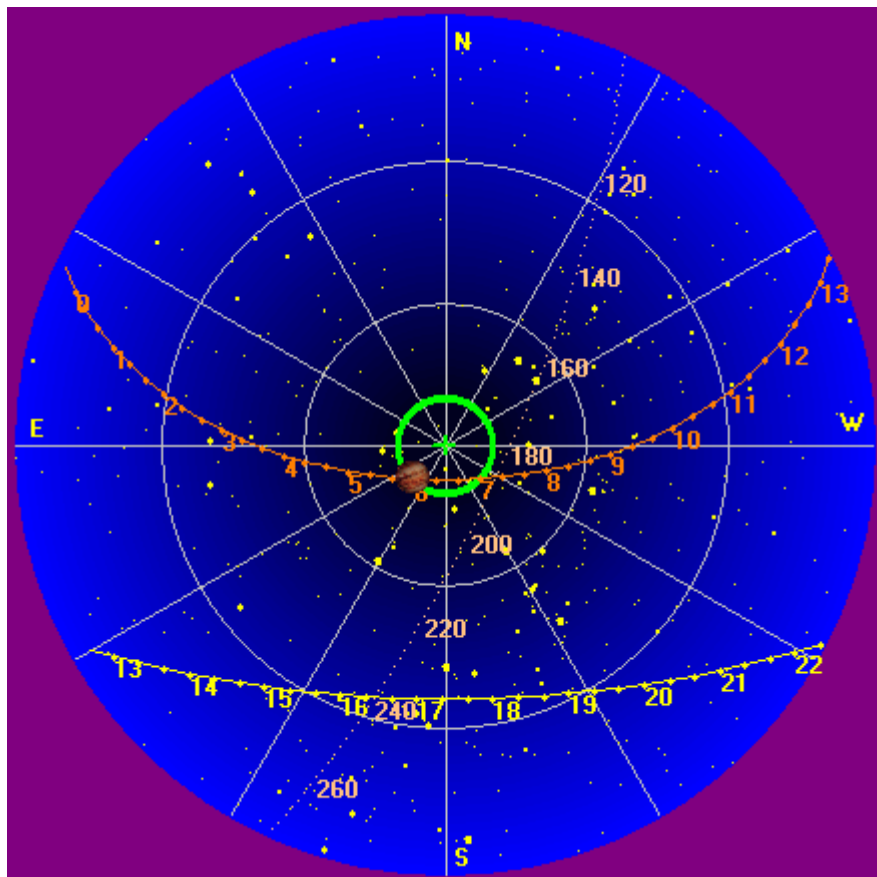
Jupiter was off axis by about 10° .

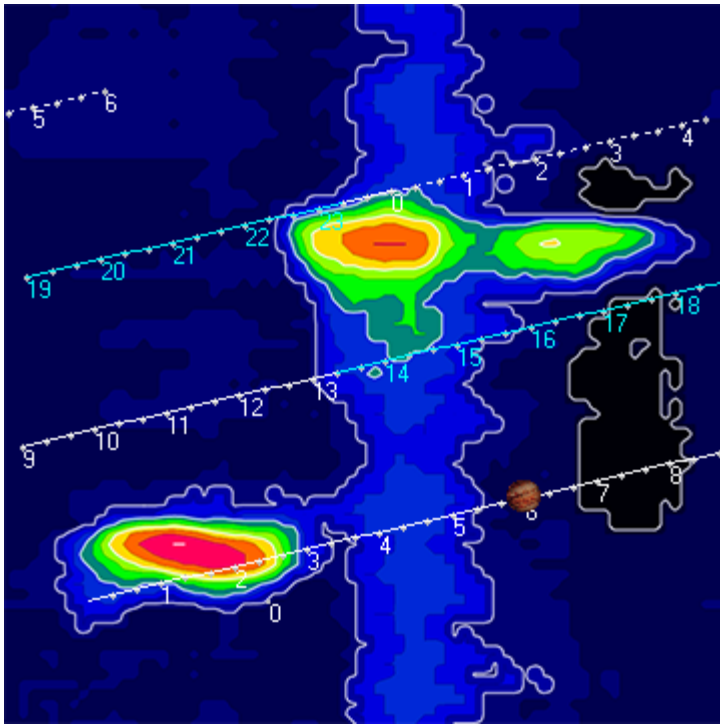
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 167° .

