RCP dominant L bursting from 18 to 26 MHz. No modulation lanes evident.

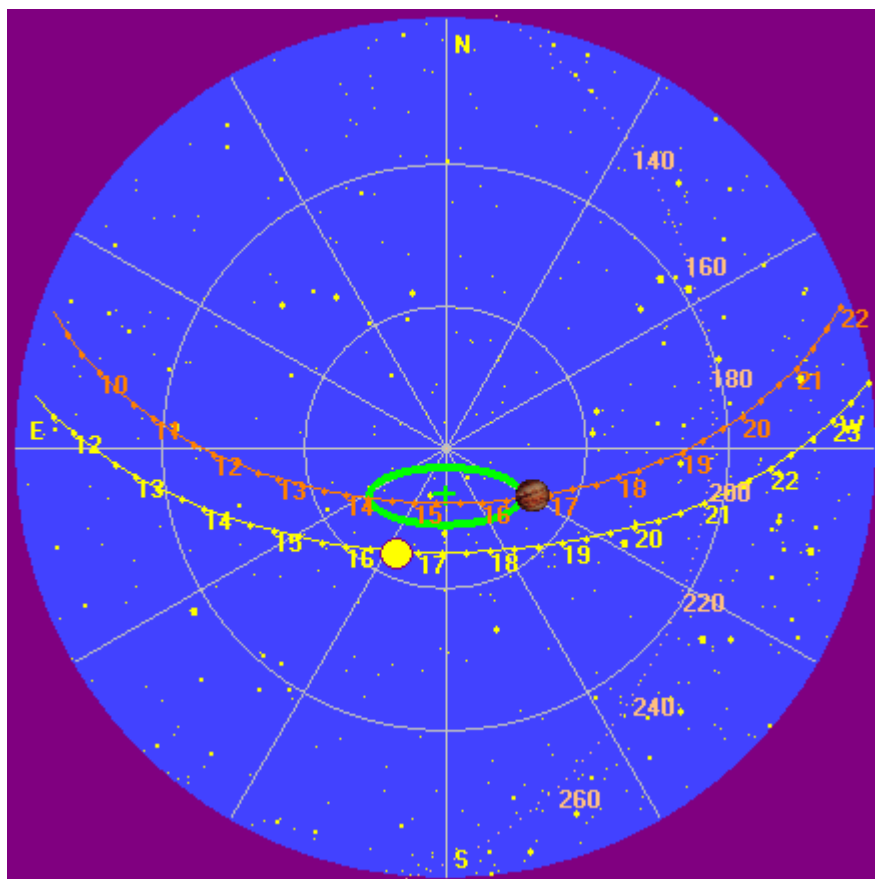
Jupiter was $+7^\circ$ to $+28^\circ$ off axis.

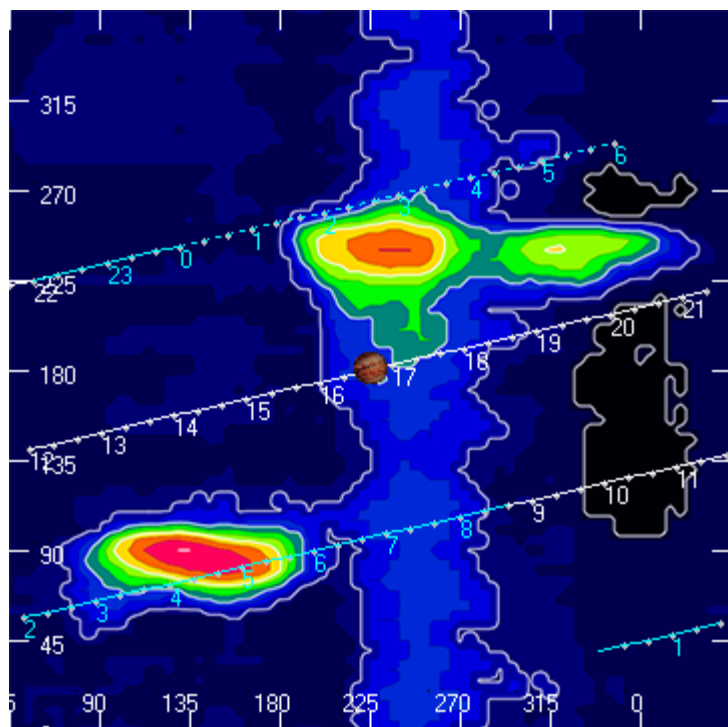
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 31° .

