RCP L bursts; emission observed from 16 to 28 MHz. Modulation lanes, positive drift.

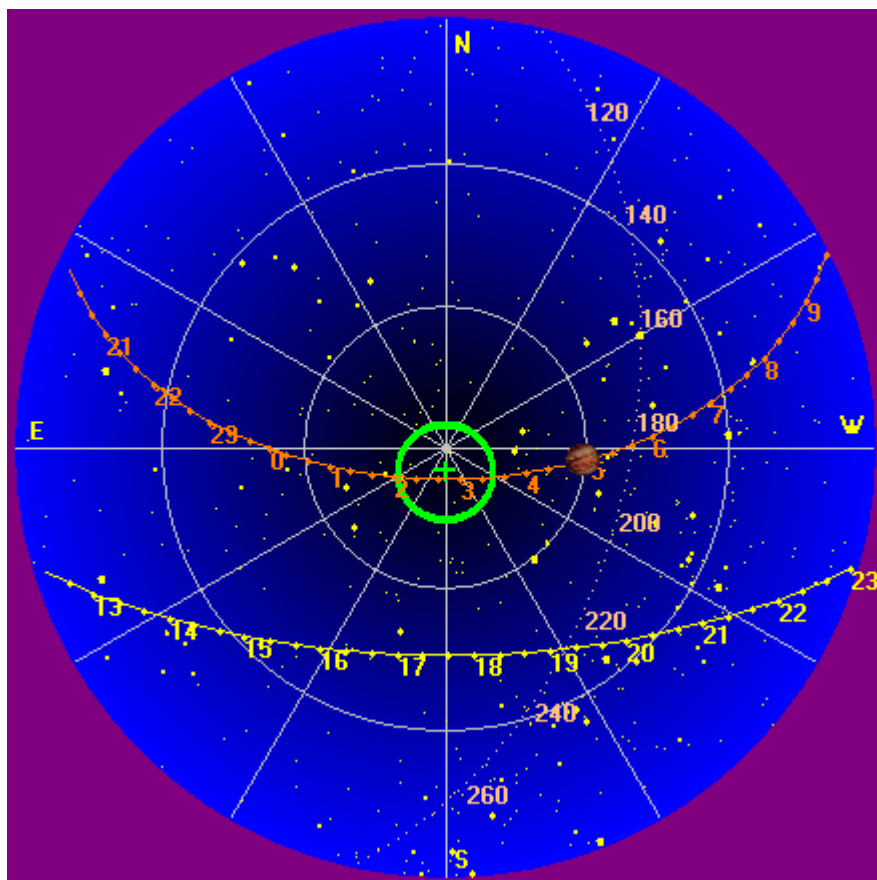
Jupiter was 15° to 41° off axis.

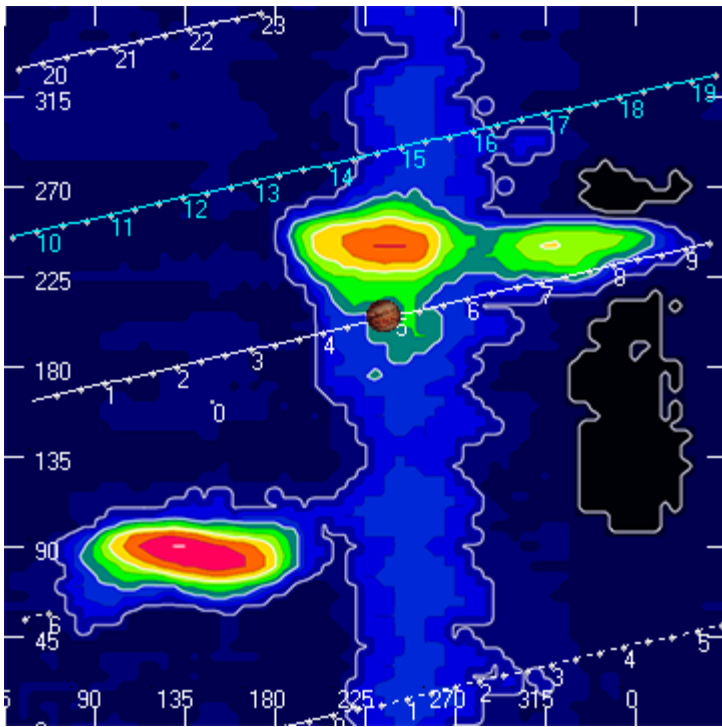
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 137° .

