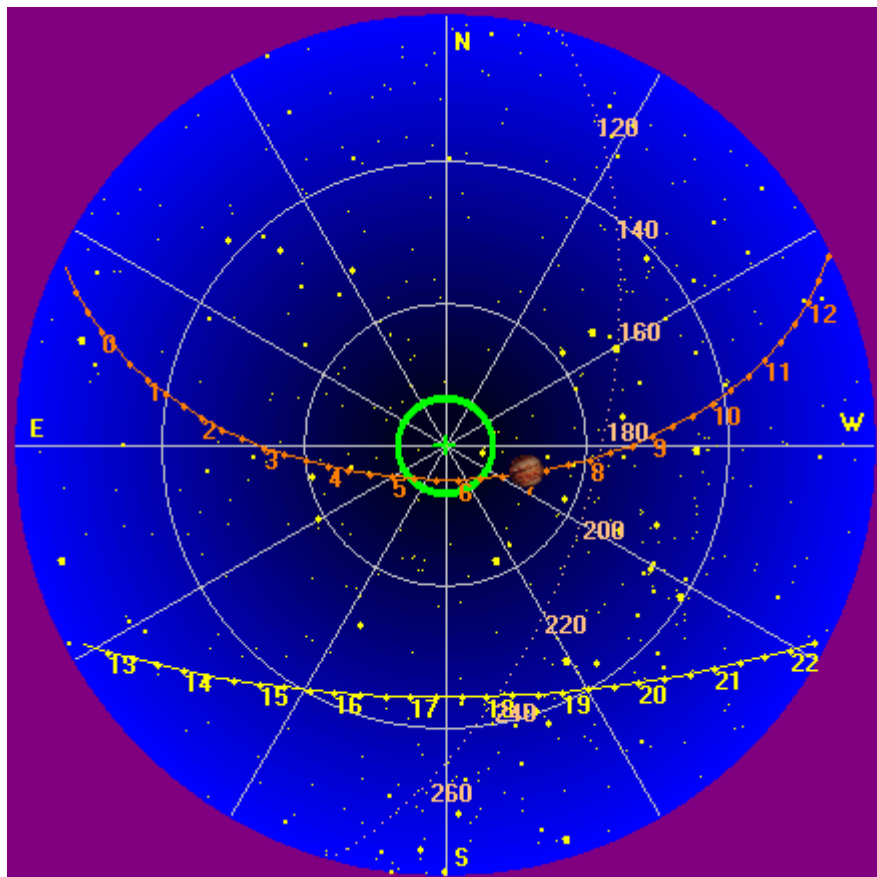
Jupiter was off axis by 7° to 34° .

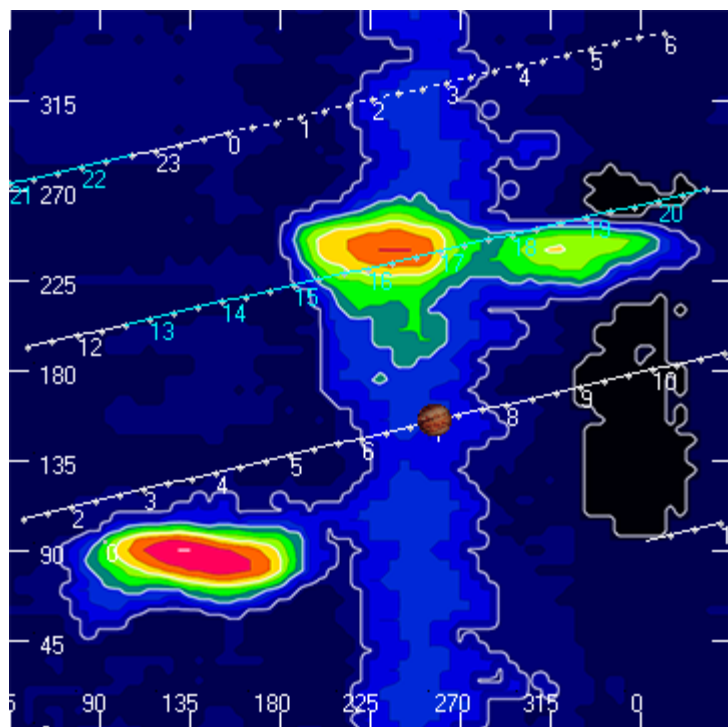
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 177° .

