Faint modulation lanes with negative drift.

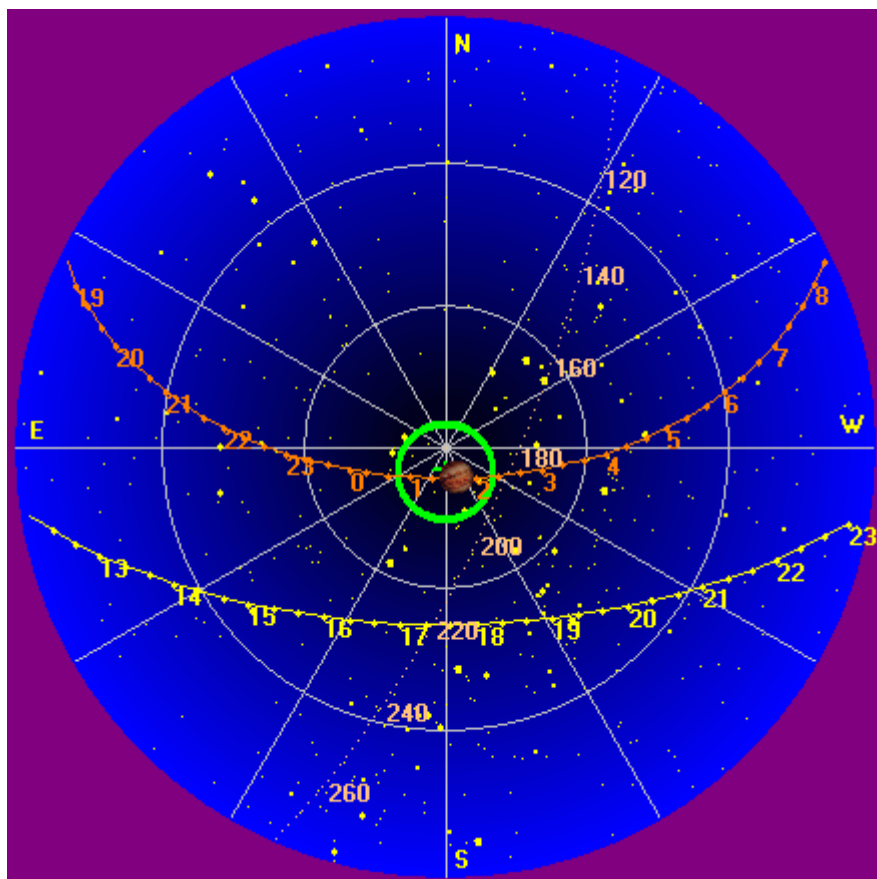
Jupiter was 3° to 17° off axis.

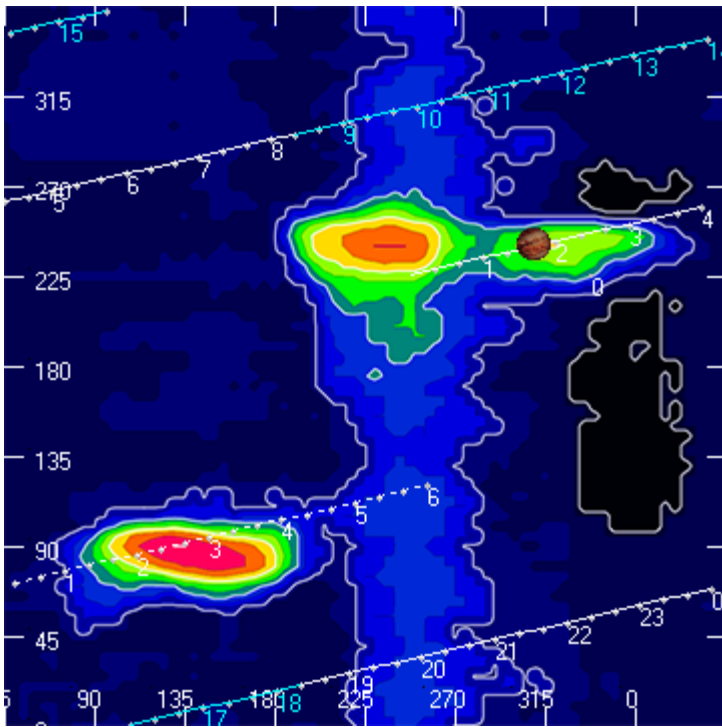
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 118°.

