All RCP L bursting from 17 to 33 MHz. Very nice crosshatched modulation lanes.

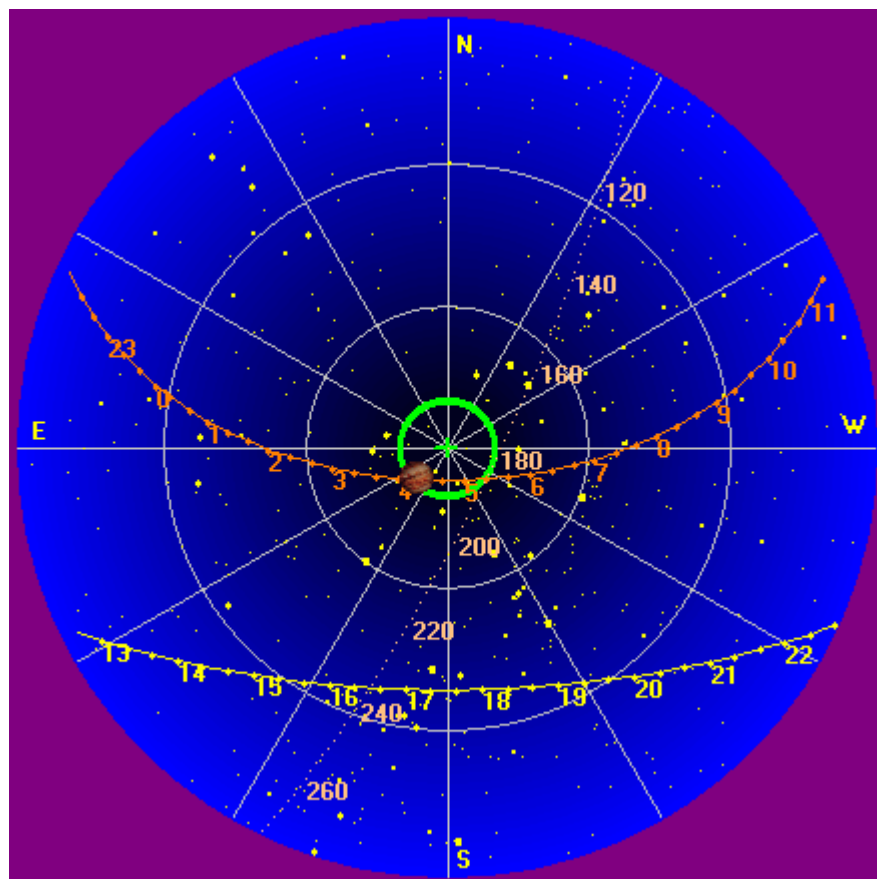
Jupiter was 7° to 12° off axis.

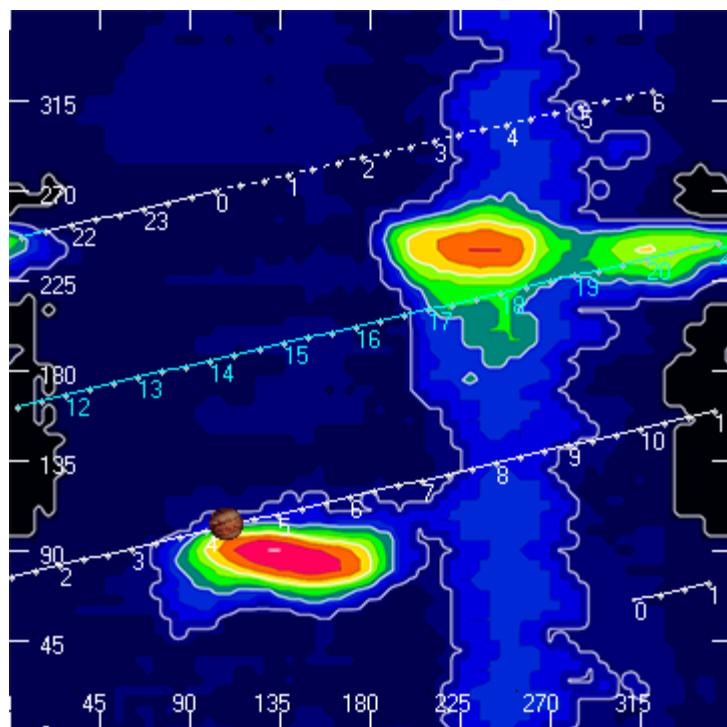
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 167°.

