Emission observed from 16 to 25 MHz. Fairly nice negative drift modulation lanes, too.

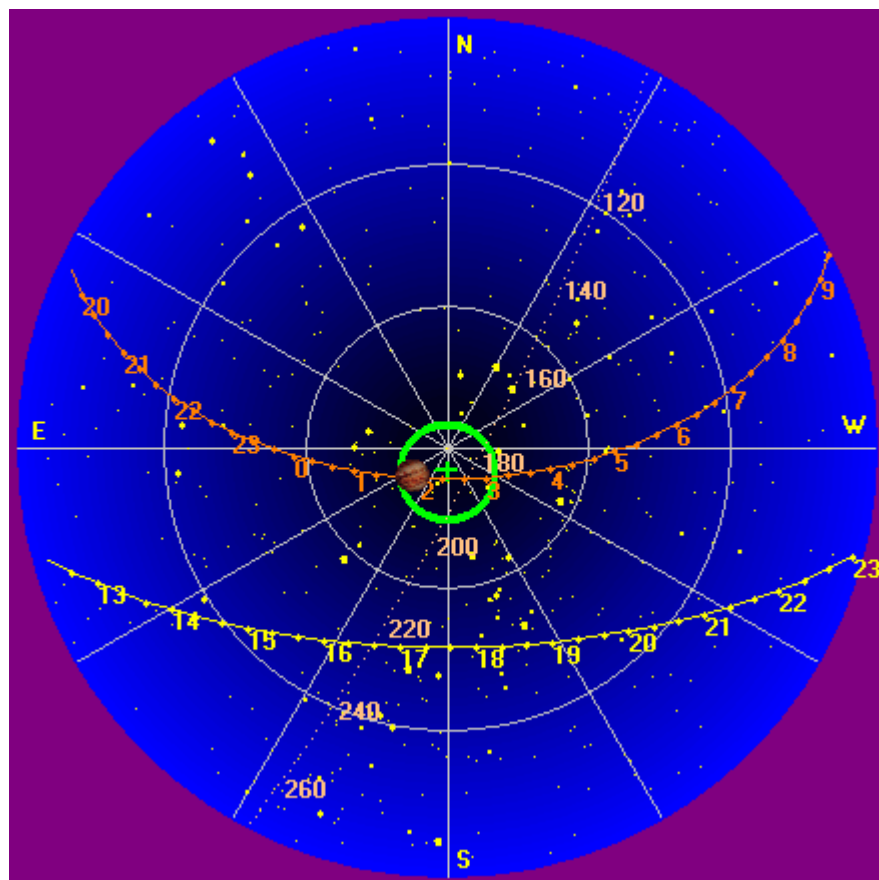
Jupiter was 10° to 5° off axis.

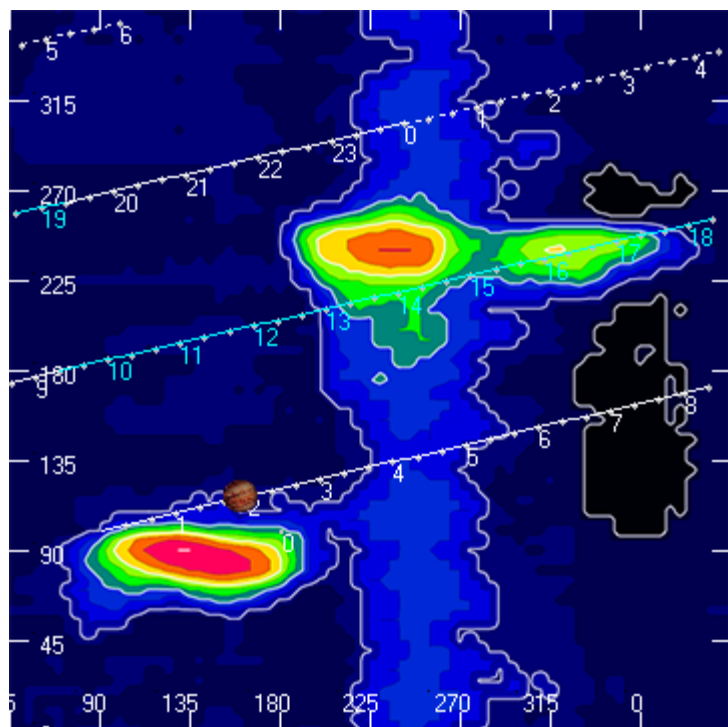
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 132° .

