Emission was RCP dominant with L bursting visible from 18 MHz to 23 MHz.

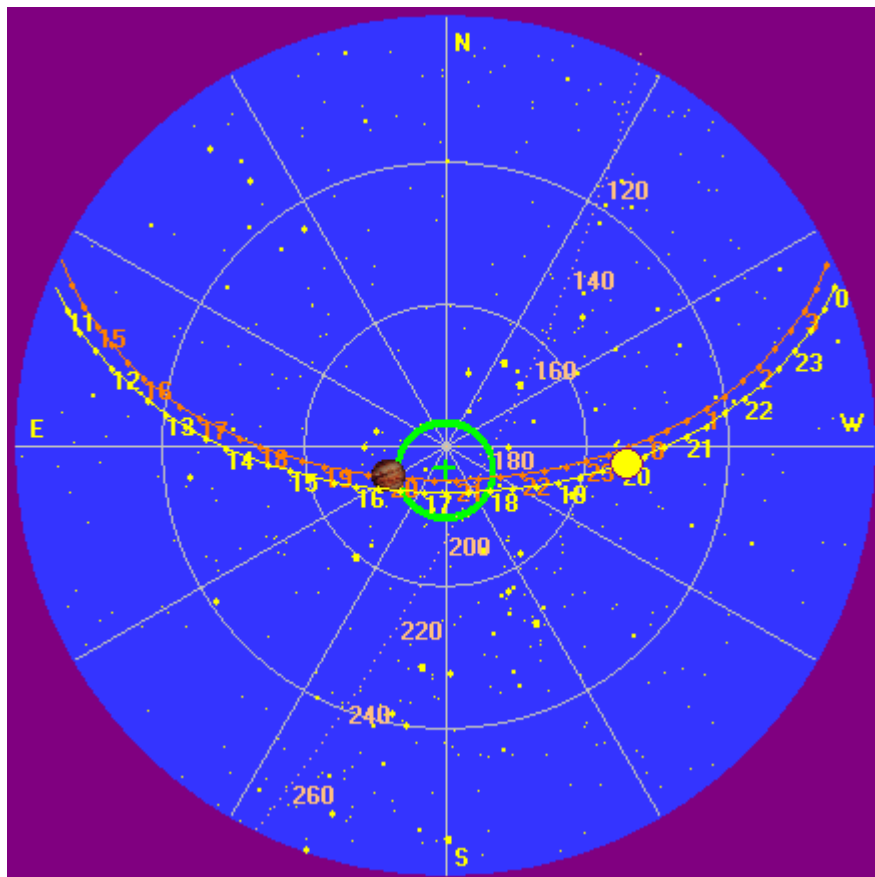
Jupiter was 18° to 7° off axis.

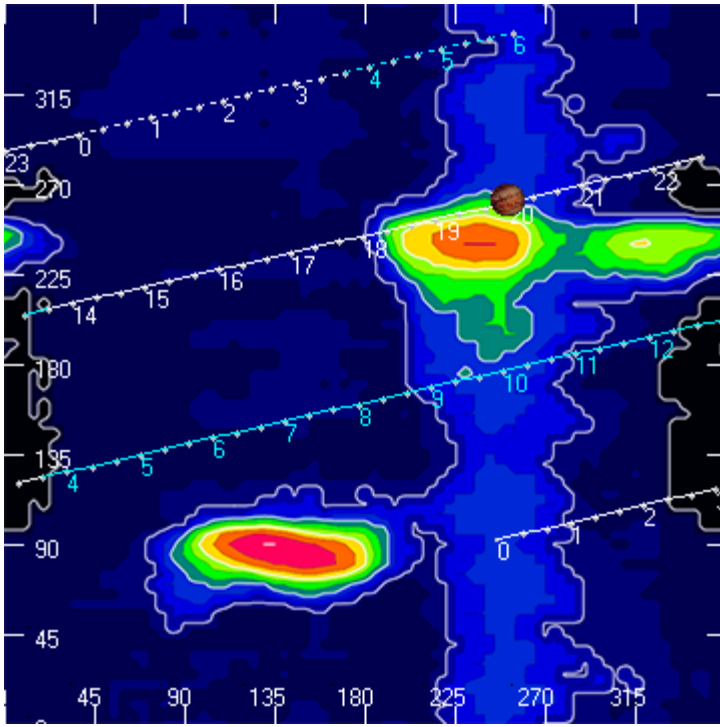
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 48°.

