All RCP emission, weak L bursting visible from 17 to 24 MHz. Prominent modulation lane with positive drift.

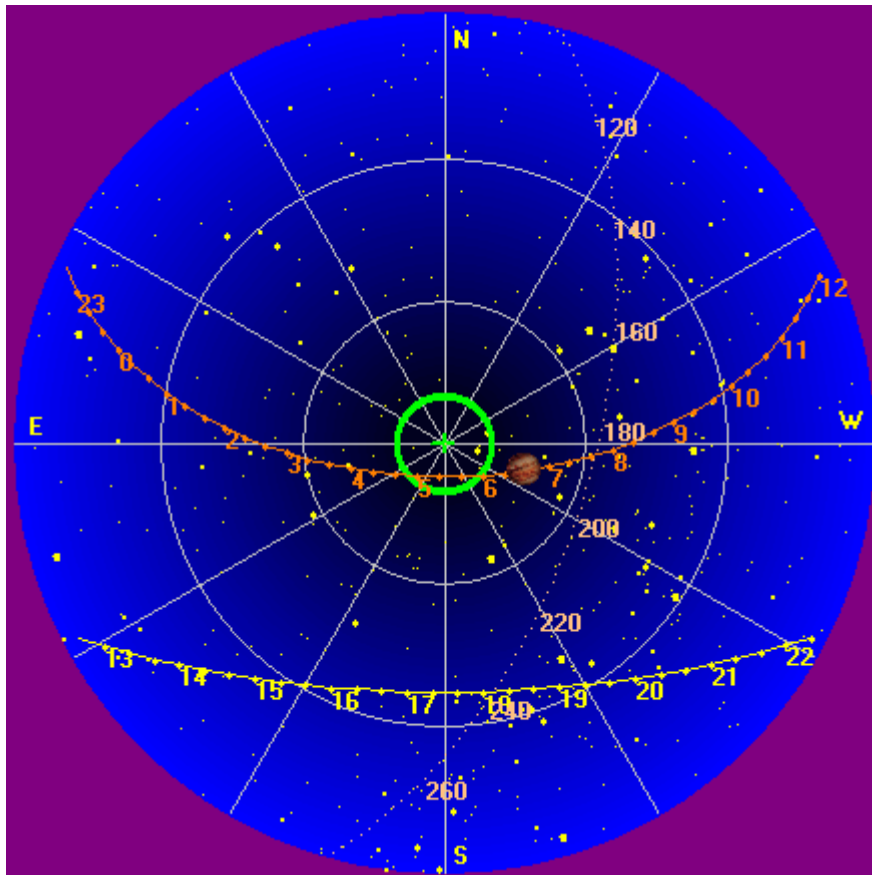
Jupiter was off axis by 14° to 21° .

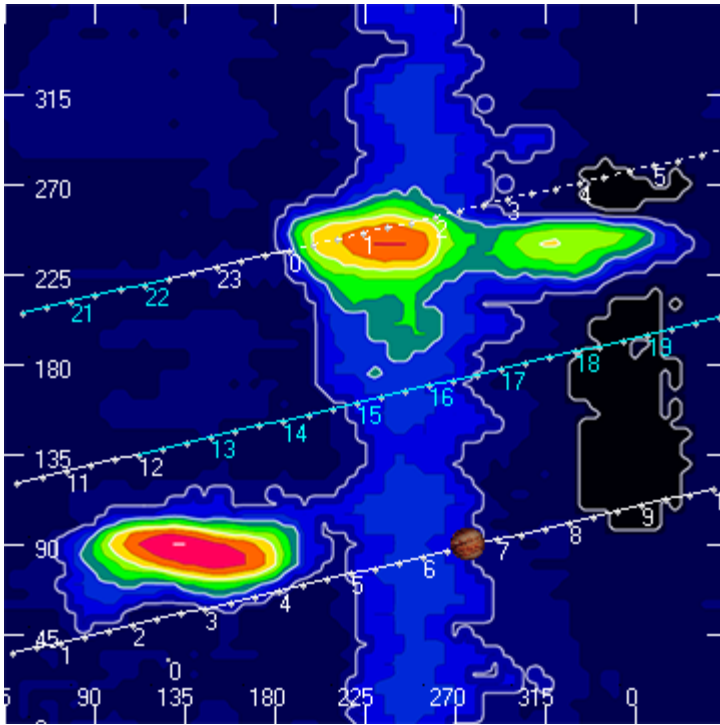
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 177° .