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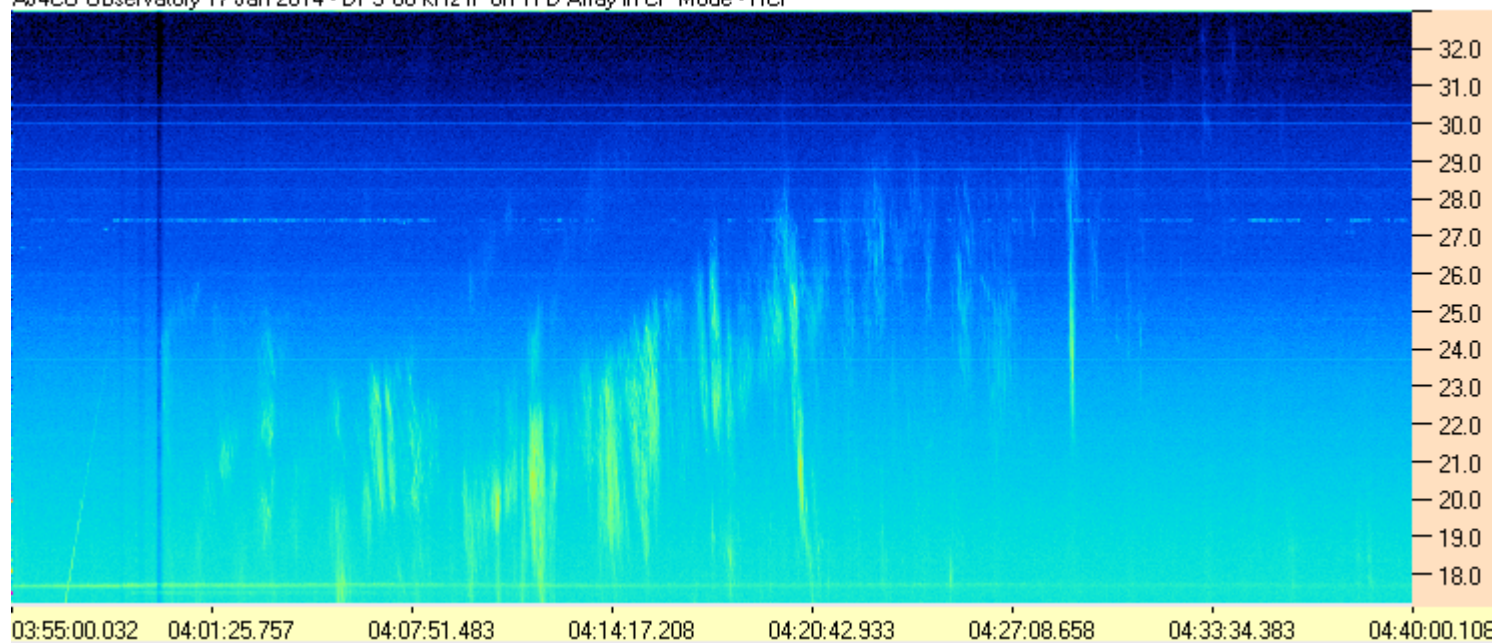

