All RCP emission, L bursting visible from 17 to 27 MHz. Modulation lanes barely visible in the sporadic emission.

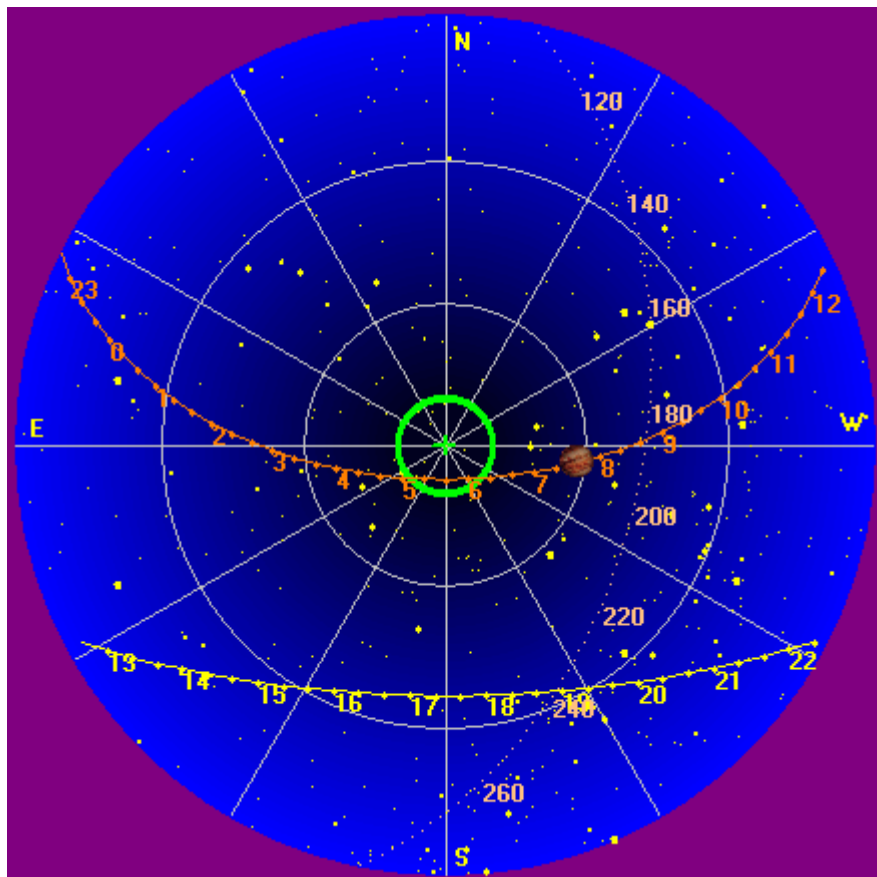
Jupiter was off axis by 19° to 37° .

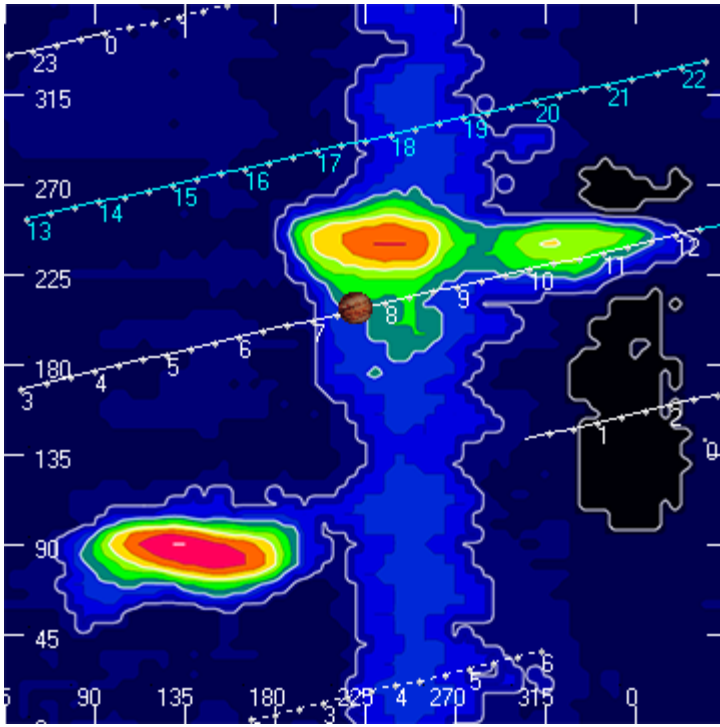
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 179° .