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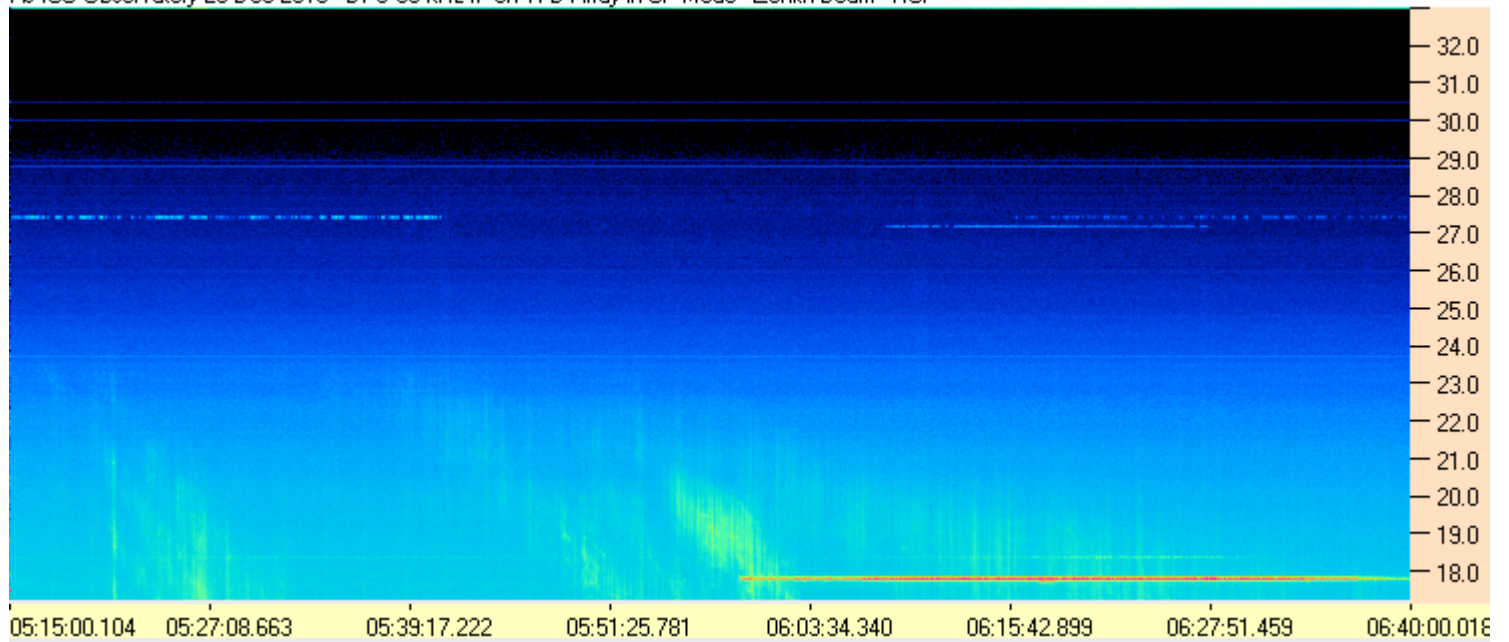

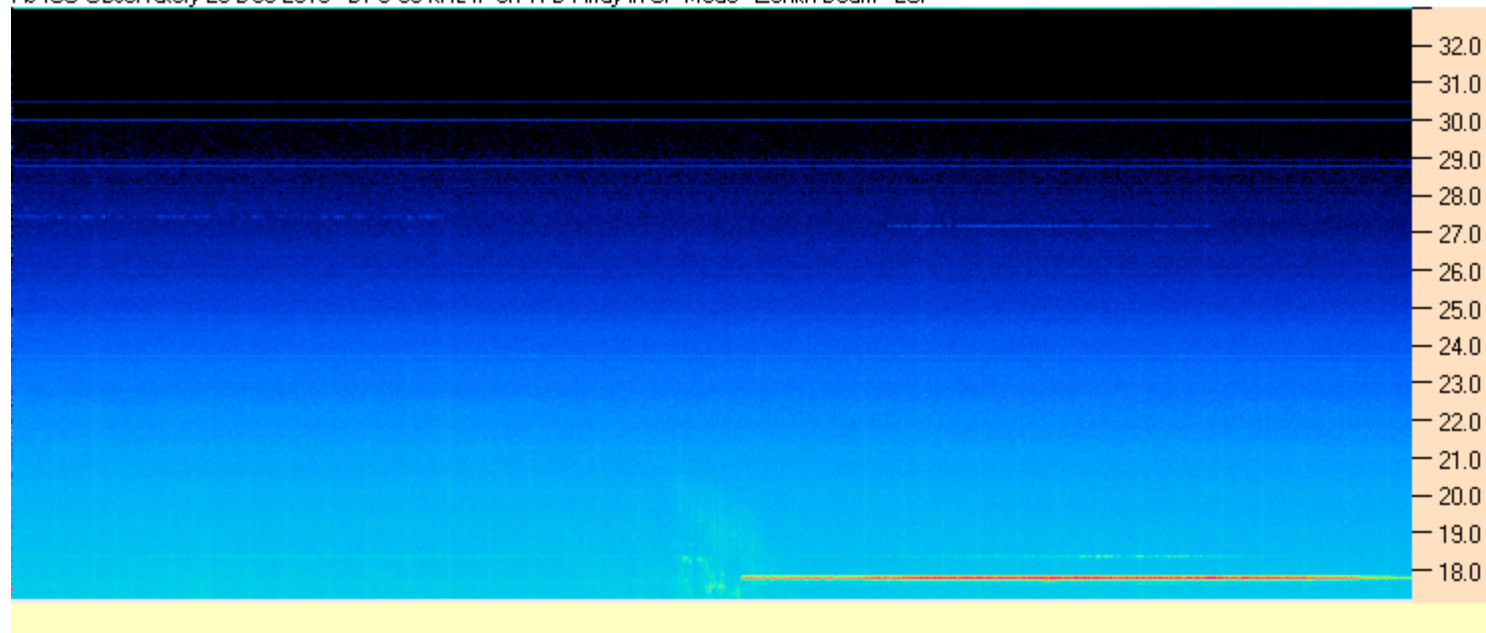




