L bursting from 18 to 25 MHz, RCP. Some modulation lanes with negative drift.

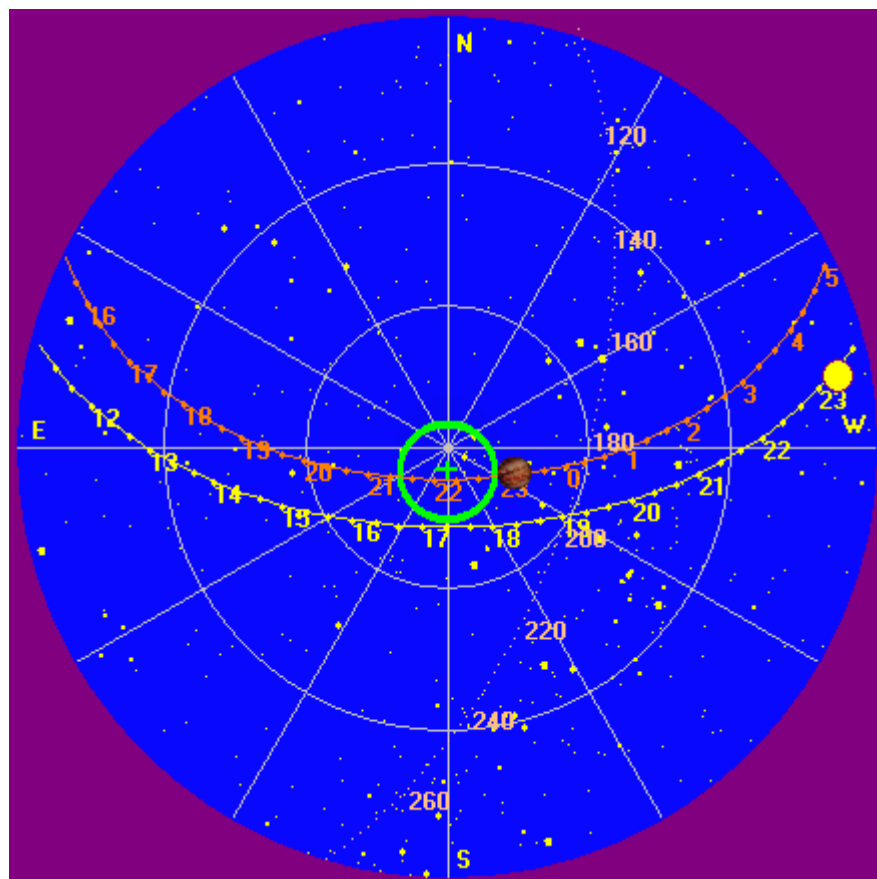
Jupiter was 5° to 13° off axis.

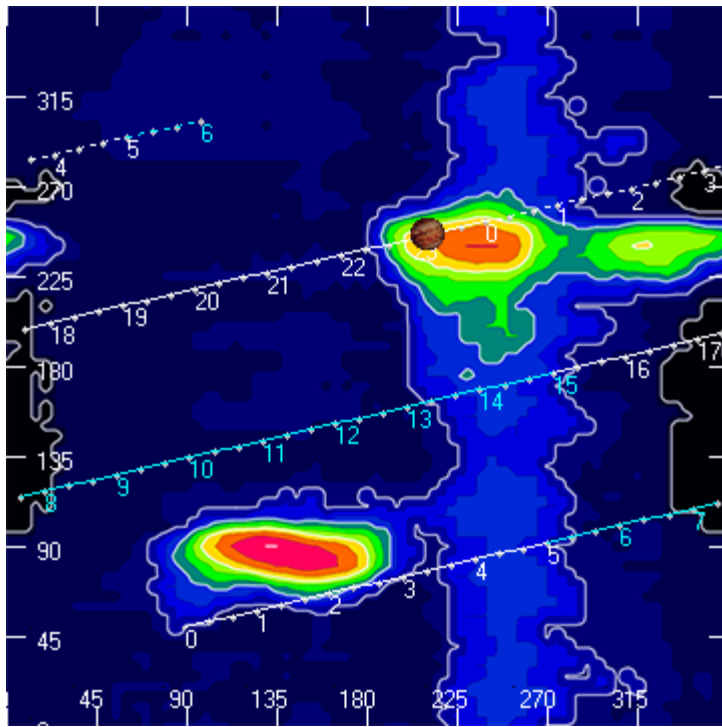
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 68°.

