All RCP L bursting from 17 to 23 MHz. Interesting modulation lanes; mostly positive slope, but some negative too.

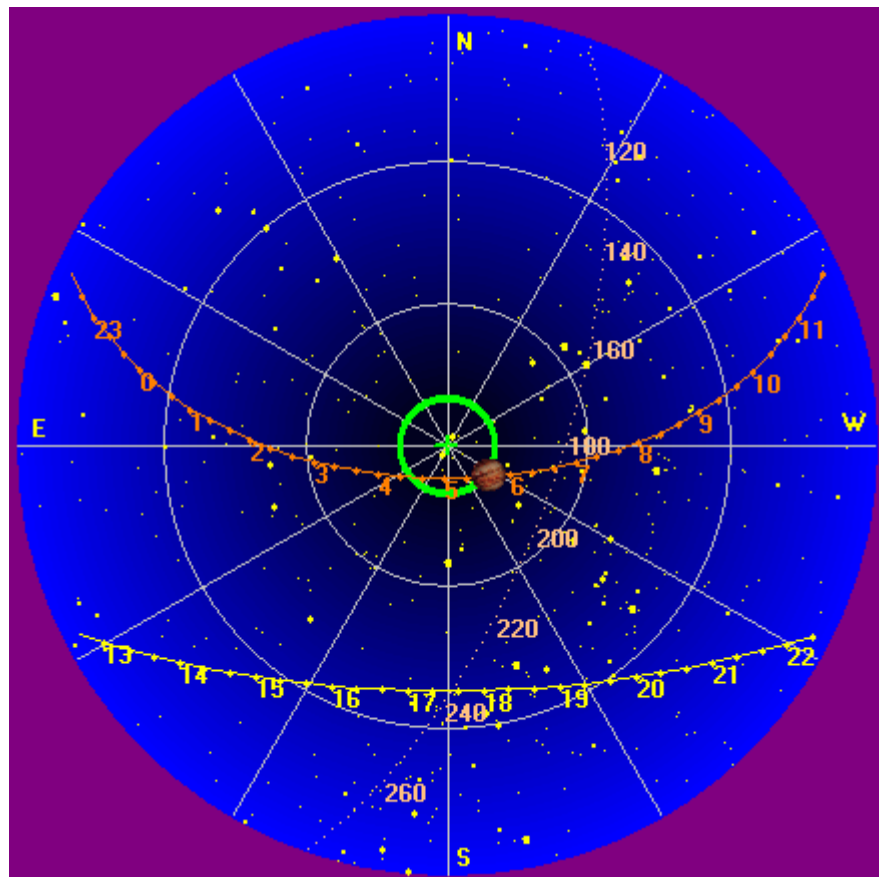
Jupiter was off axis from 8° to 17°.

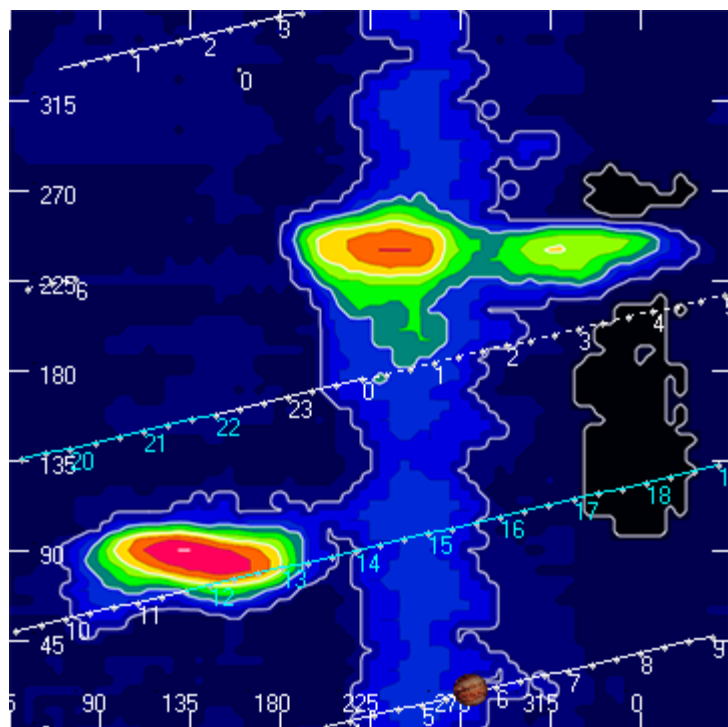
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 172°.

