Thanks to Tom Ashcraft for the heads up on this one. Here's some decent lo-B from Friday night. About an hour and a half, extending into Saturday morning.


L bursting from 16 to 32 MHz, RCP. Nice modulation lanes with negative drift. S bursting, if any, was invisible due to the early evening band noise.