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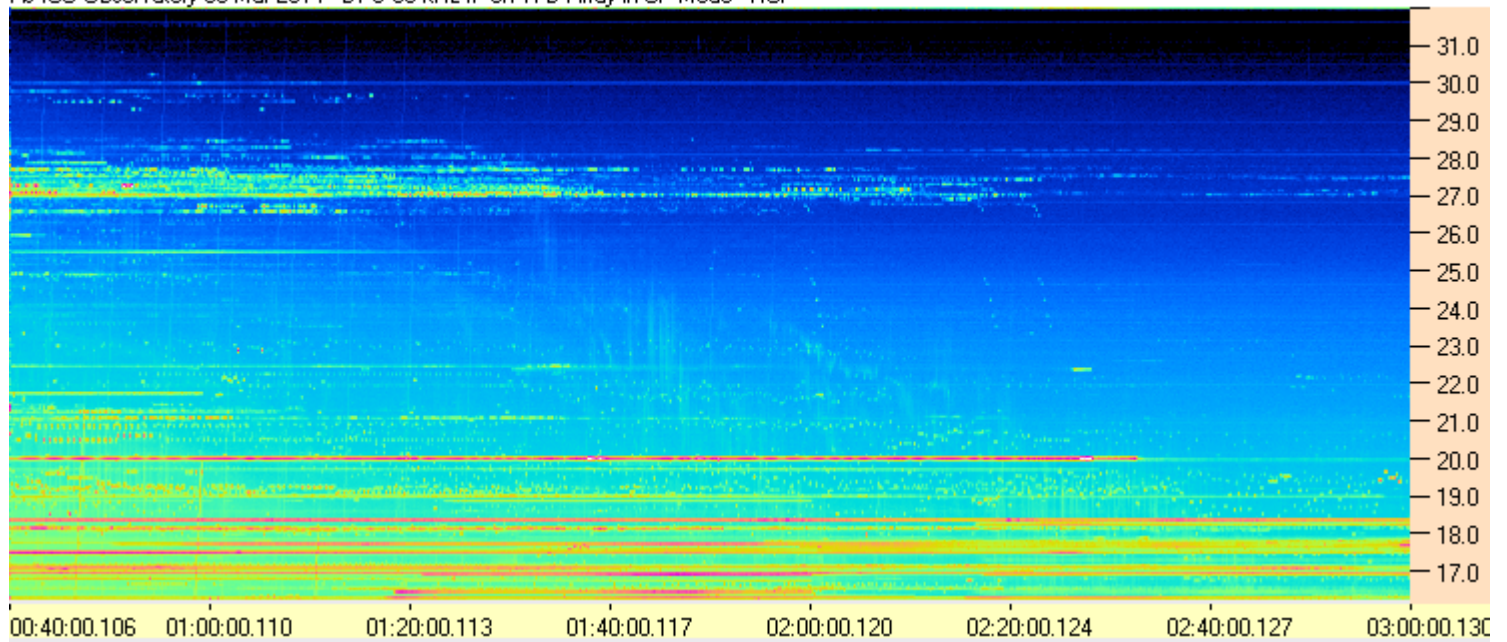

