The bulk of the emission was LCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 23 MHz. Negative drift modulation lanes evident circa 1345 UTC.

As Tom noted, there was a weak N event between 1215 and 1240 UTC at around 23 MHz.

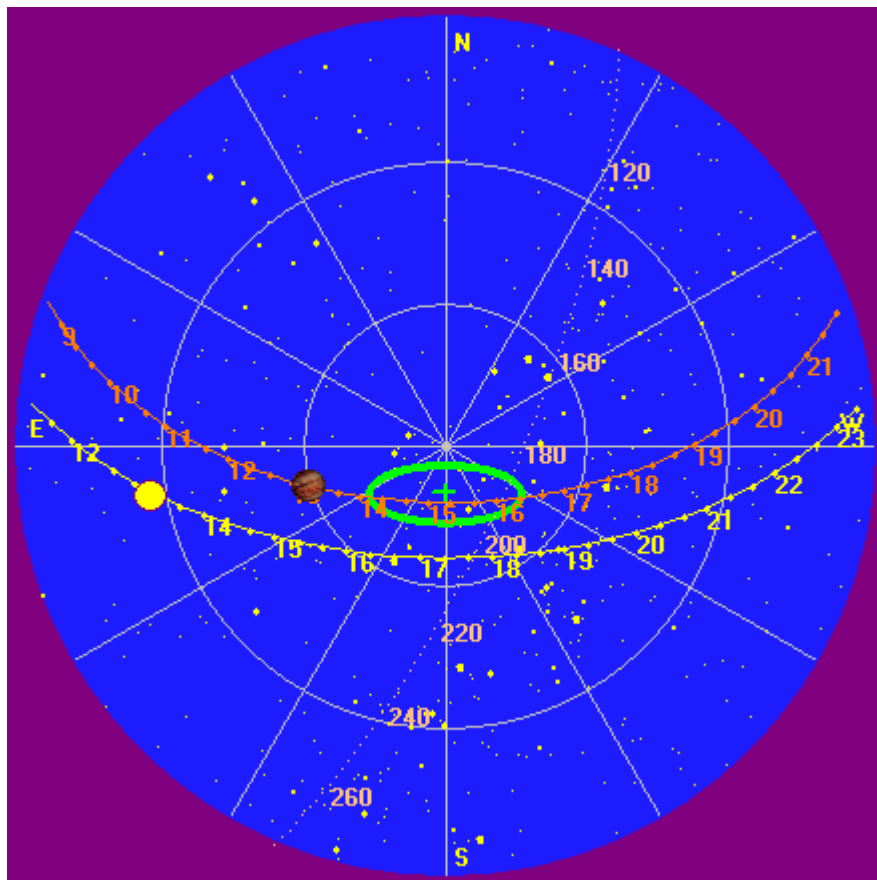
Jupiter was -41° to -16° off axis.

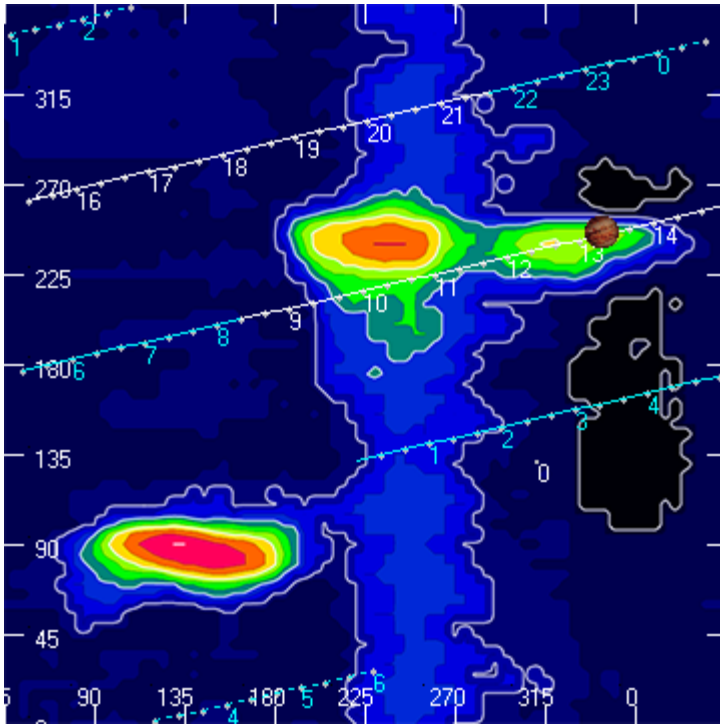
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 34° .