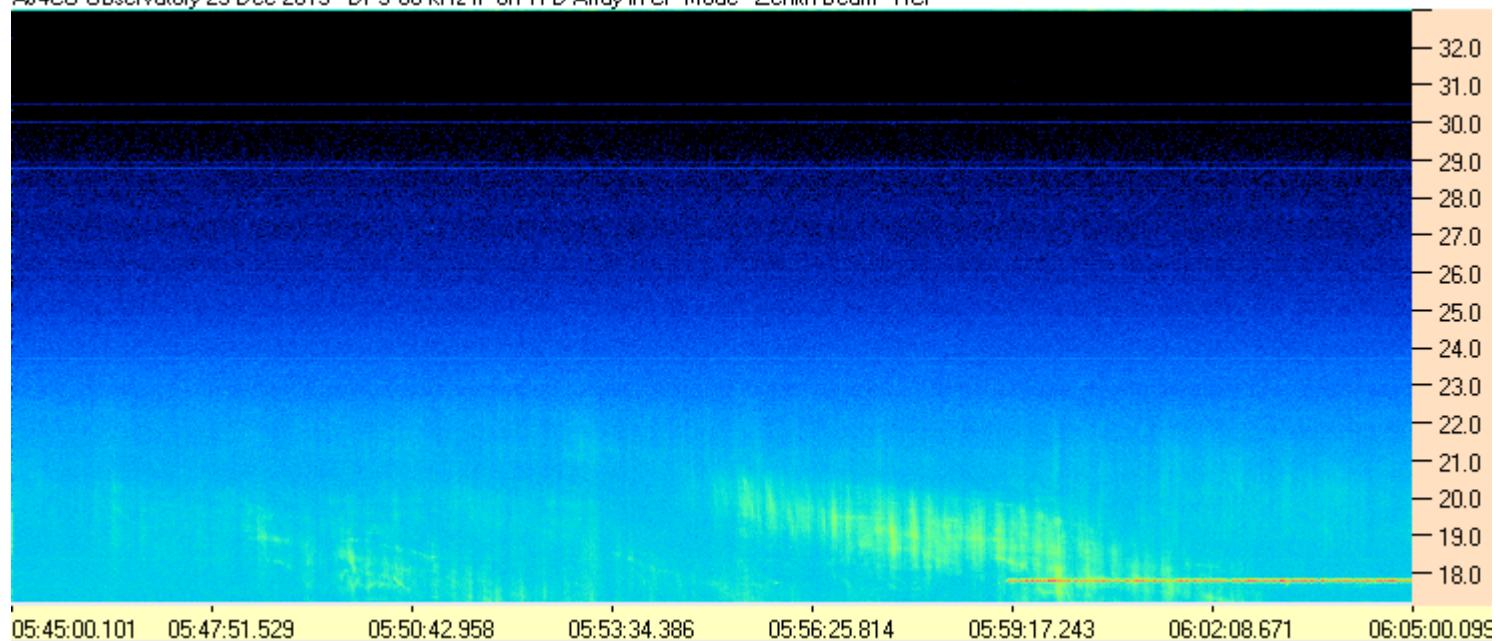
AJ4CO Observatory 25 Dec 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - Zenith Beam - RCP



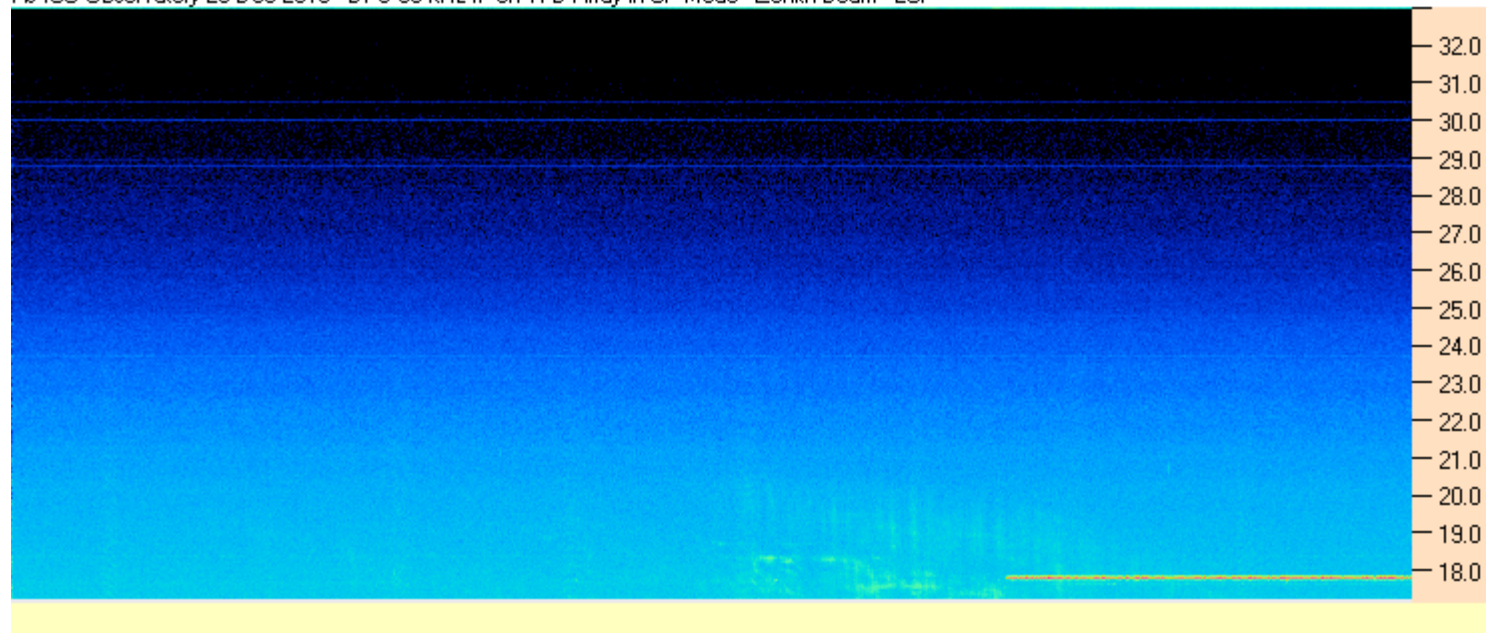
