Some hints of positive sloping modulation lanes at 2001 UTC.

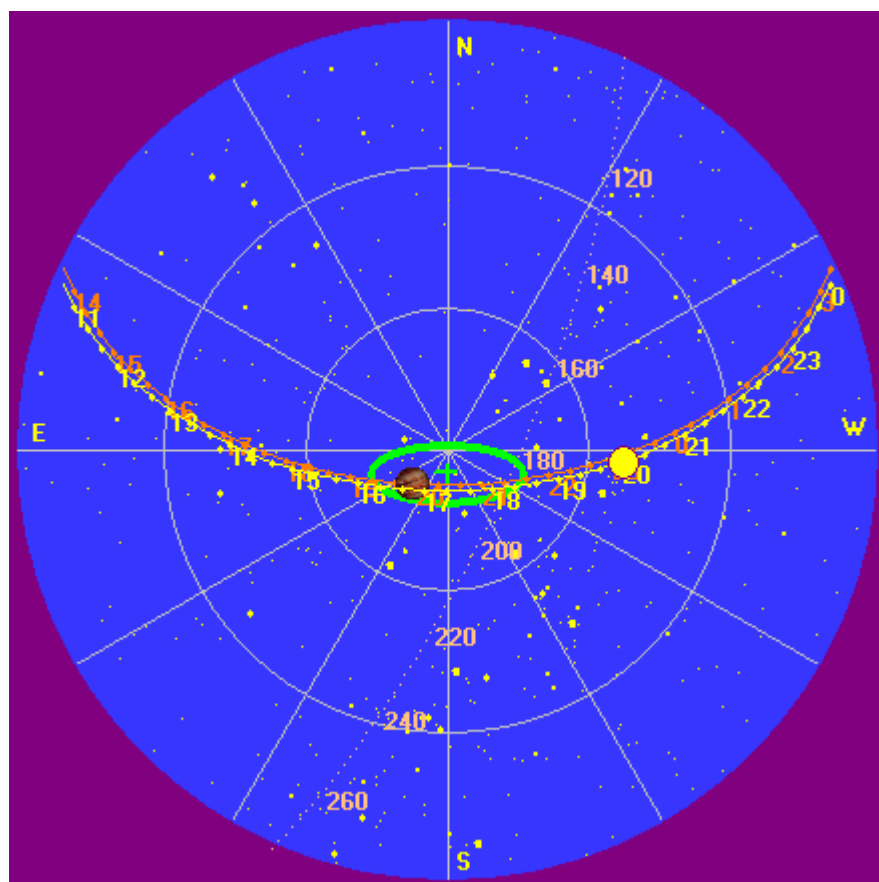
Jupiter was 21° to 6° off axis.

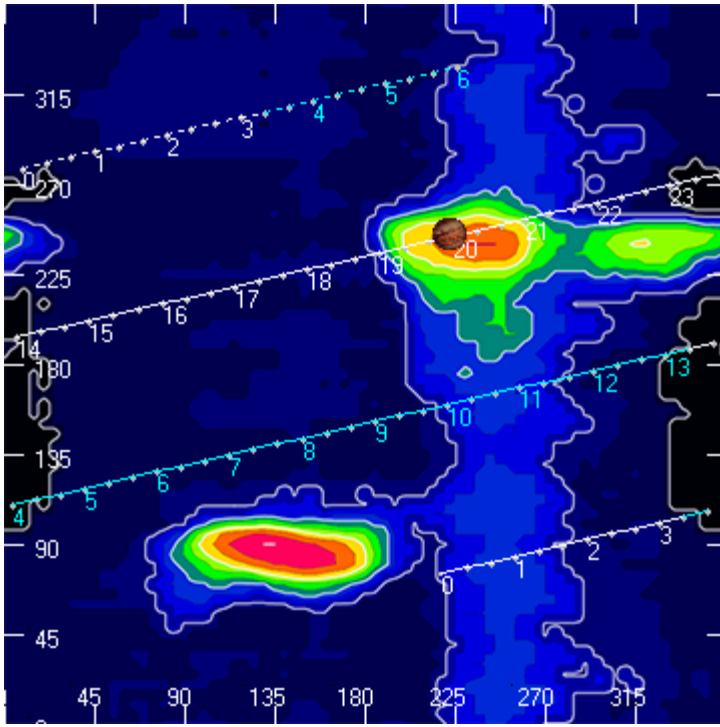
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 42° .

