Jupiter was leading the Sun by  $35^\circ$ .

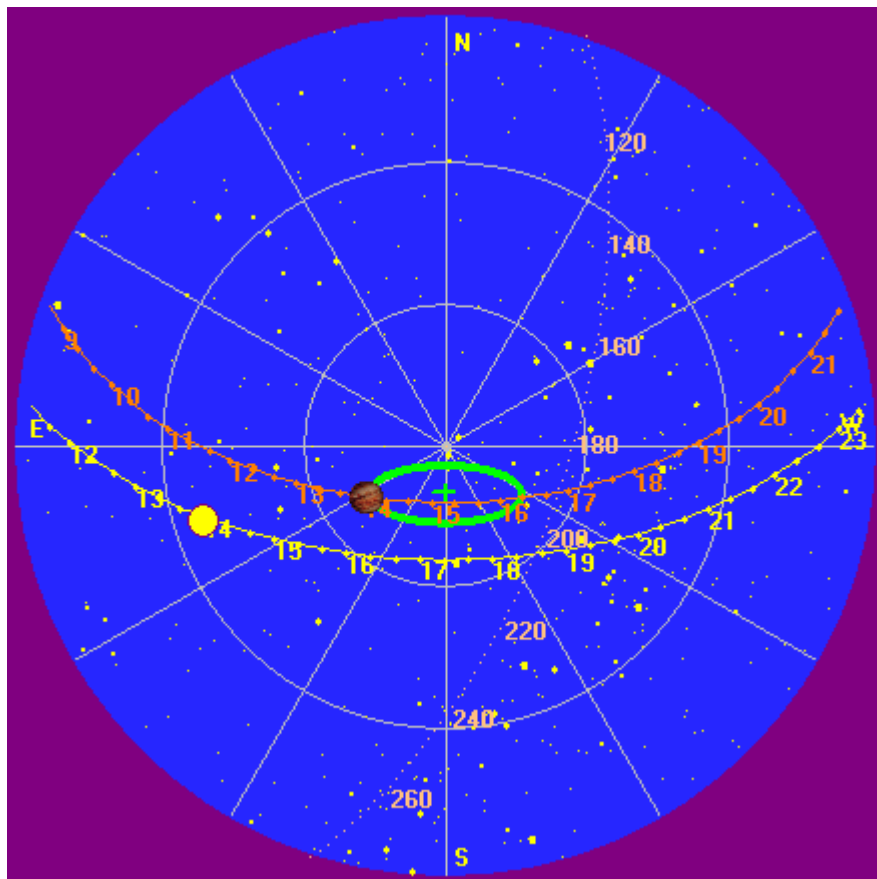
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