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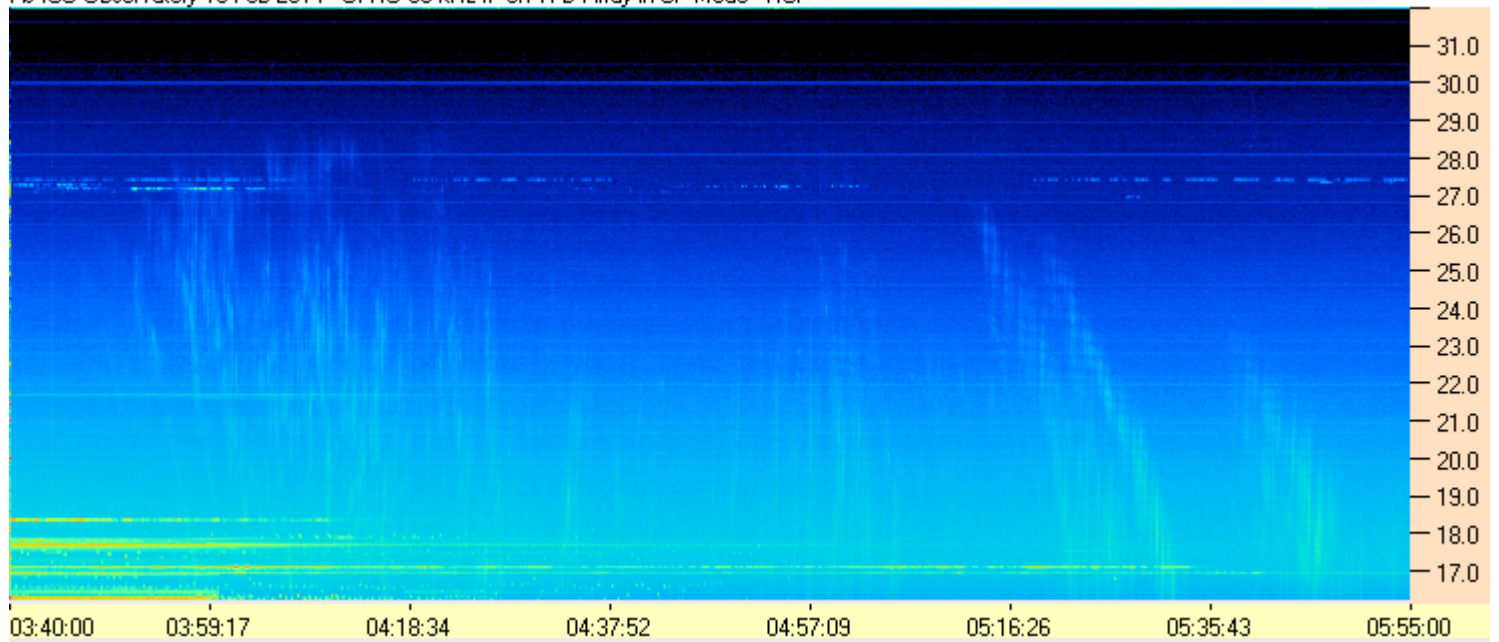