AJ4CO Observatory 25 Dec 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - Zenith Beam - LCP



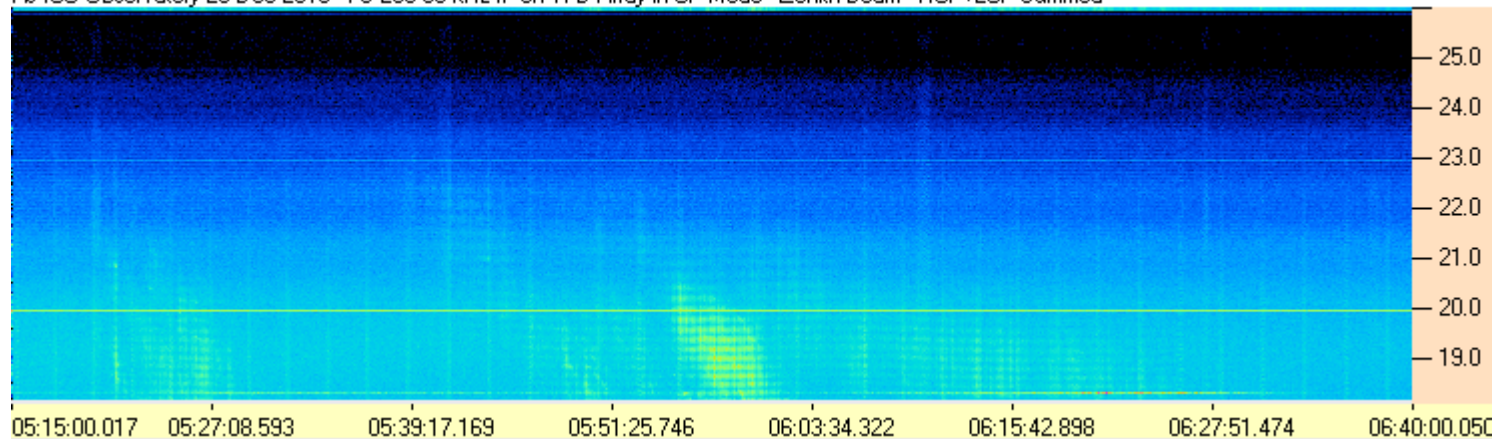