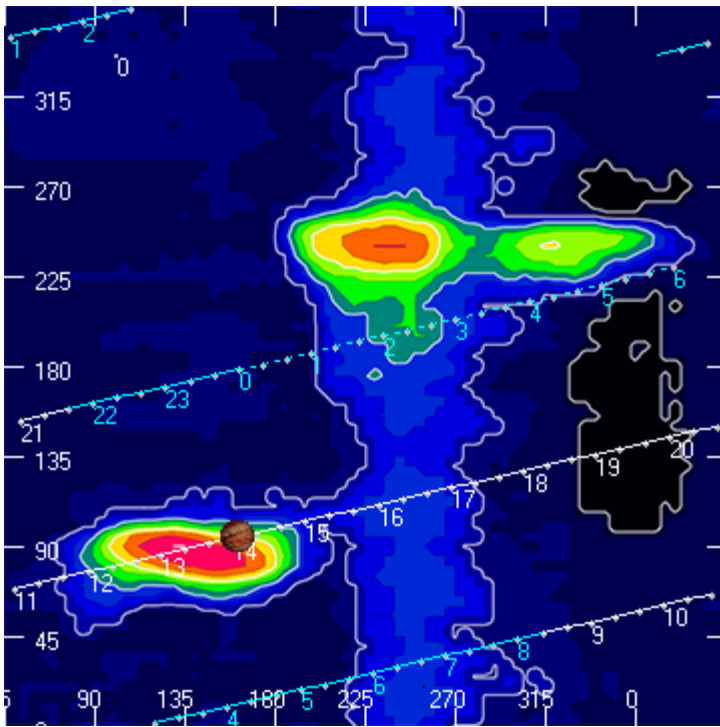

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