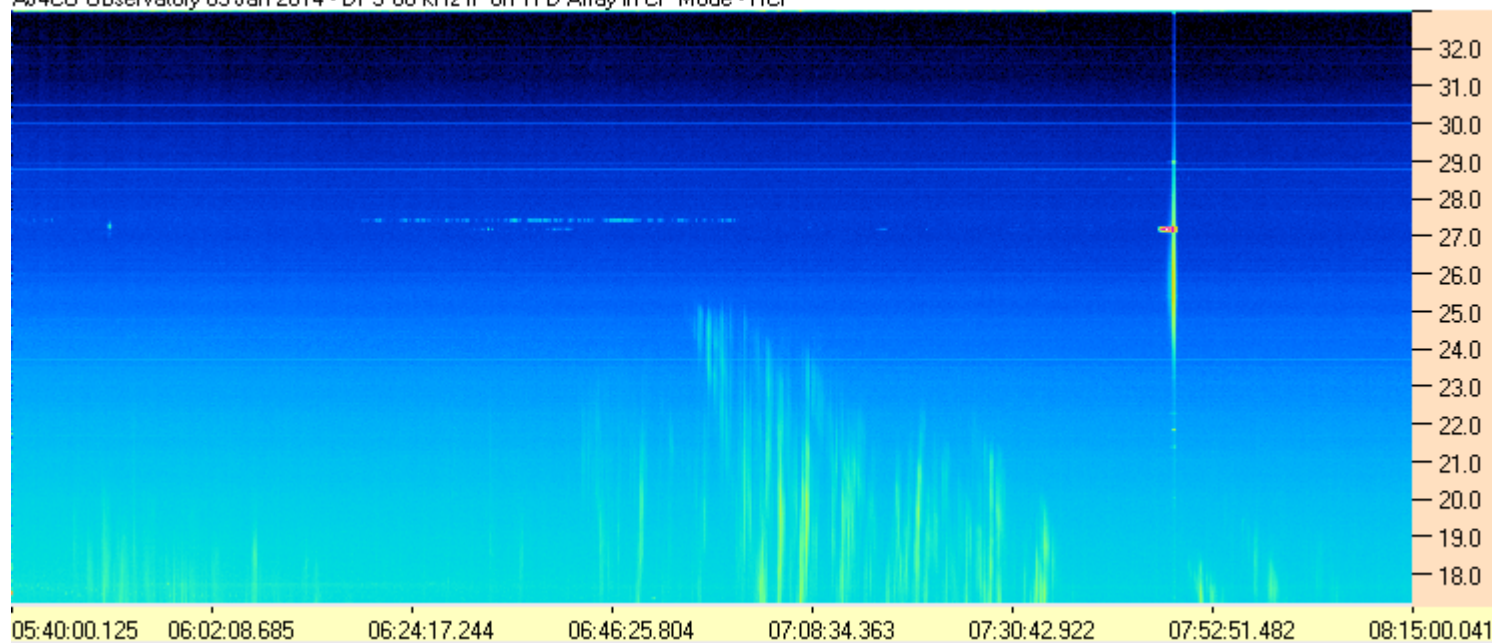

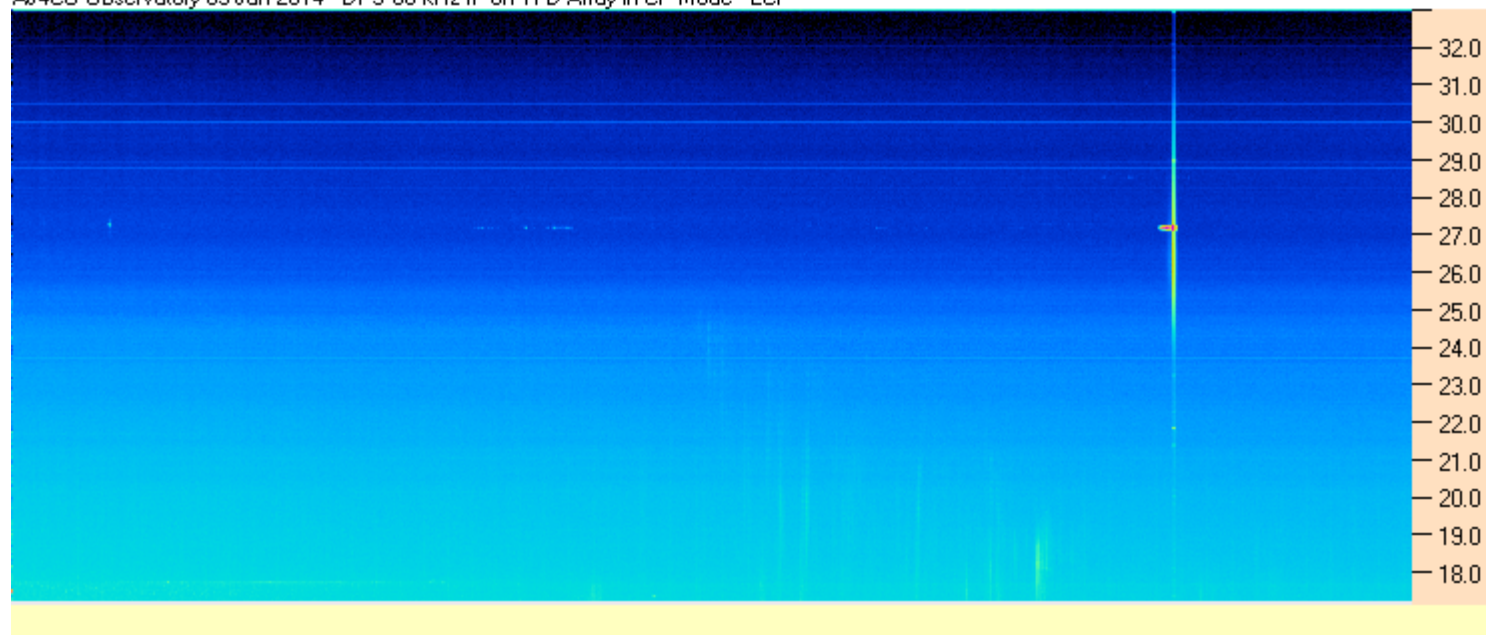




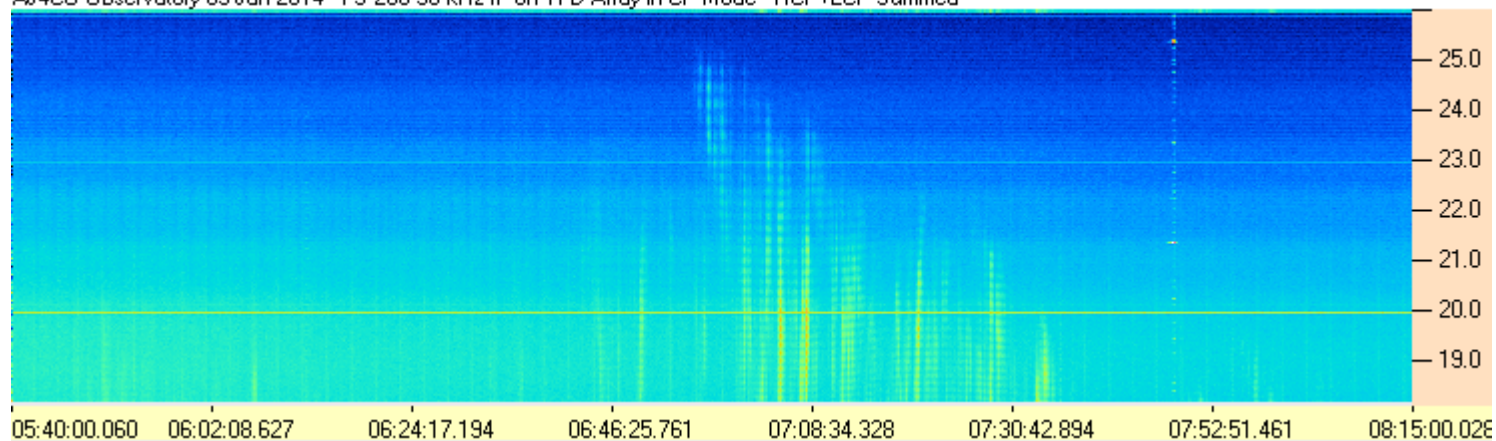
