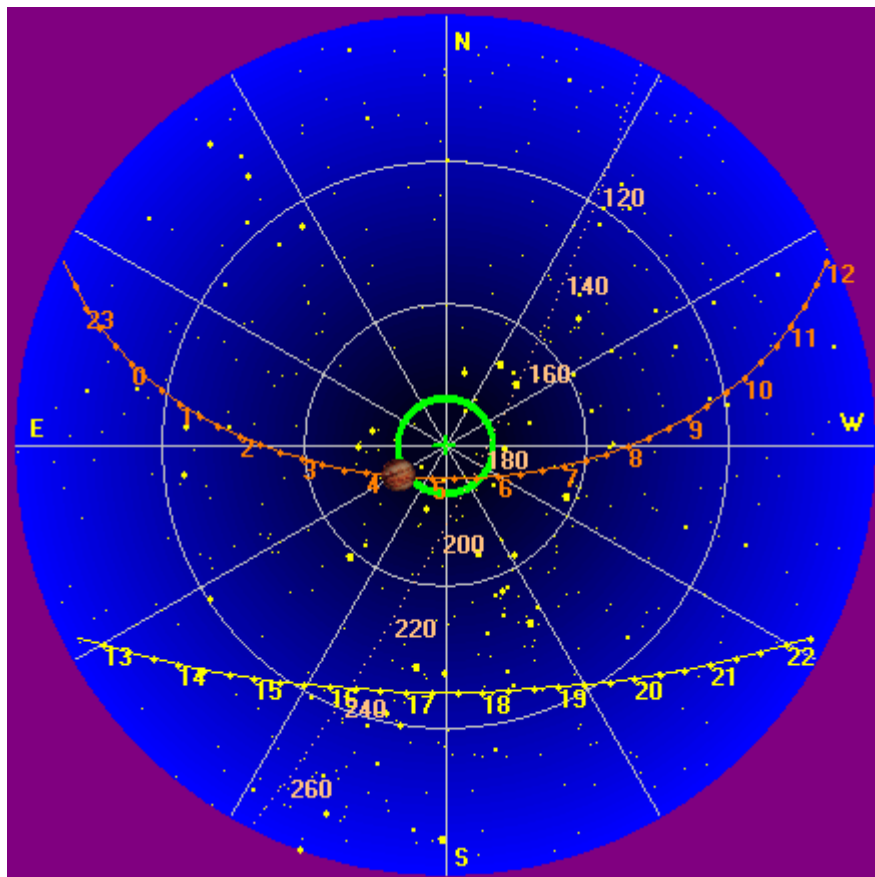
Jupiter was off axis 17° for A and 6° for C.

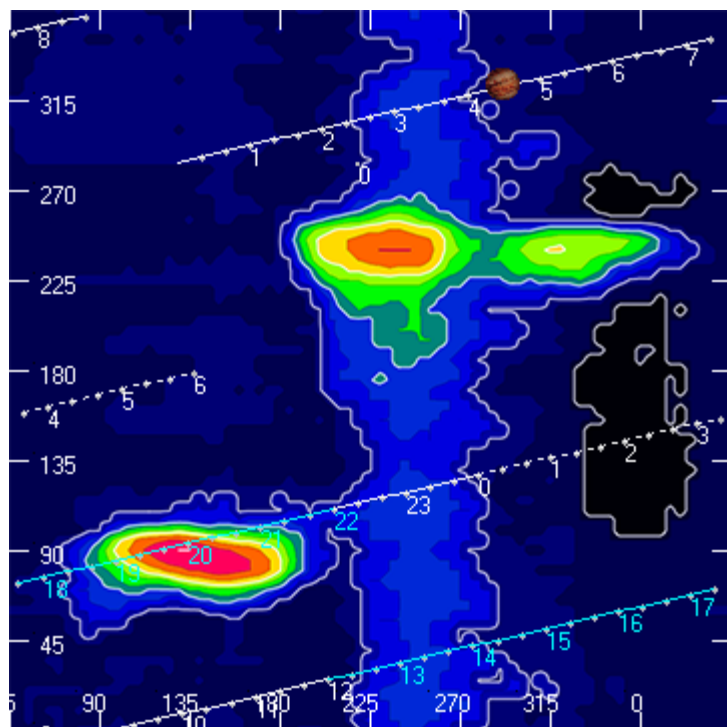
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 174° .