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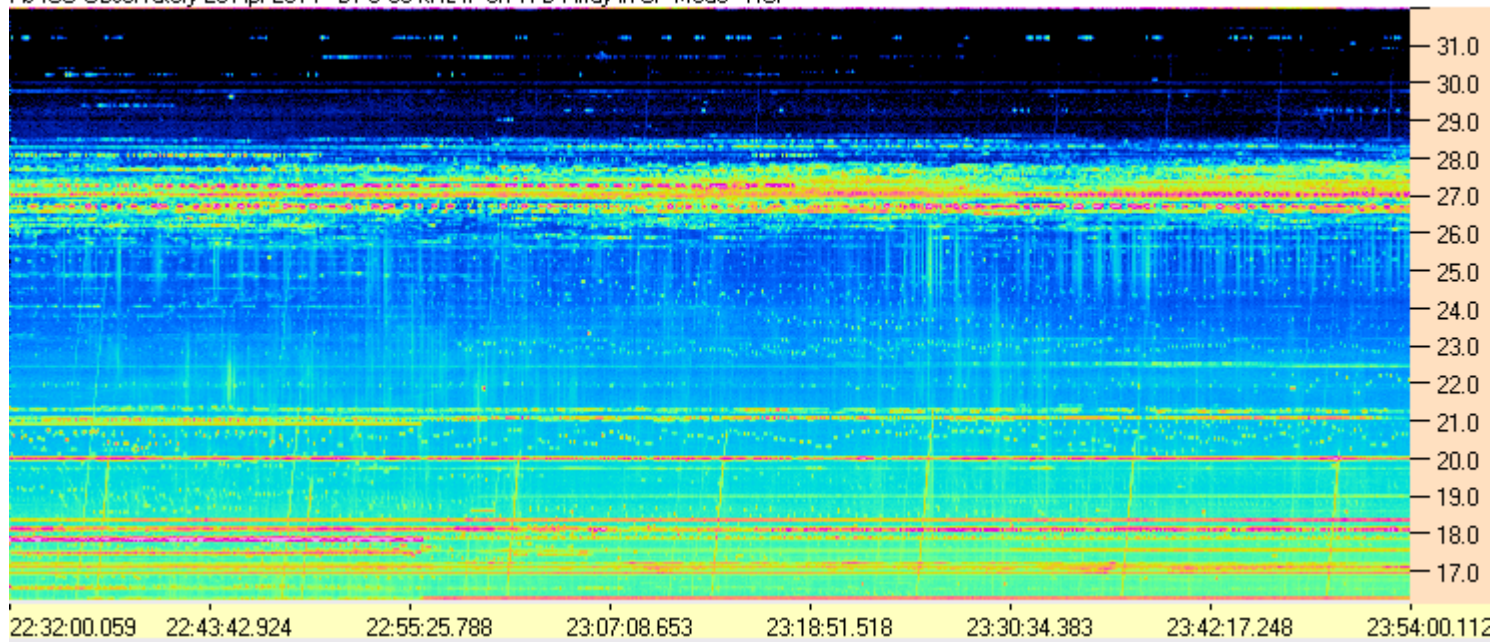

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