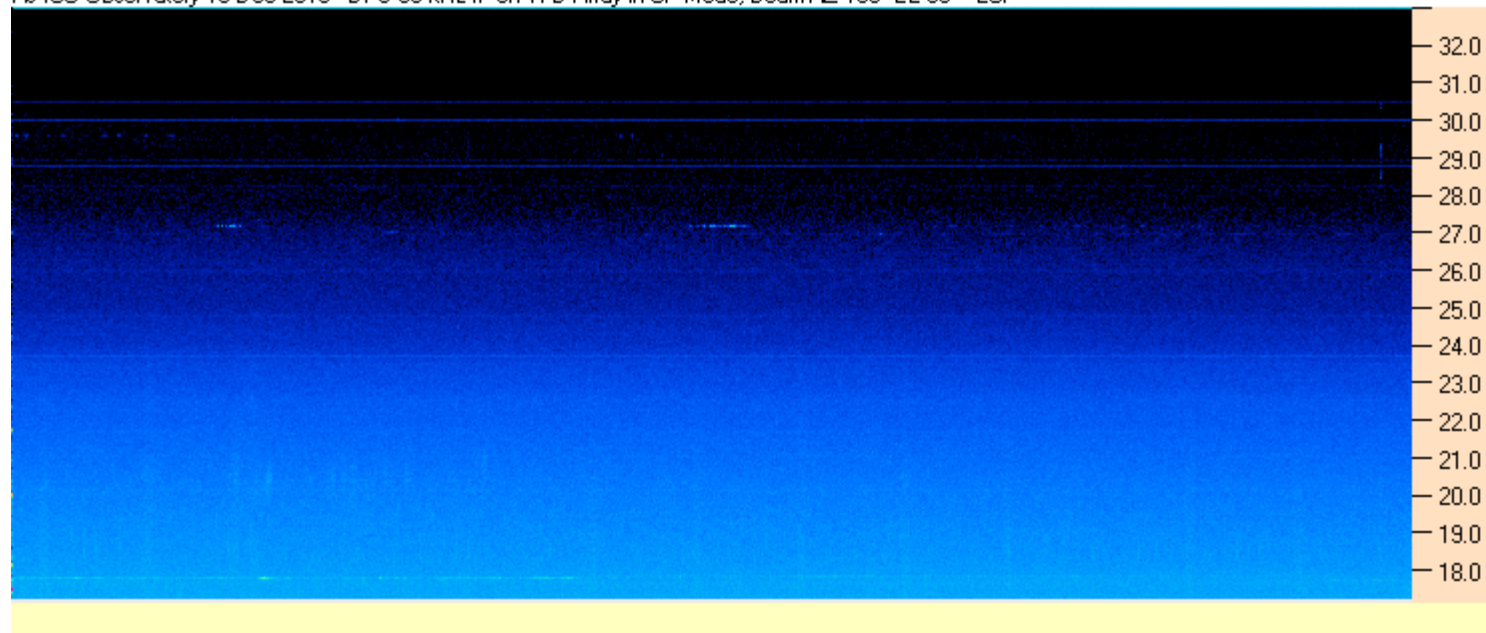




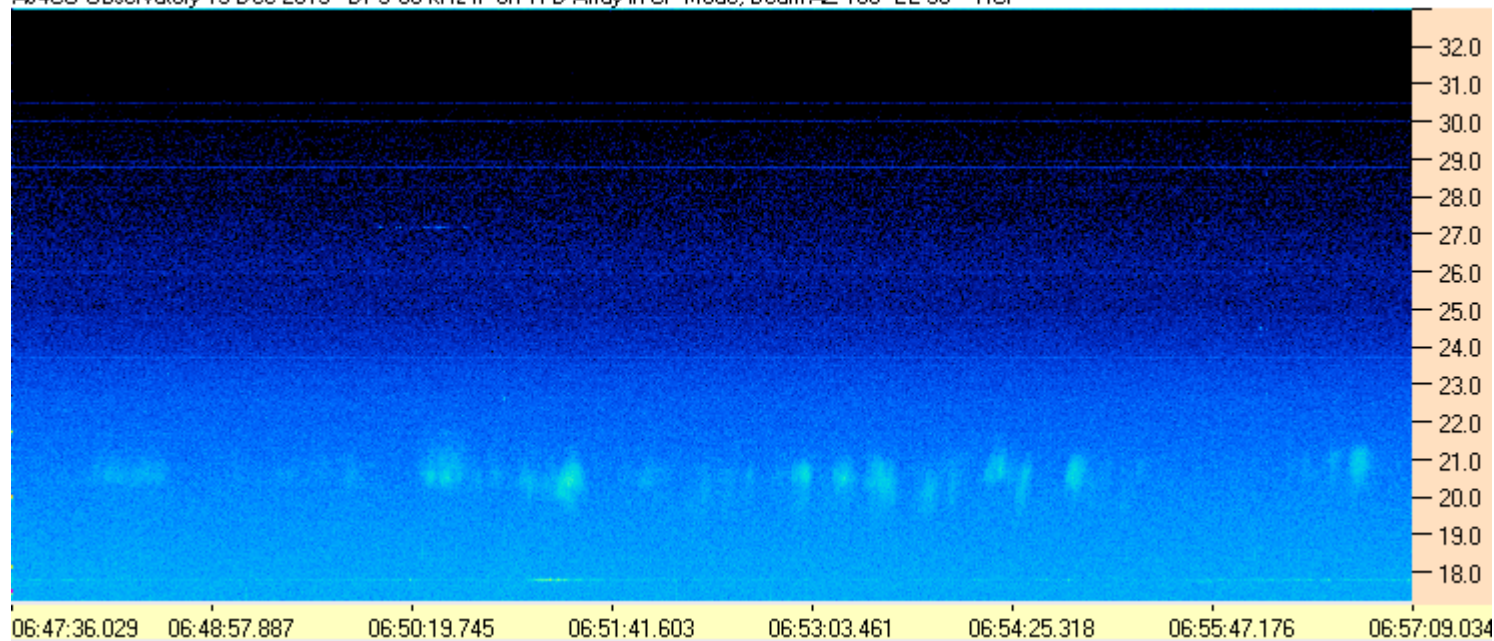