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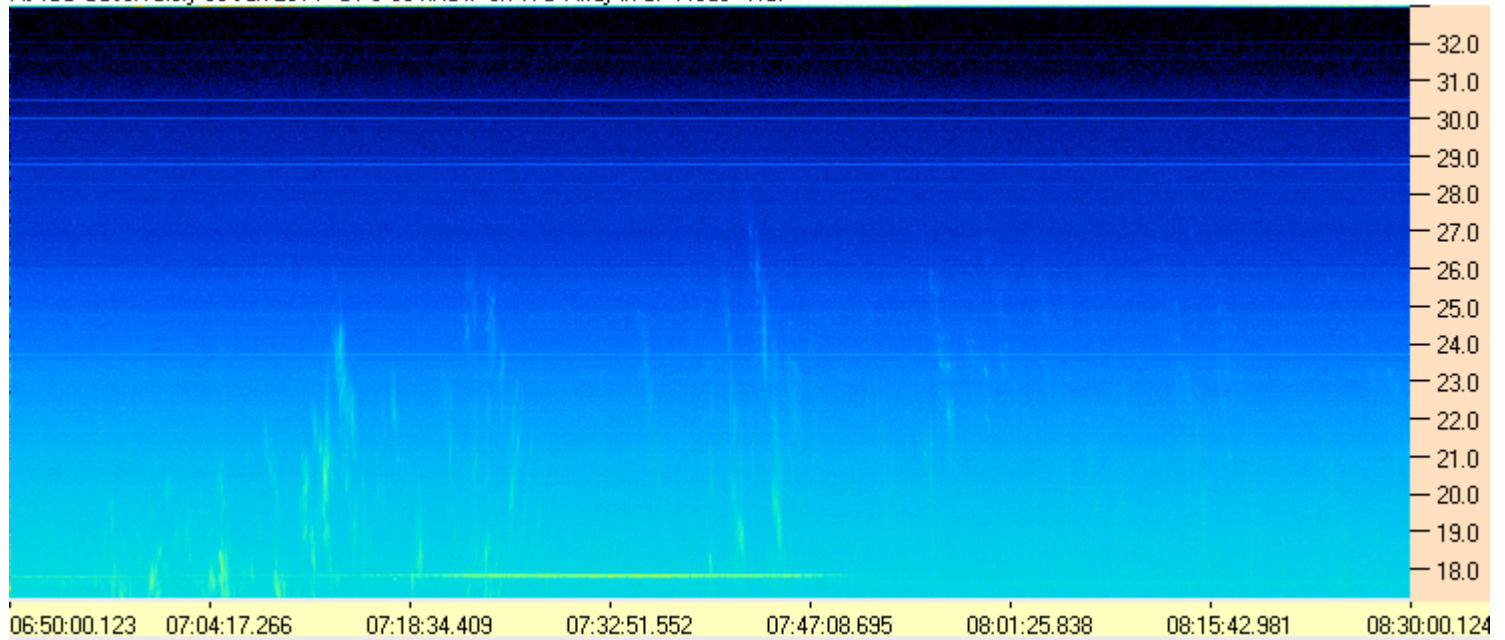

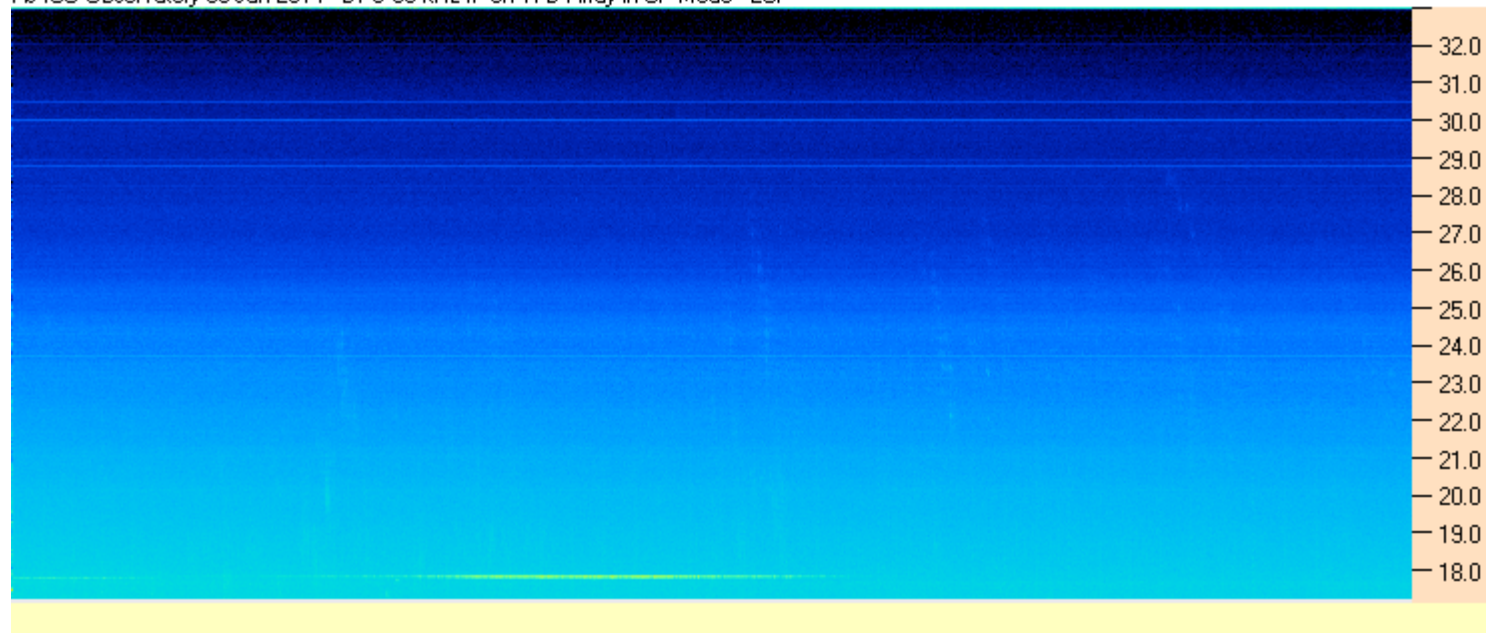