AJ4CO Observatory 03 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP



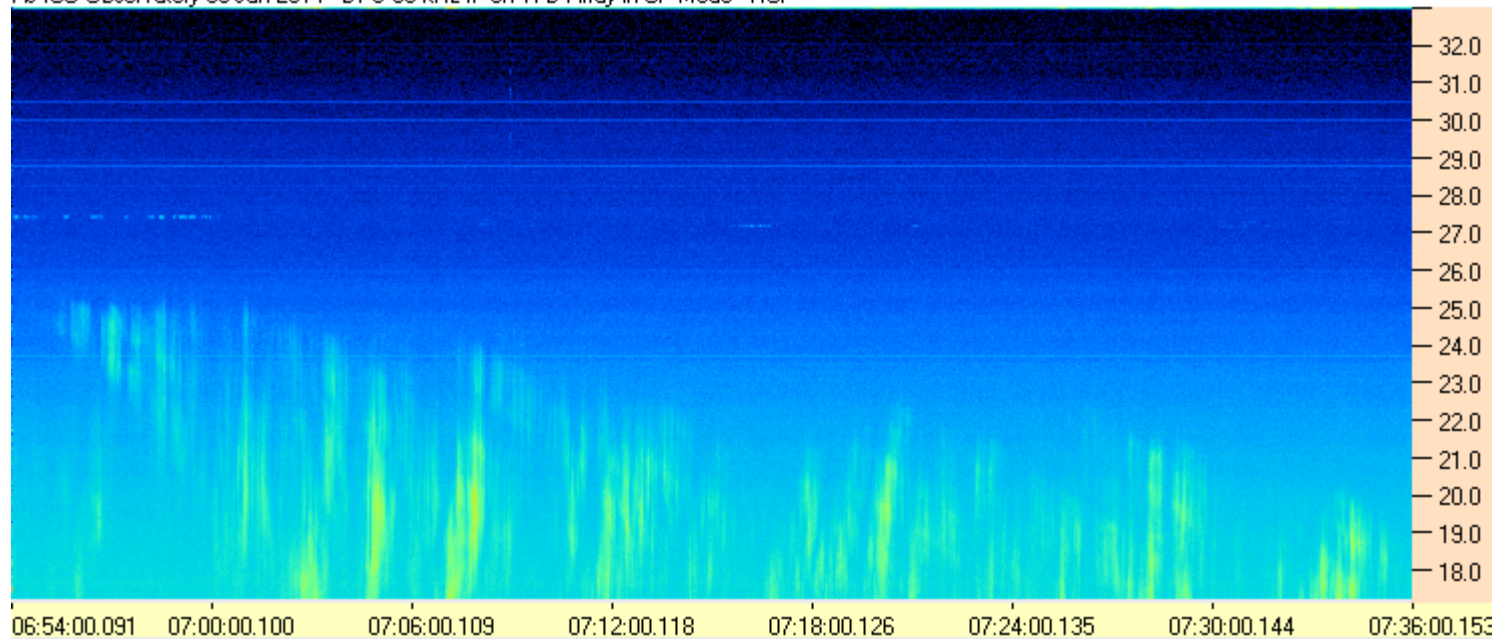
AJ4CO Observatory 03 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - LCP