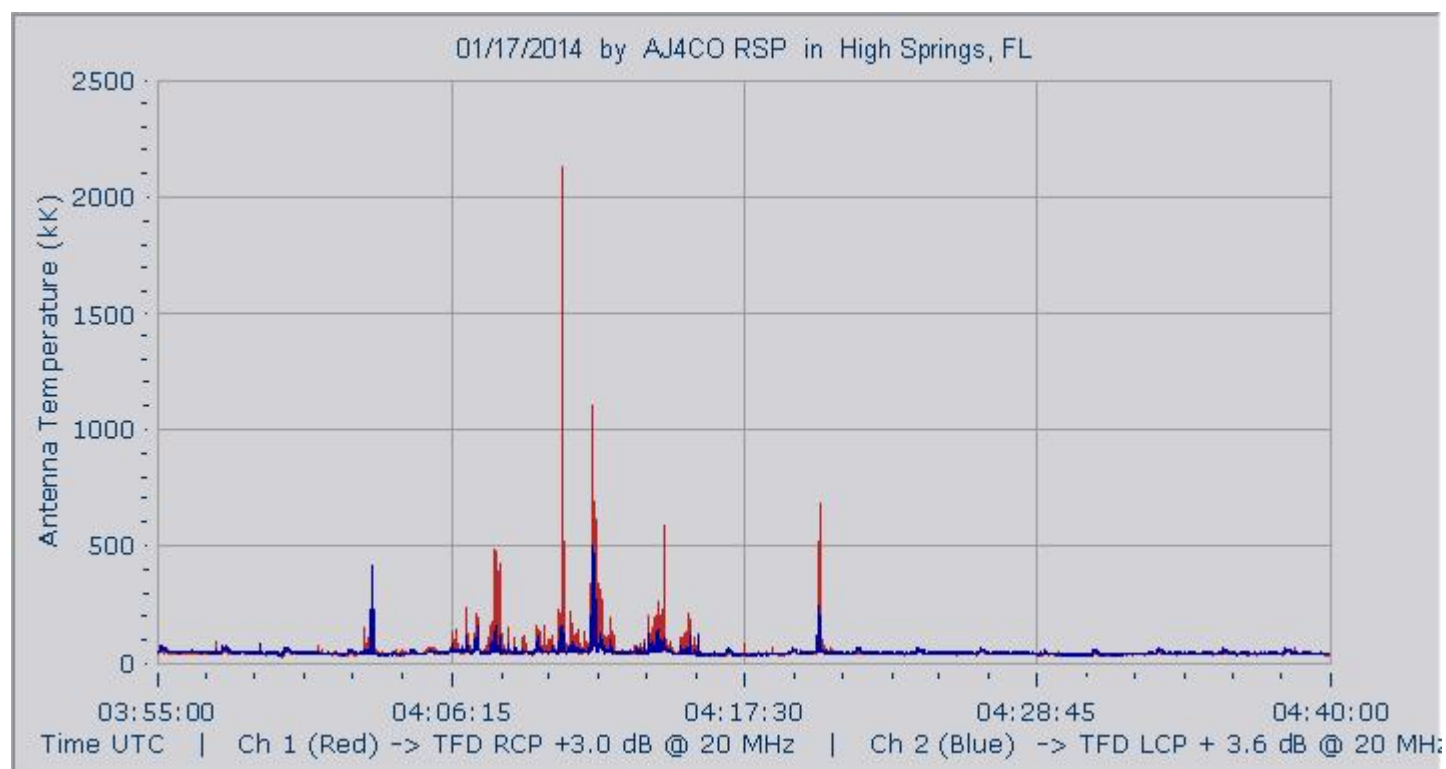
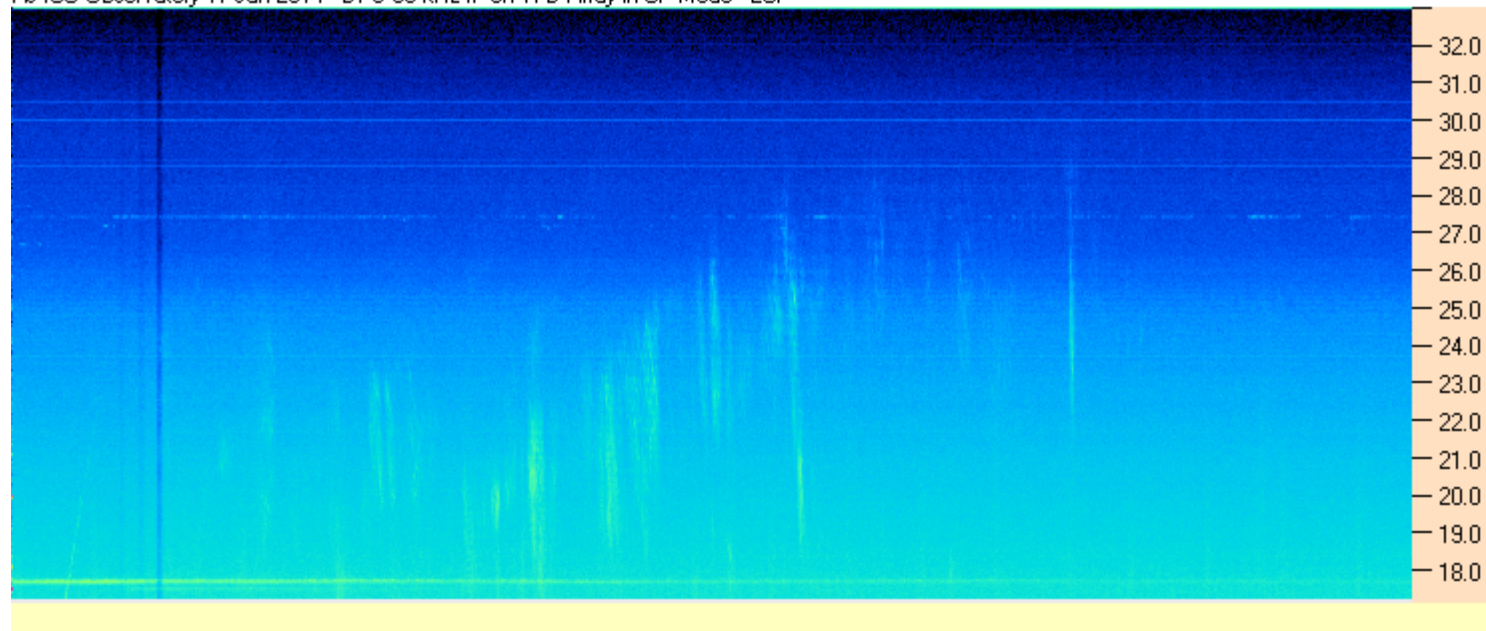




