Adding to Tom's nice report, here's this morning's non-lo-A.


Barely visible L bursts visible from 20 to 26 MHz. Probably RCP since the TFD seems to go CP backwards when the source is so far off axis..

Jupiter was off axis by about 50°. I'm surprised the DPS saw this stuff at all. Nothing at all in the UFRO spectro or the Jove receivers.


Jupiter was leading the Sun by 168°.