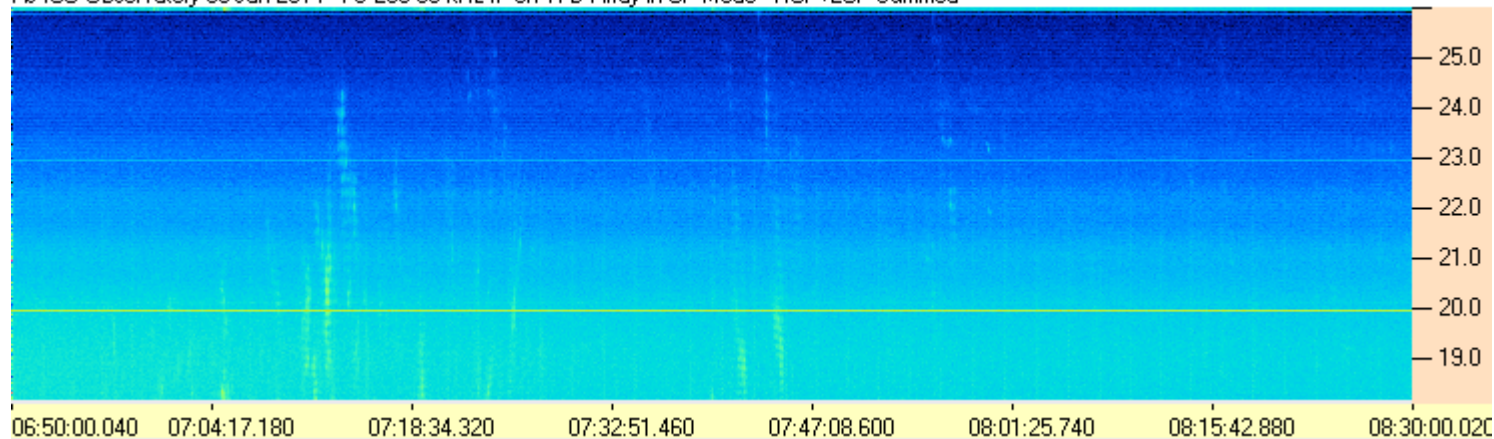
AJ4CO Observatory 05 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP



