Here's some non-Io-A from yesterday afternoon. RCP L bursting. No modulation lanes evident. Emission visible from about 18 to 26 MHz.

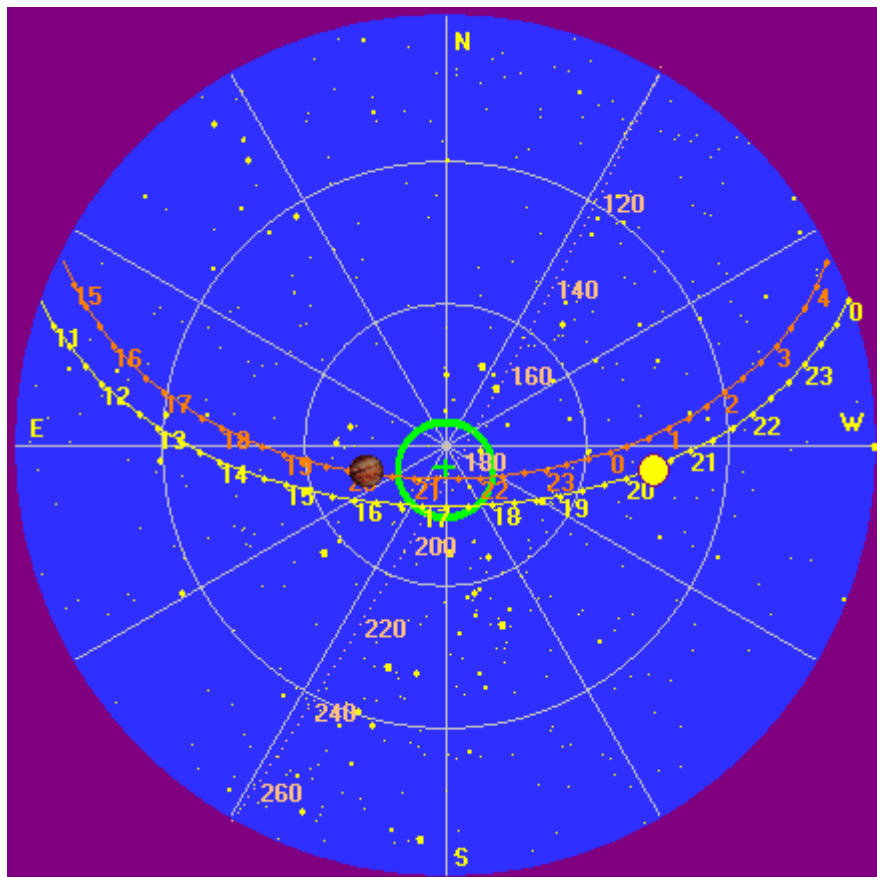
Jupiter was 18° to 14° off axis.

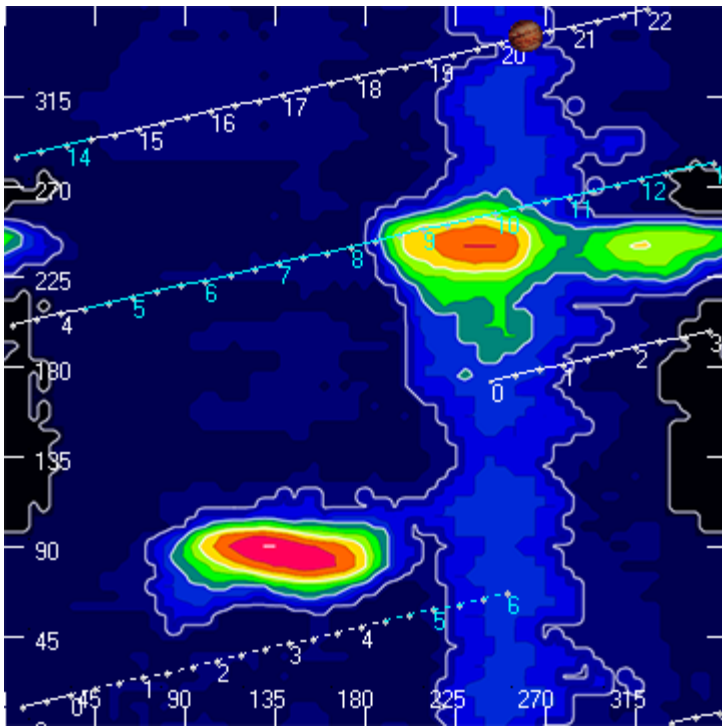
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 57°.