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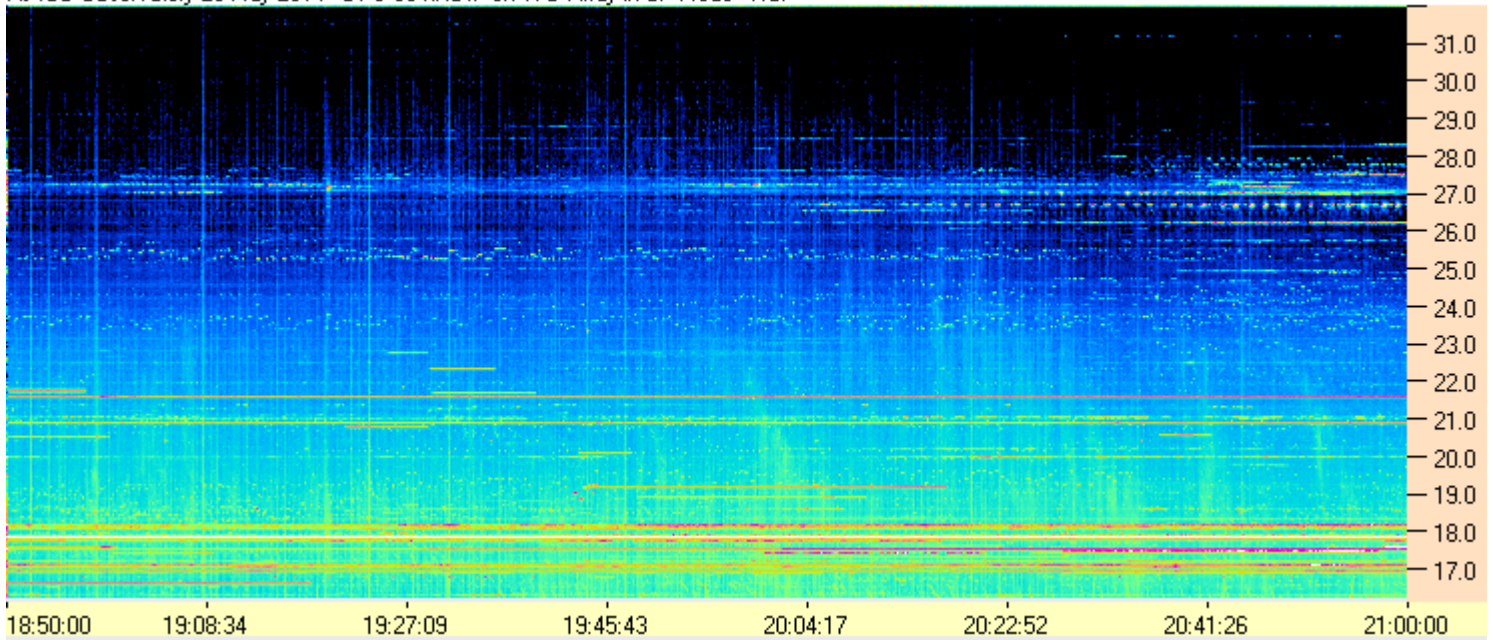

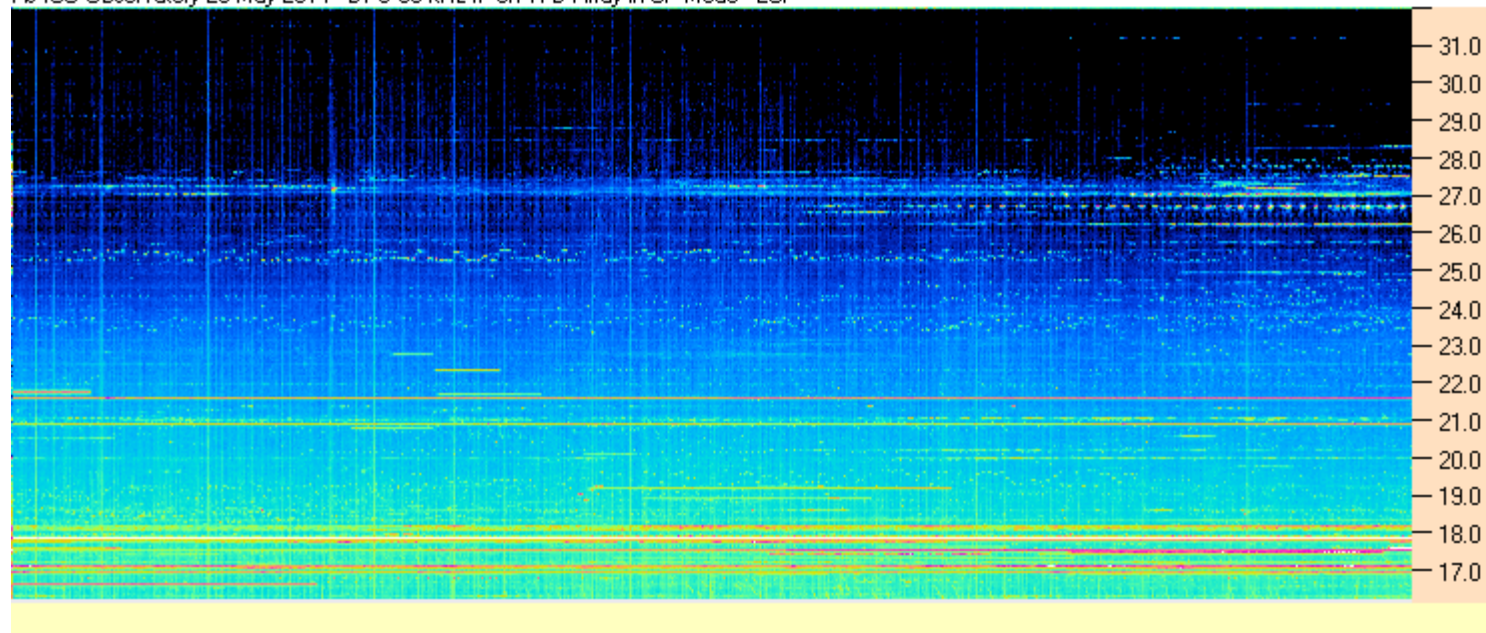




