Surprising presence of modulation lanes (positive drift) at around 1650 UTC.

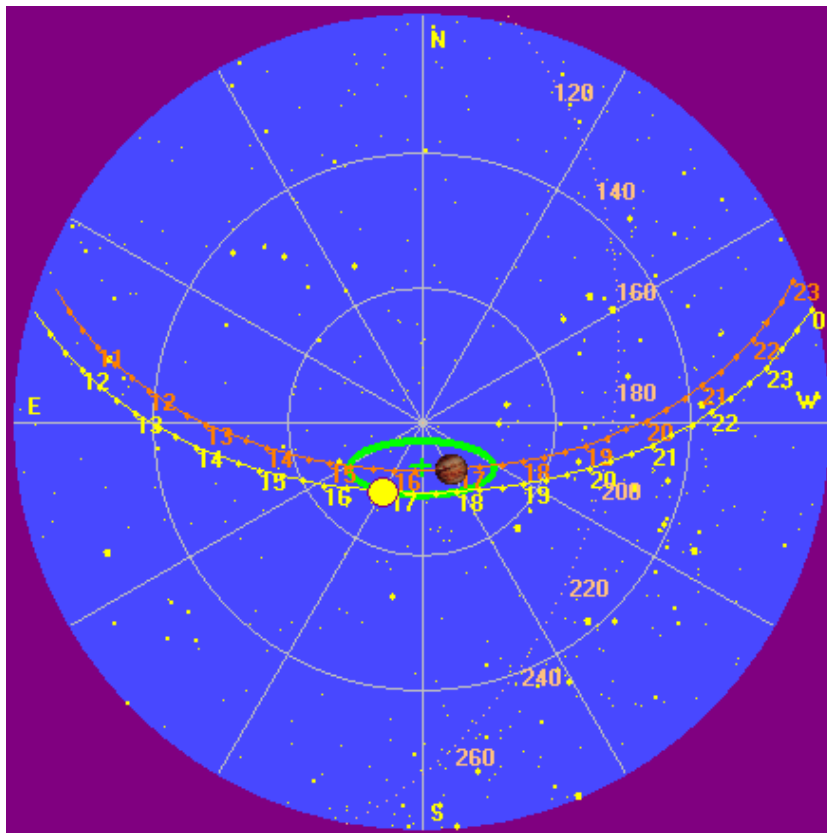
Jupiter was -7° to $+16^\circ$ off axis.

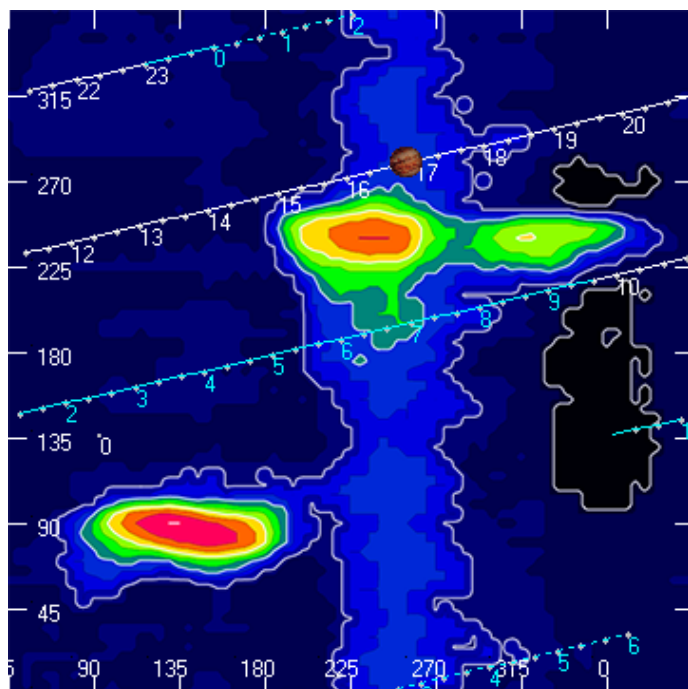
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 17° .