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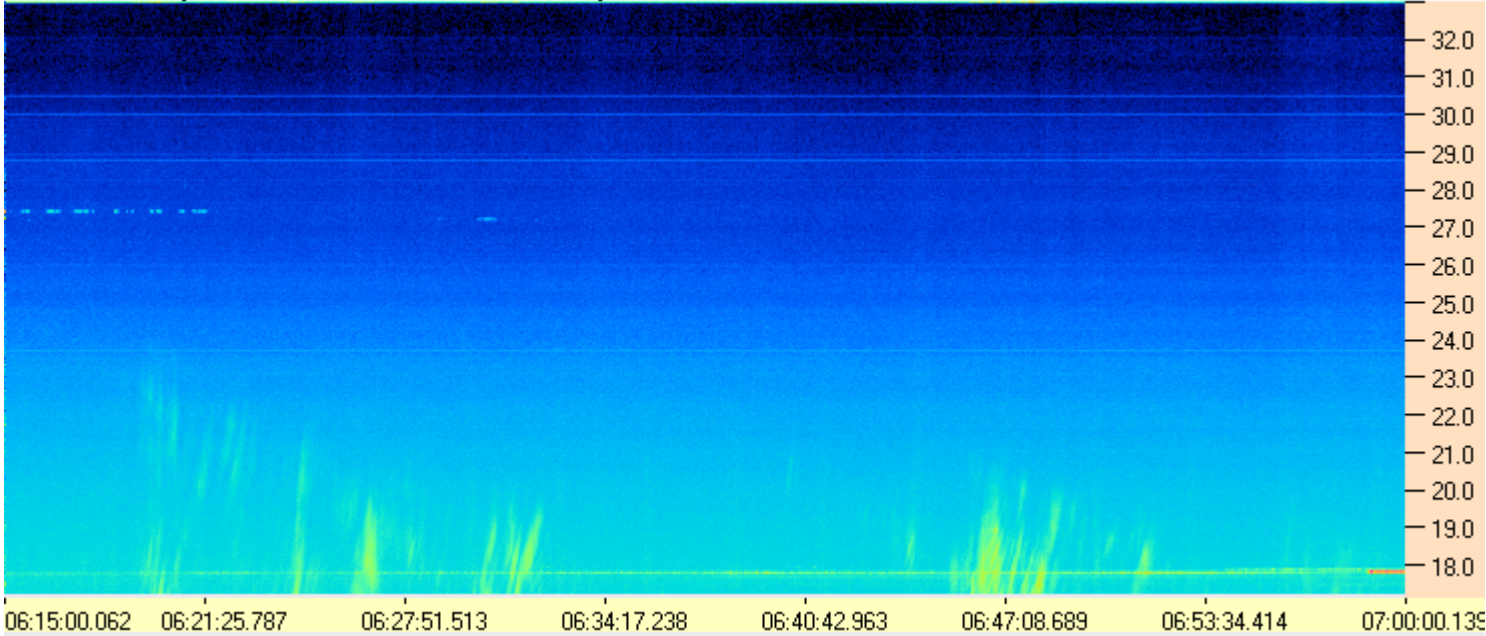

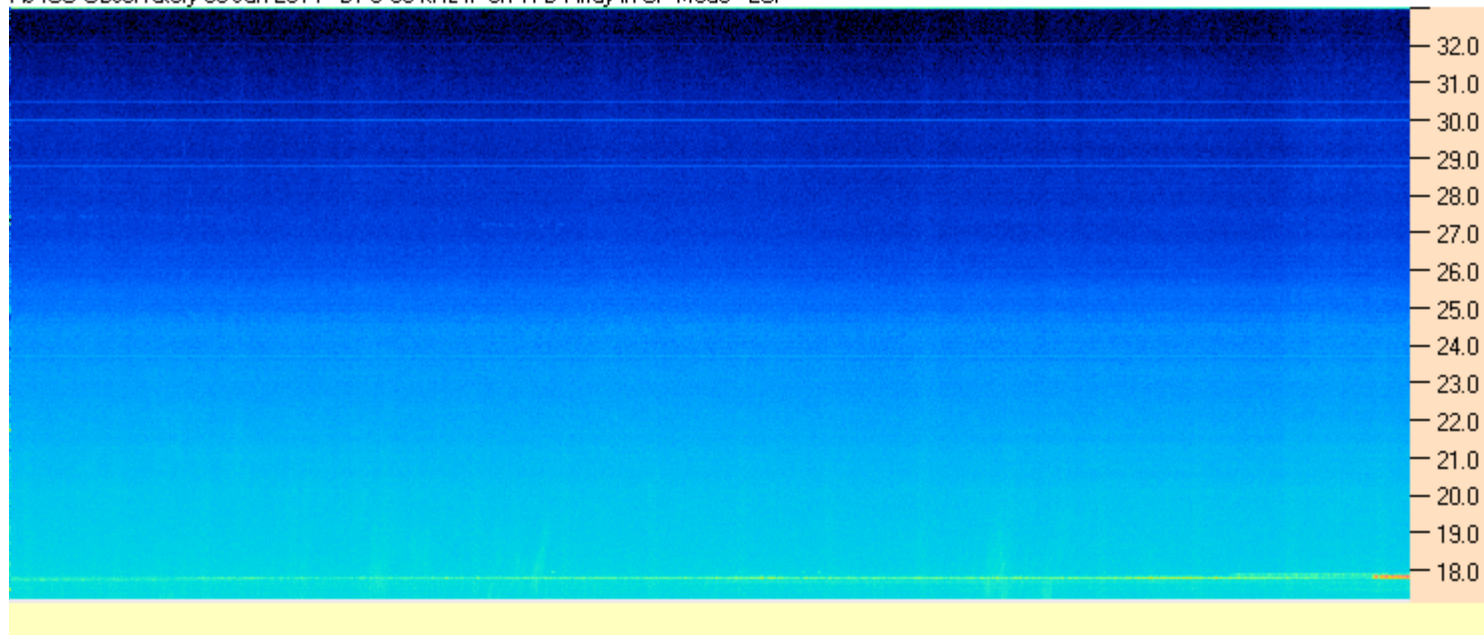




