A nice RCP L burst arc, with an LCP N event.

RCP L-bursting, negative drift arc, observed from 18 to 27 MHz. Some negative-drift modulation lanes.

LCP N event observed from 19 to 21 MHz; at times moderately strong on the 20.1 MHz strip chart.

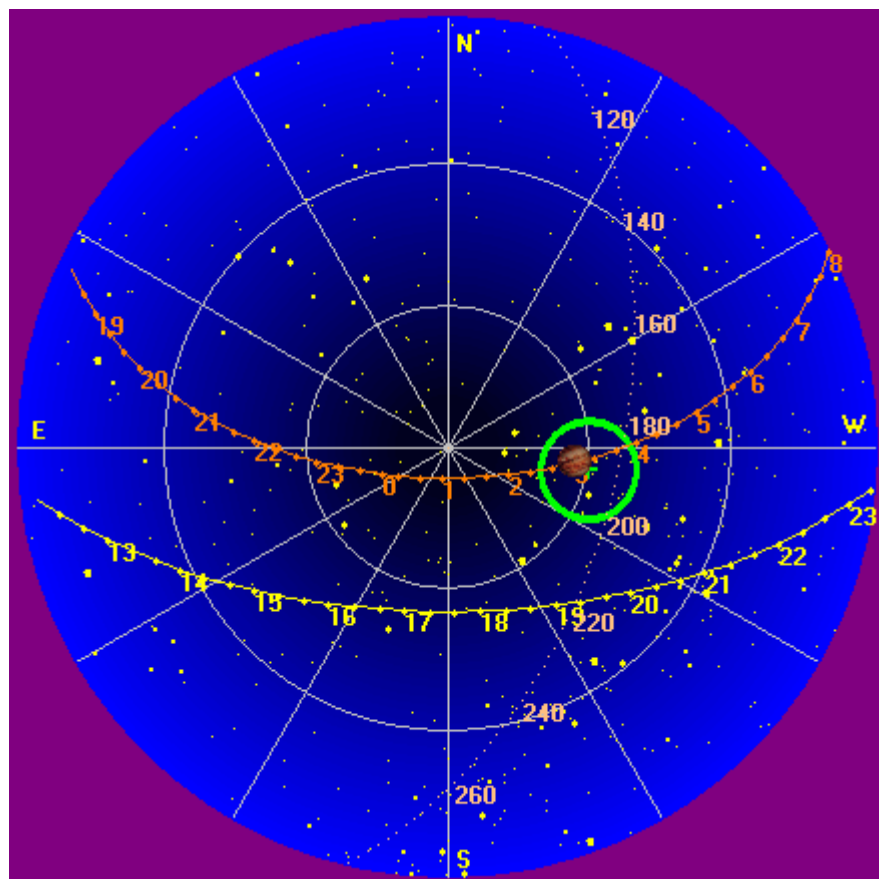
Jupiter was 2° to 18° off axis.

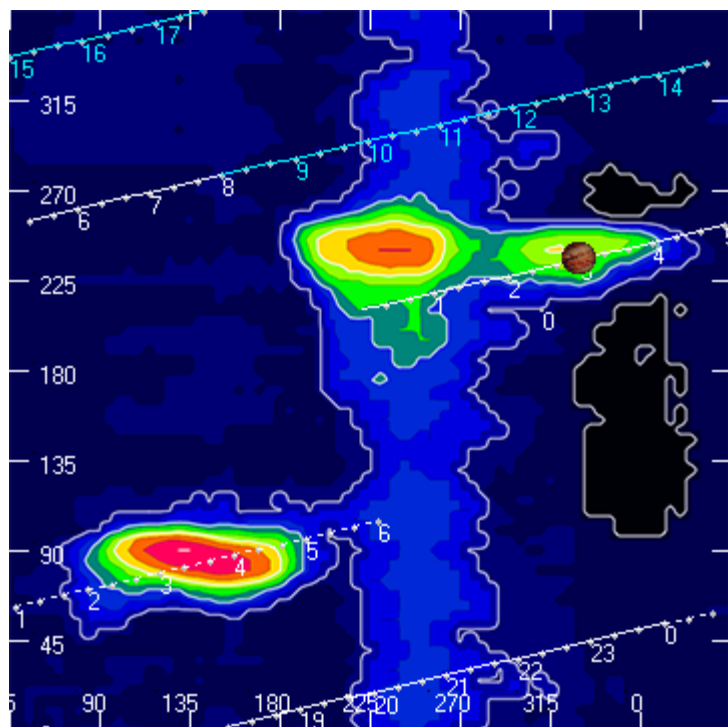
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 111°.

