Strong S bursting early on, changing to L bursting later. Some negative slope modulation lanes. Emission was all RCP, from 16 to 25 MHz.

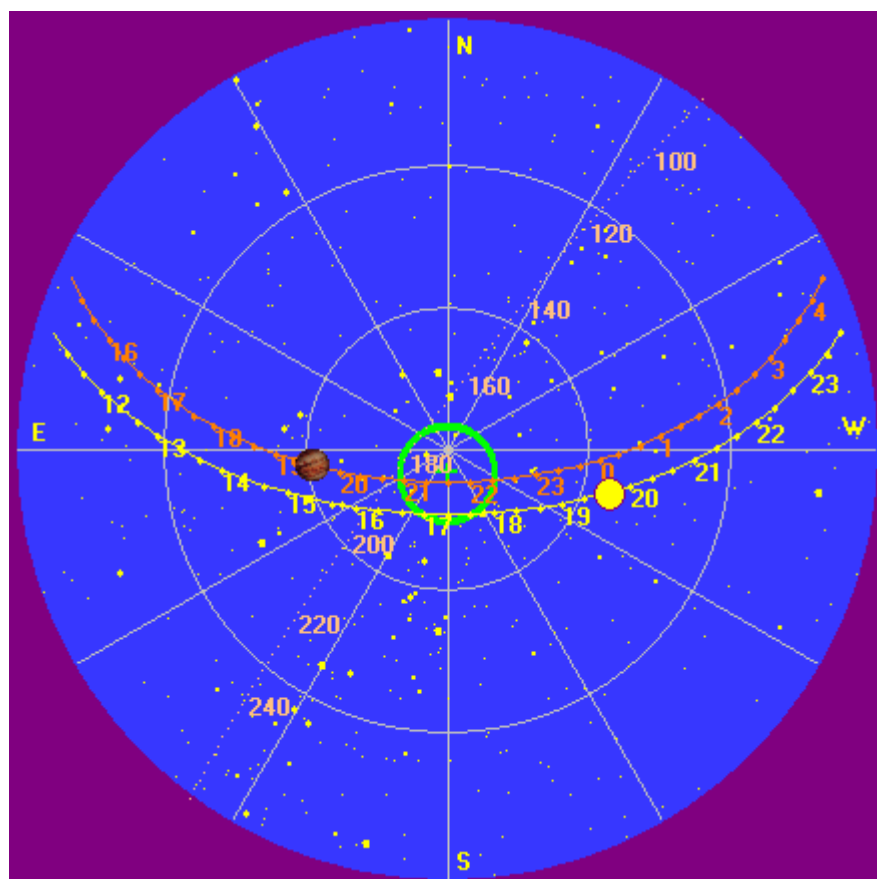
Jupiter was 36° to 28° off axis.

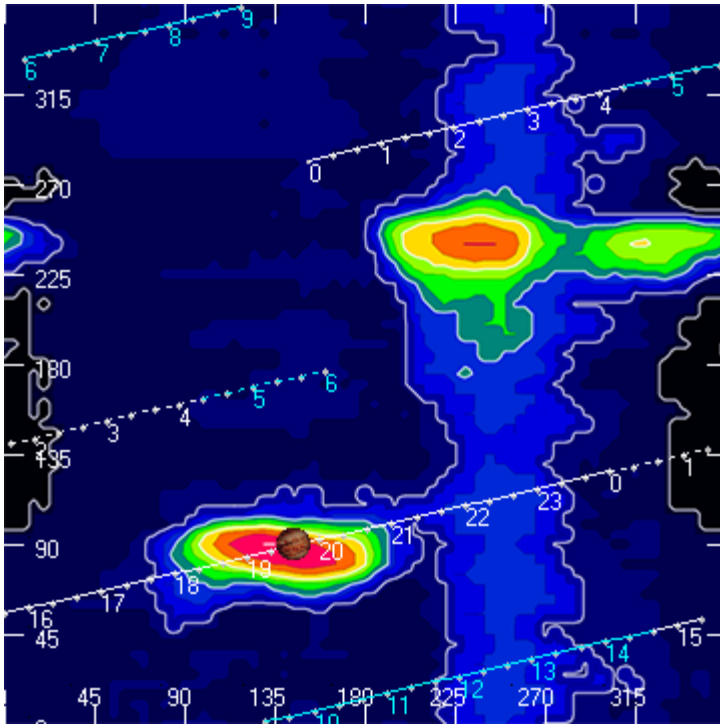
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 60° .