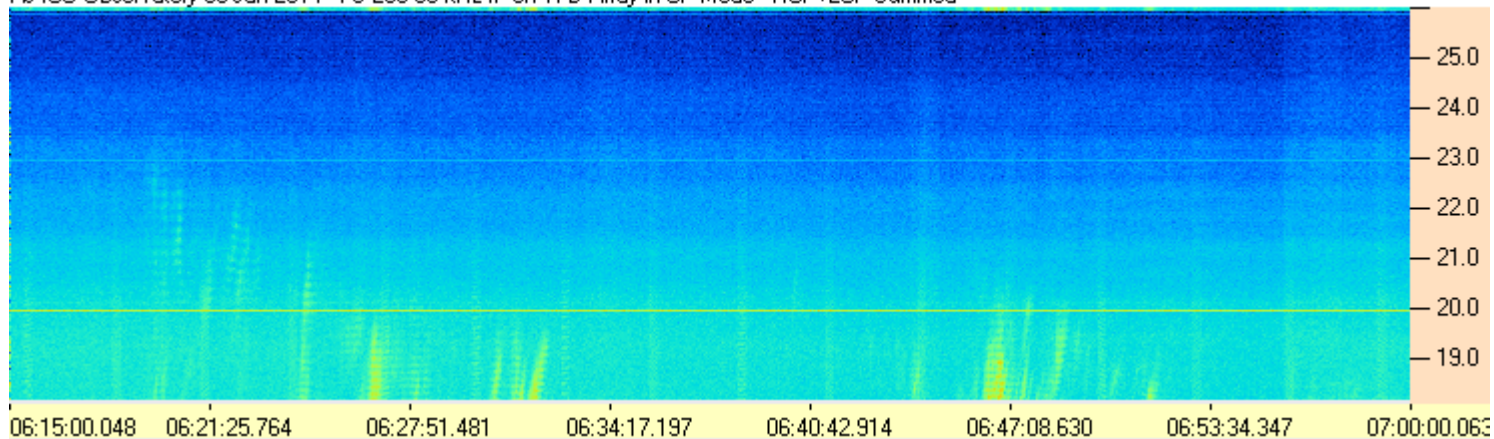
AJ4CO Observatory 08 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP