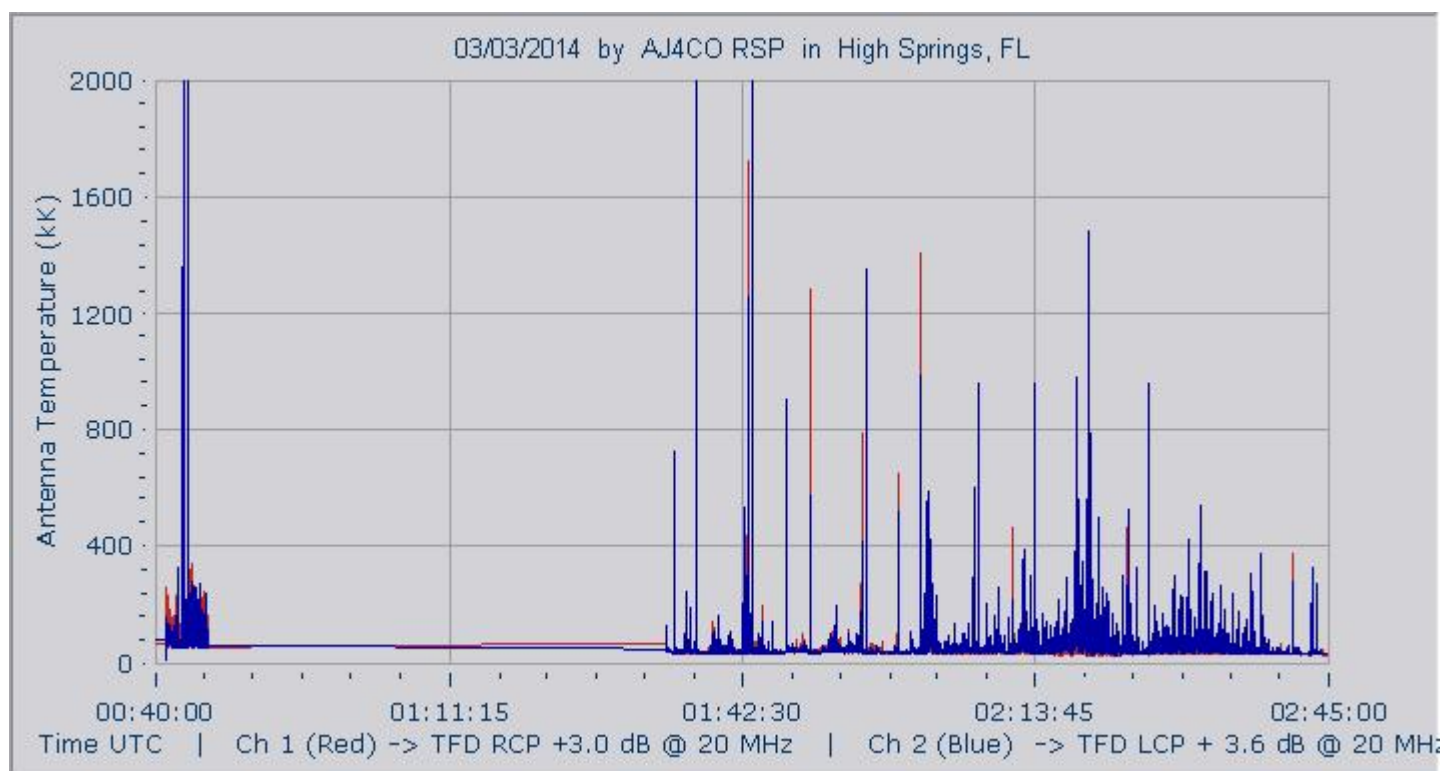
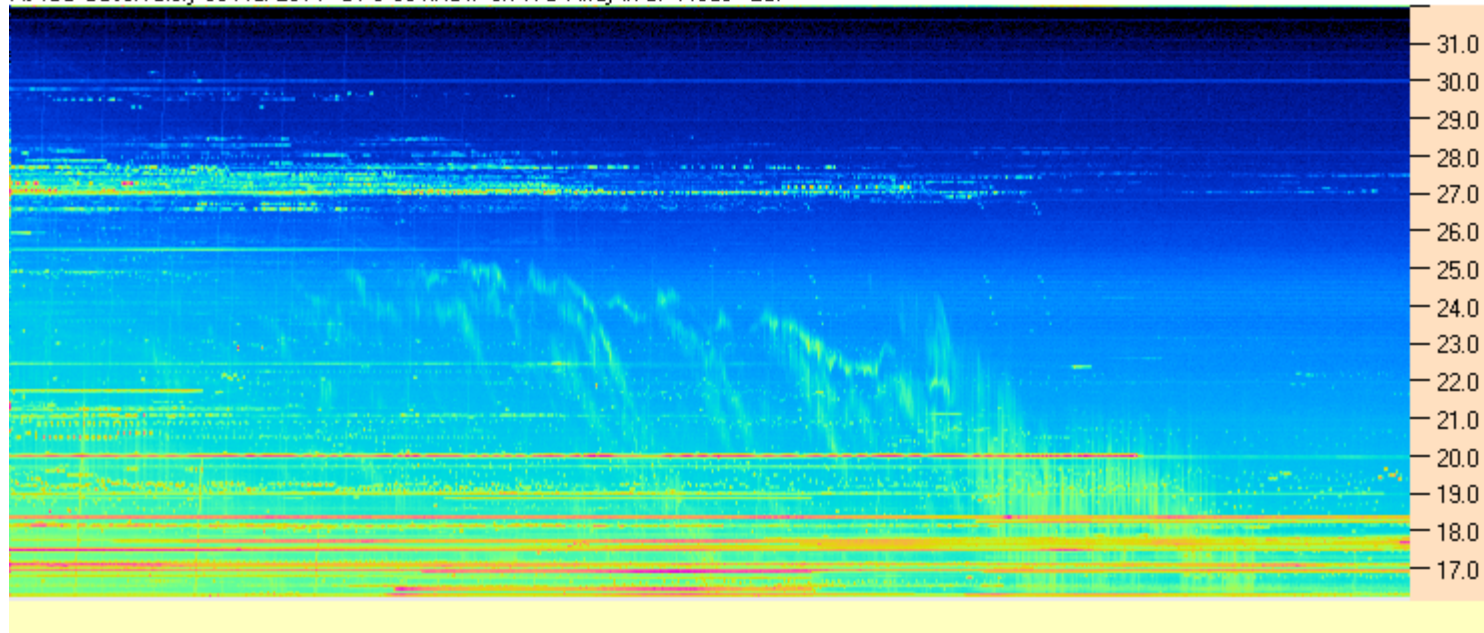