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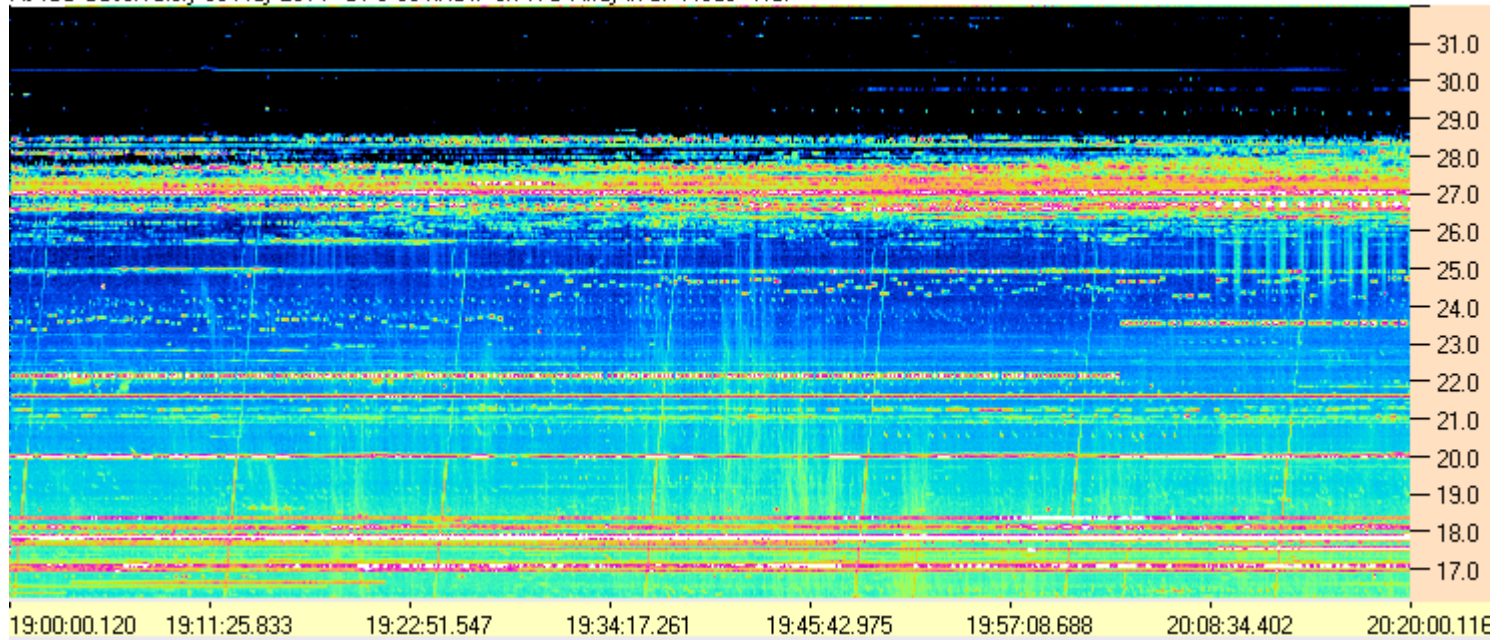

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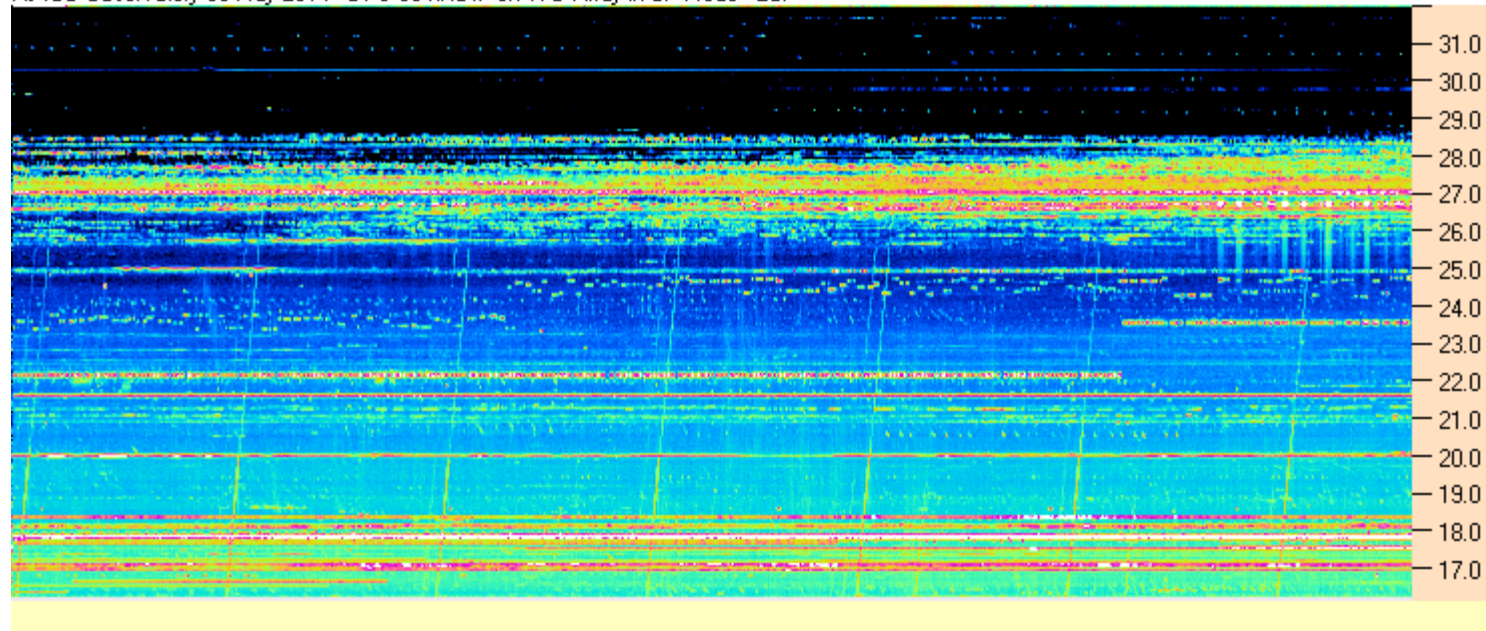