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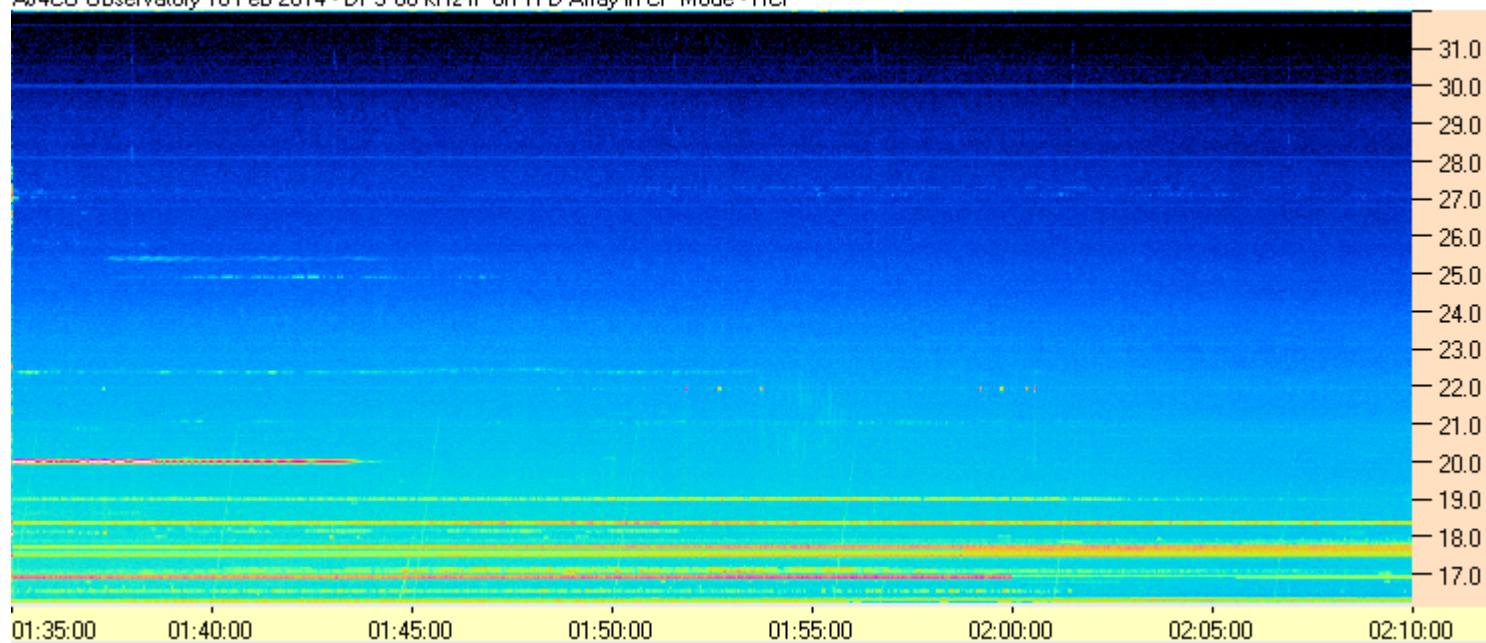