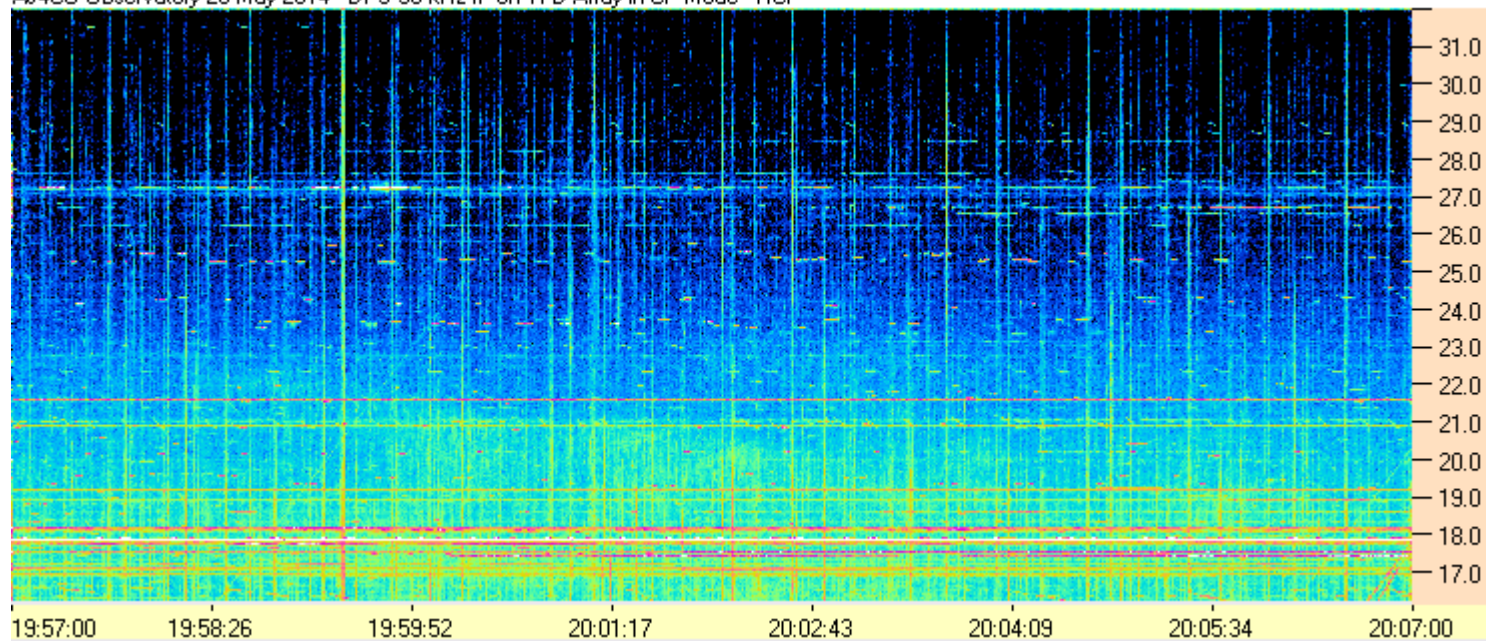
AJ4CO Observatory 28 May 2014 - DPS 30 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - RCP