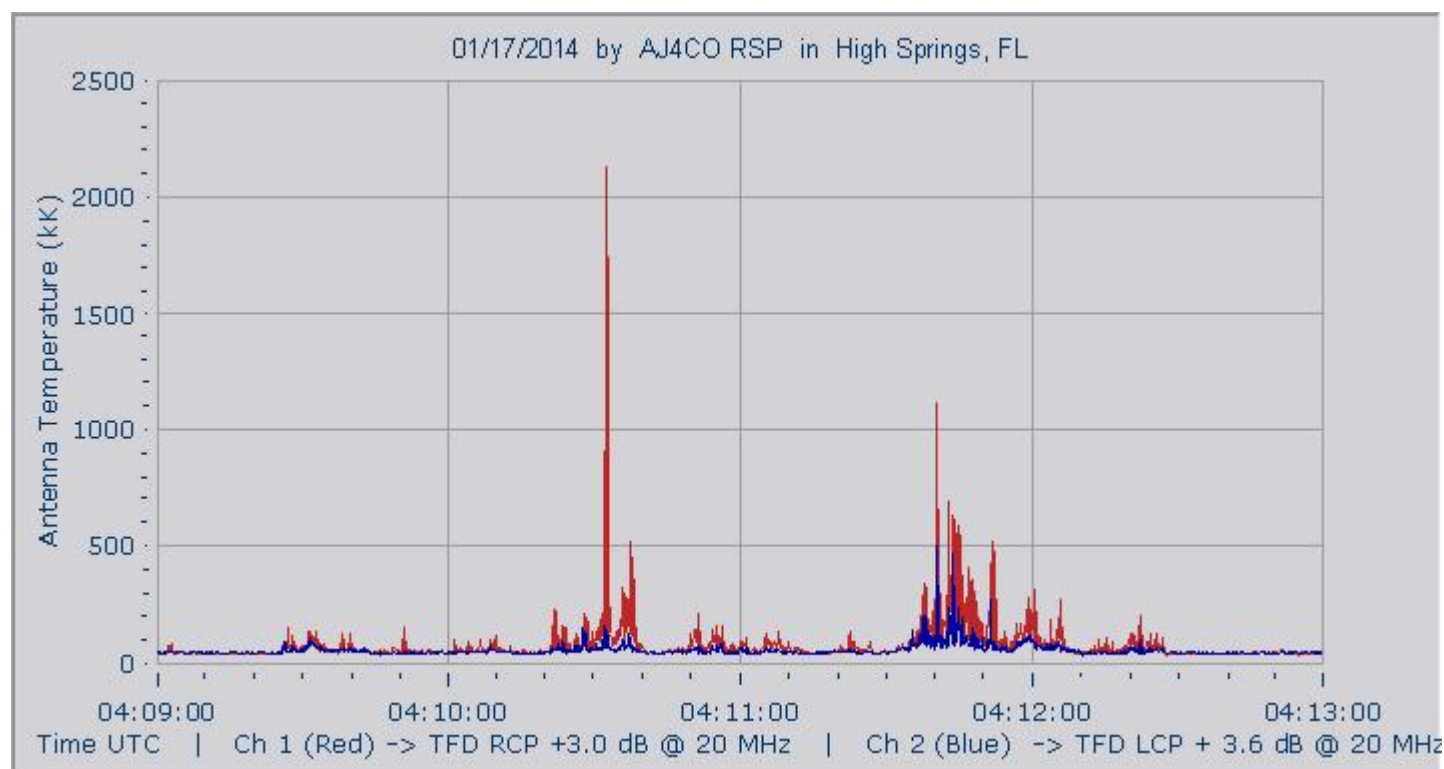
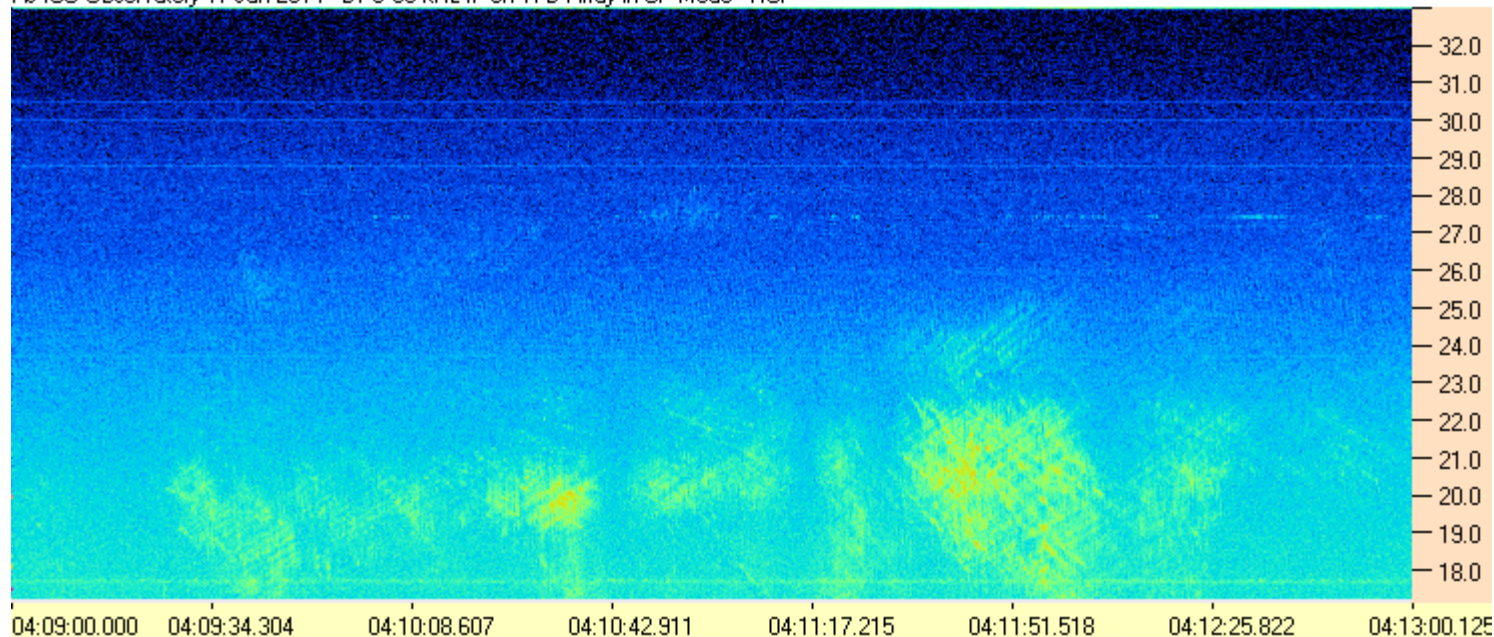