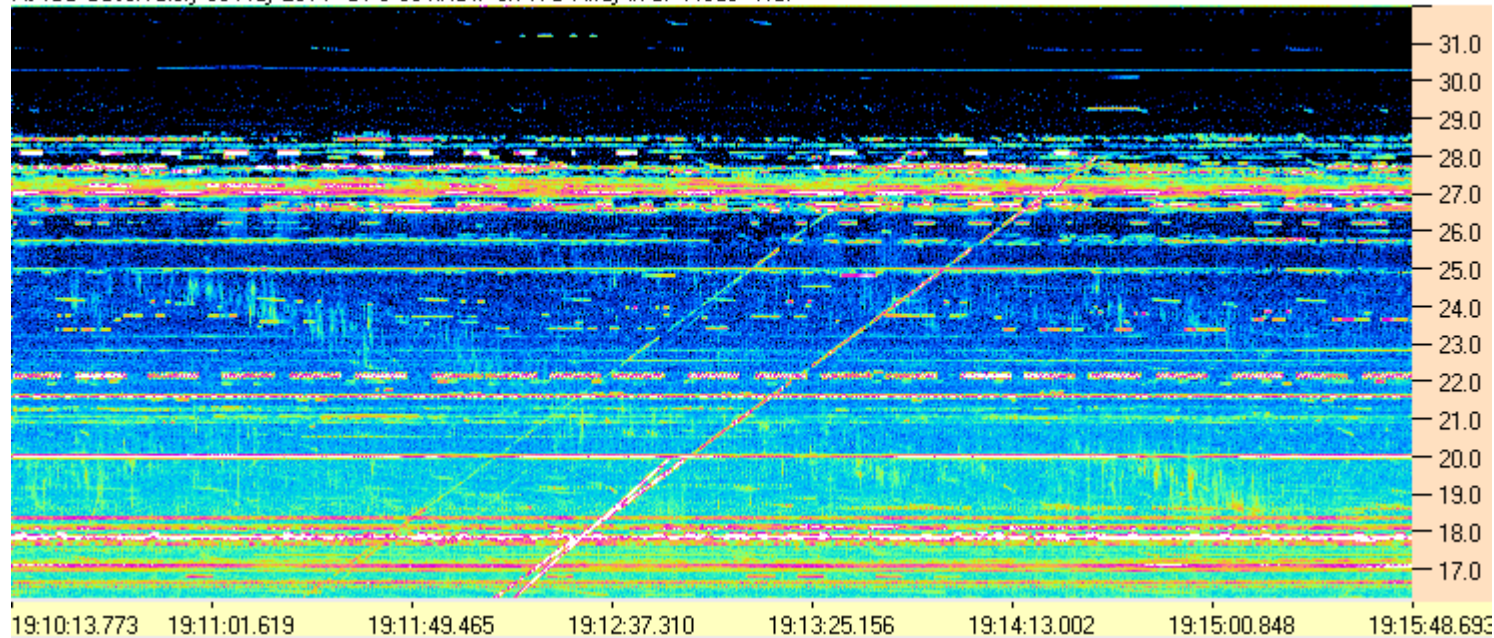
AJ4CO Observatory 06 May 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP



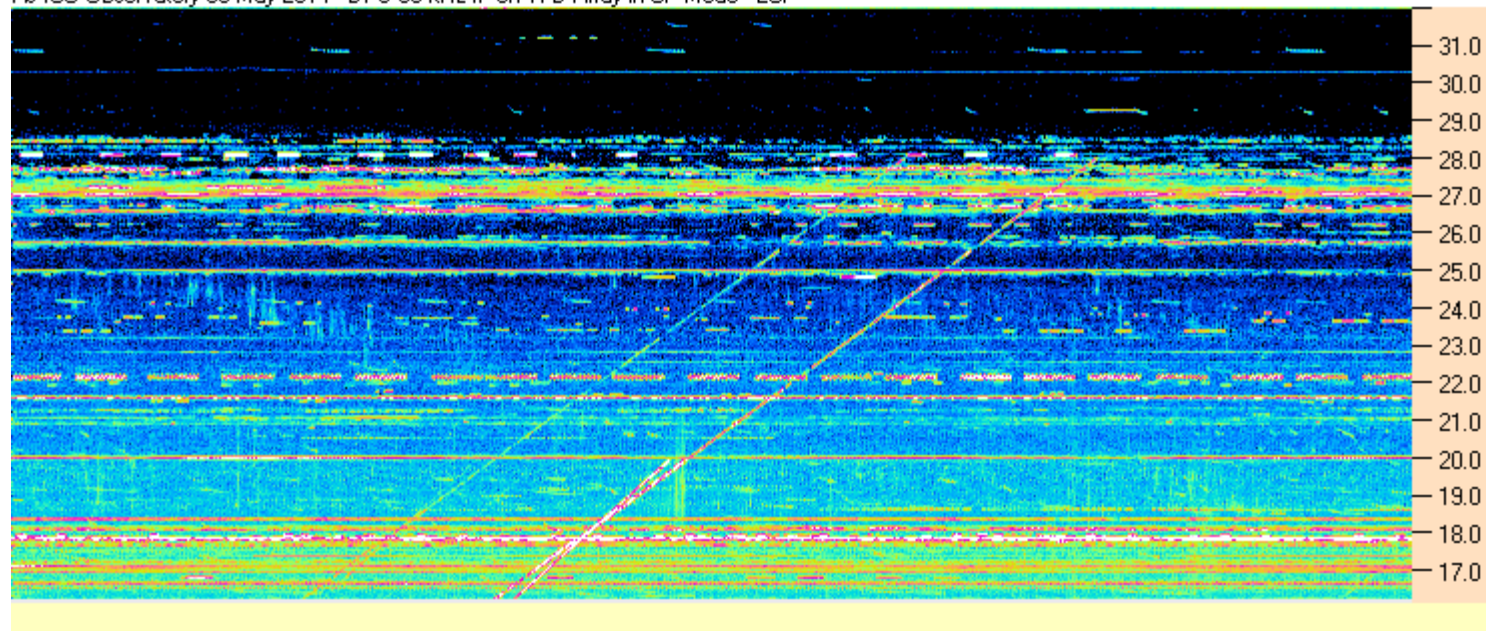