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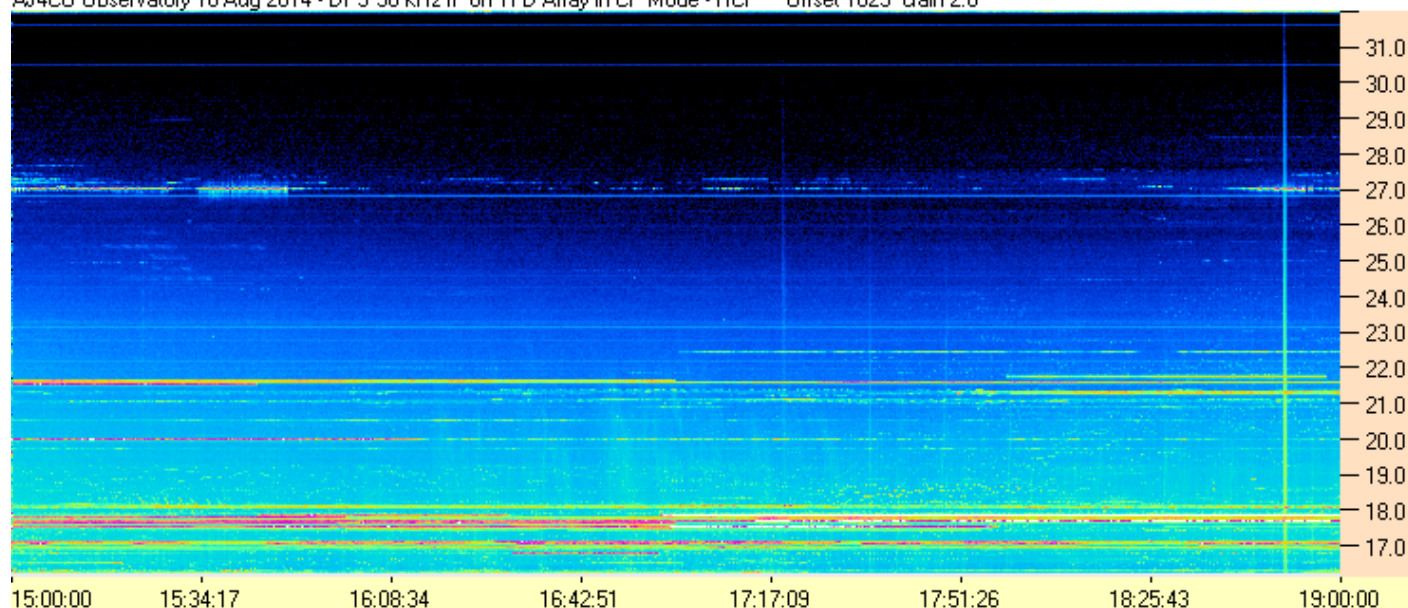