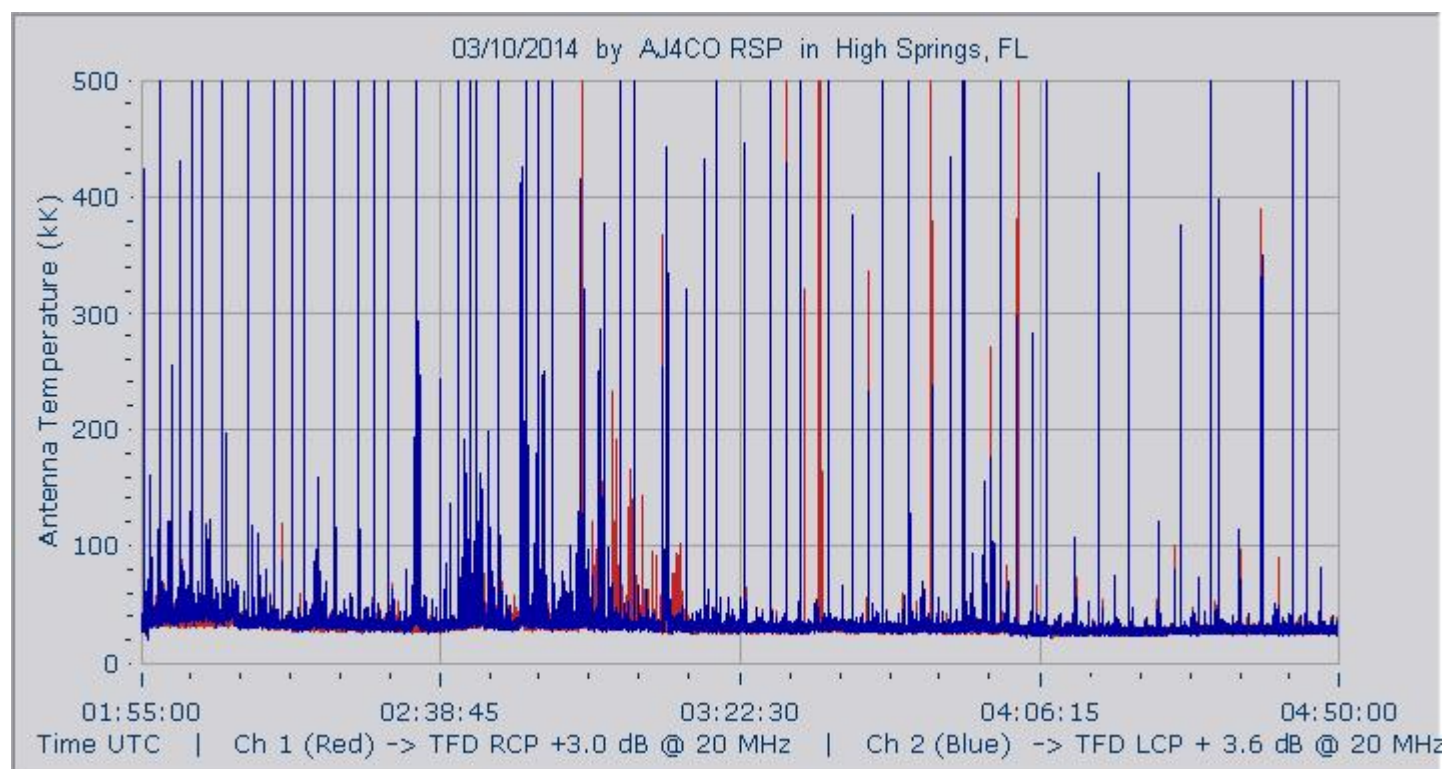
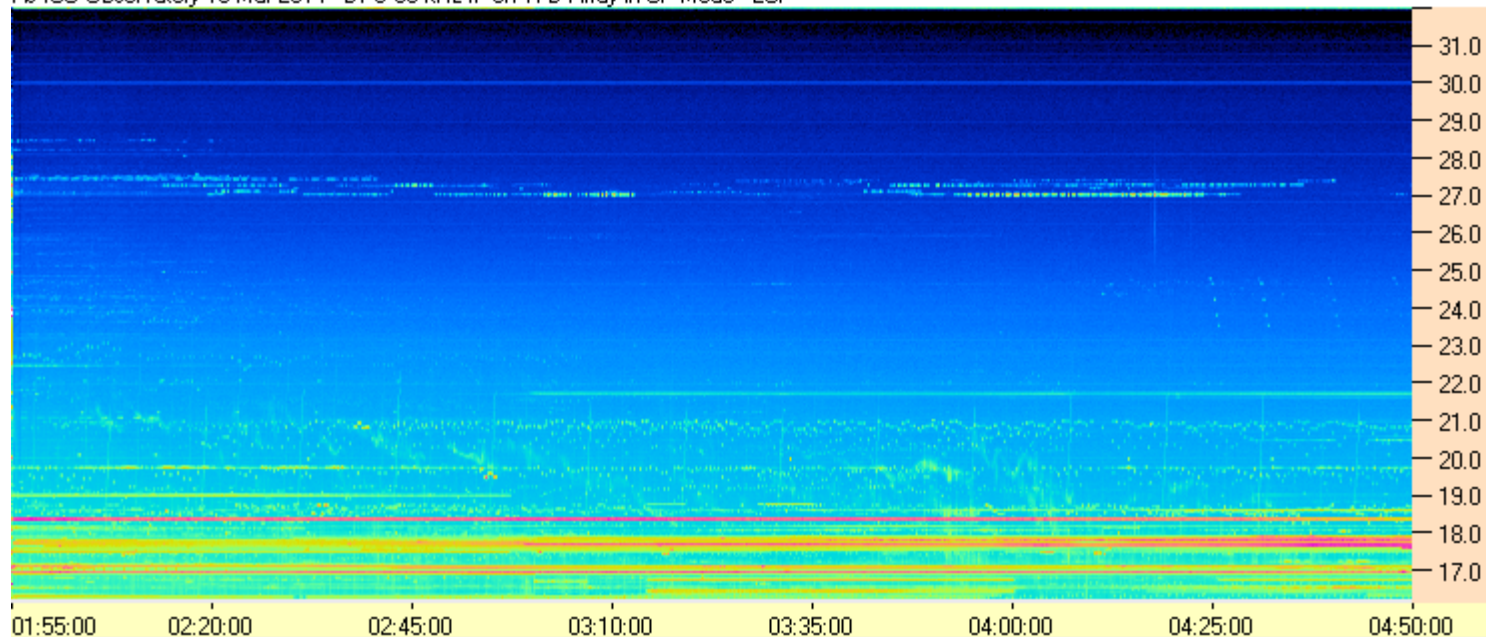




