Three notable slow RFI farkles from 0005 to 0035 UTC between 23 and 25 MHz.

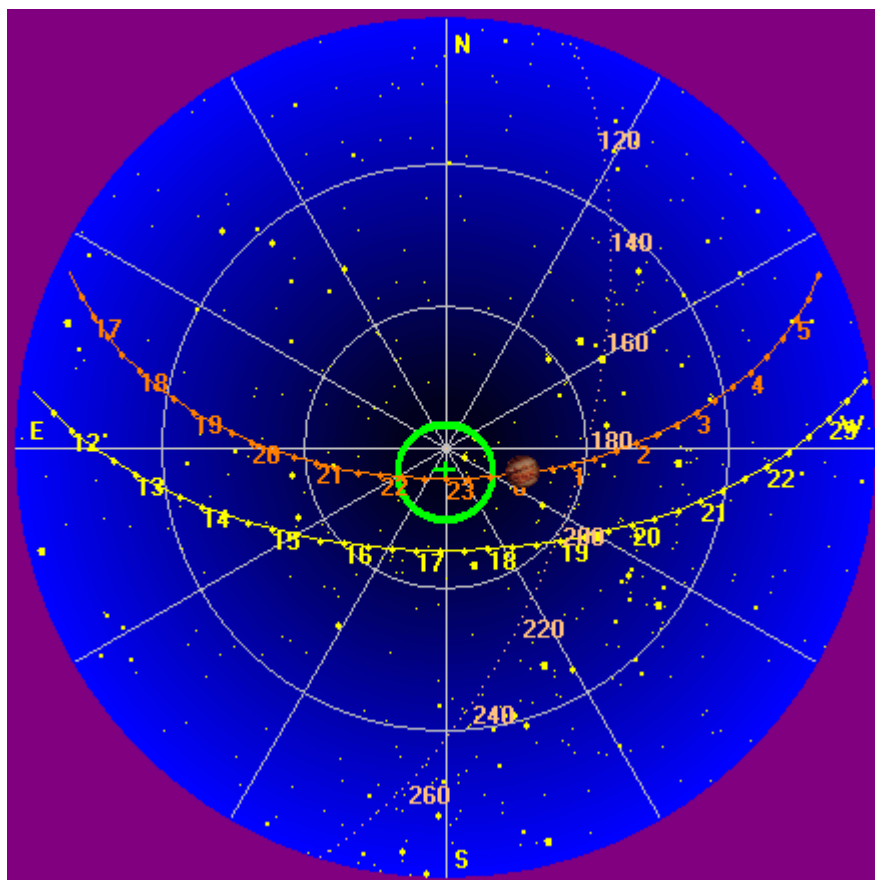
Jupiter was 10° to 22° off axis.

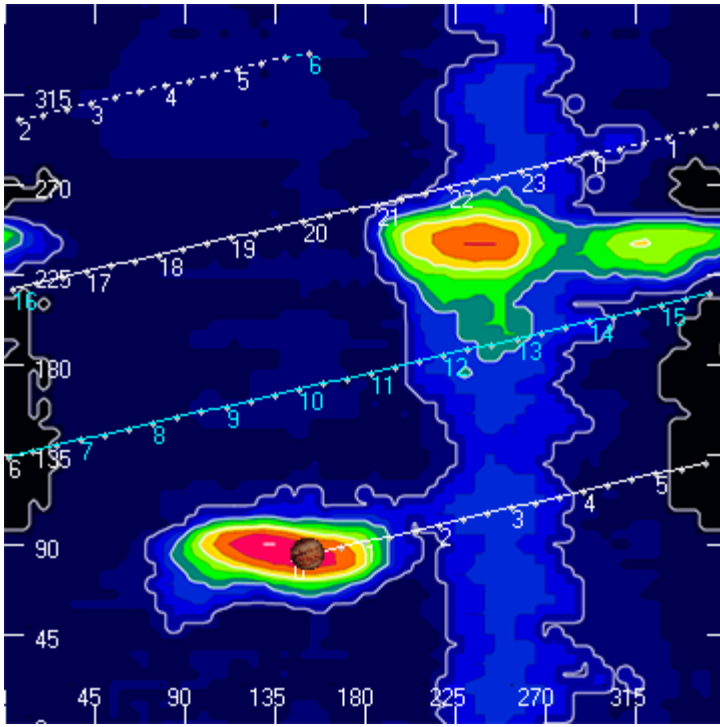
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 80°.

