RCP L bursts; emission observed from 16 to 26 MHz. No modulation lanes evident.

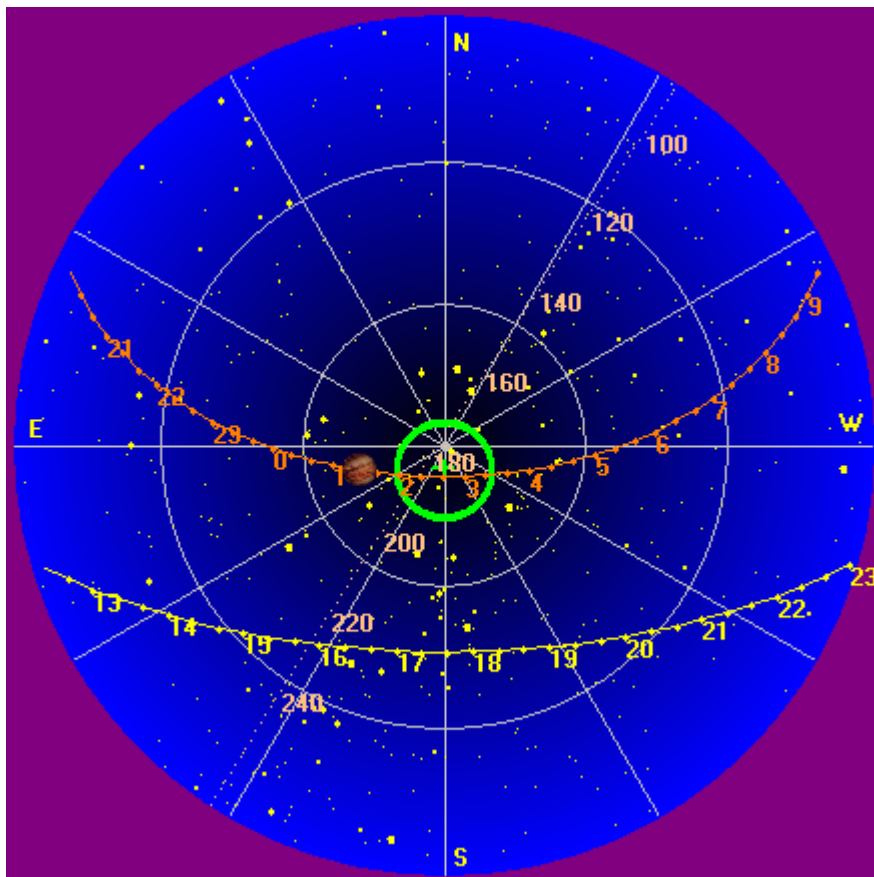
Jupiter was 19° to 15° off axis.

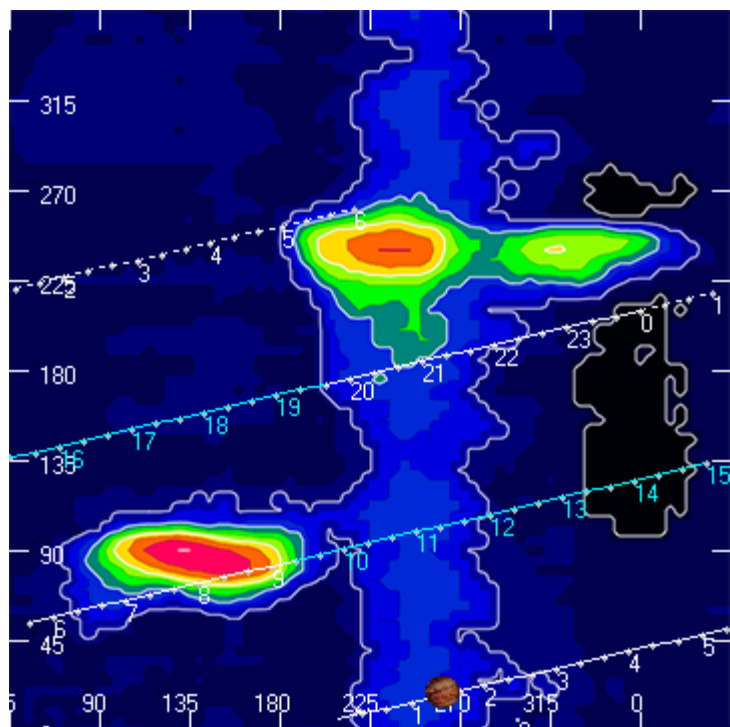
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 136°.