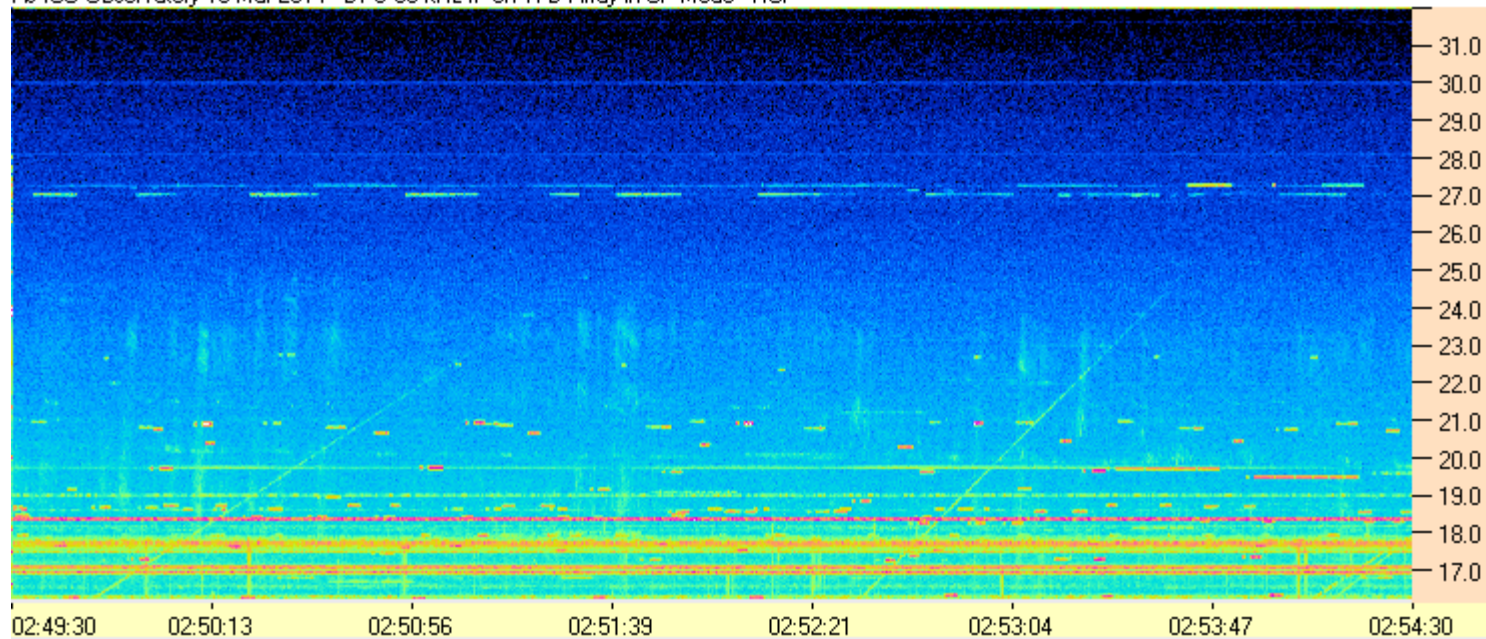