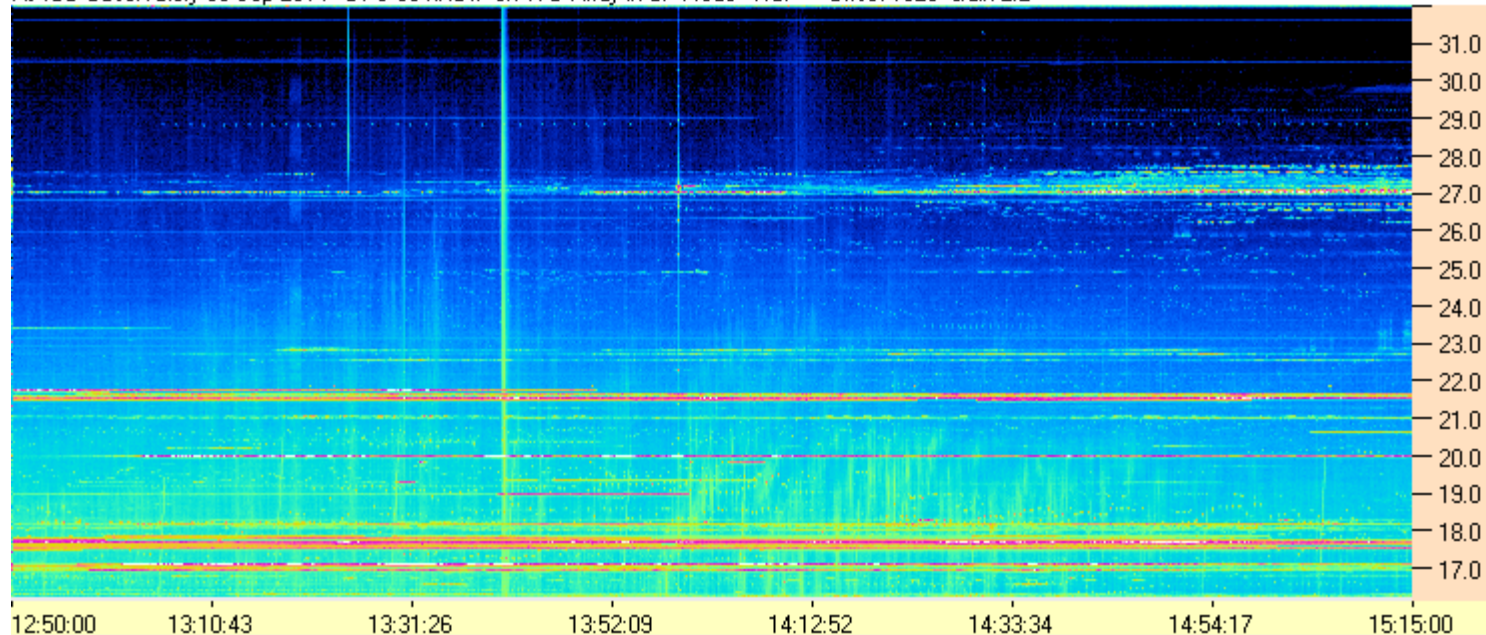

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