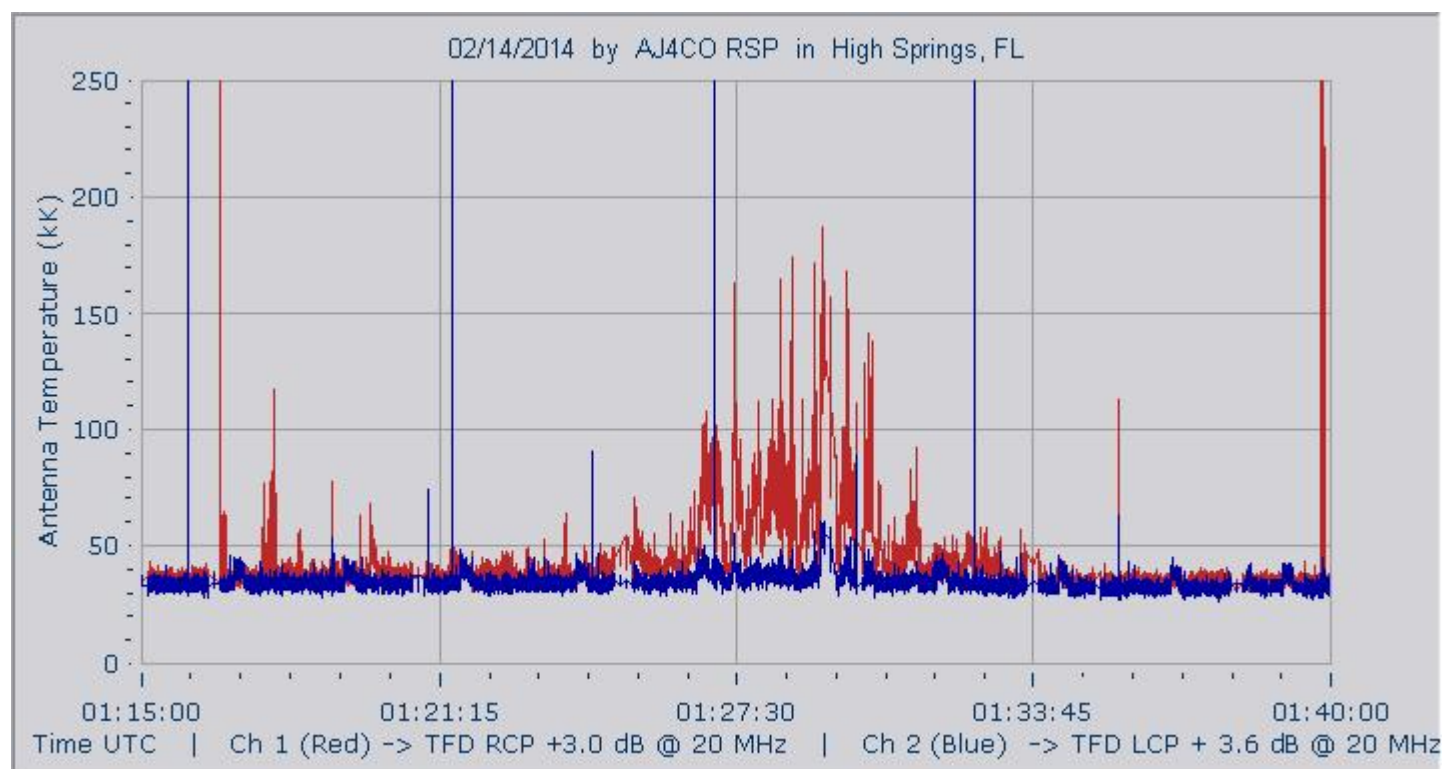
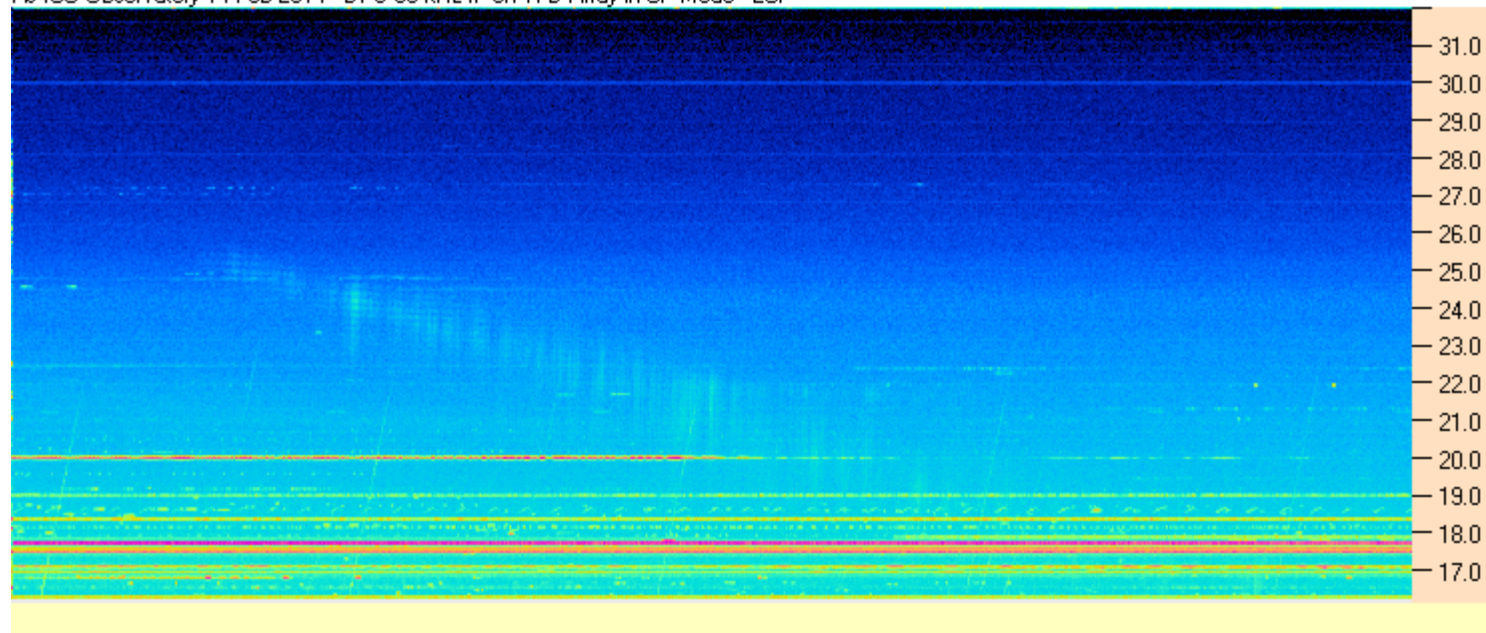