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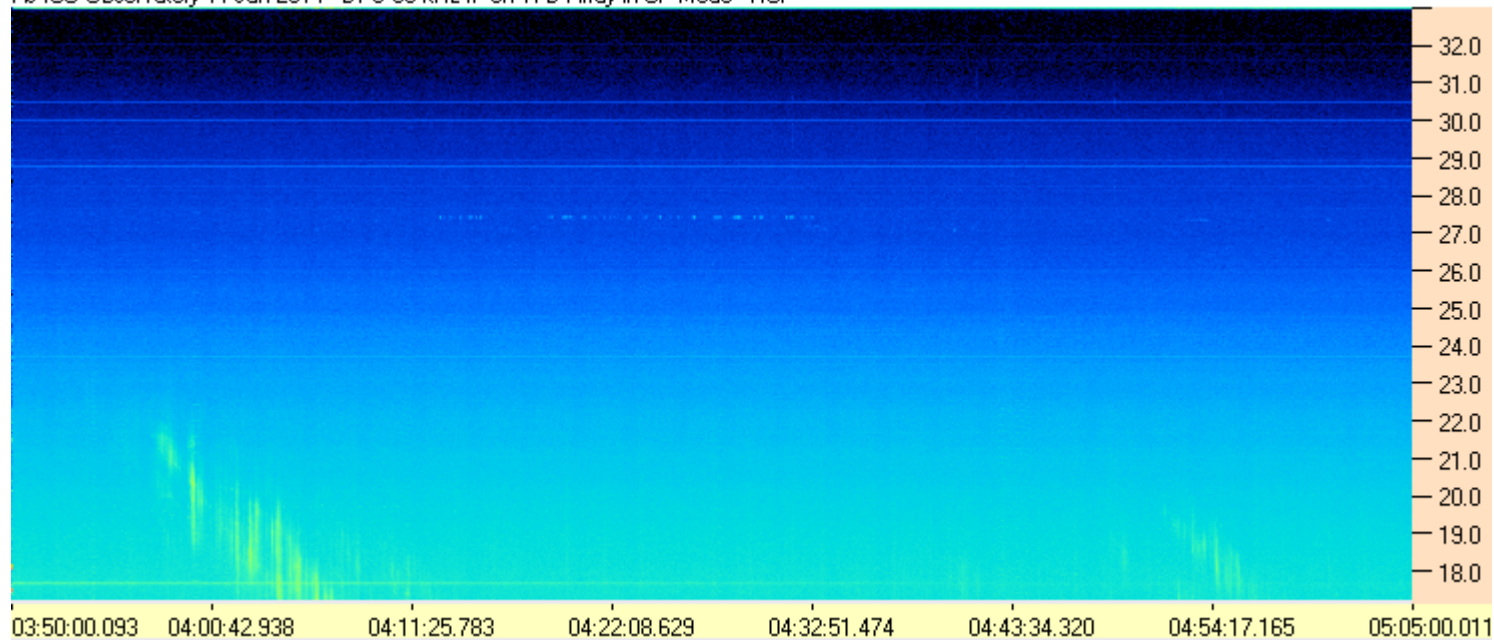

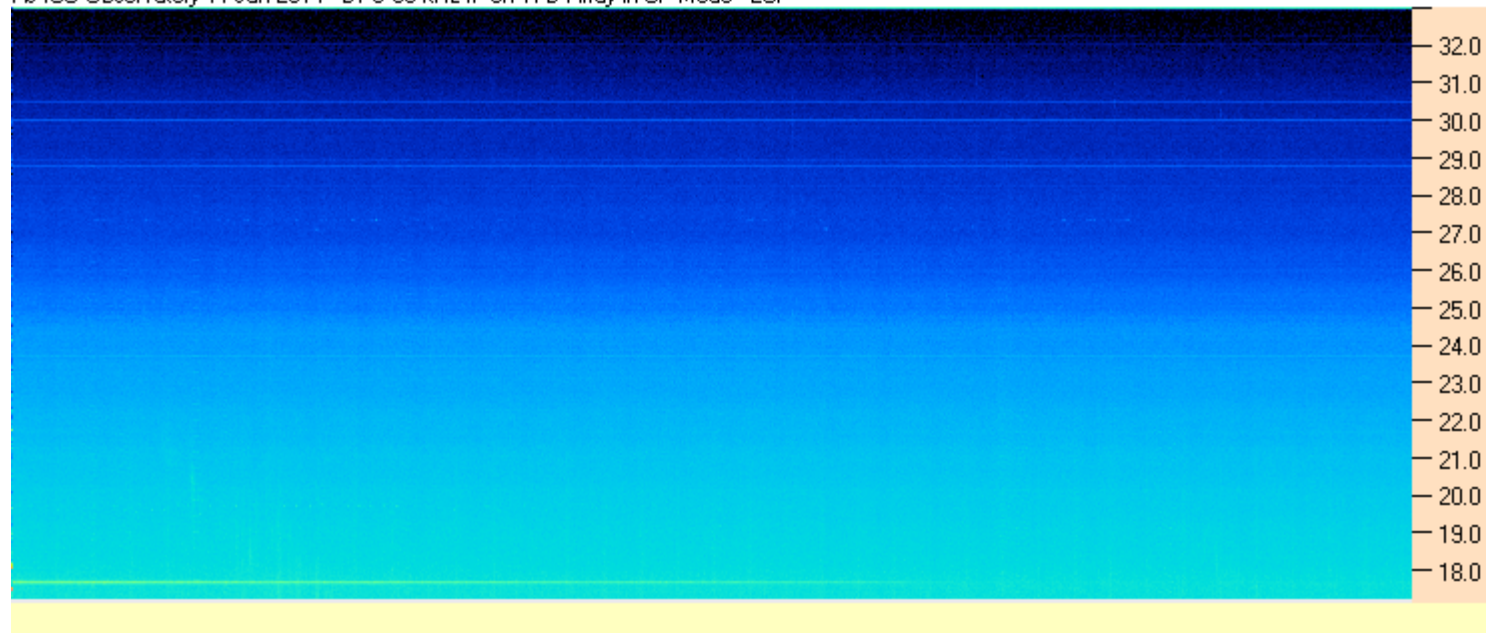