AJ4CO Observatory 10 Mar 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP



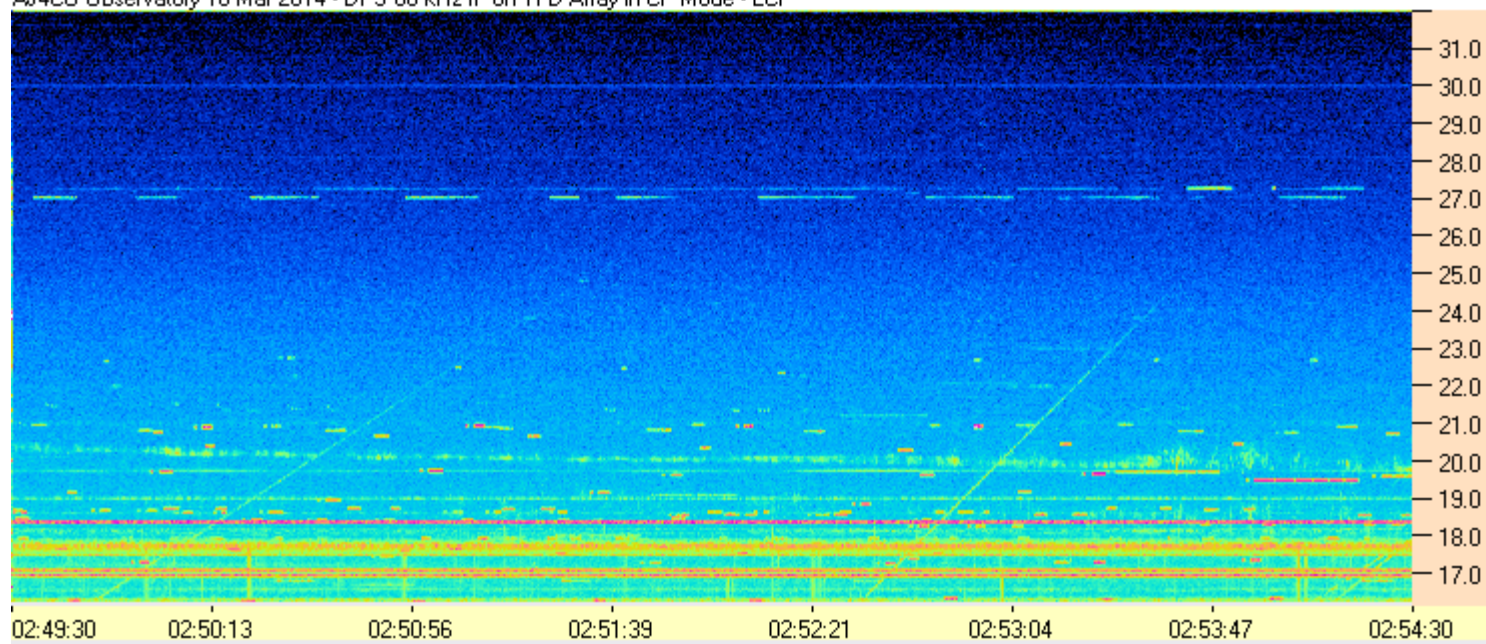