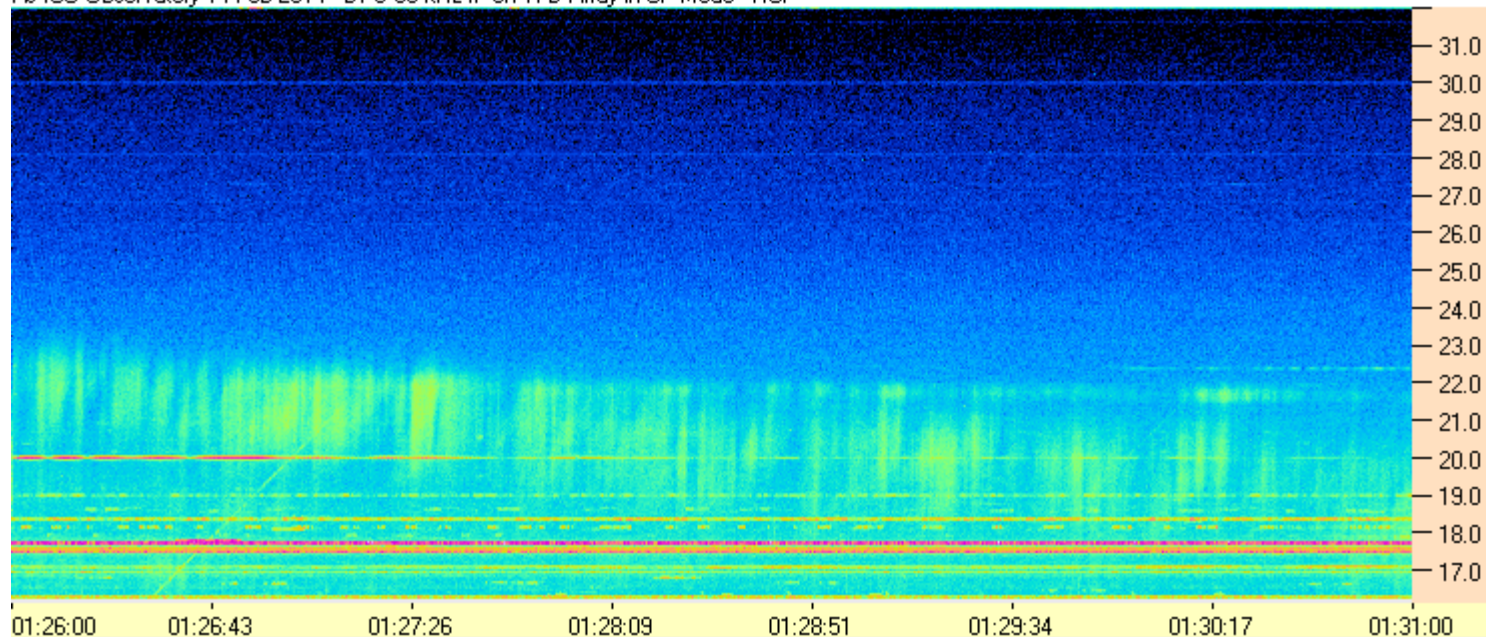
AJ4CO Observatory 14 Feb 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP