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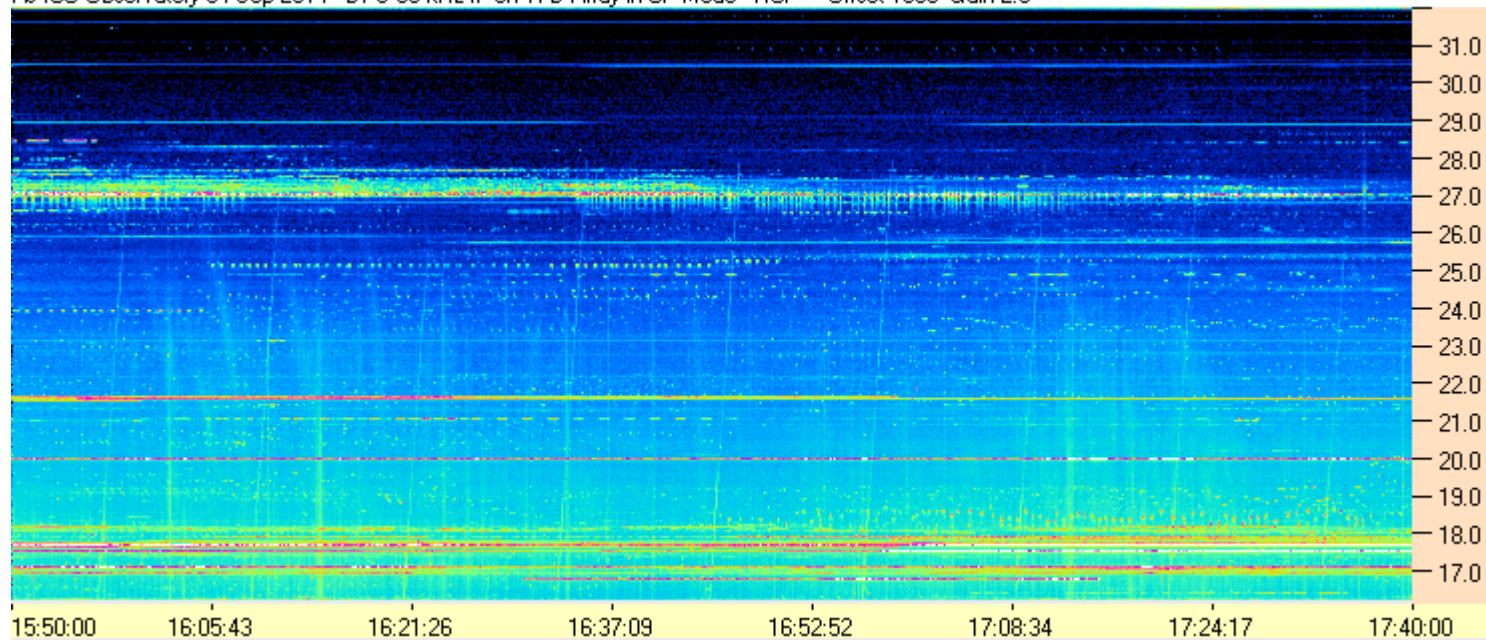

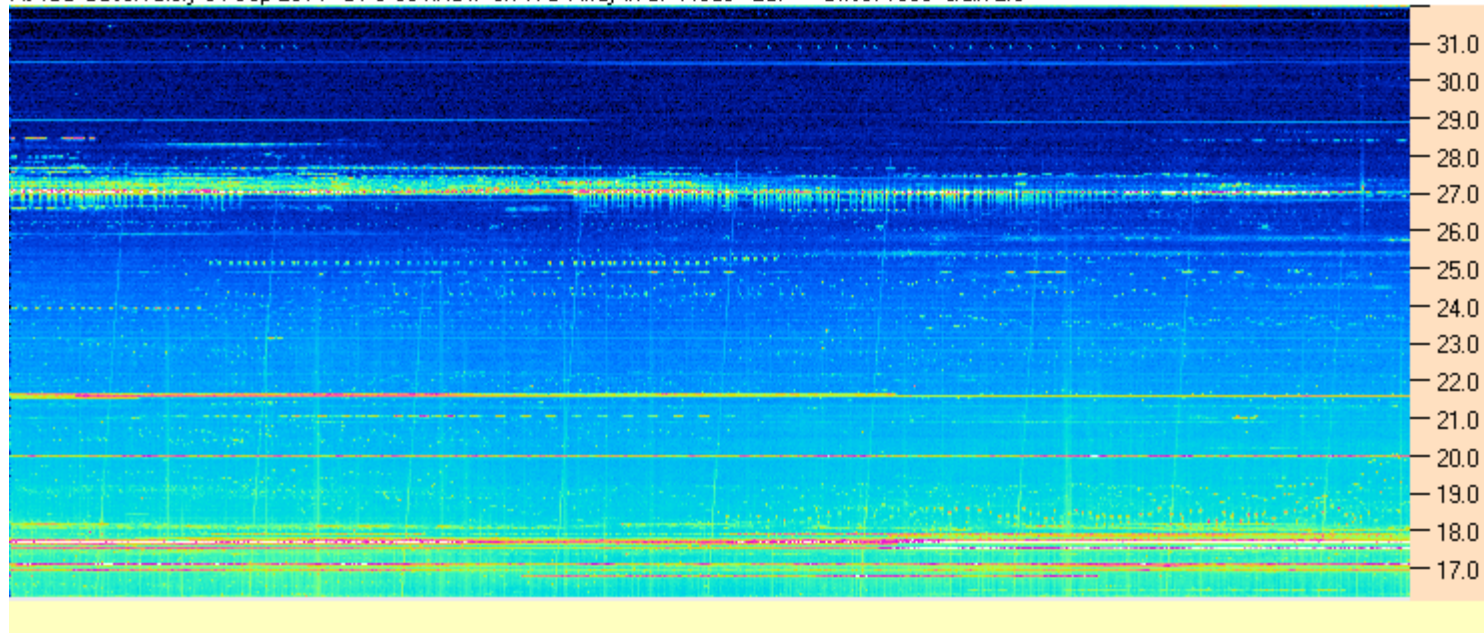