AJ4CO Observatory 06 May 2014 - DPS 60 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - LCP



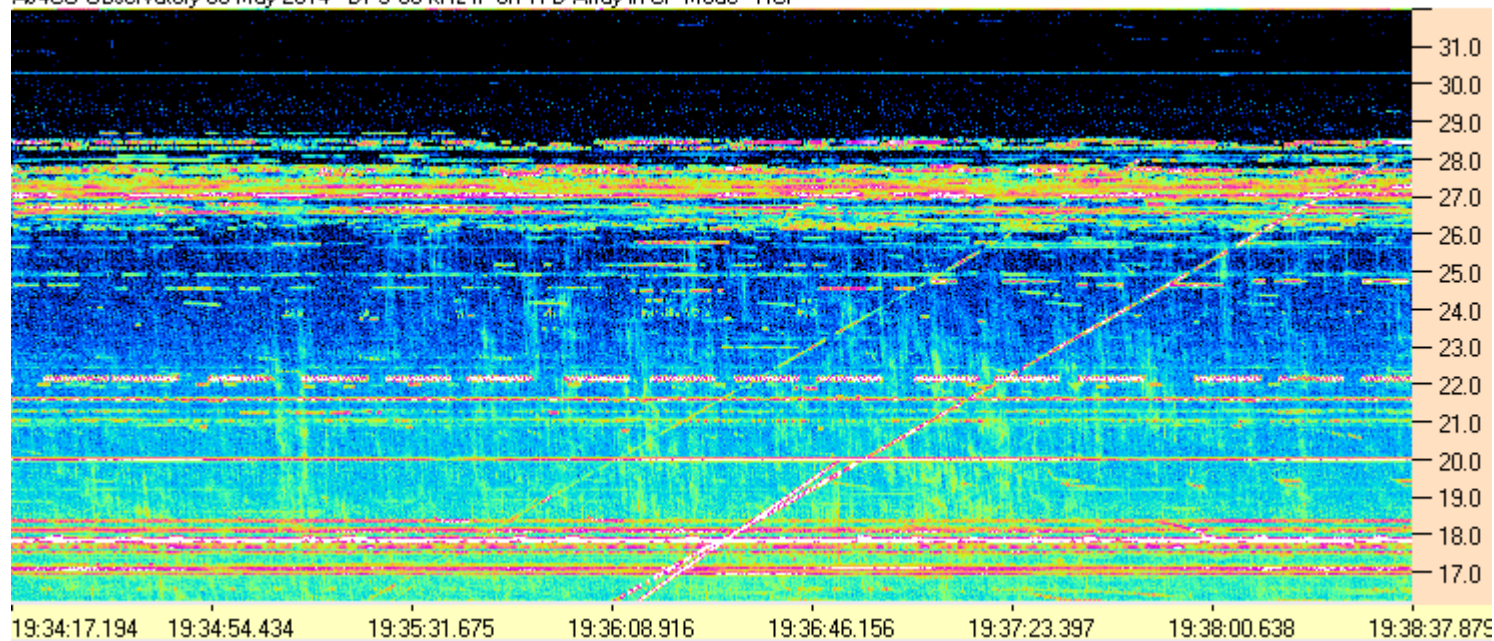
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