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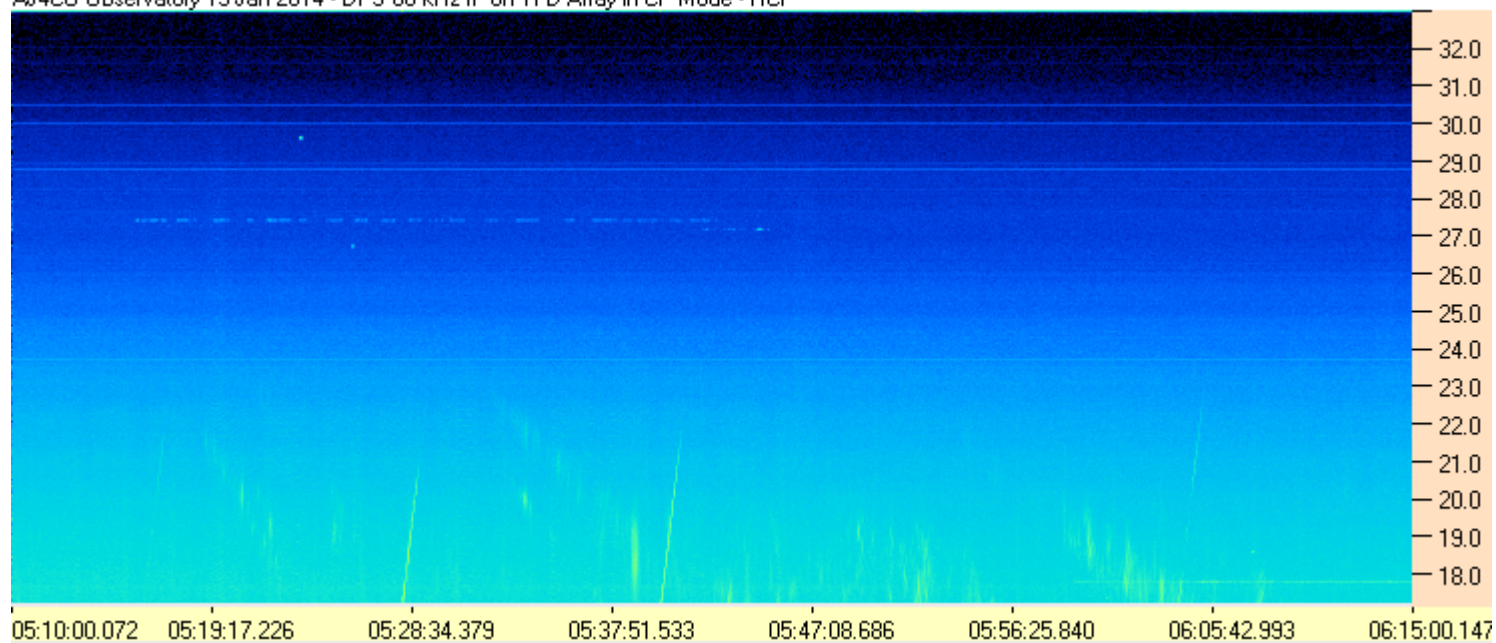

