One period of nice S bursting from 0733 to 0739 covering 17 to 22 MHz.

Looked like a very brief N event from 0612 to 0613 at 23 MHz.

Very distinct negatively sloping modulation lanes form 0714 to 0718.


lo-C, around 0845, was very weak and also RCP, all below 23 MHz.