AJ4CO Observatory 17 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP



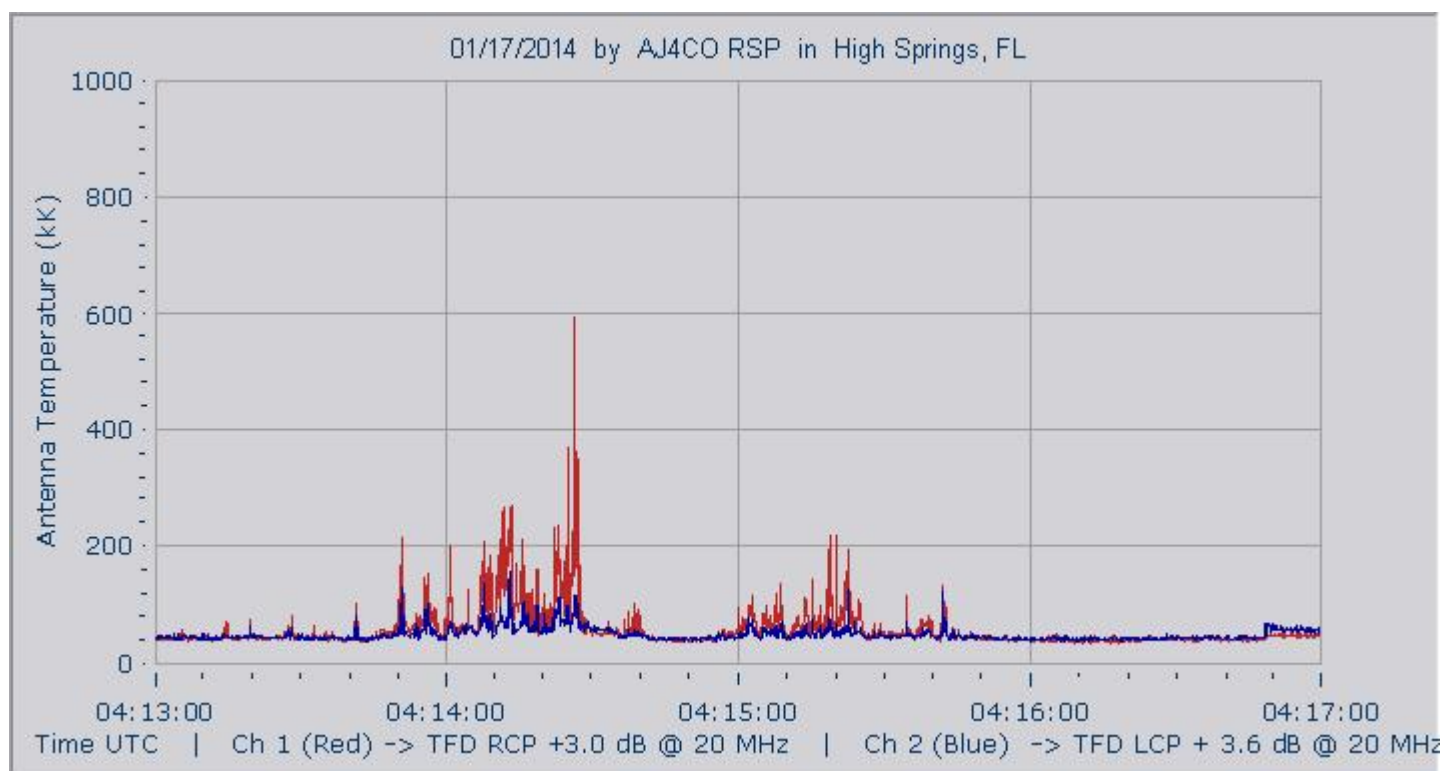
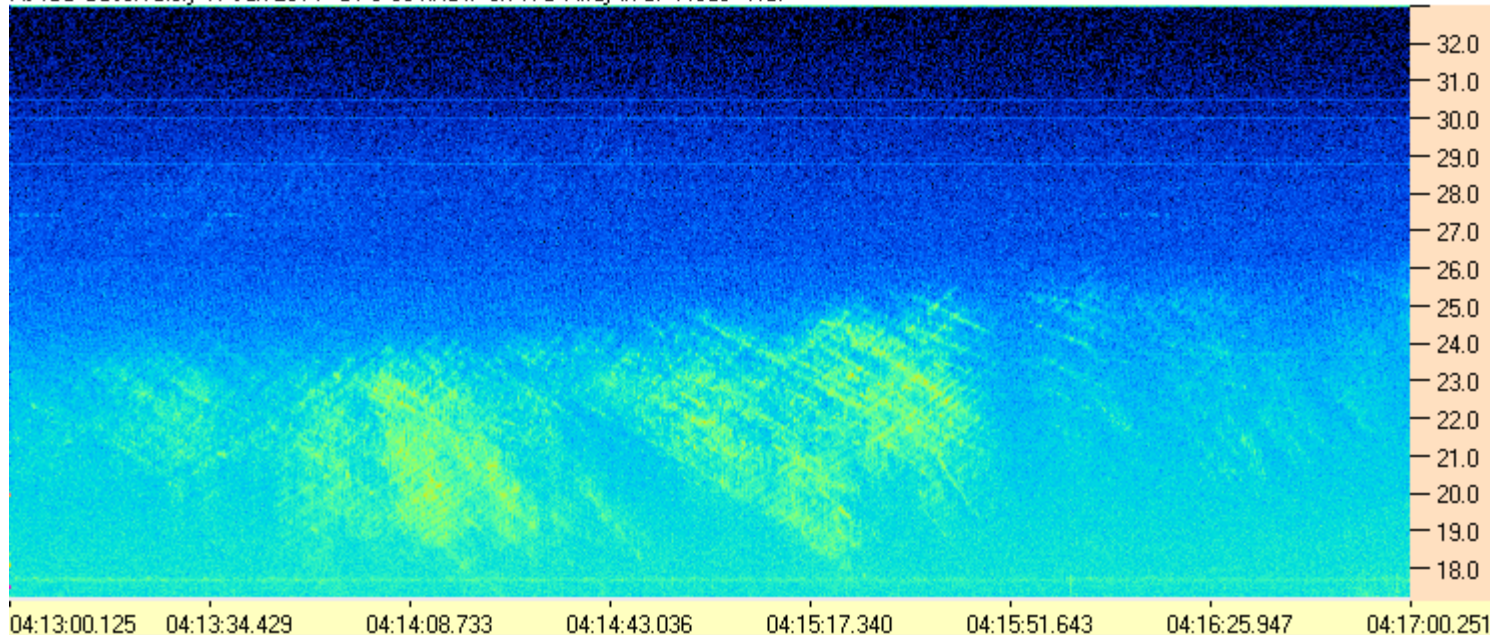
AJ4CO Observatory 17 Jan 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - LCP