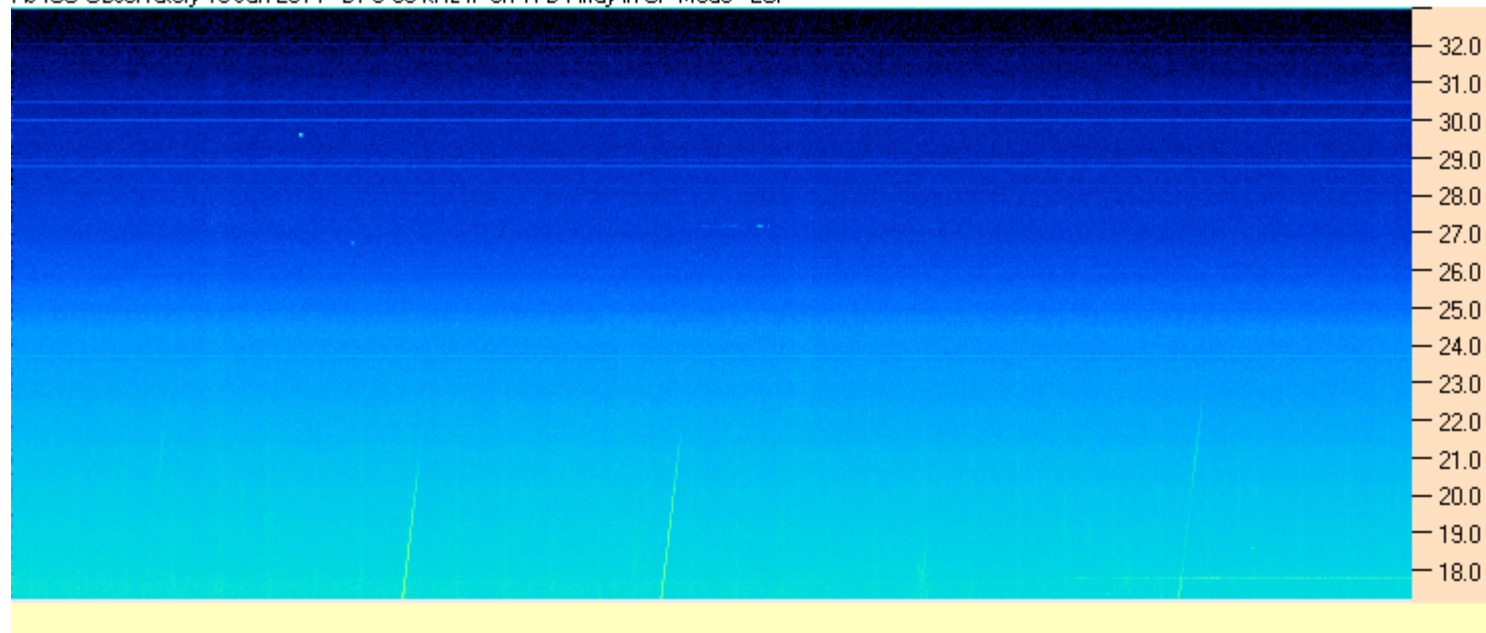




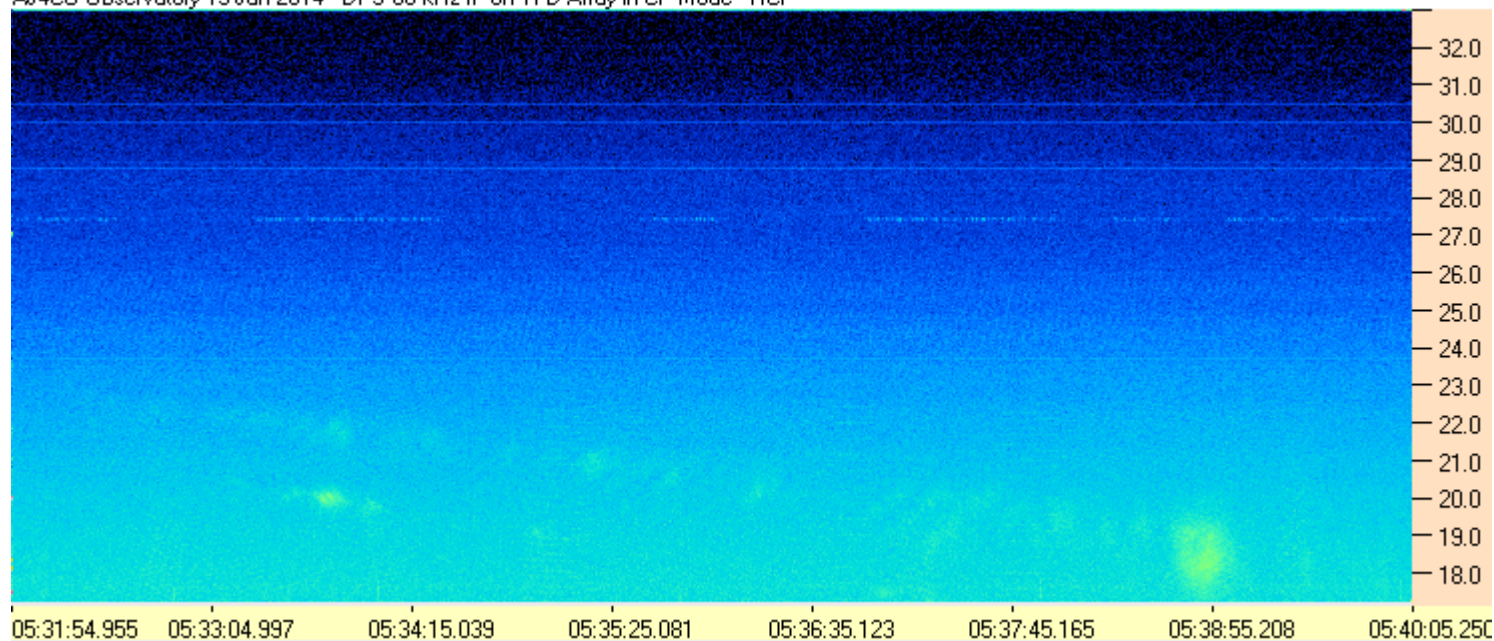
AJ4CO Observatory 