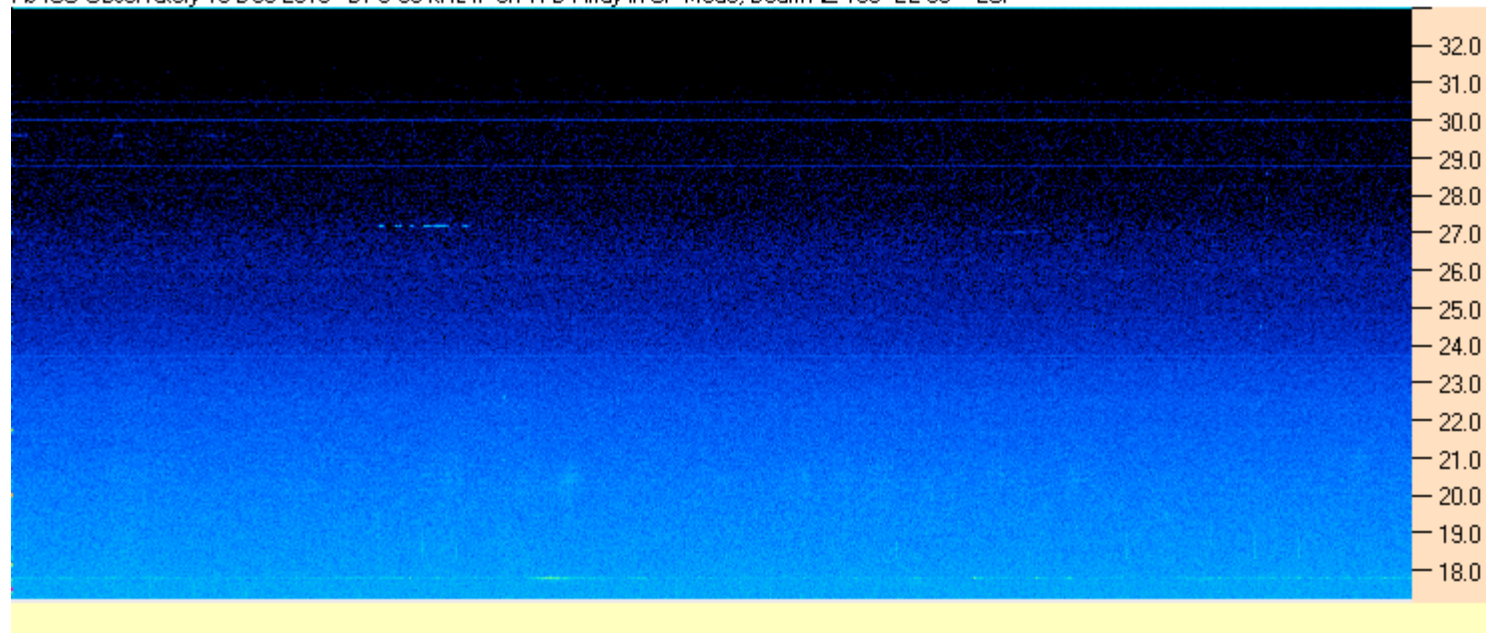

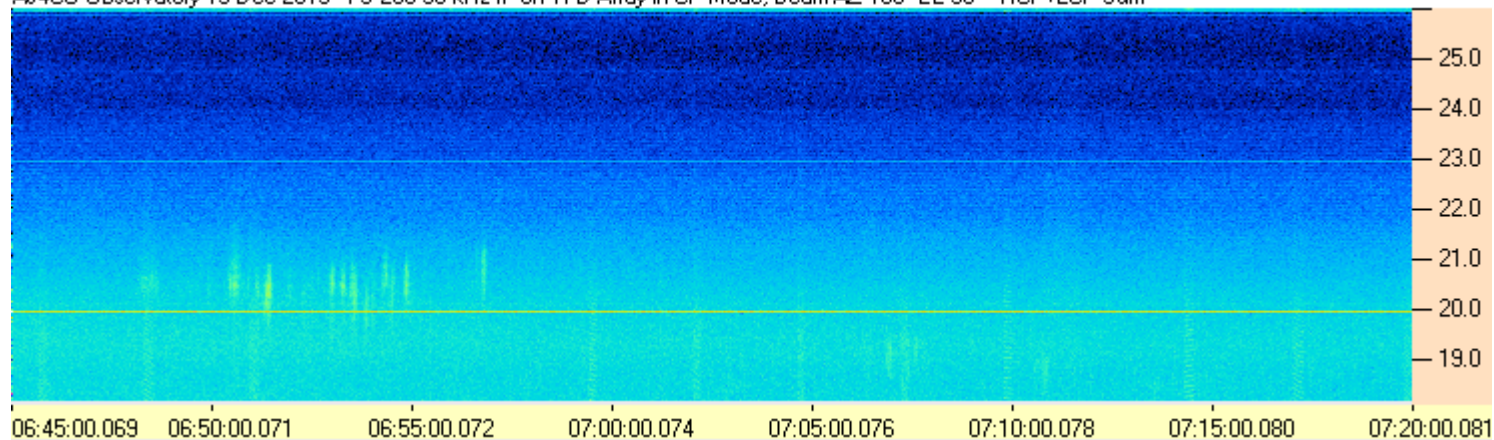