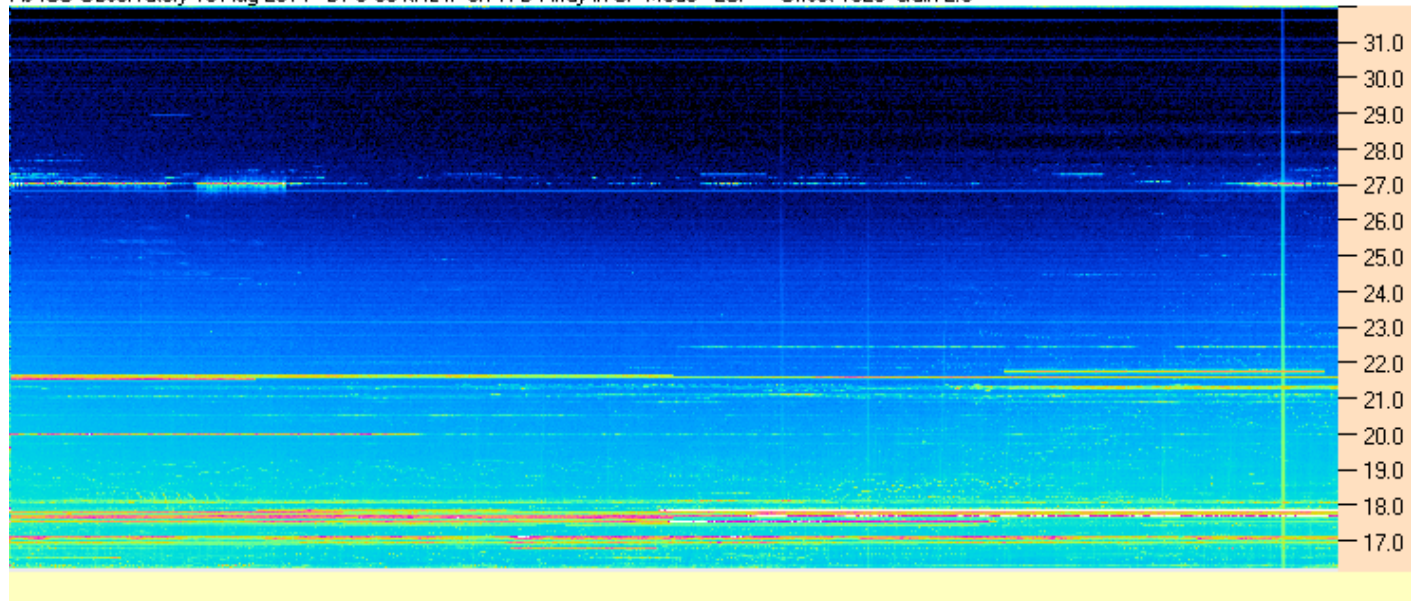




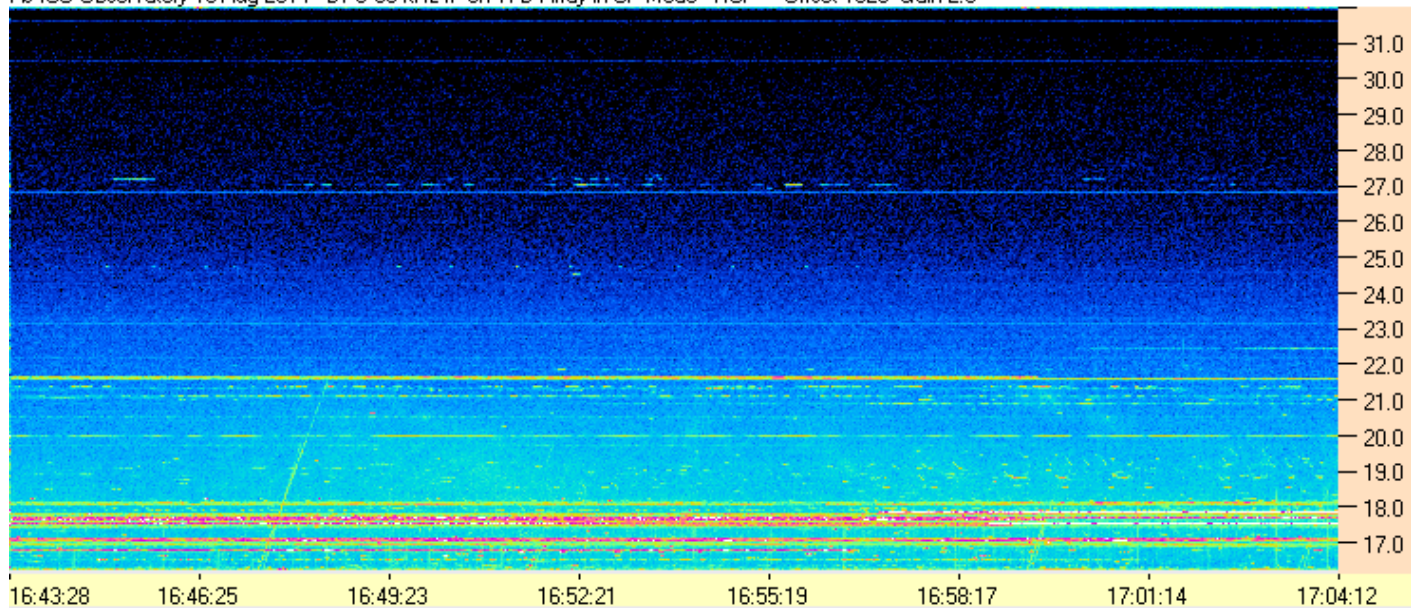