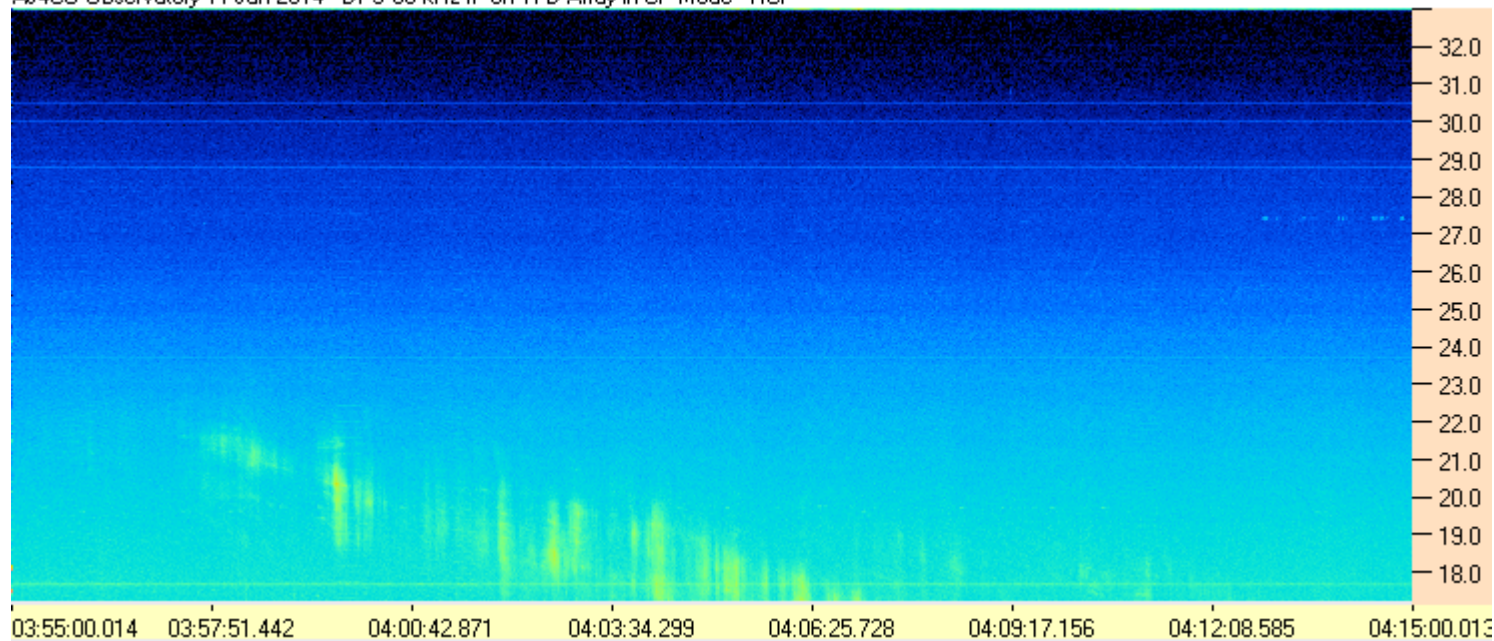
AJ4CO Observatory 11 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP