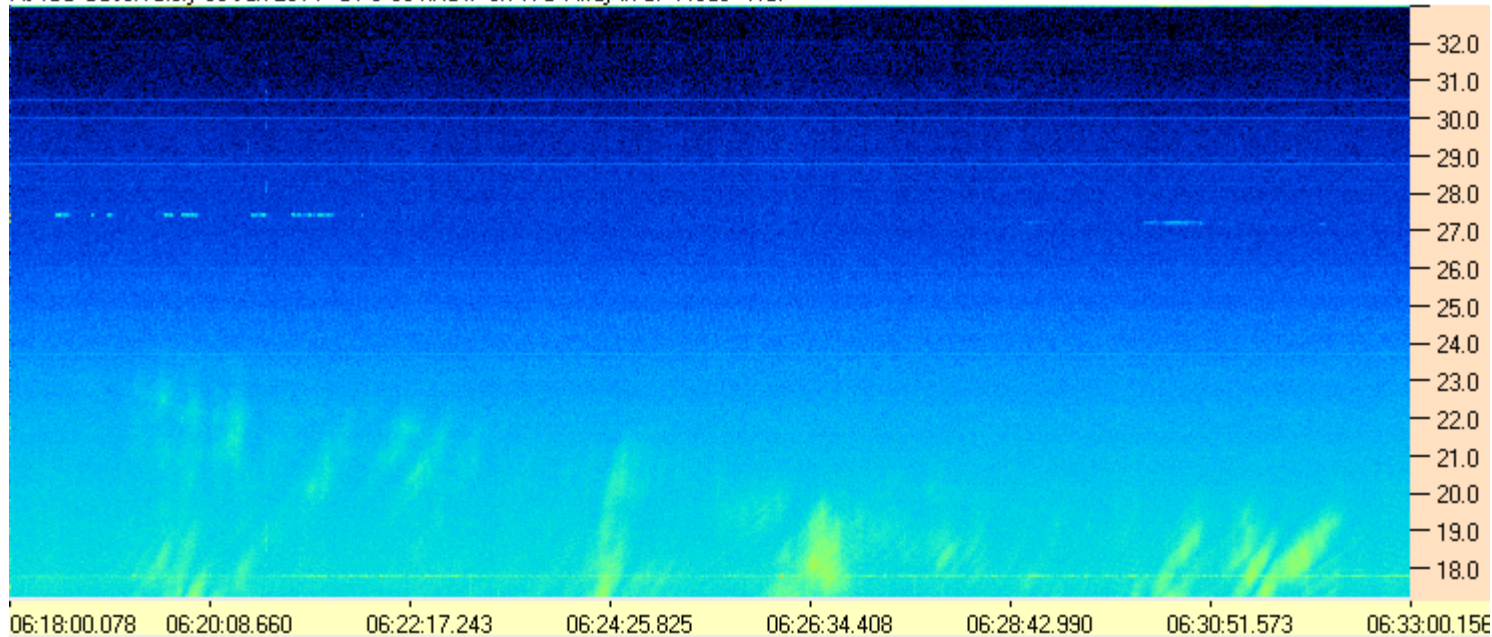
AJ4CO Observatory 08 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - LCP