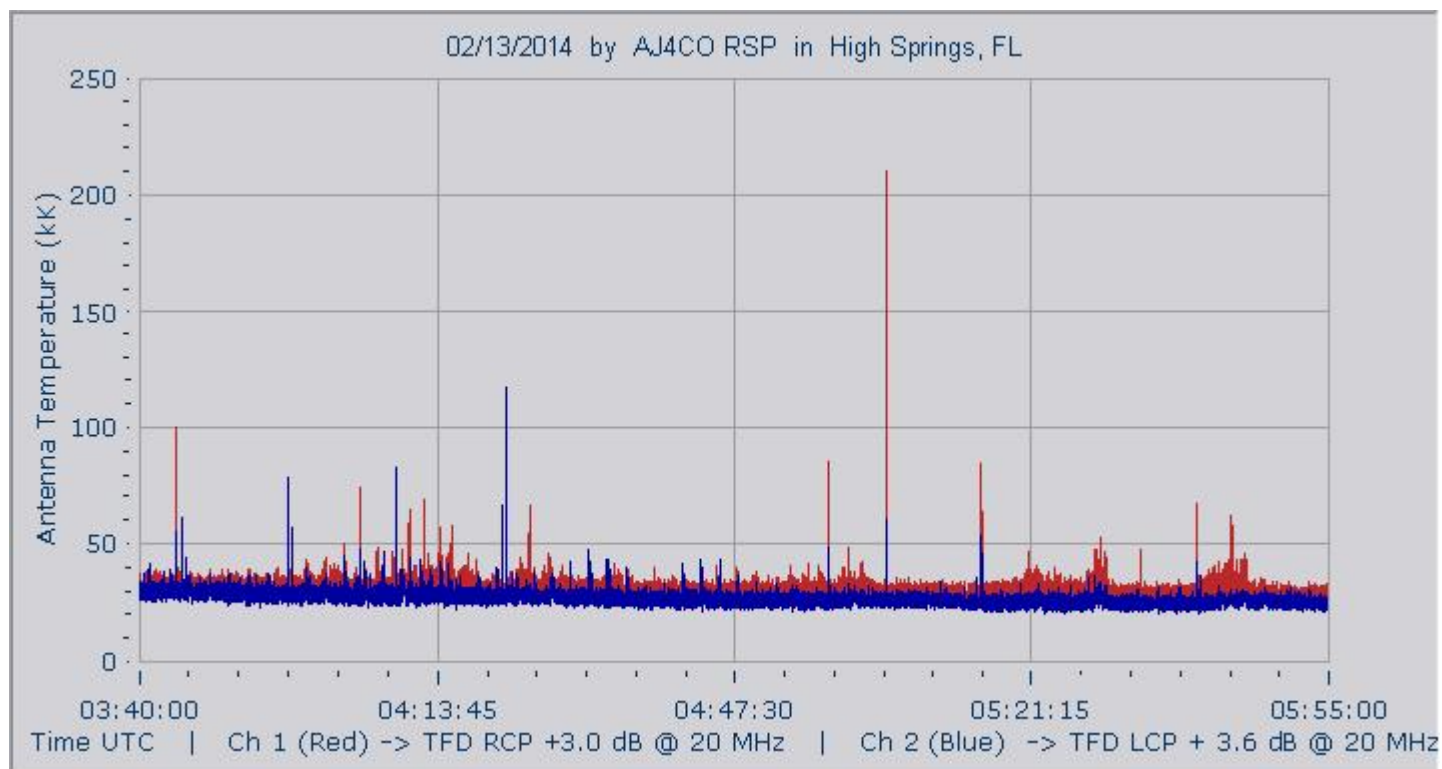
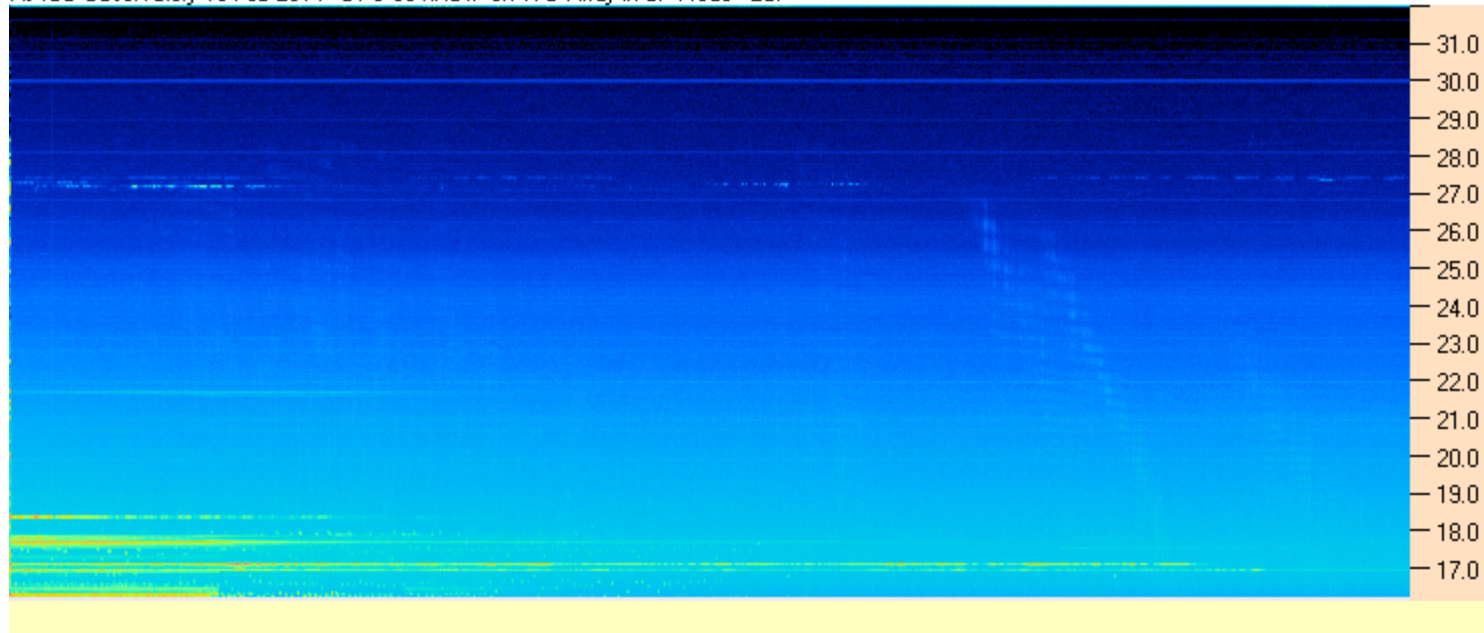