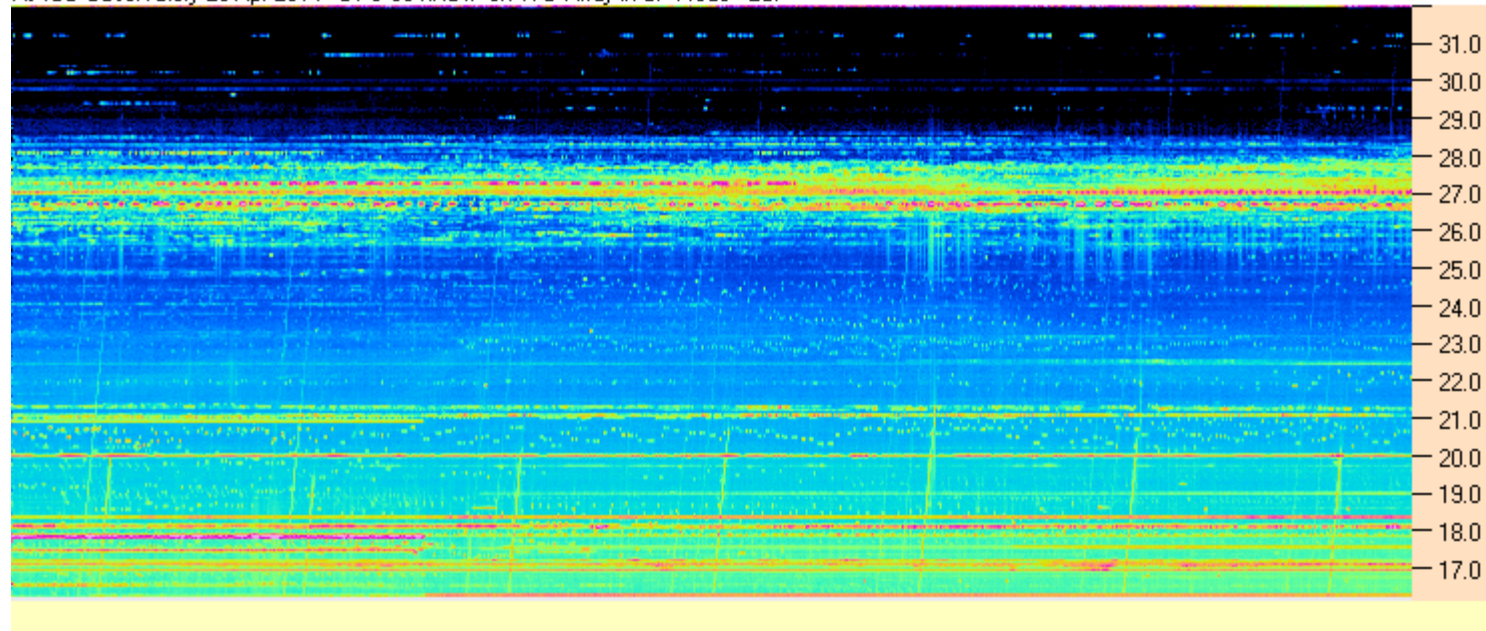




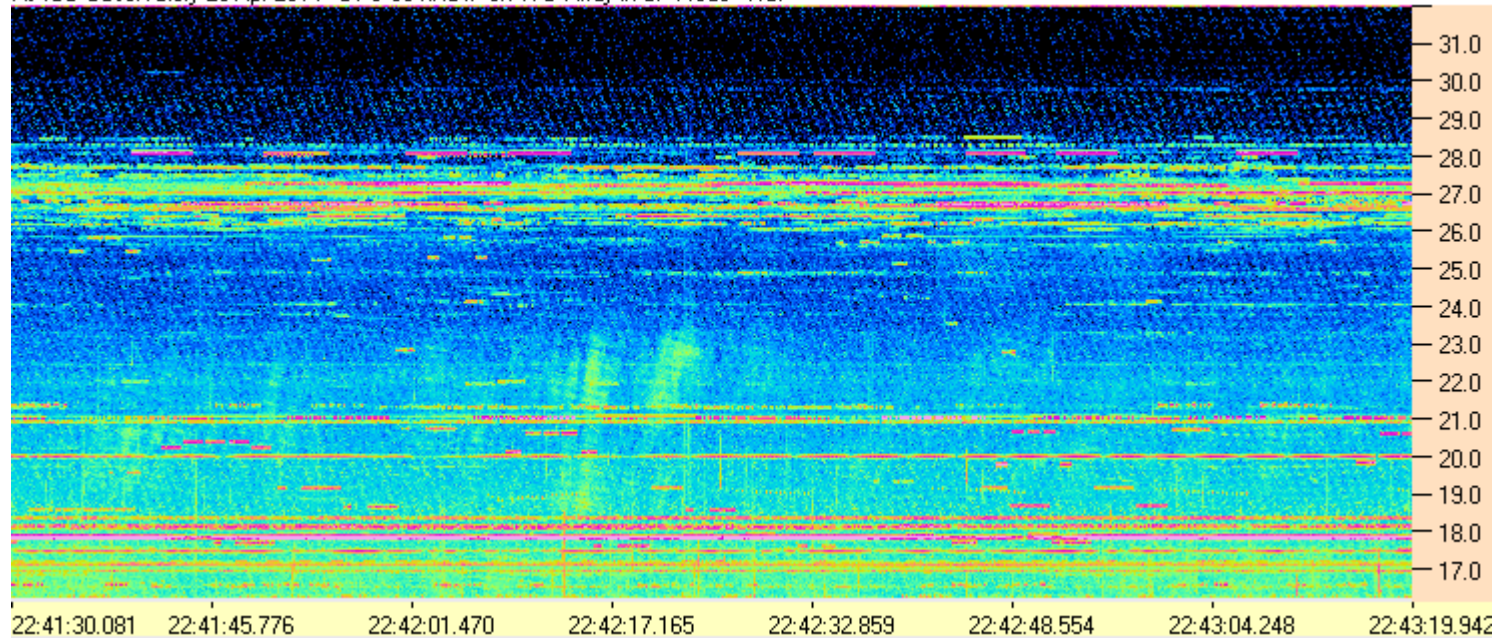
AJ4CO Observatory 26 Apr 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP



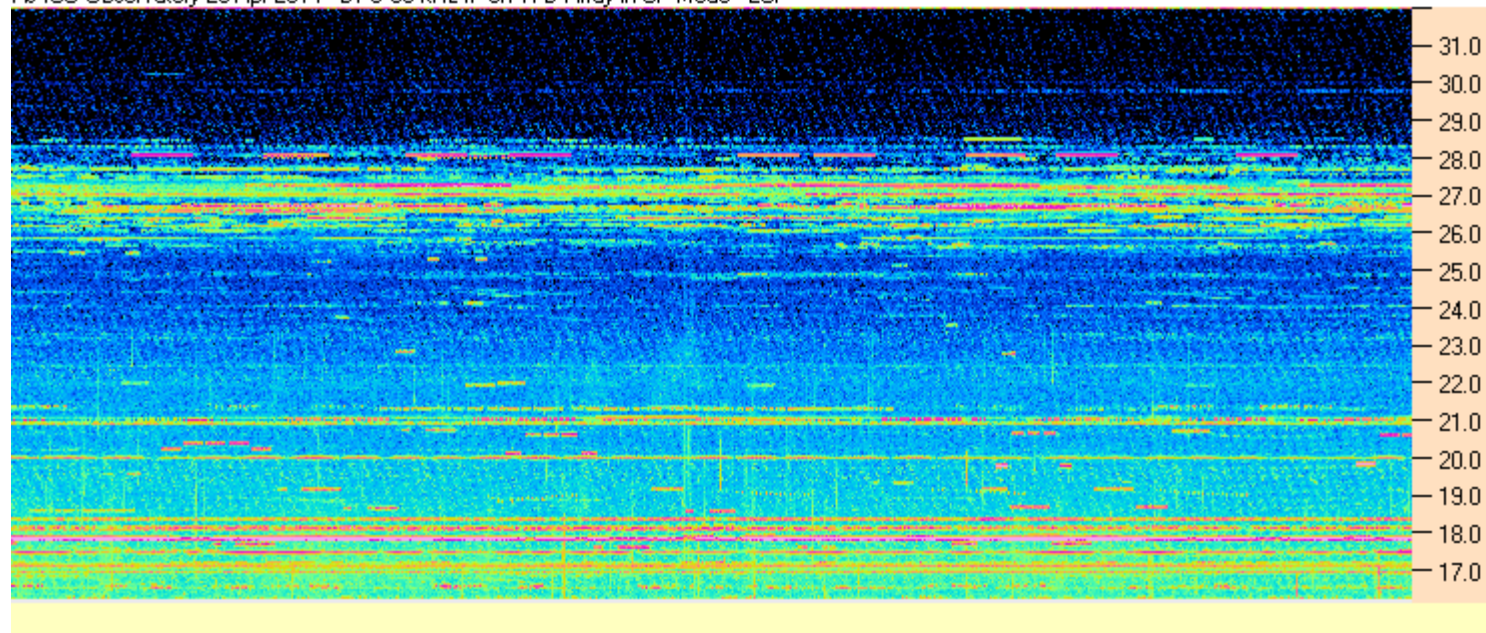
AJ4CO Observatory 26 Apr 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - LCP