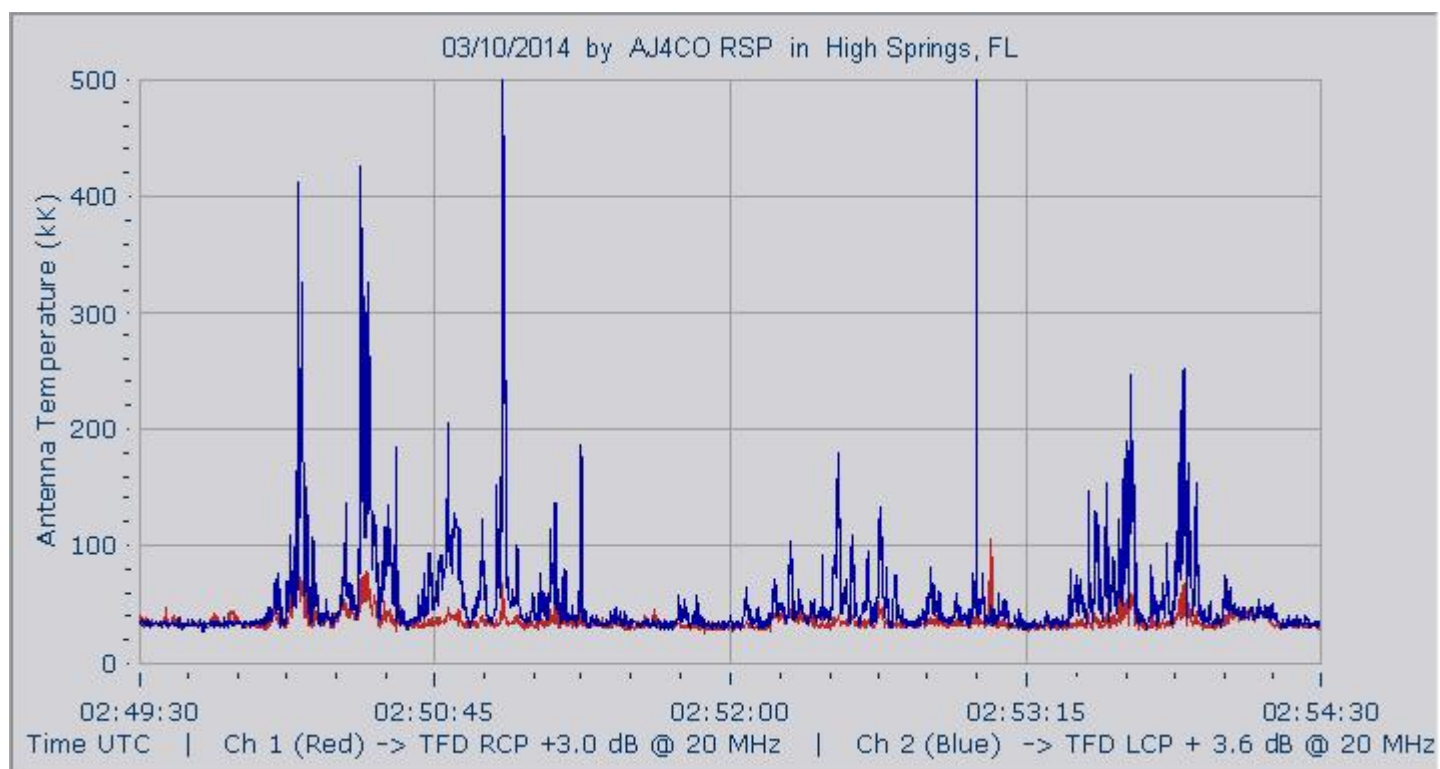

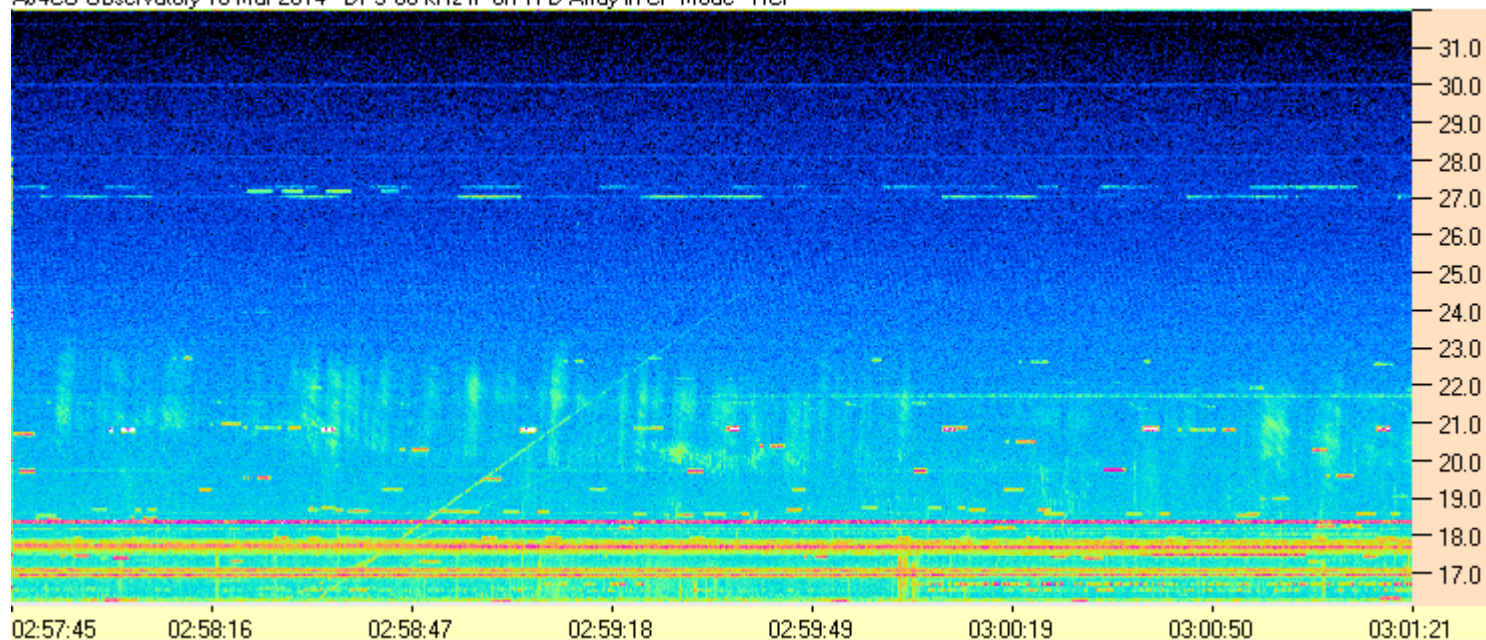