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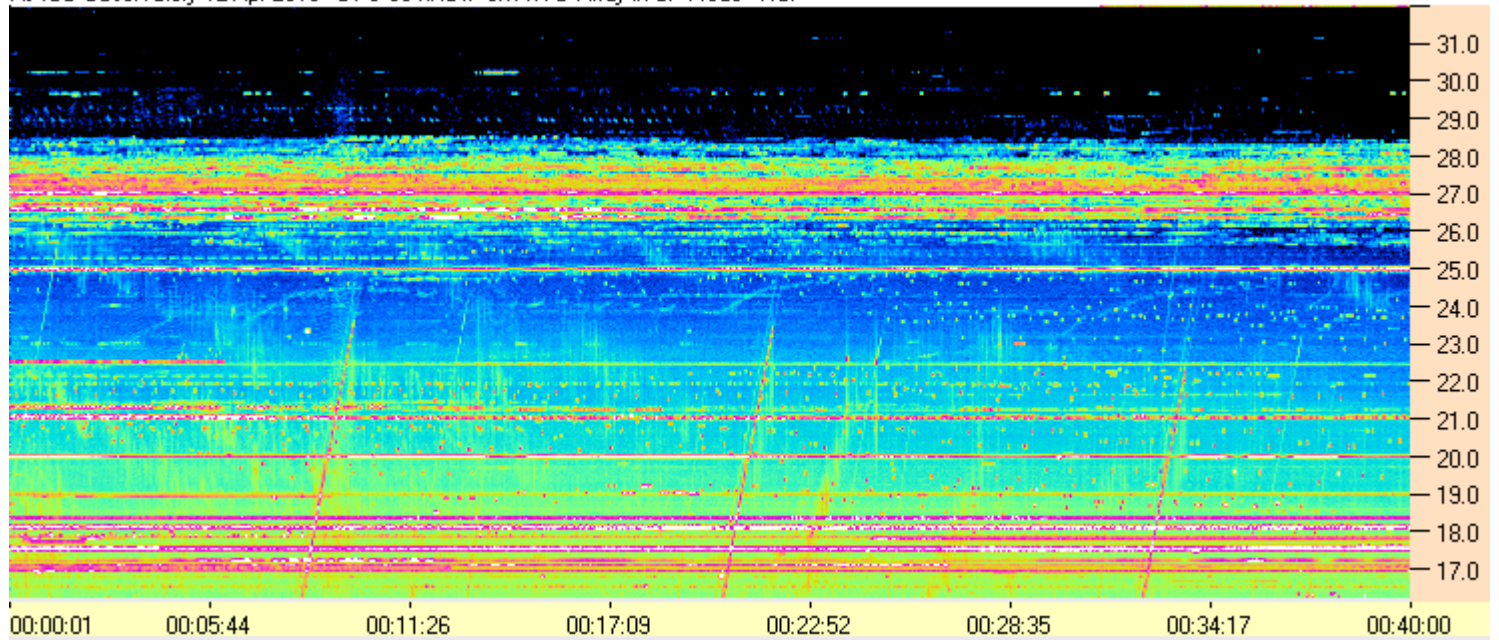