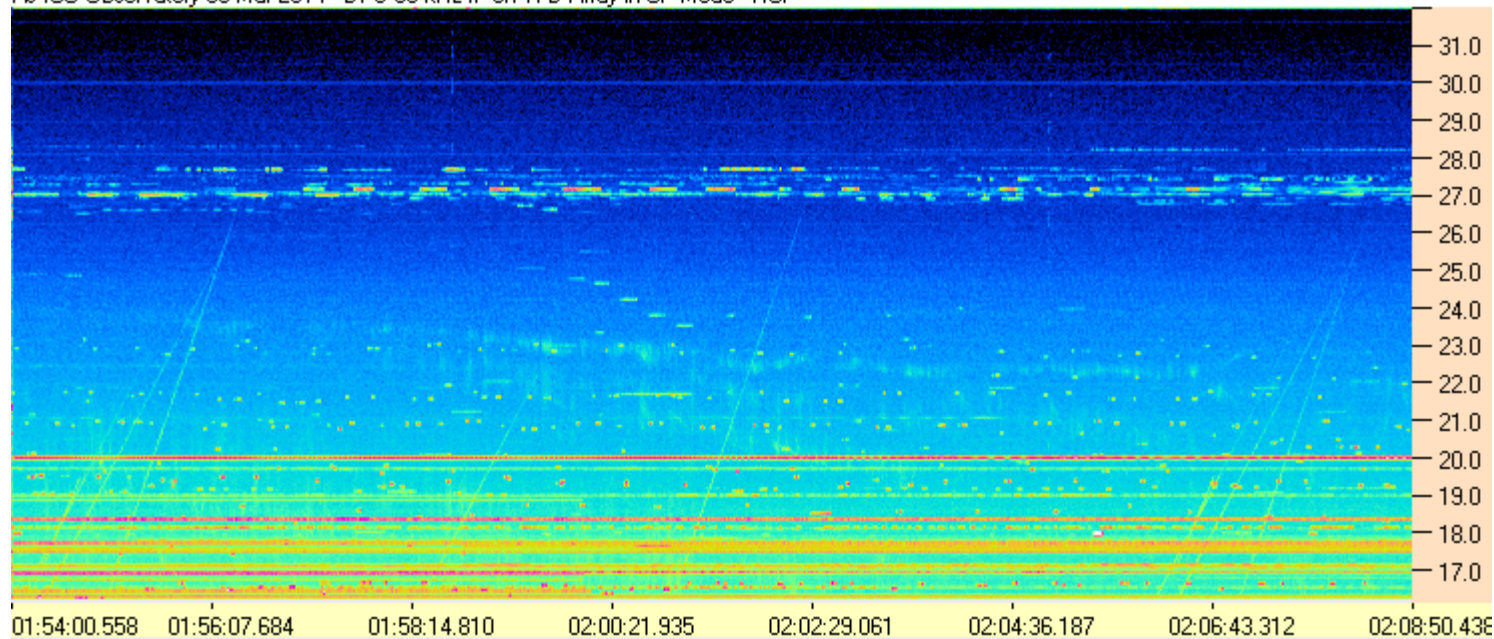
AJ4CO Observatory 03 Mar 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP