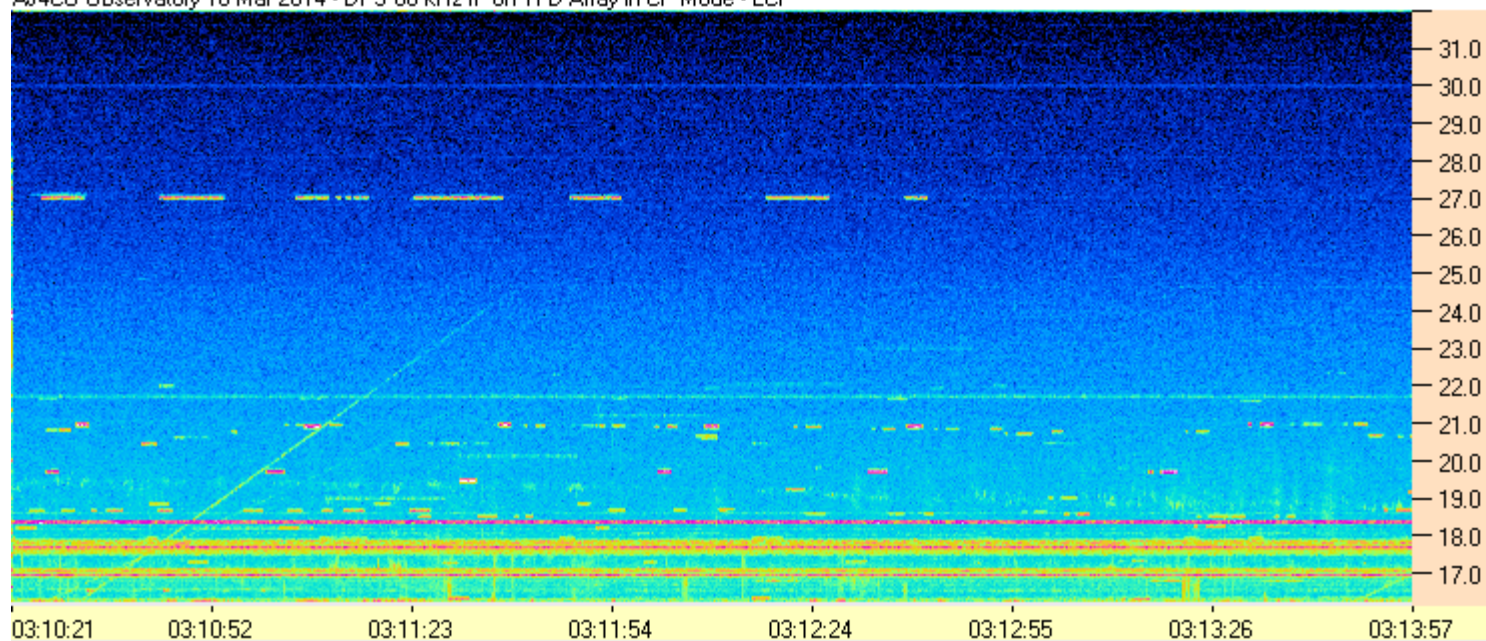