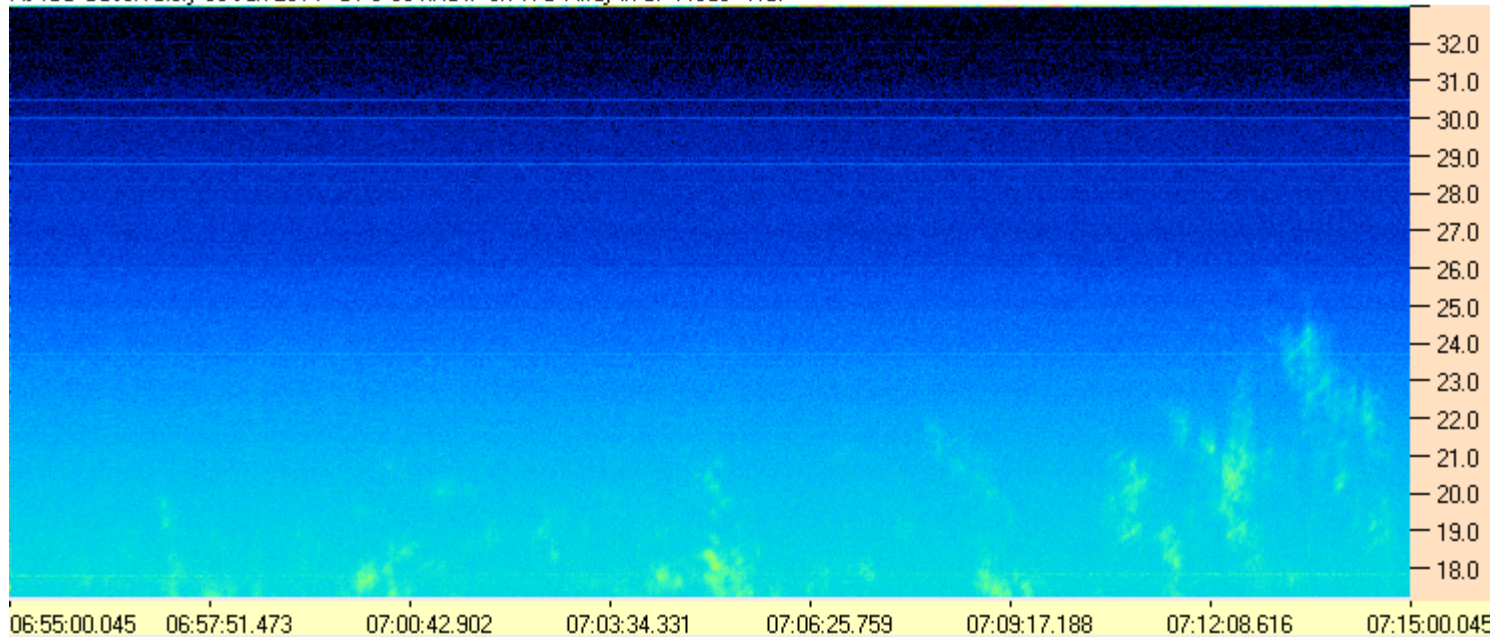
AJ4CO Observatory 05 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - LCP