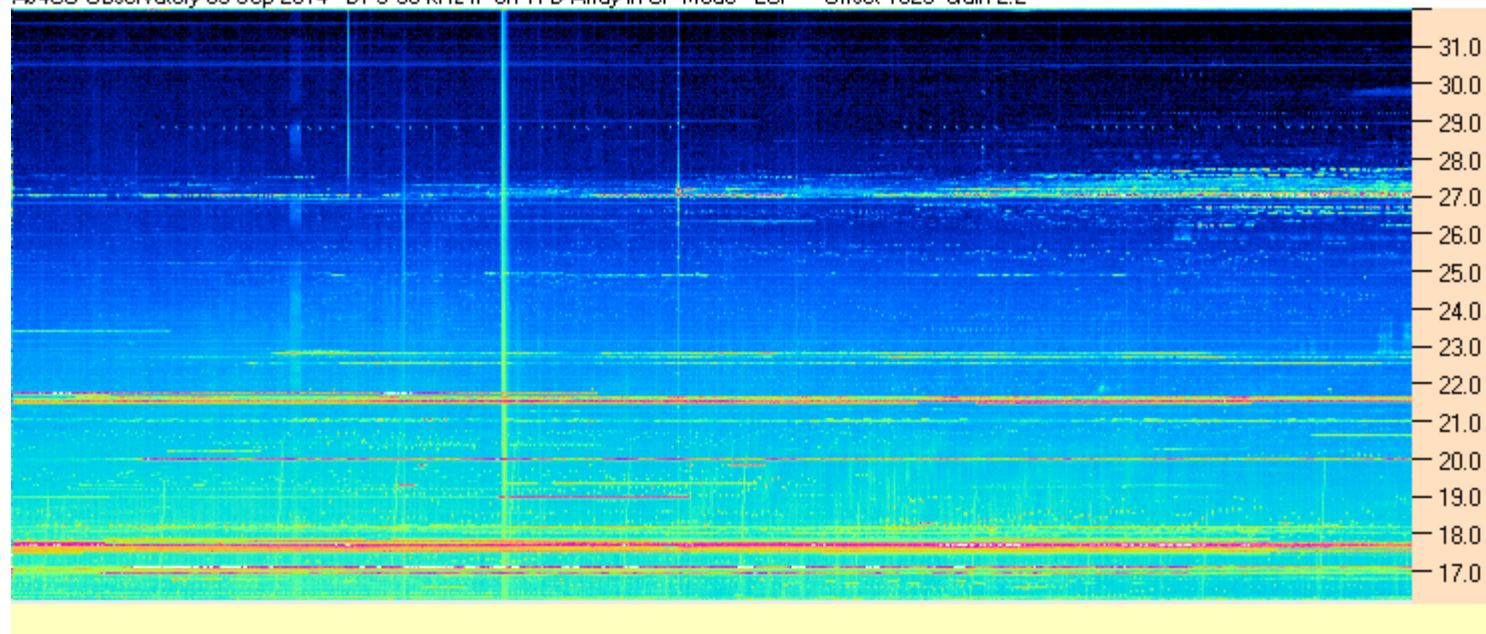

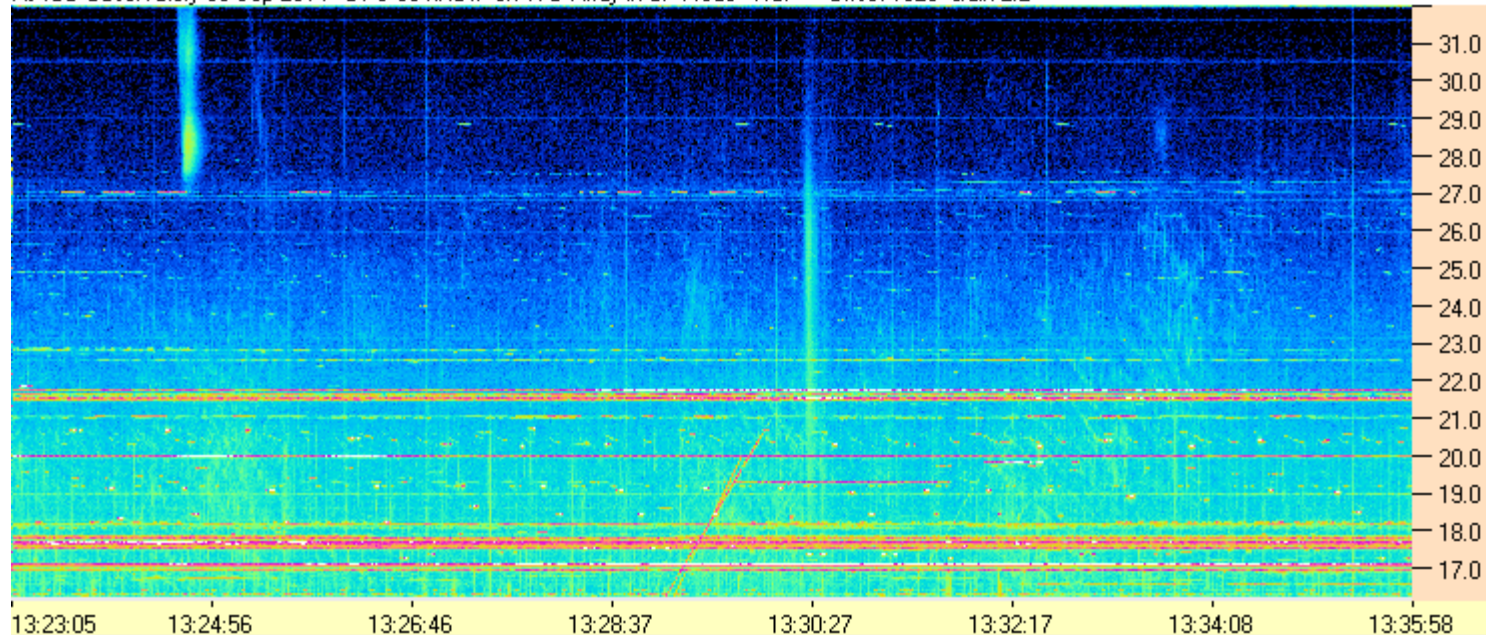

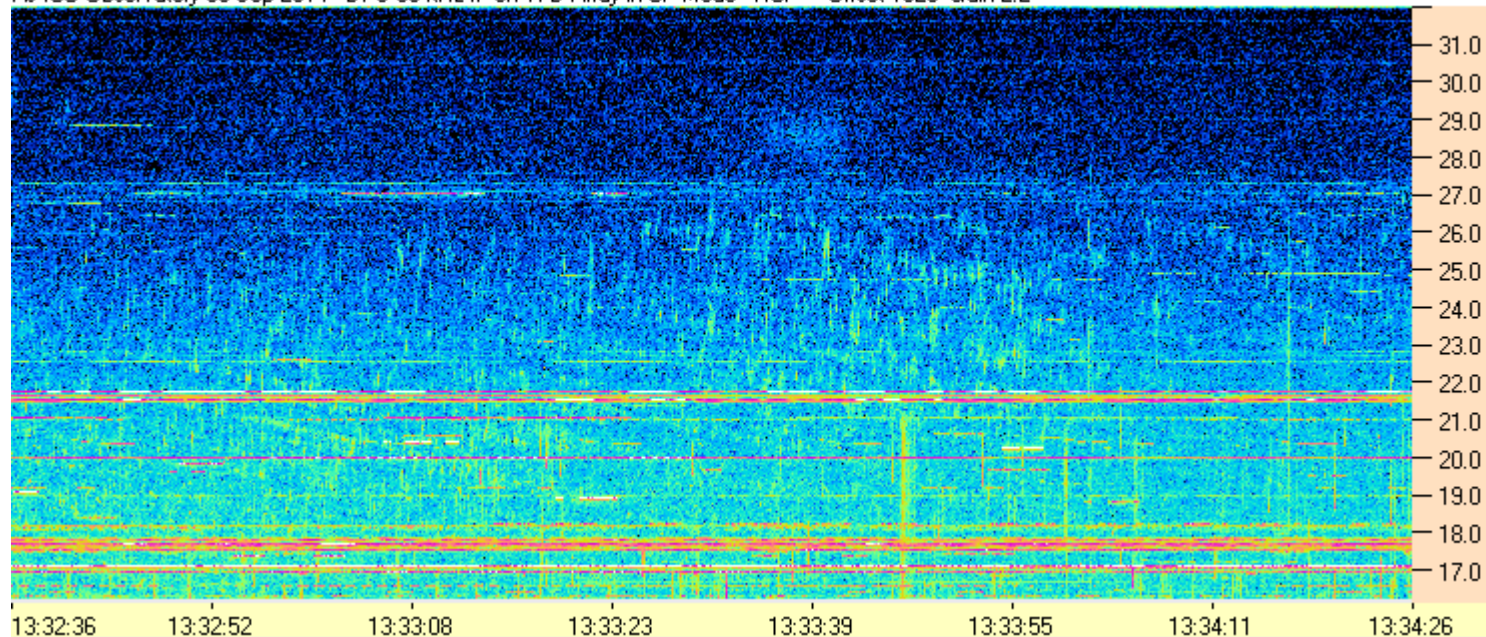