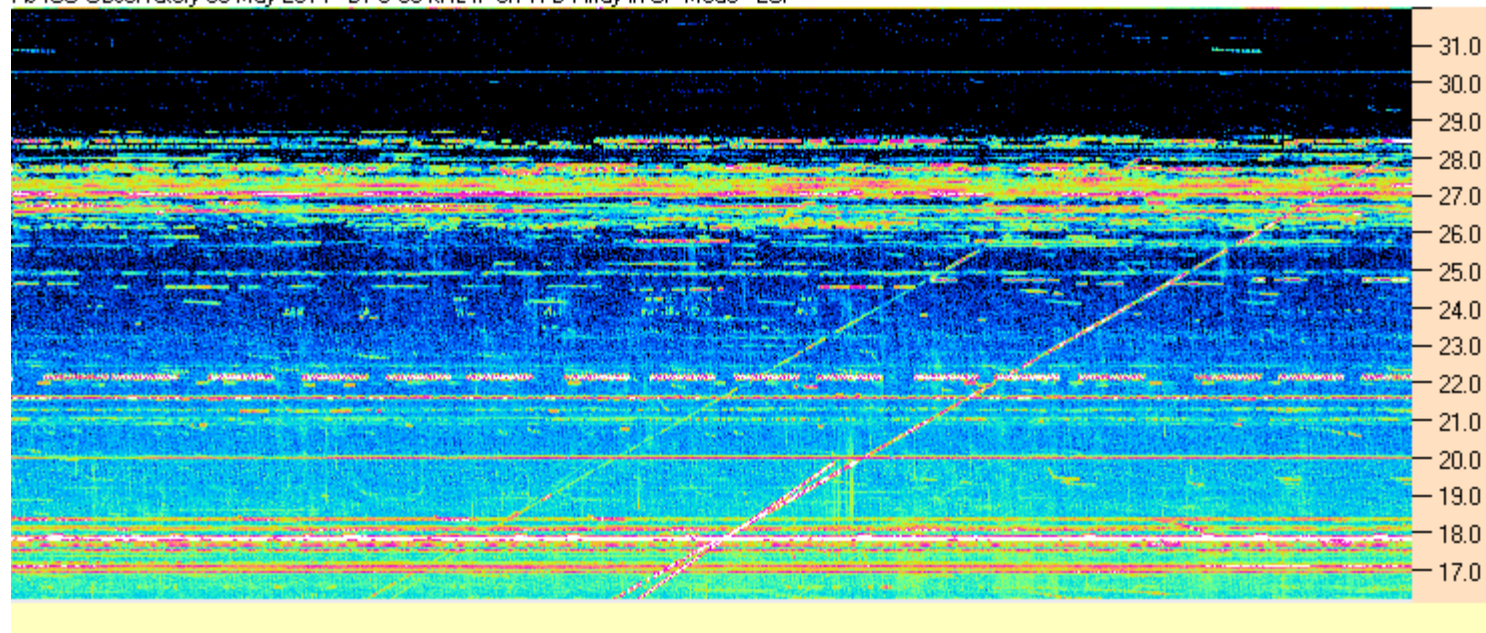
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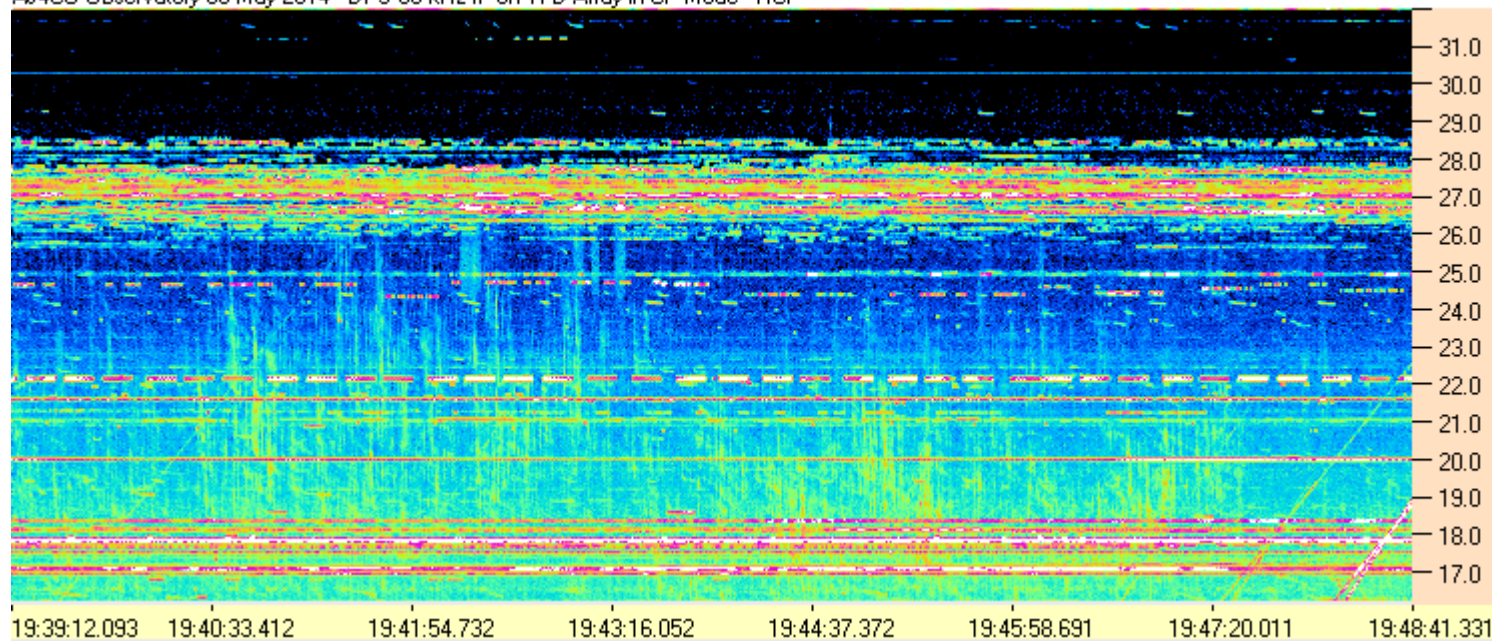
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