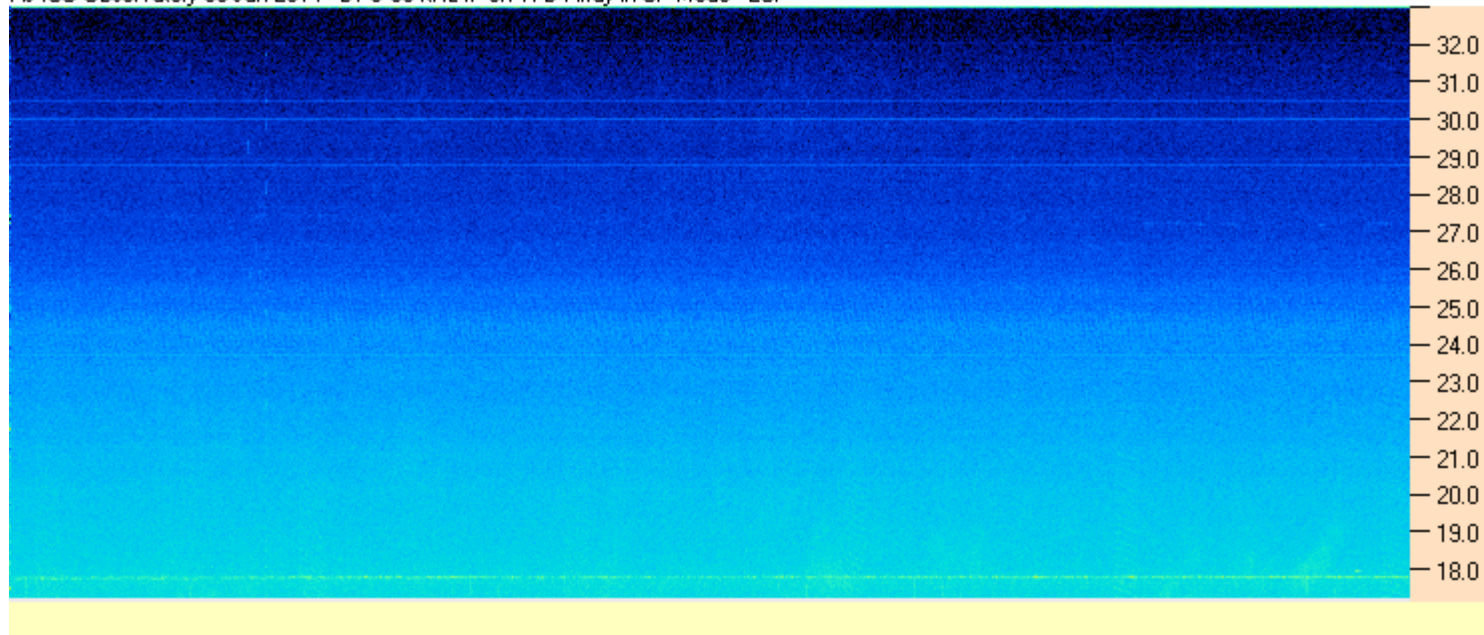
AJ4CO Observatory 08 Jan 2014 - FS-200 30 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP+LCP