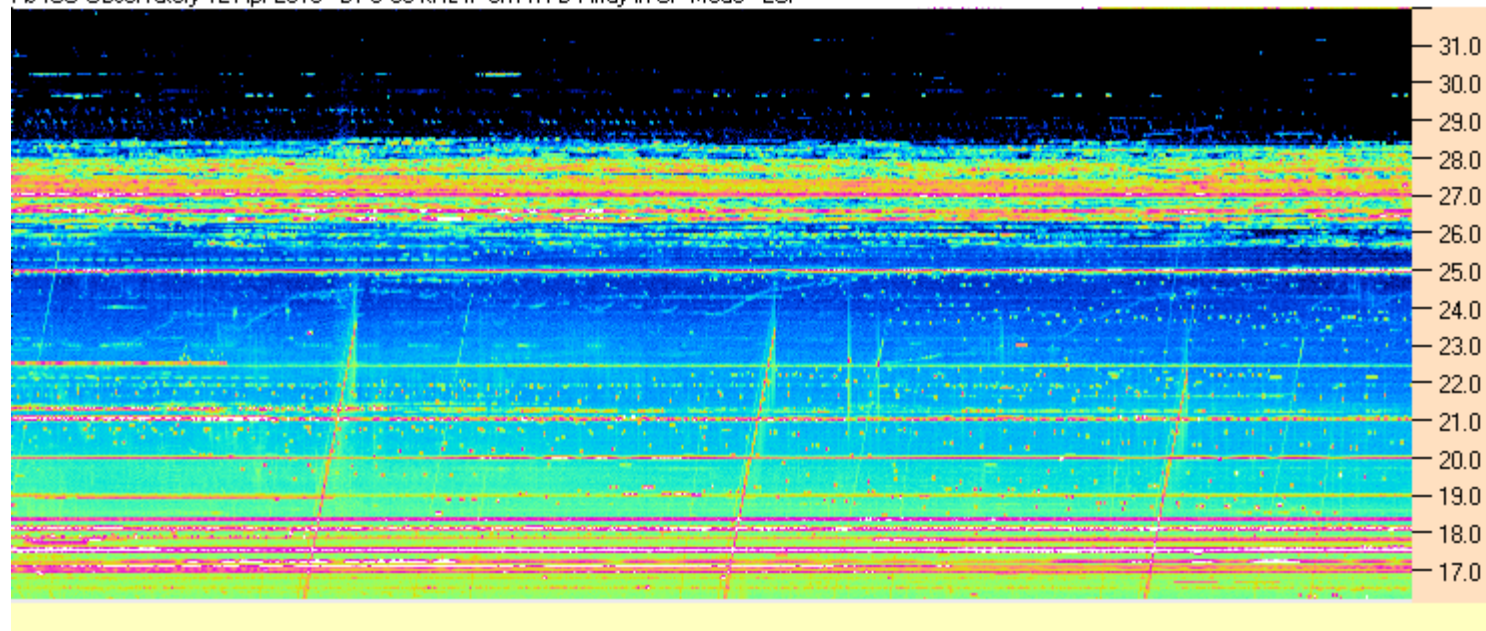




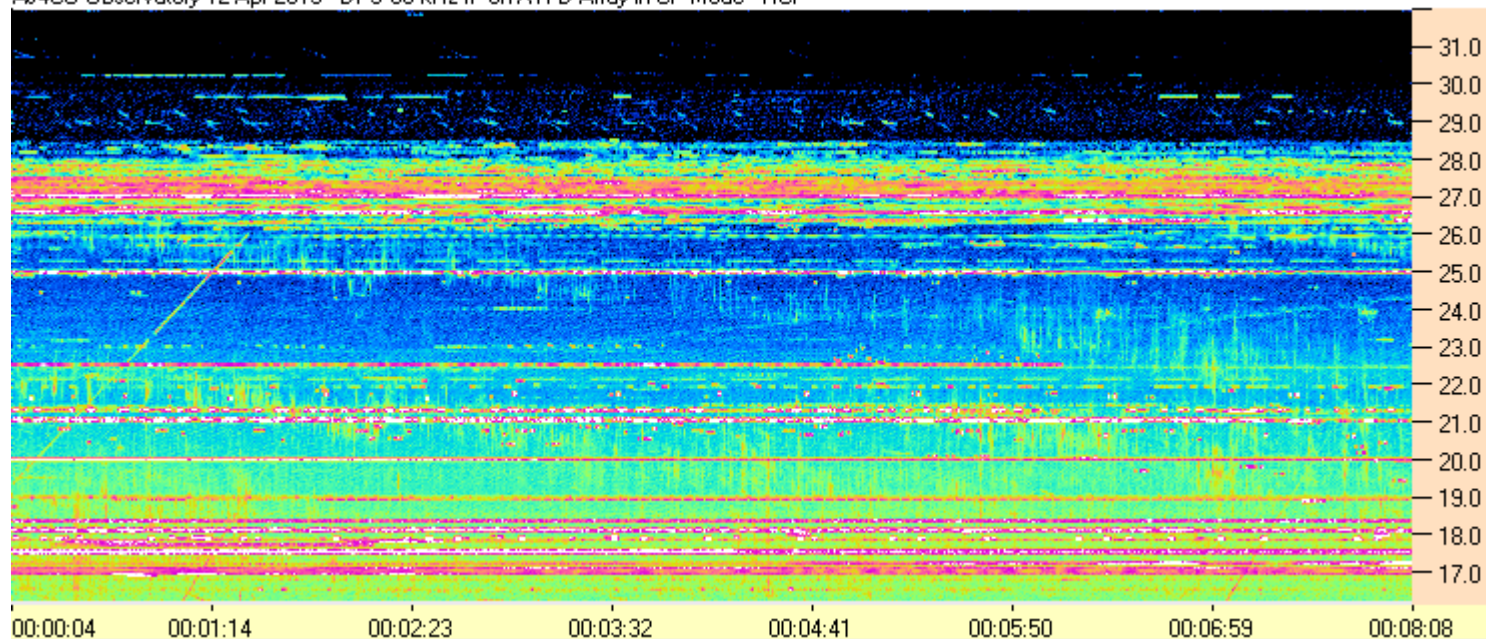
AJ4CO Observatory 12 Apr 2013 - DPS 60 kHz IF on XTFD Array in CP Mode - RCP