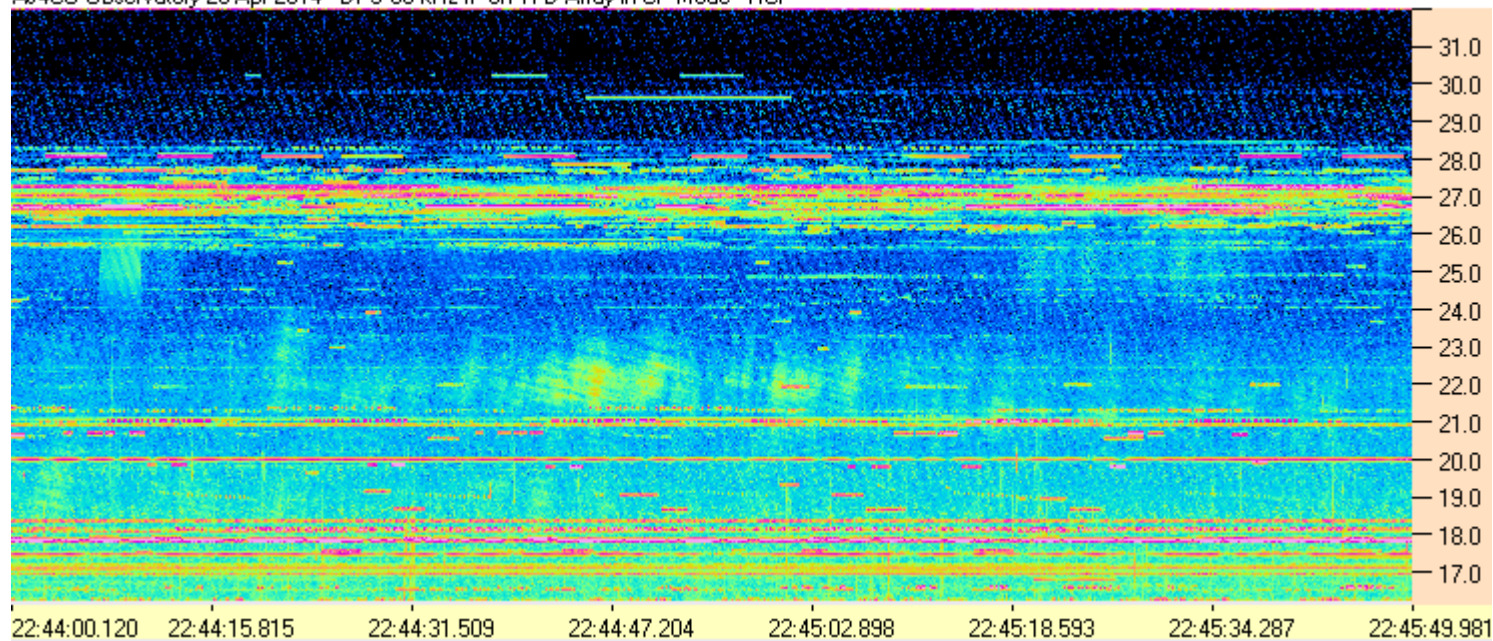
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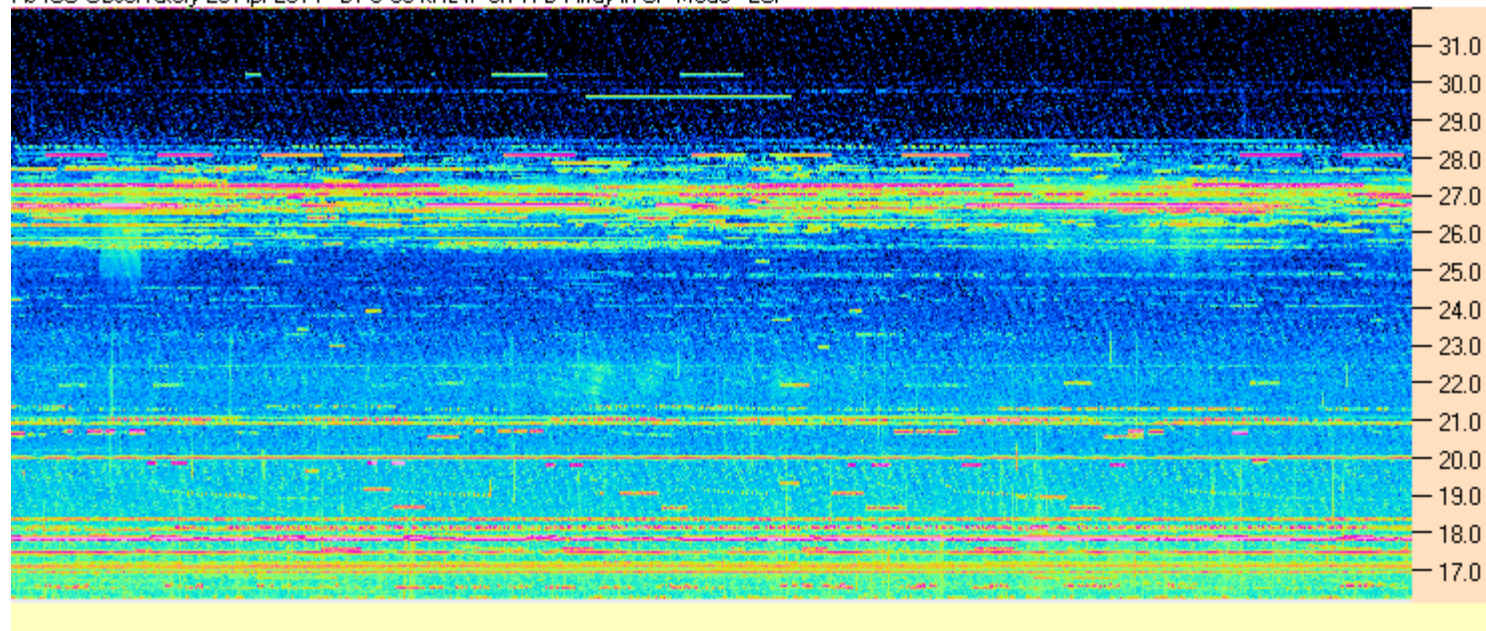