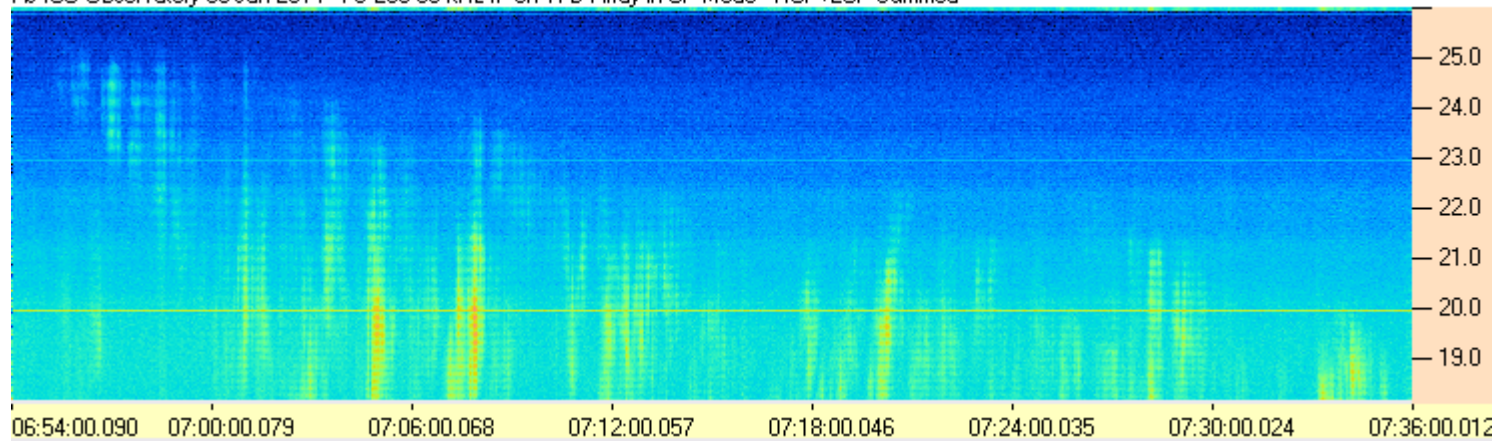
AJ4CO Observatory 03 Jan 2014 - FS-200 30 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP+LCP Summed

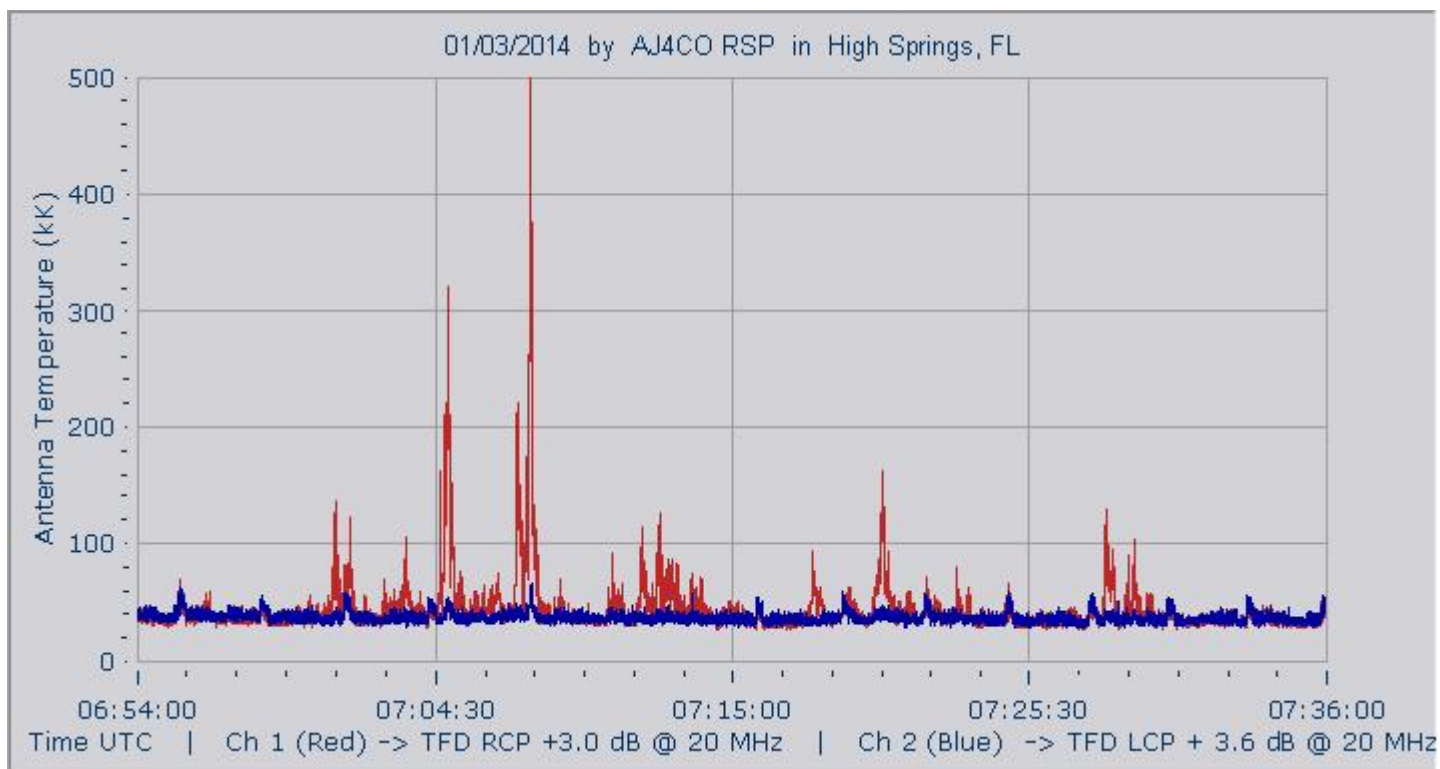

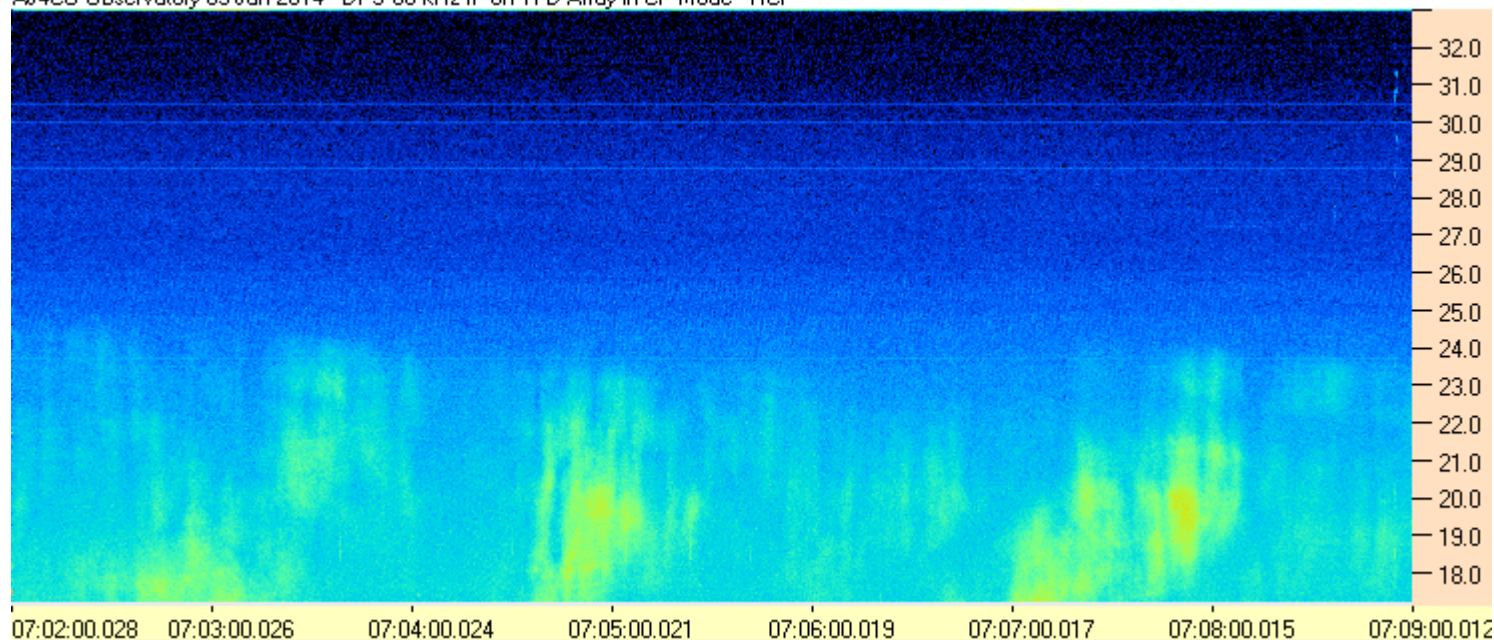