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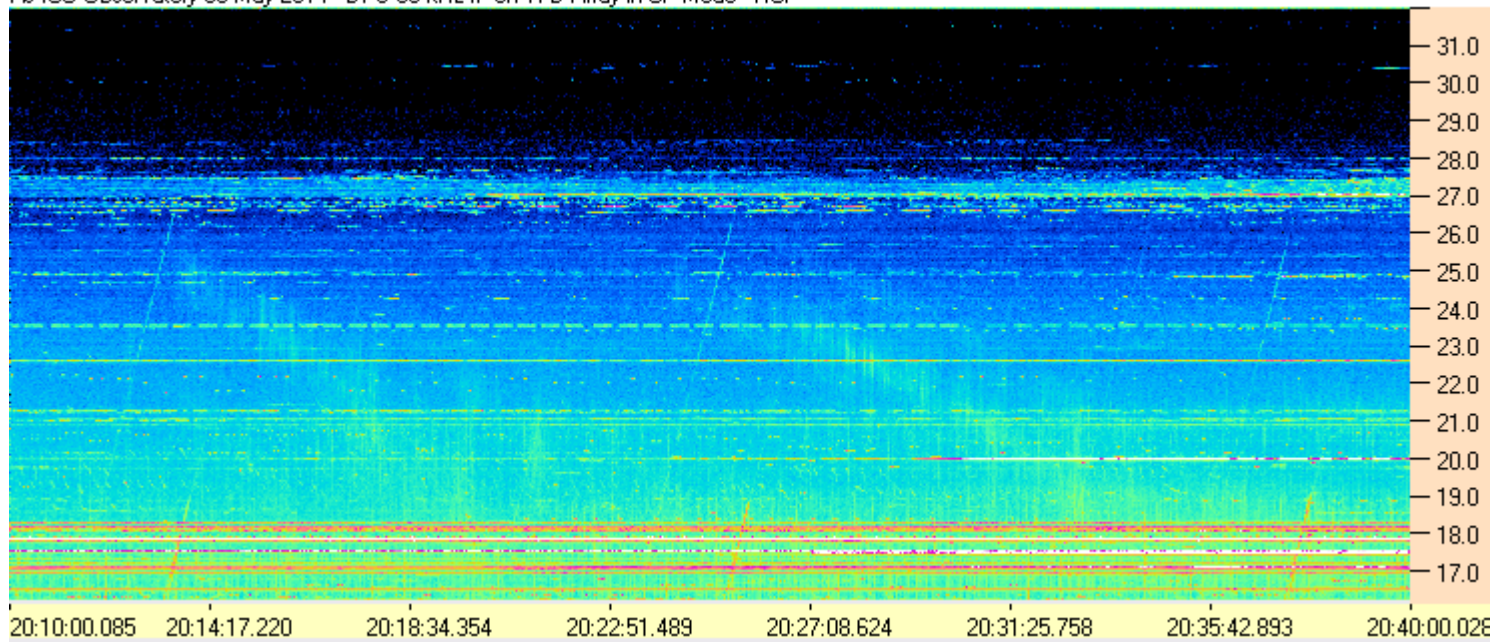