Summed



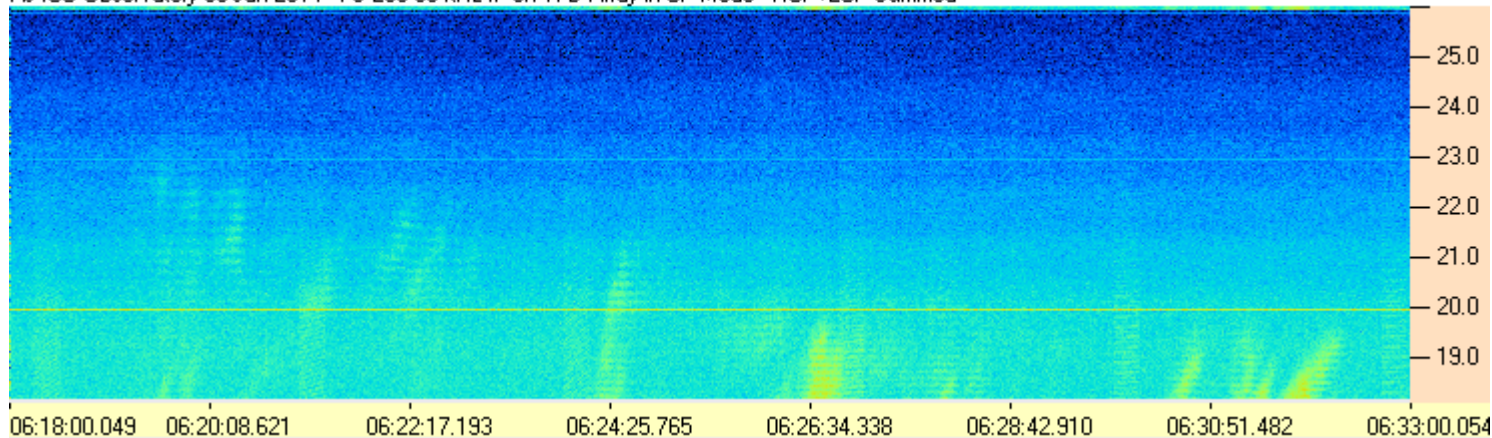

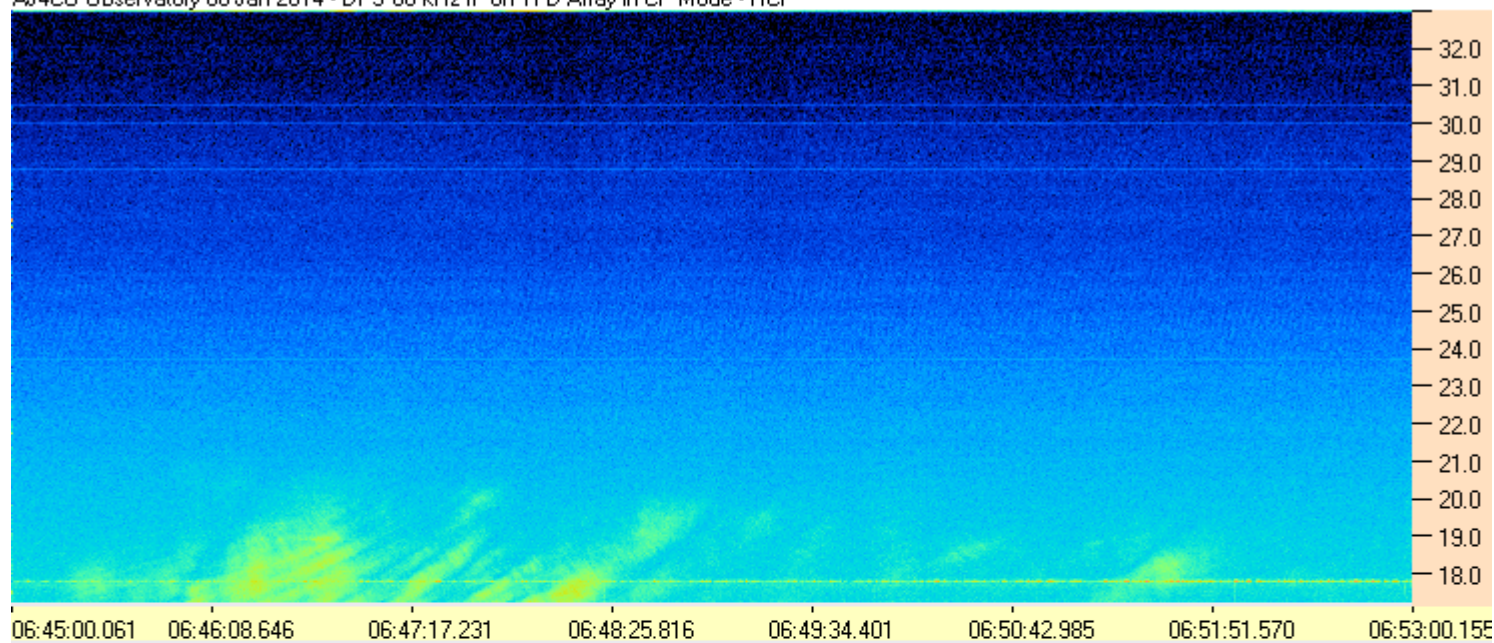

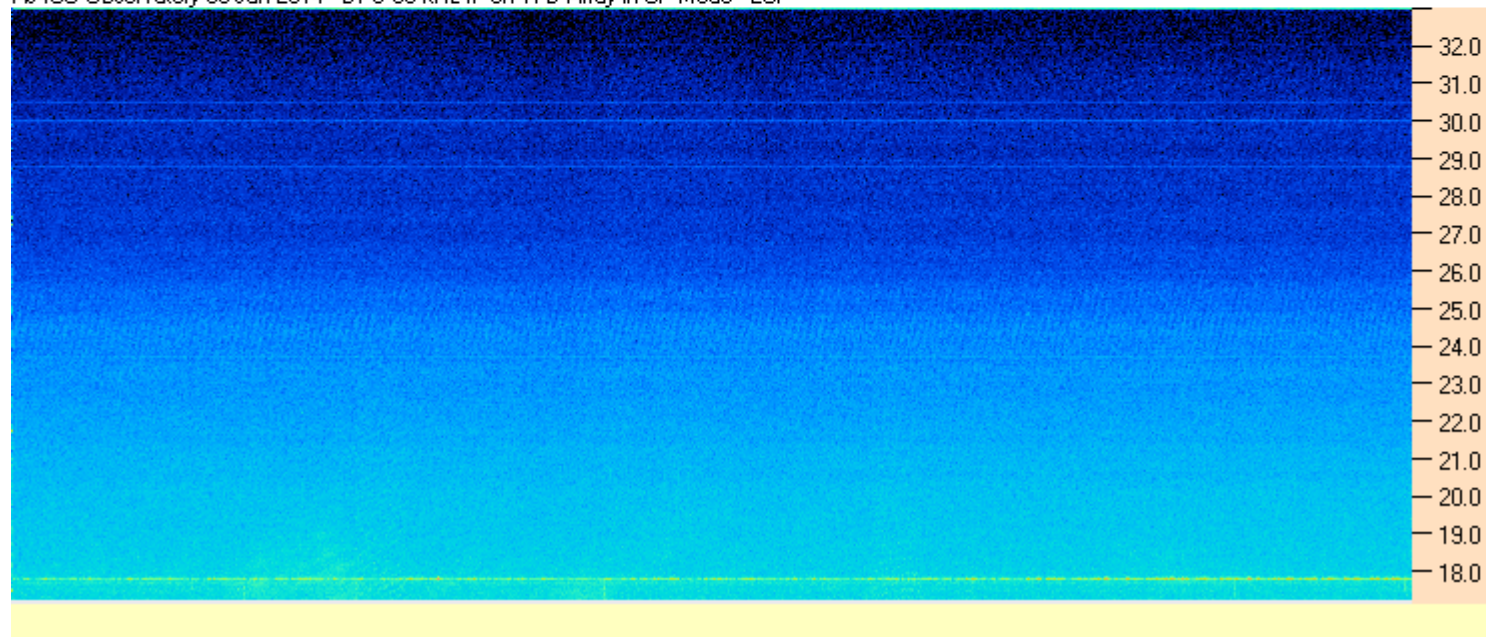
AJ4CO Observatory 08 Jan 2014 - FS-200 30 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP+LCP Summed