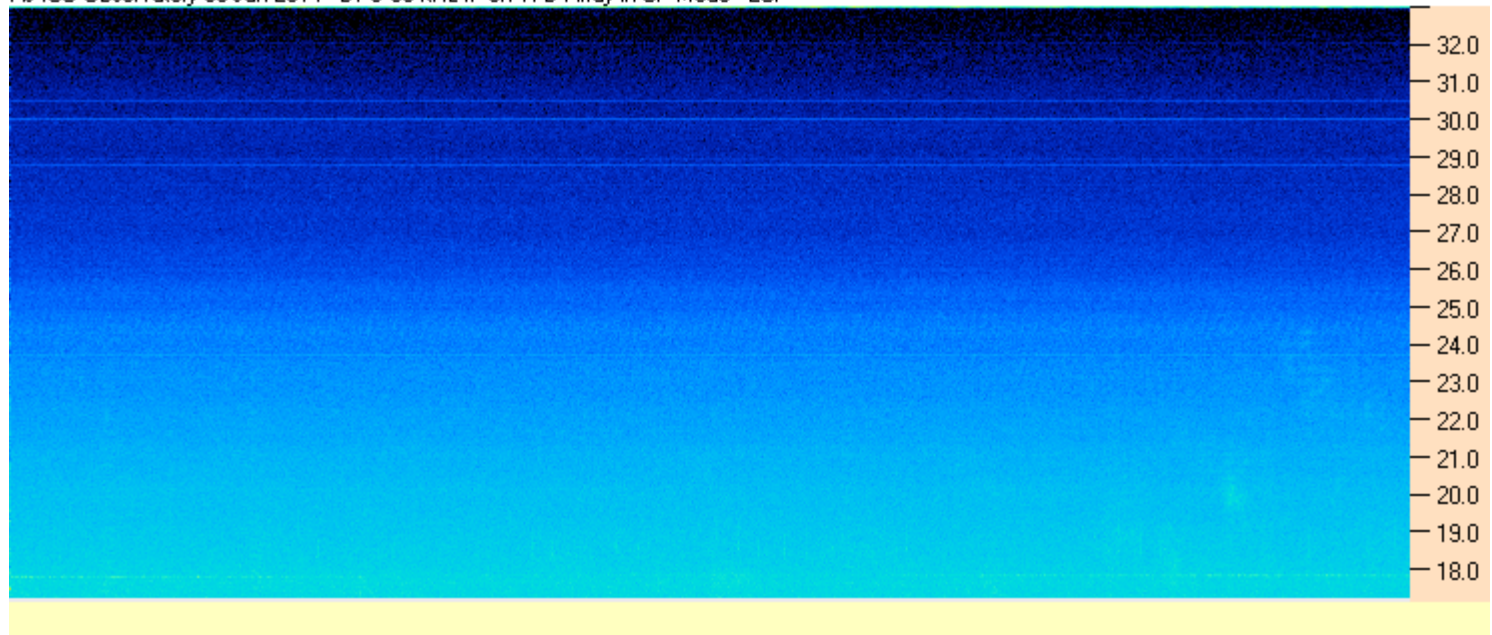
AJ4CO Observatory 06 Jan 2014 - FS-200 30 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP+LCP Summed