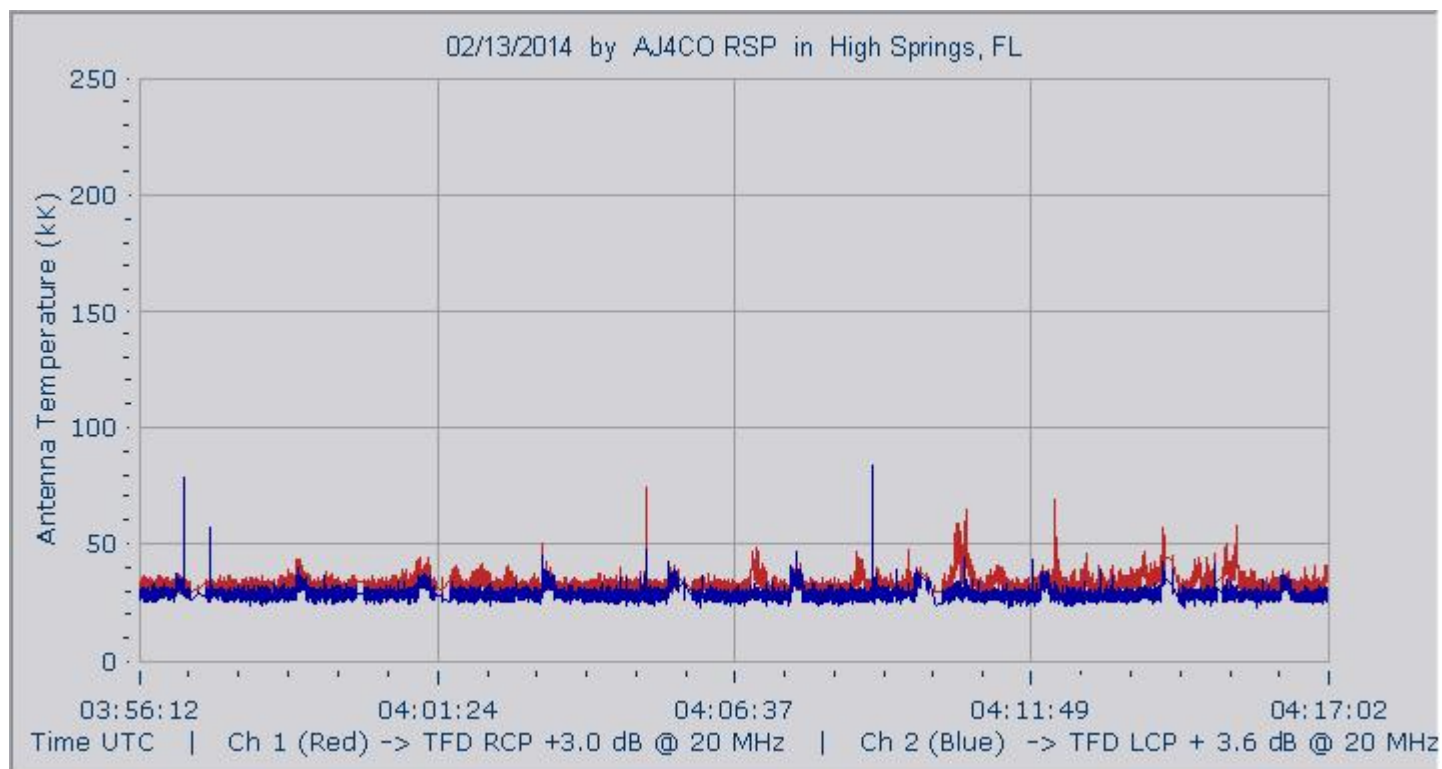
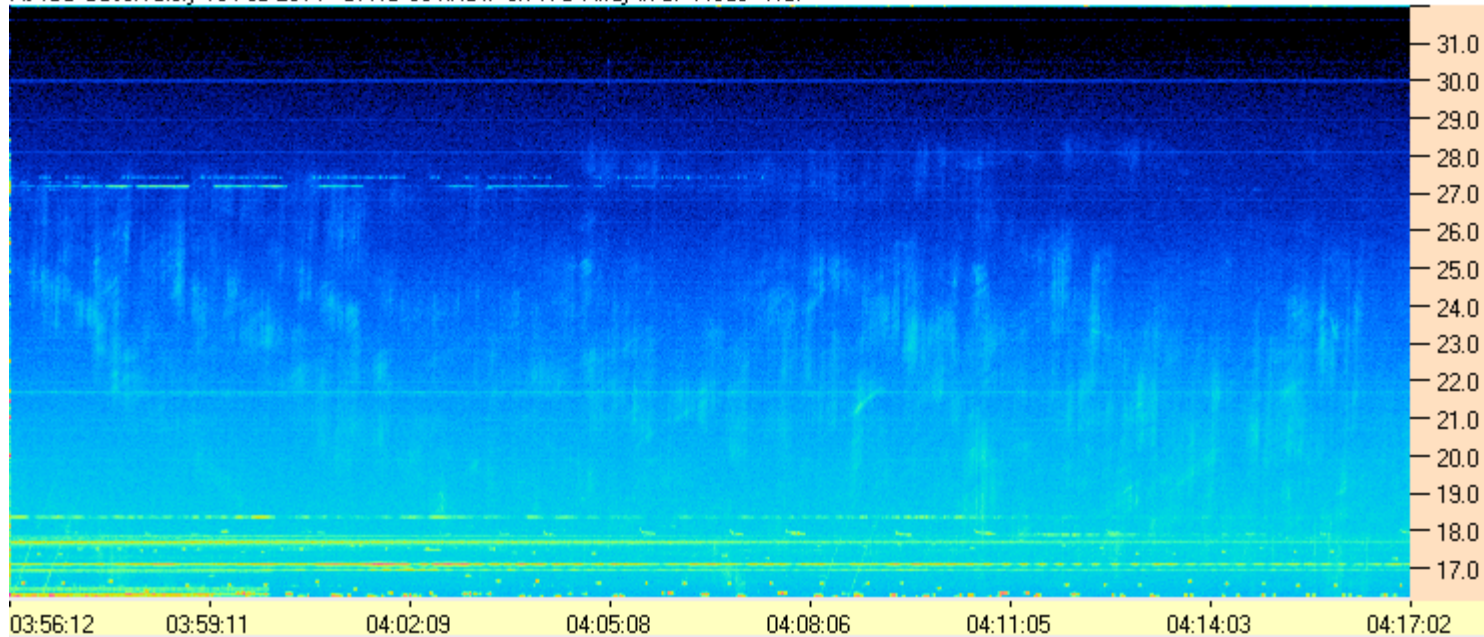