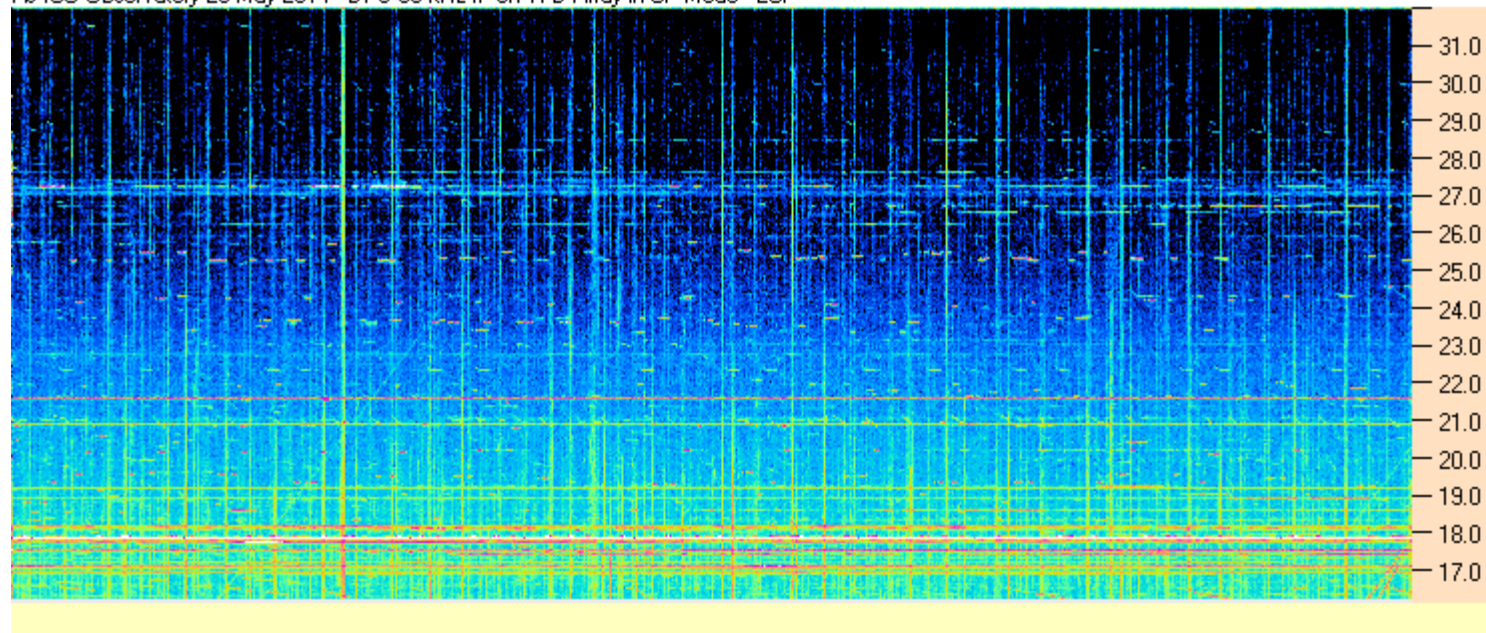
AJ4CO Observatory 28 May 2014 - DPS 30 kHz IF on TFD Array in CP Mode - LCP