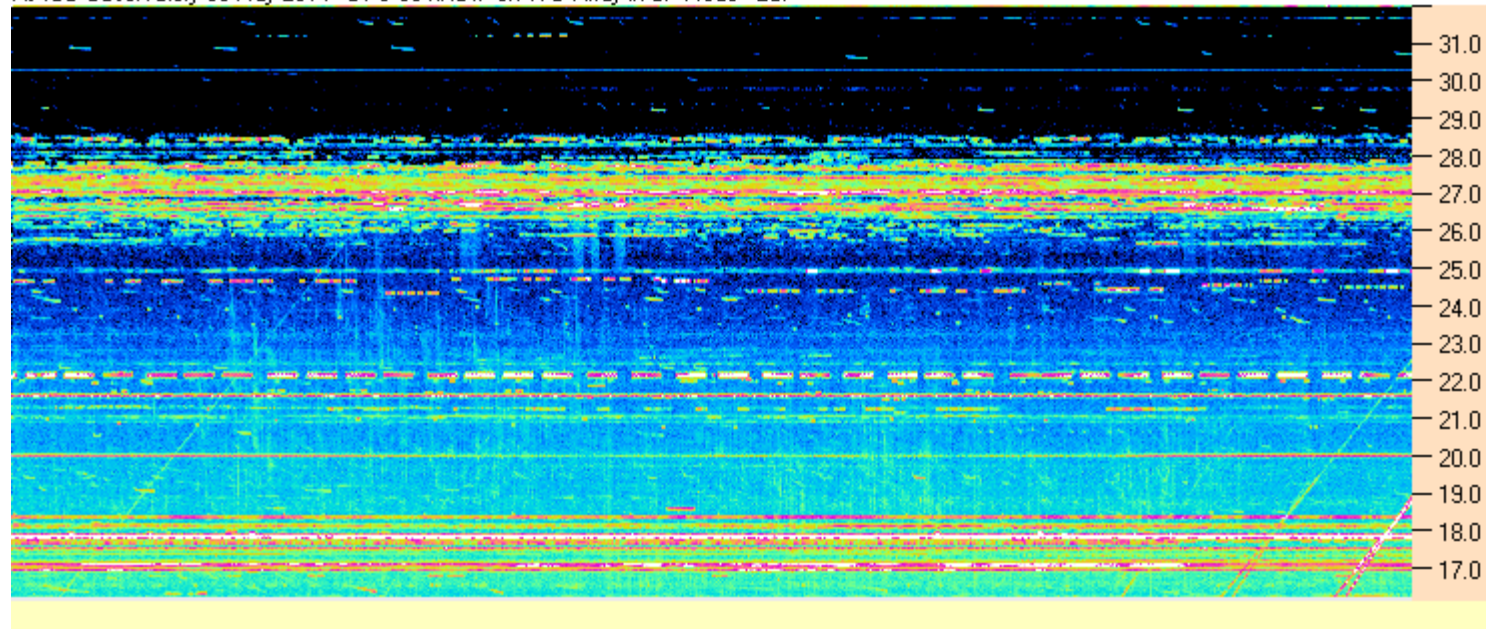
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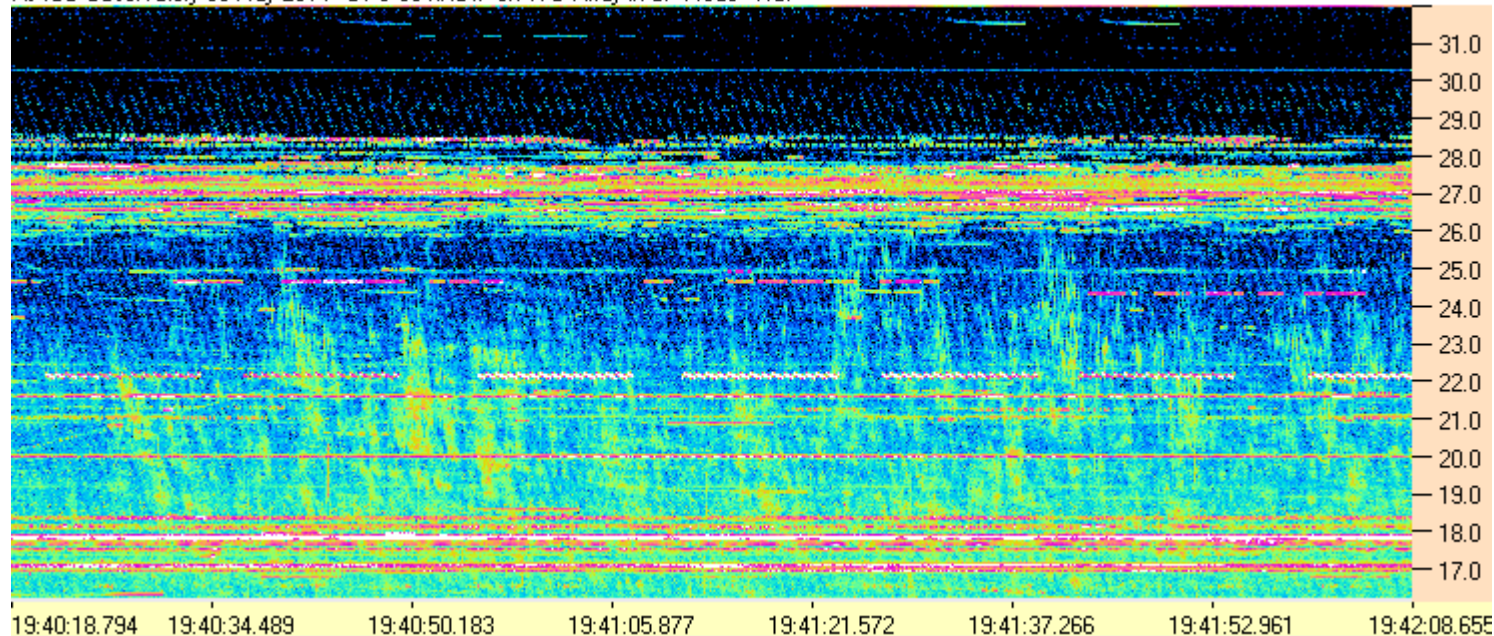
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