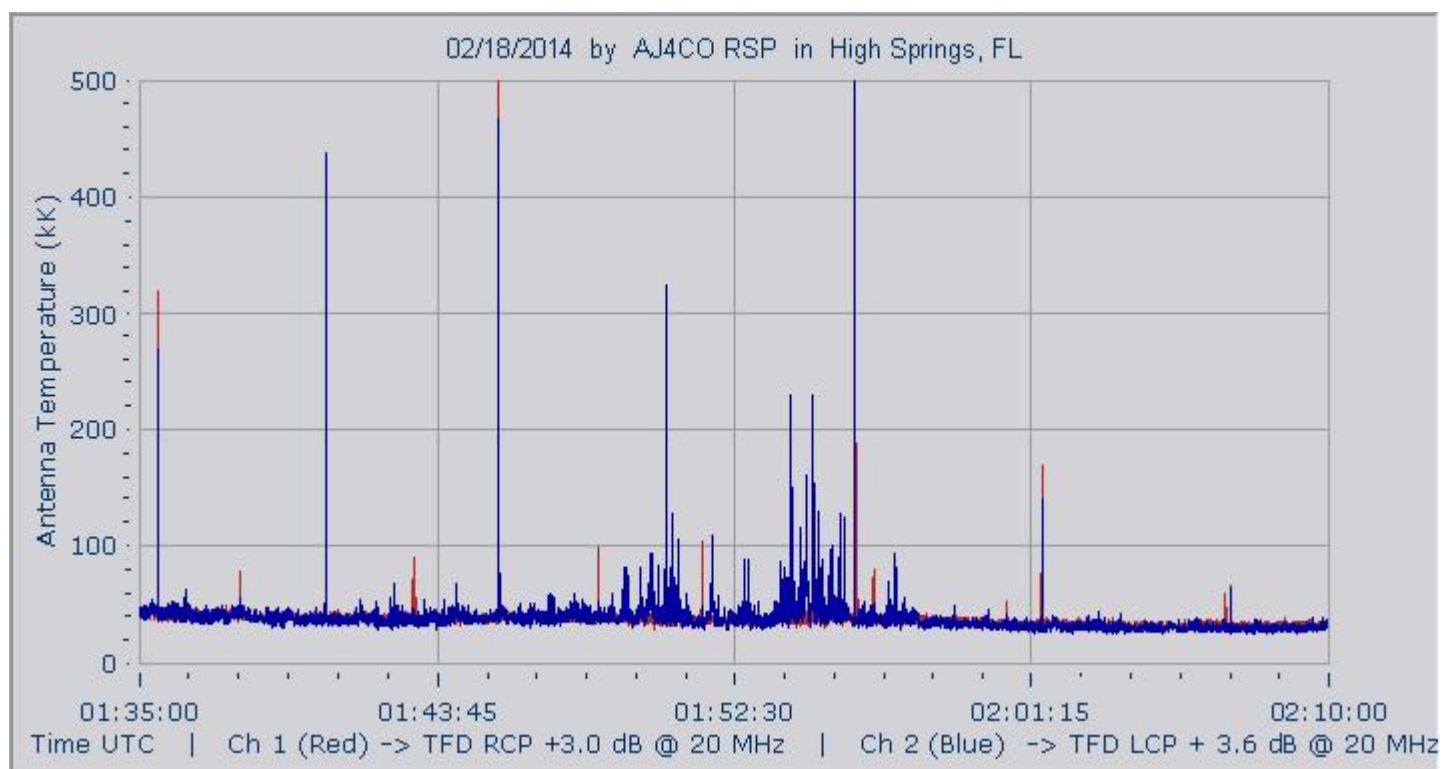
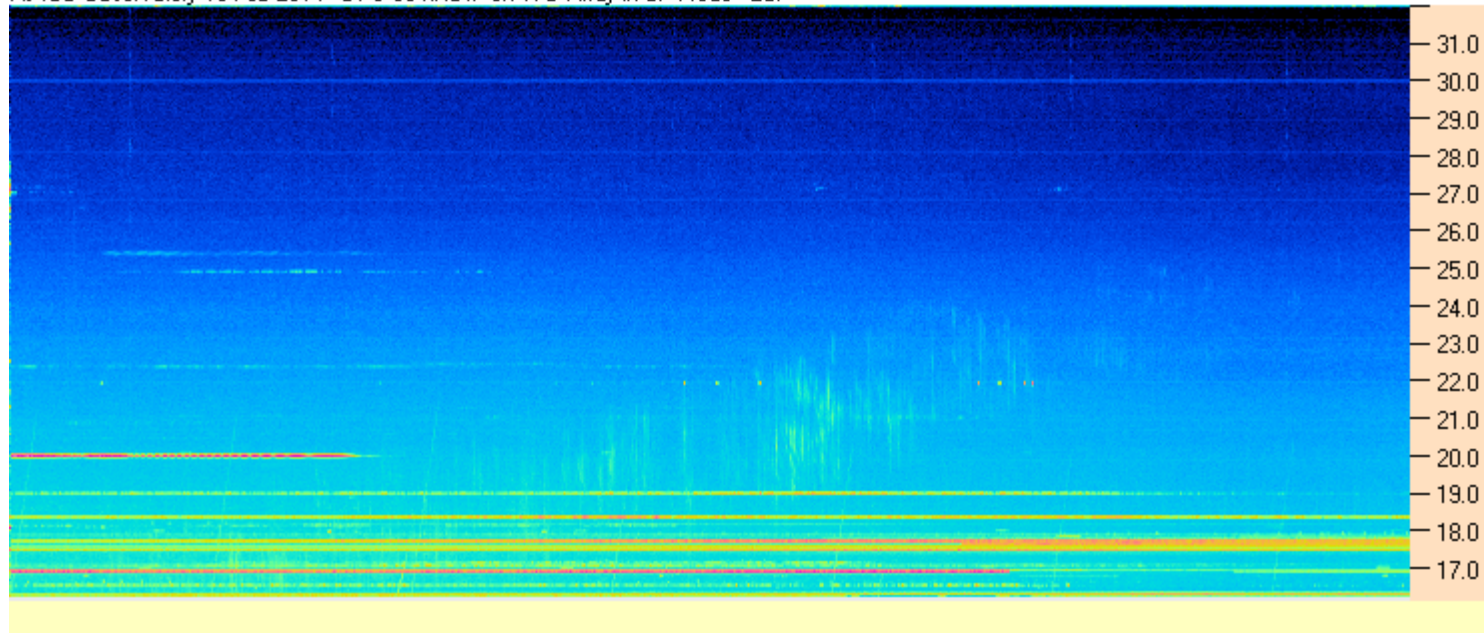