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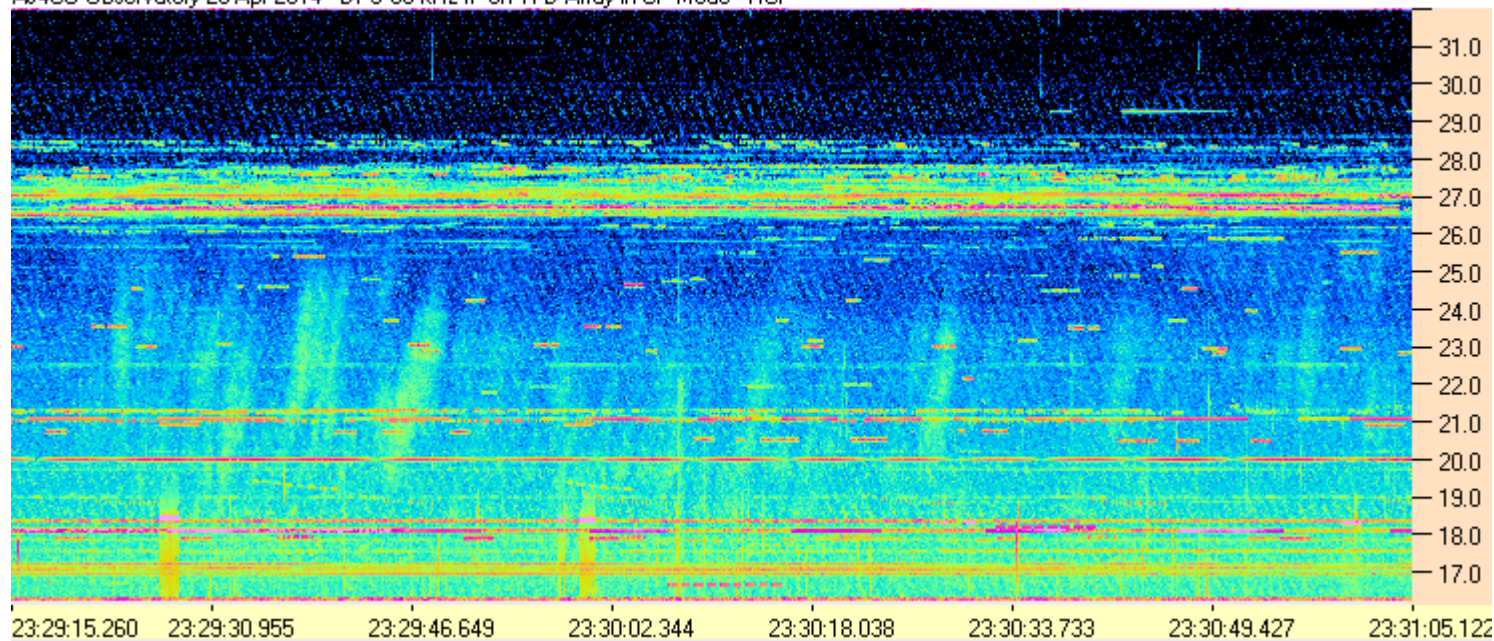
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