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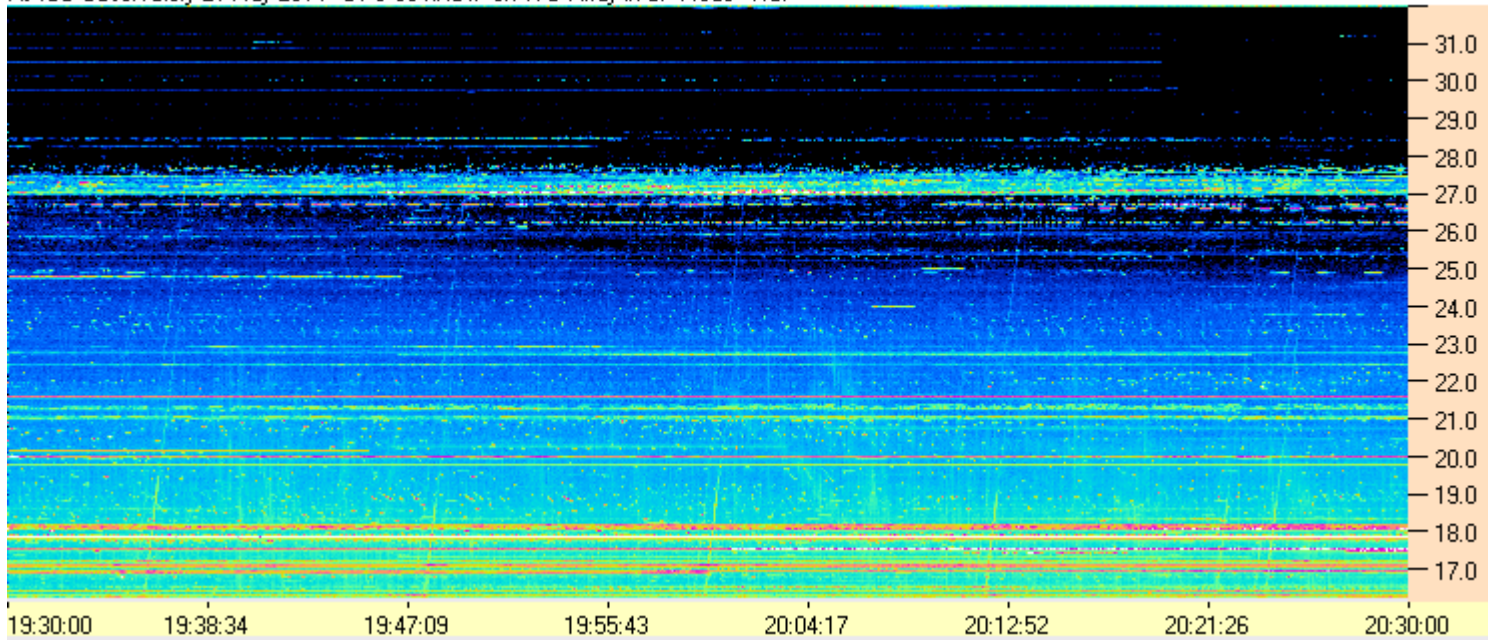