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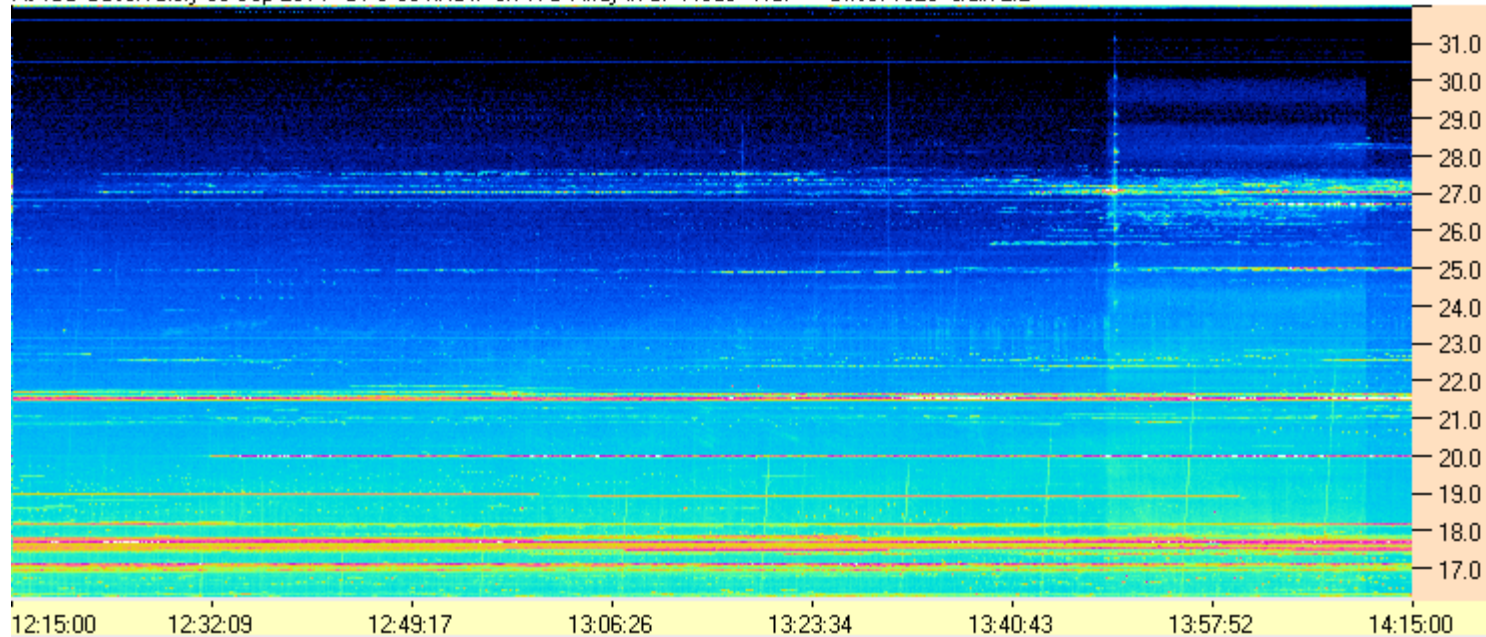

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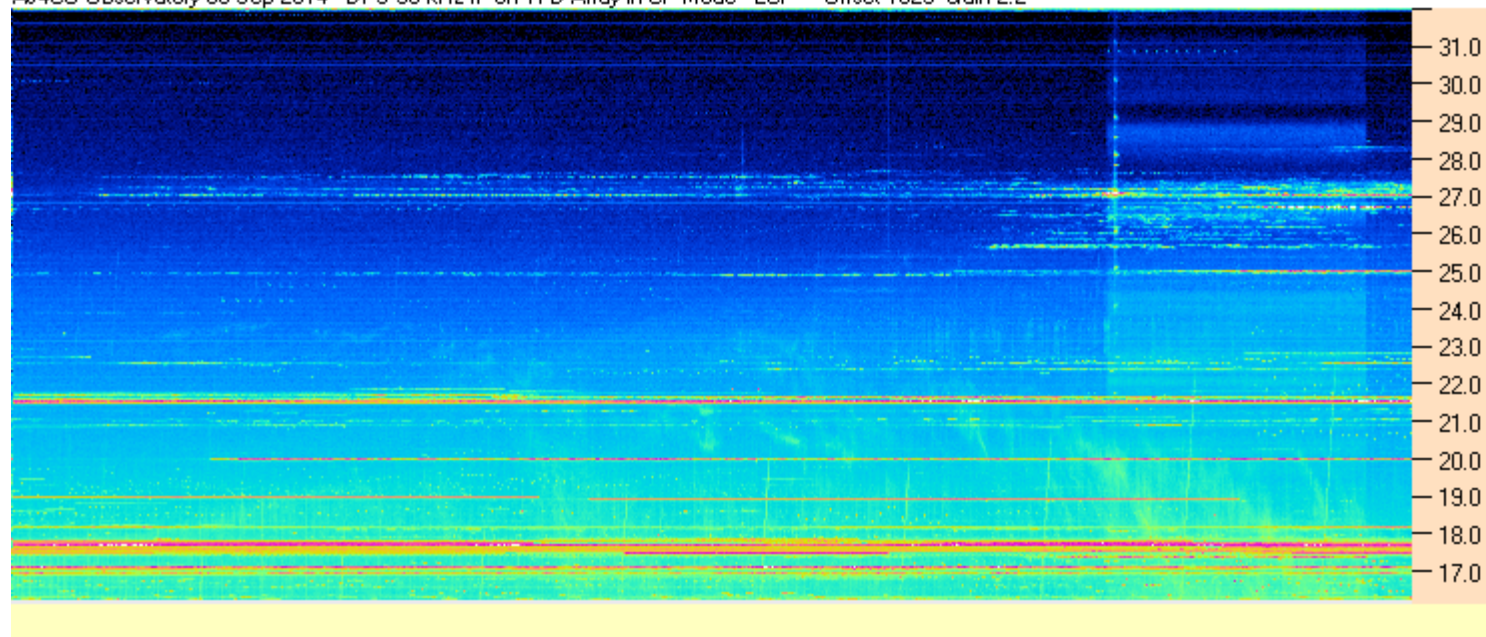