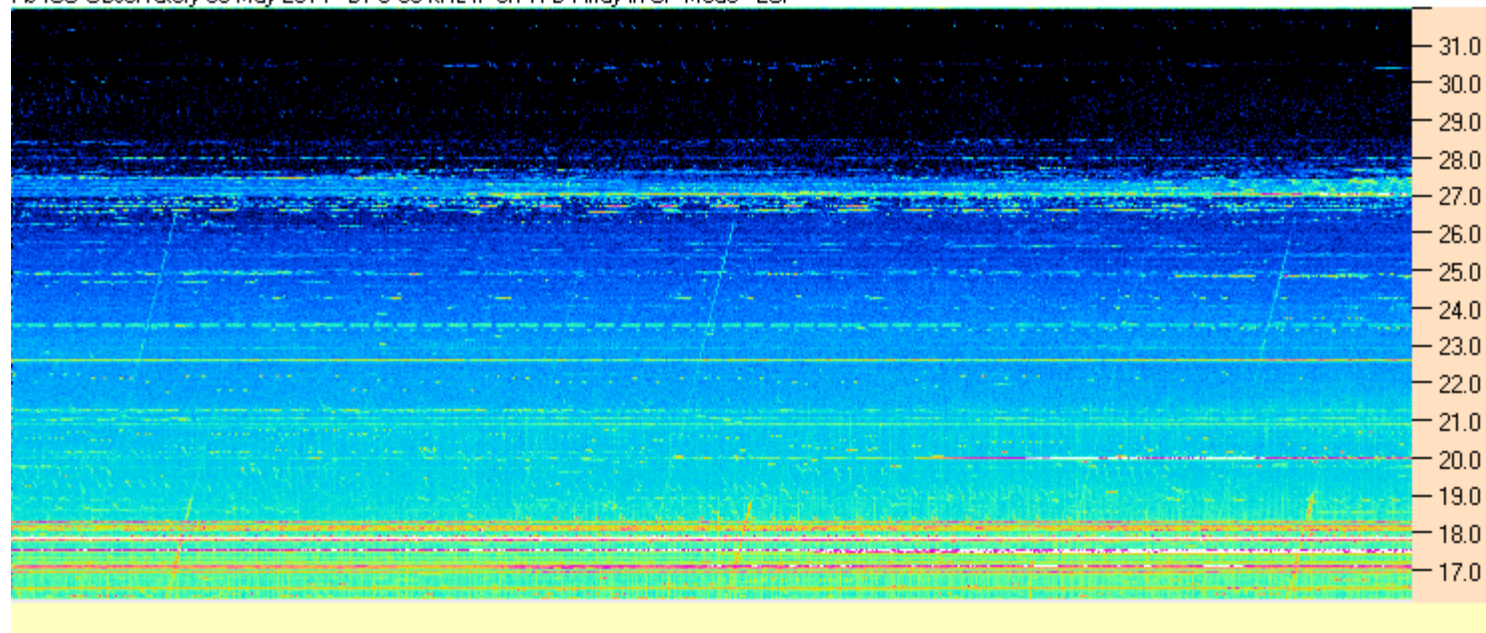




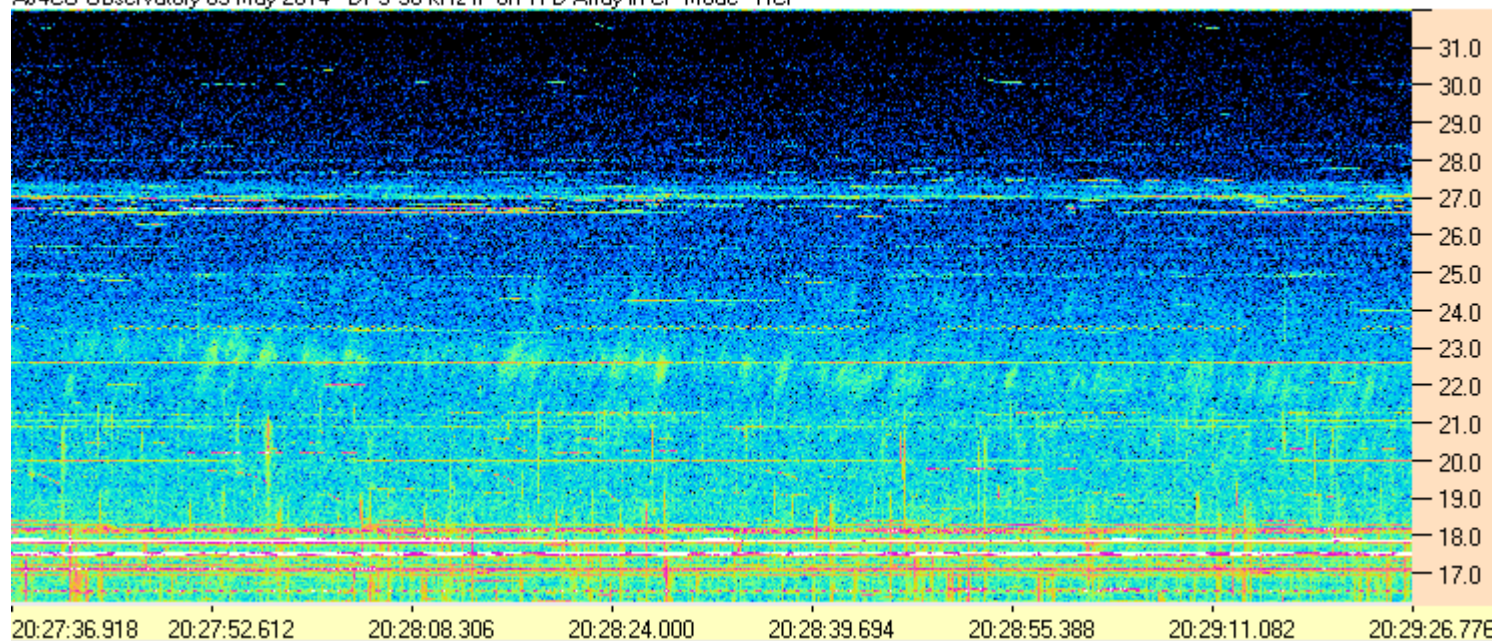
AJ4CO Observatory 09 May 2014 - DPS 30 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP



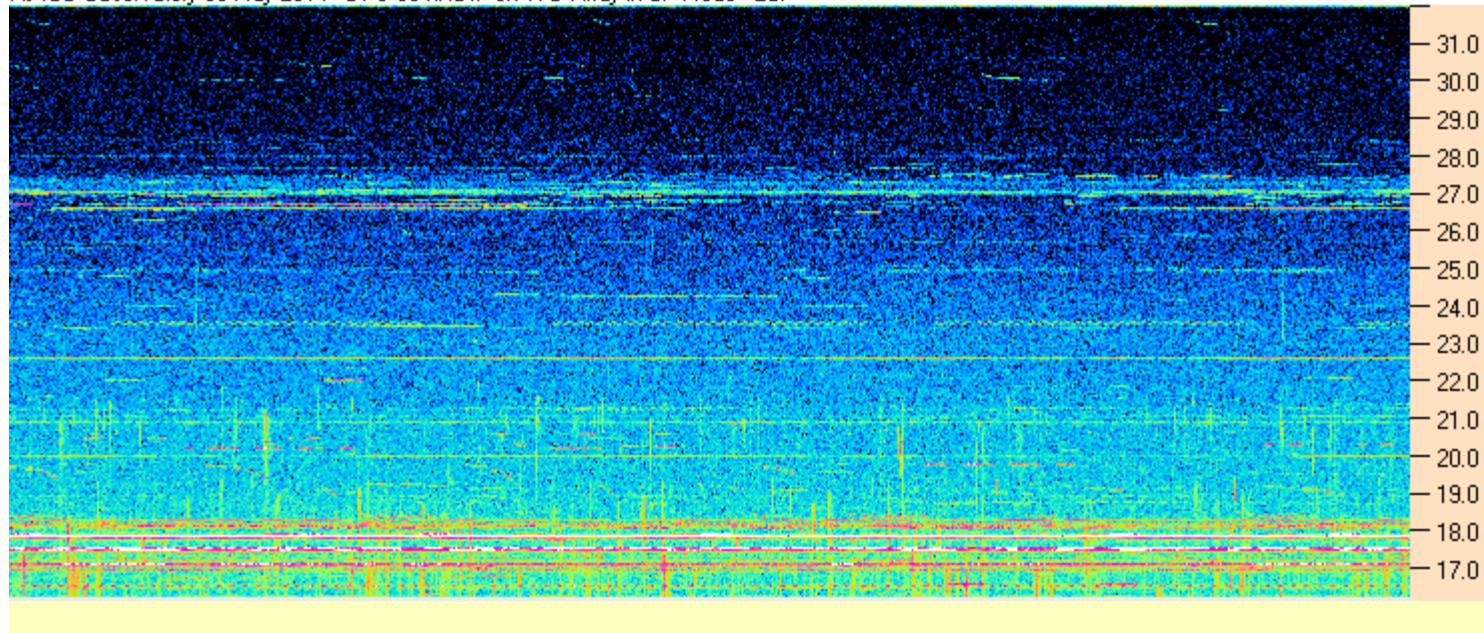