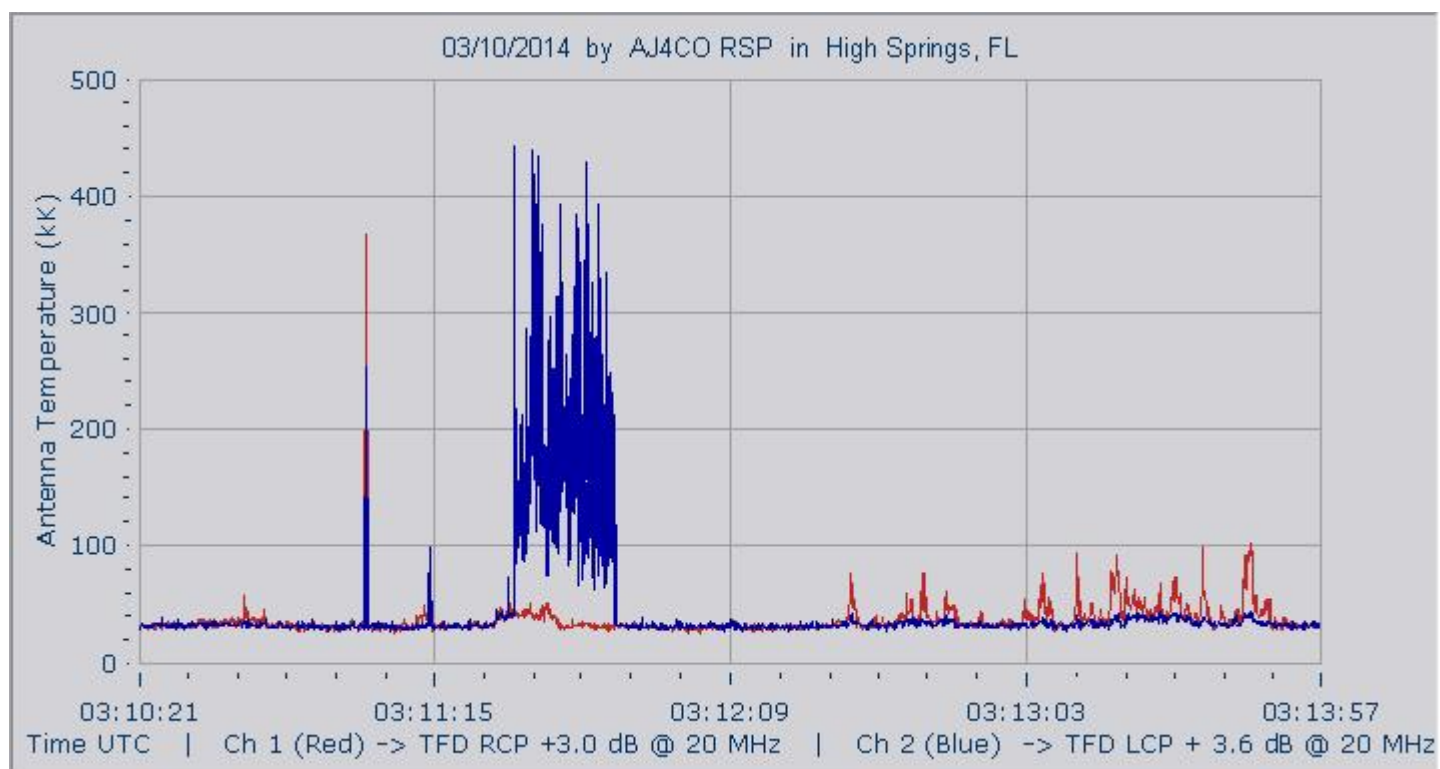

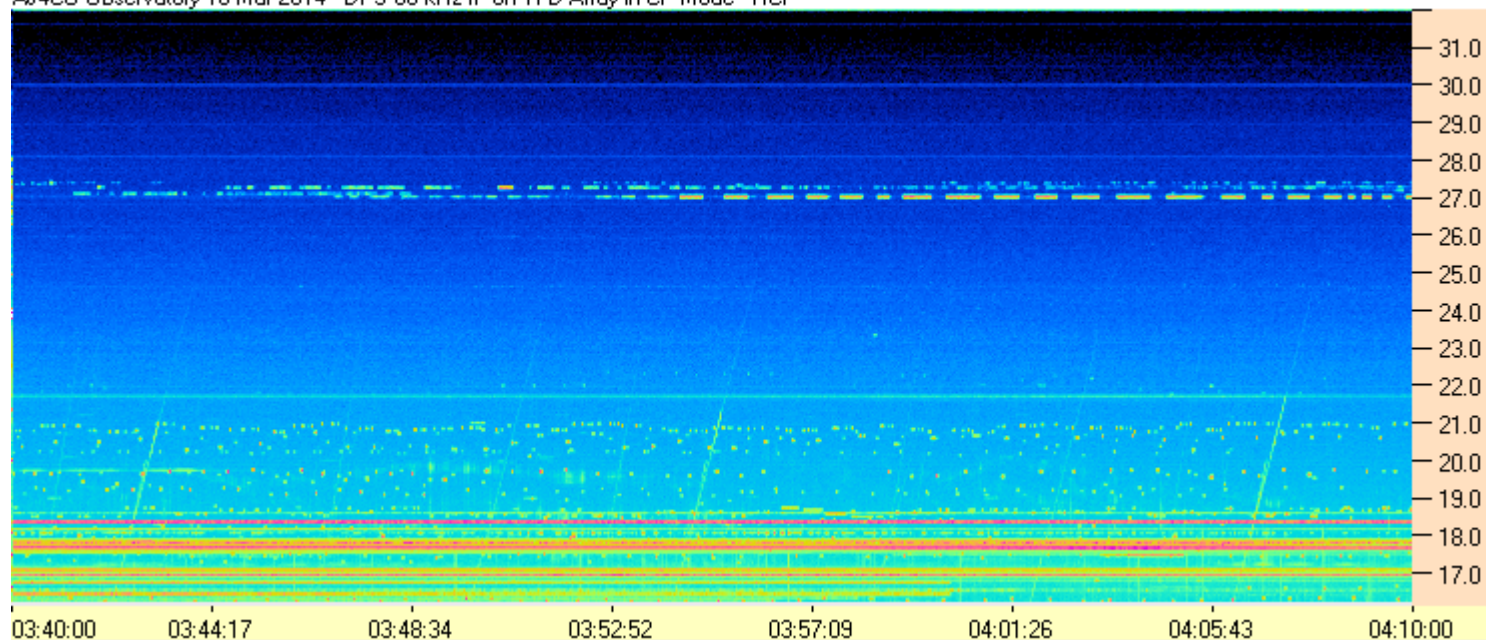