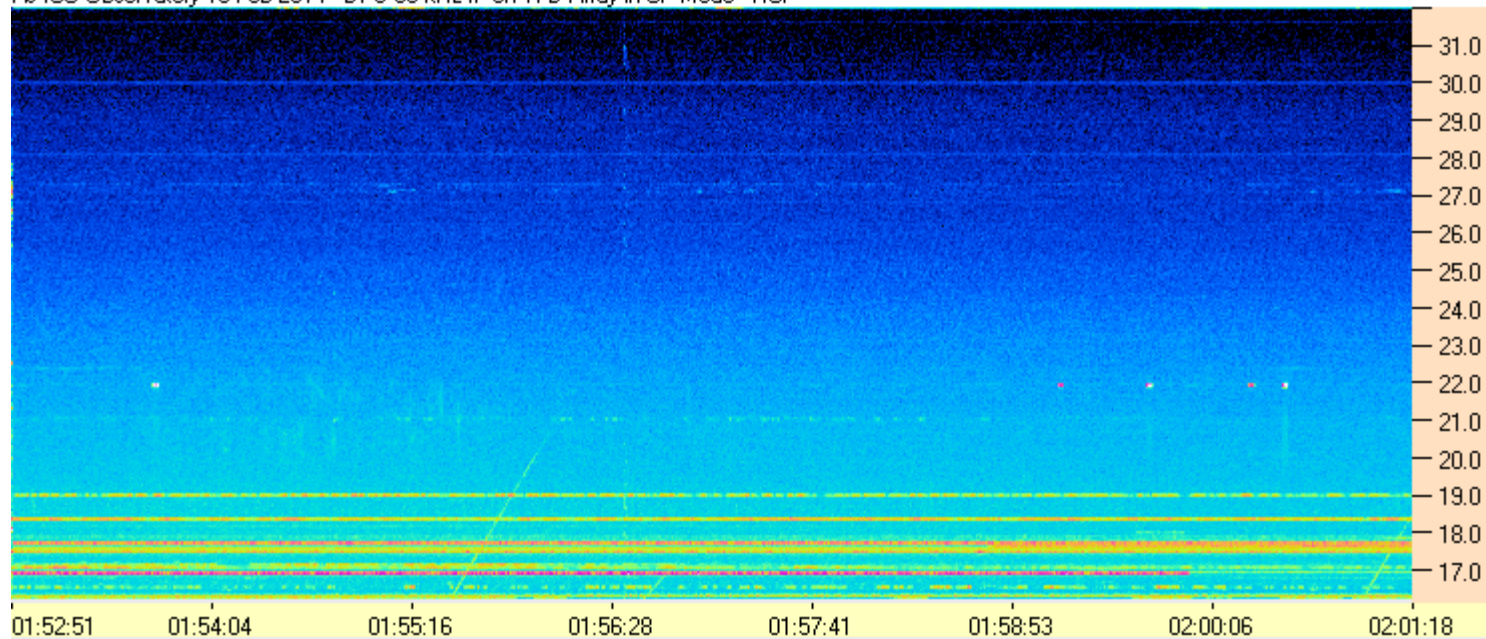
AJ4CO Observatory 18 Feb 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP