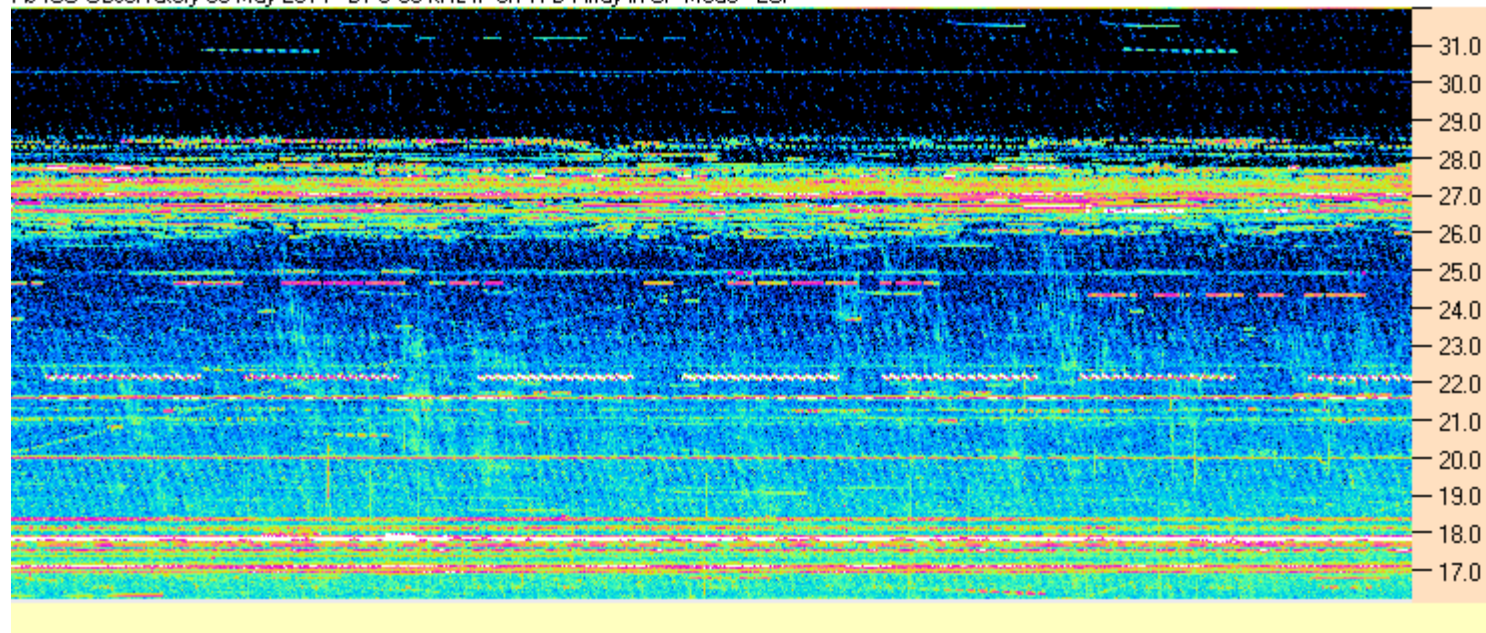
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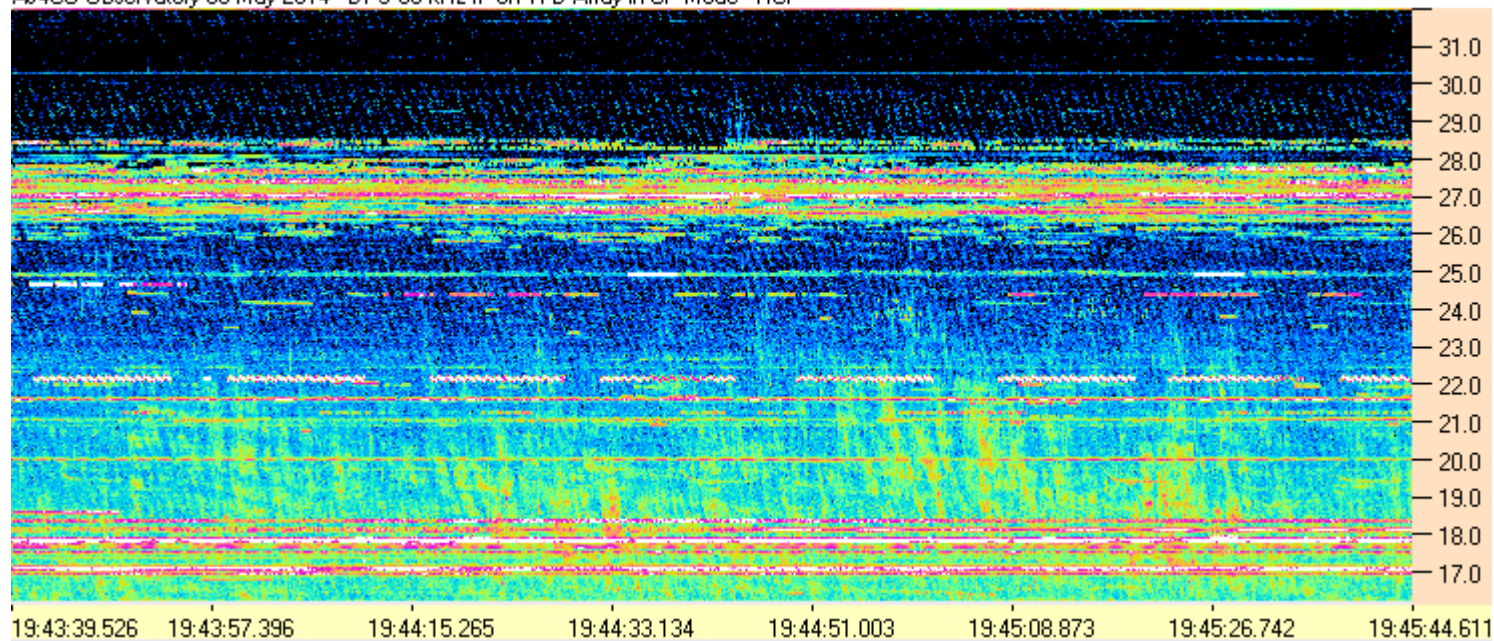
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