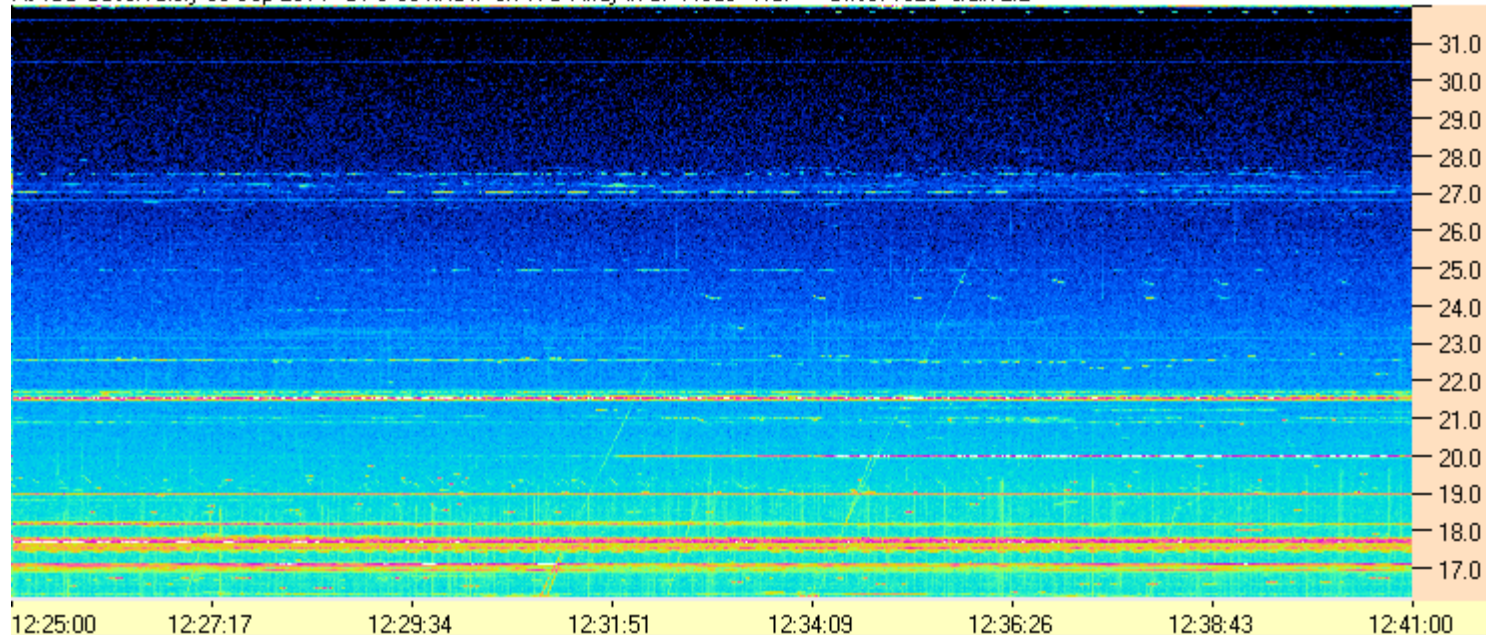