13 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP

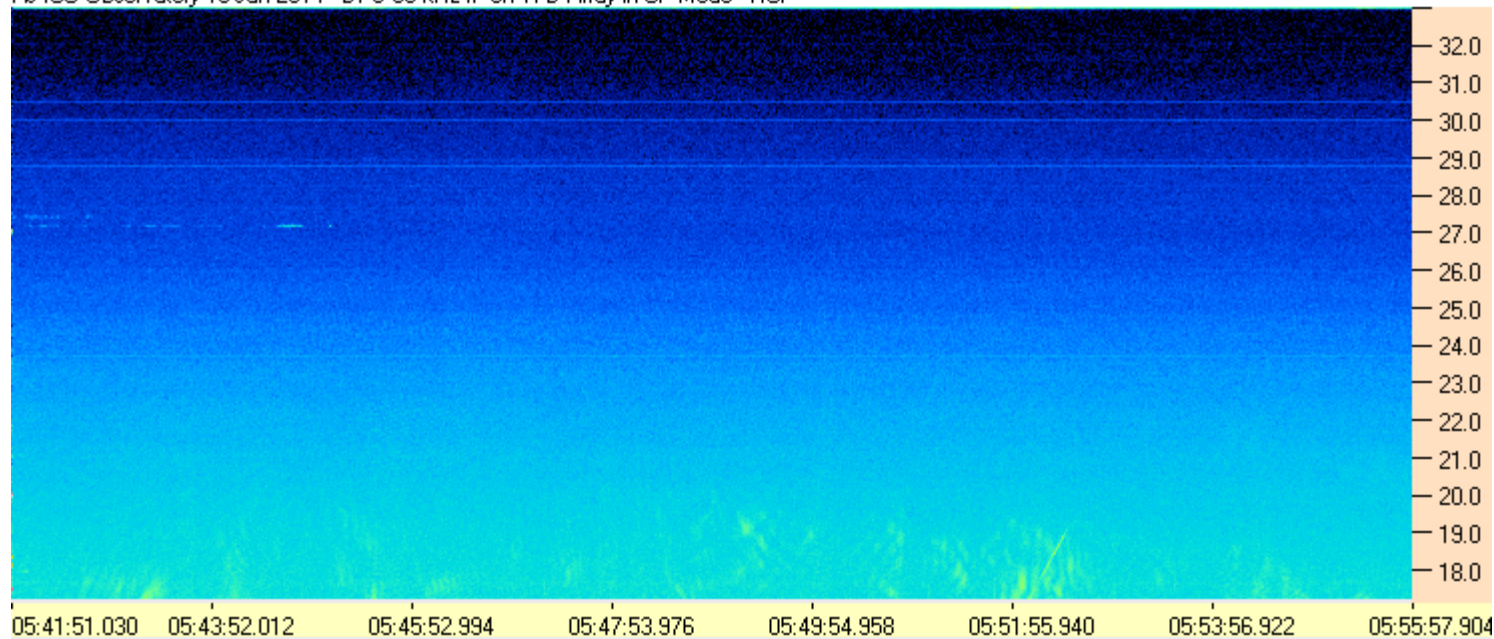