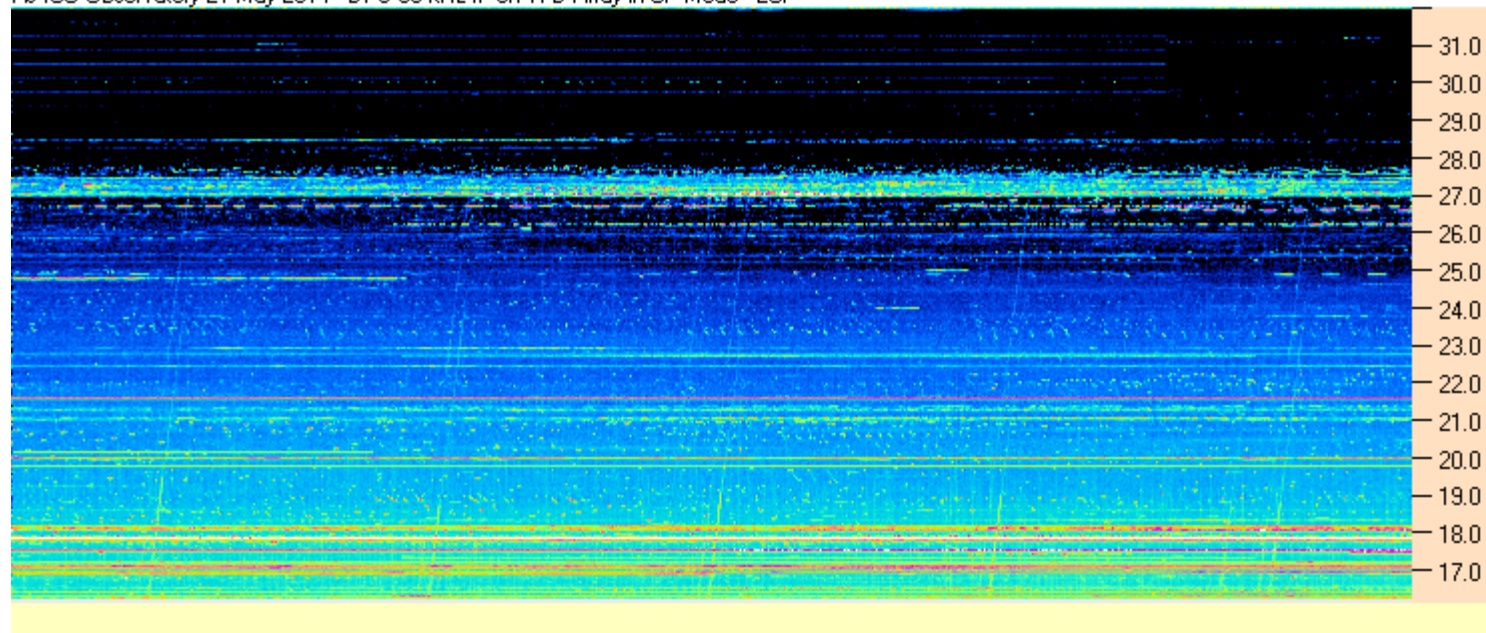




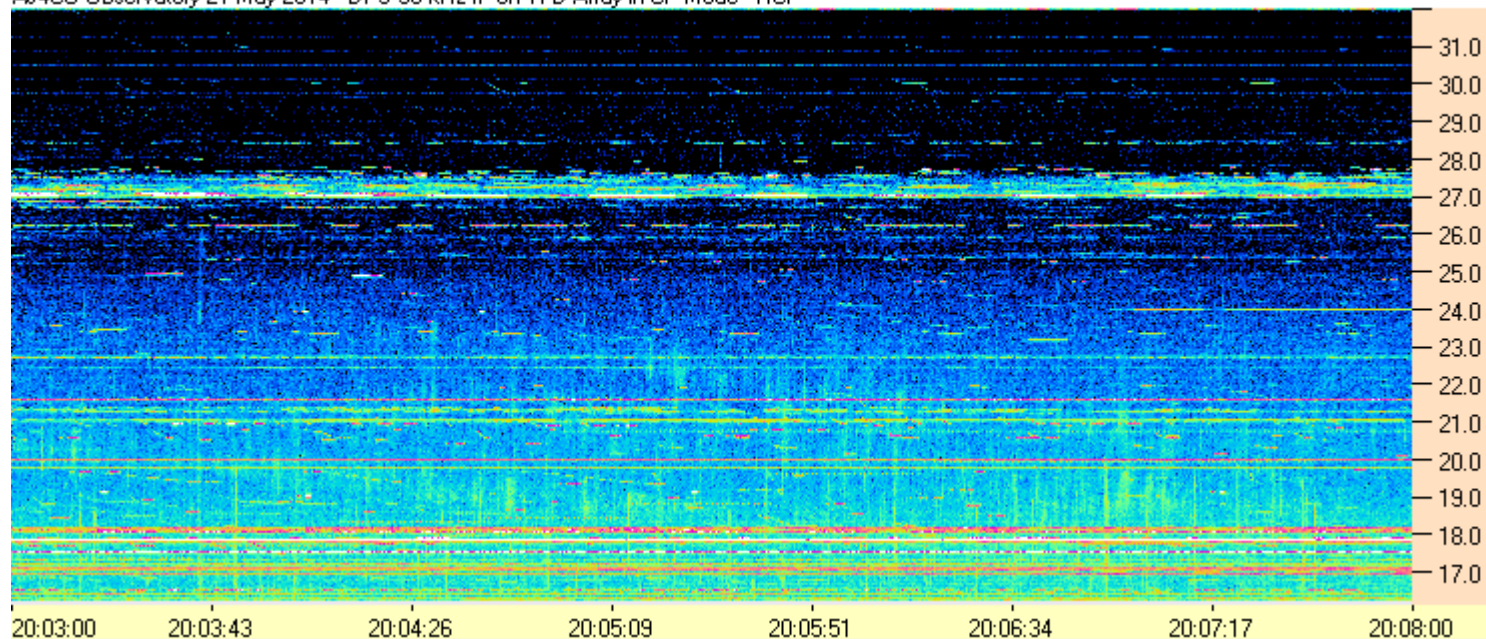
AJ4CO Observatory 21 May 2014 - DPS 30 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP