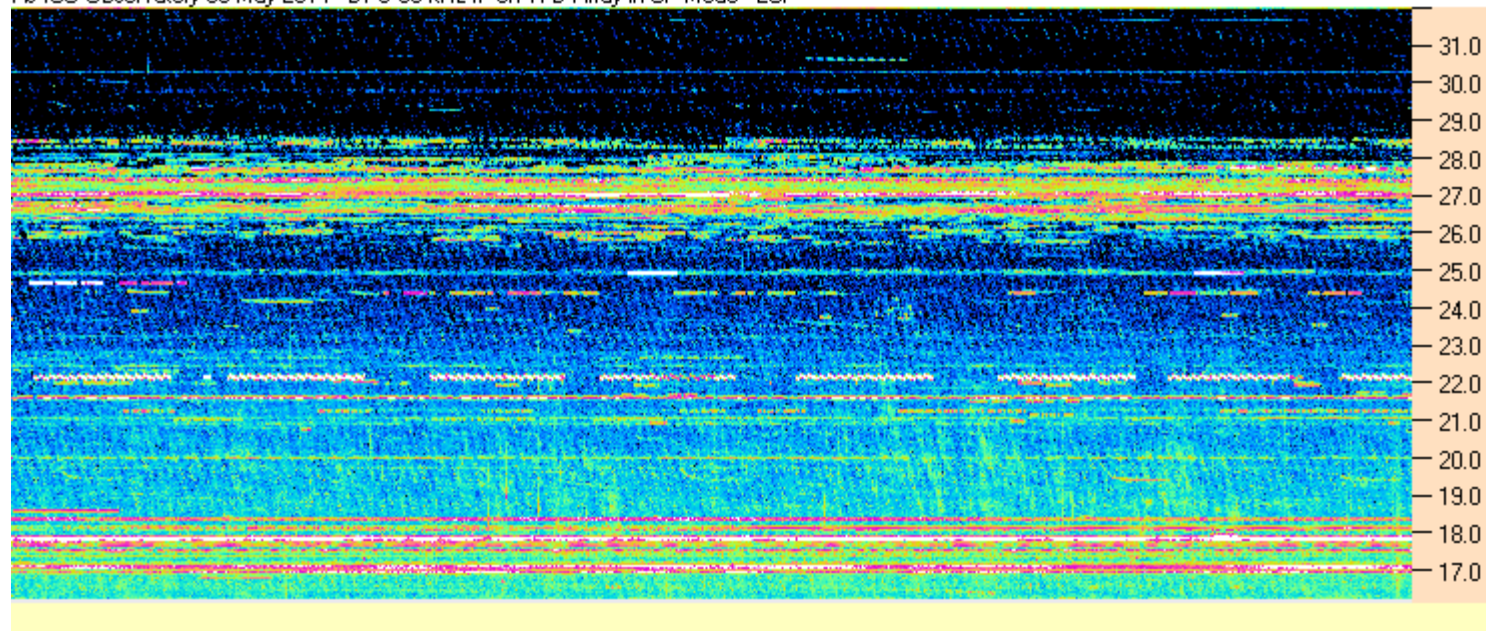
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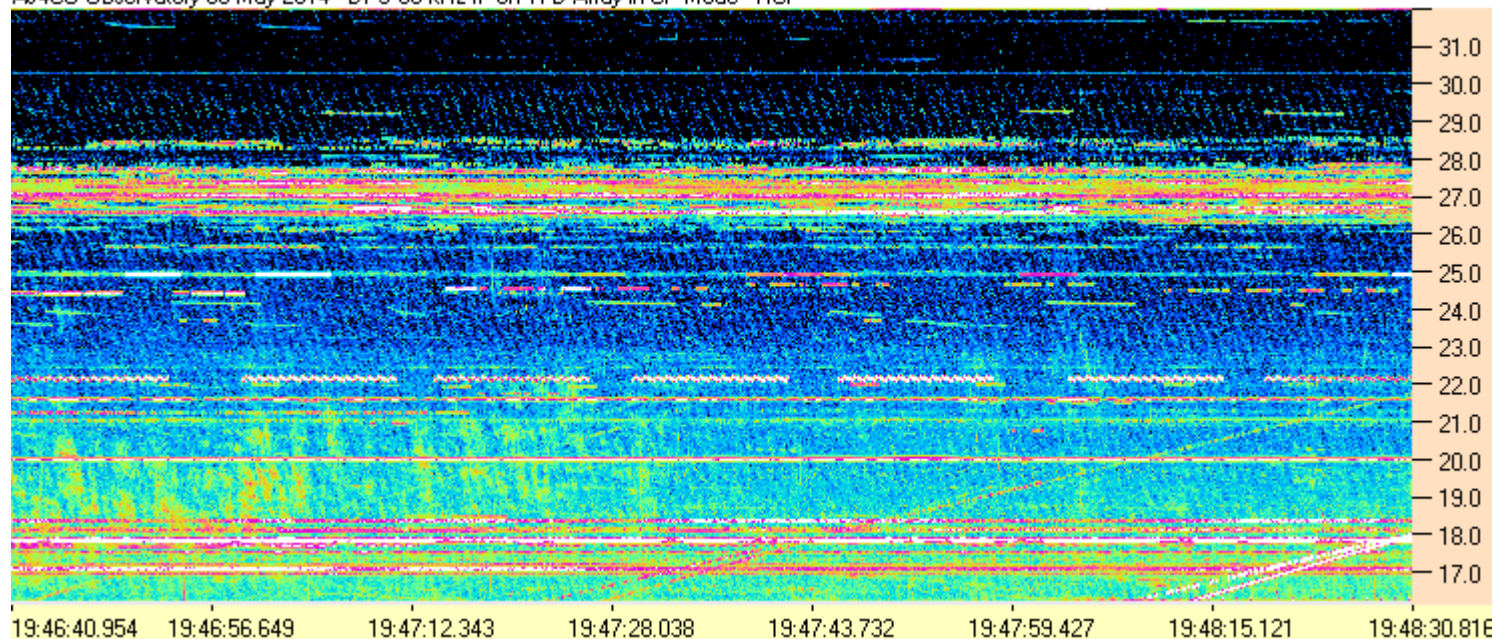
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