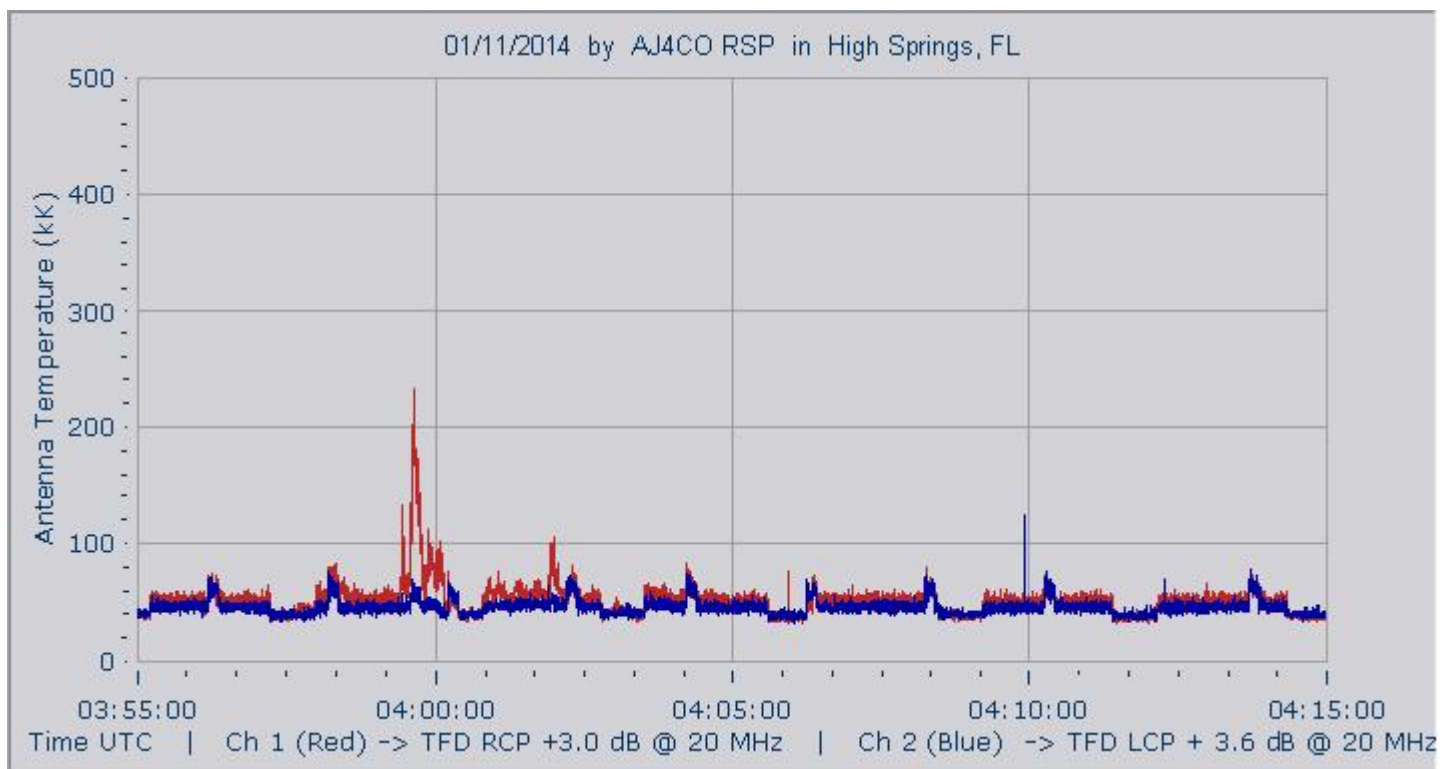


AJ4CO Observatory 11 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - LCP