AJ4CO Observatory 13 Feb 2014 - UFR0 30 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP



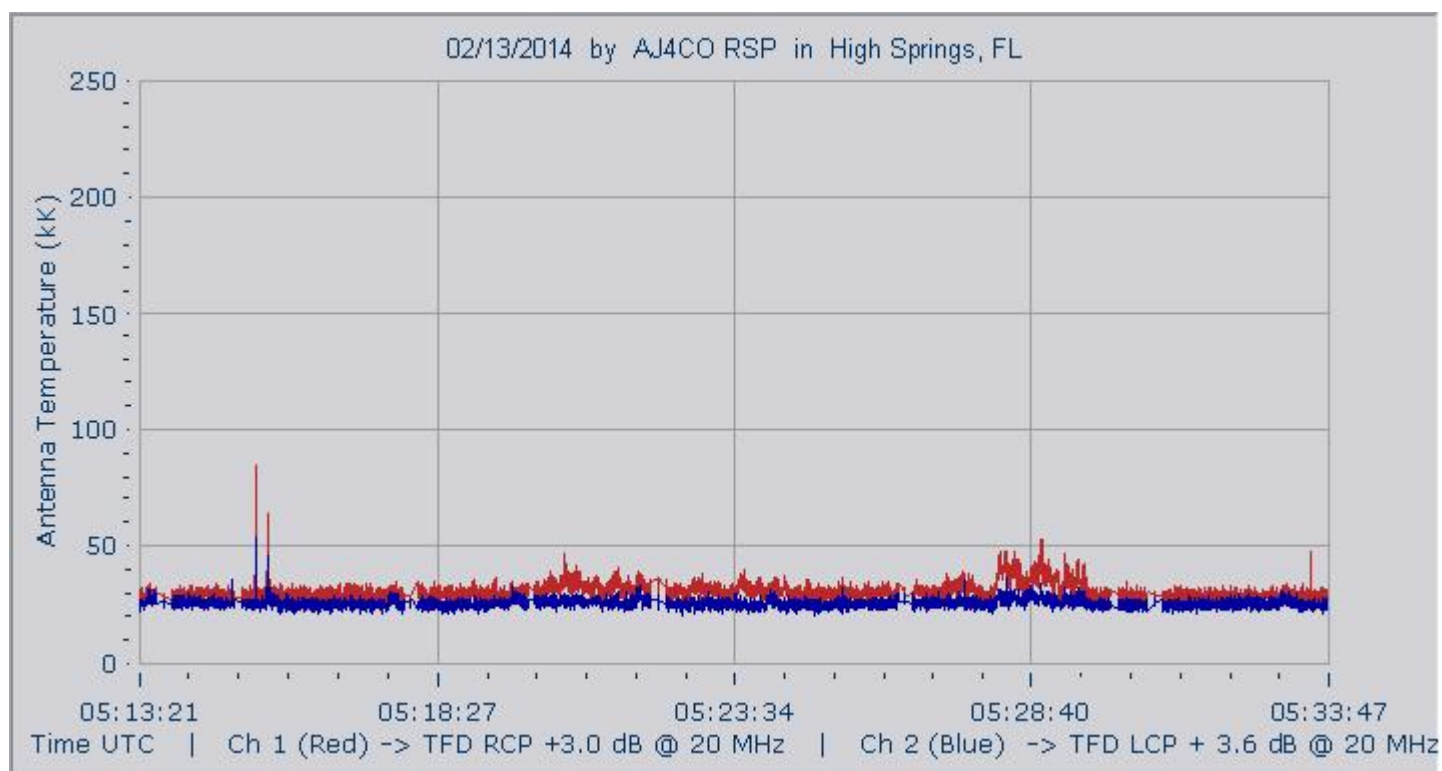
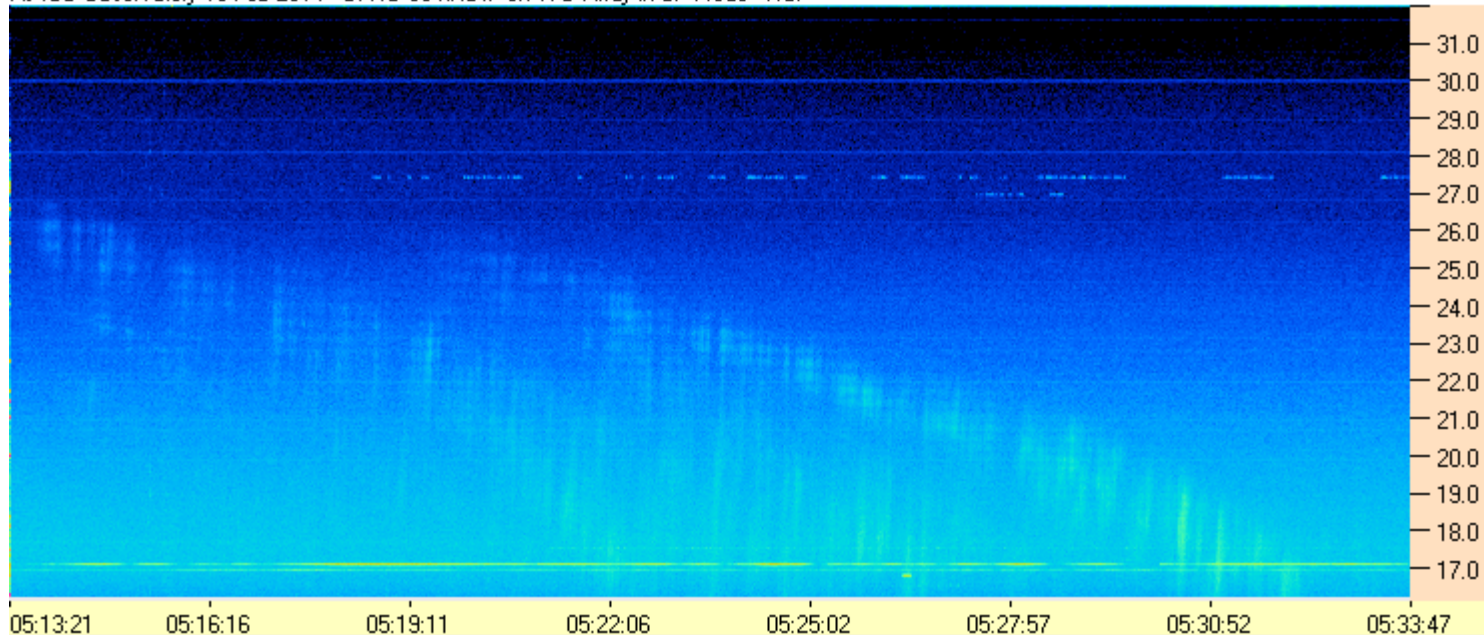
AJ4CO Observatory 13 Feb 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - LCP
