LCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 20 MHz. No modulation lanes evident.

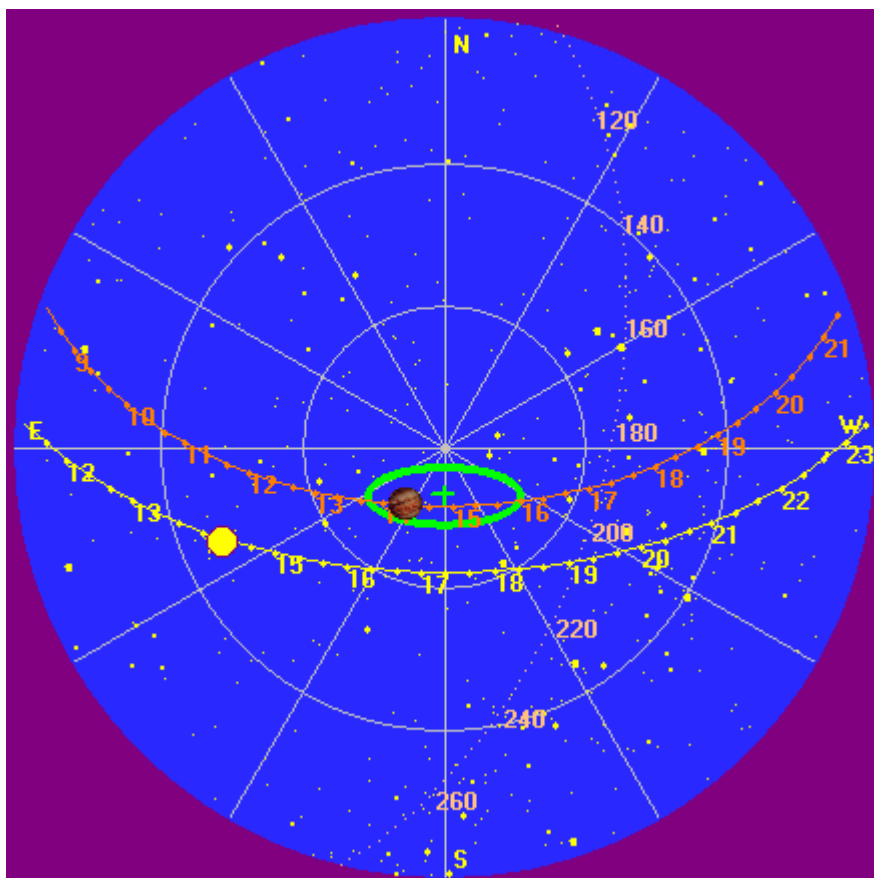
Jupiter was -25° to $+6^\circ$ off axis.

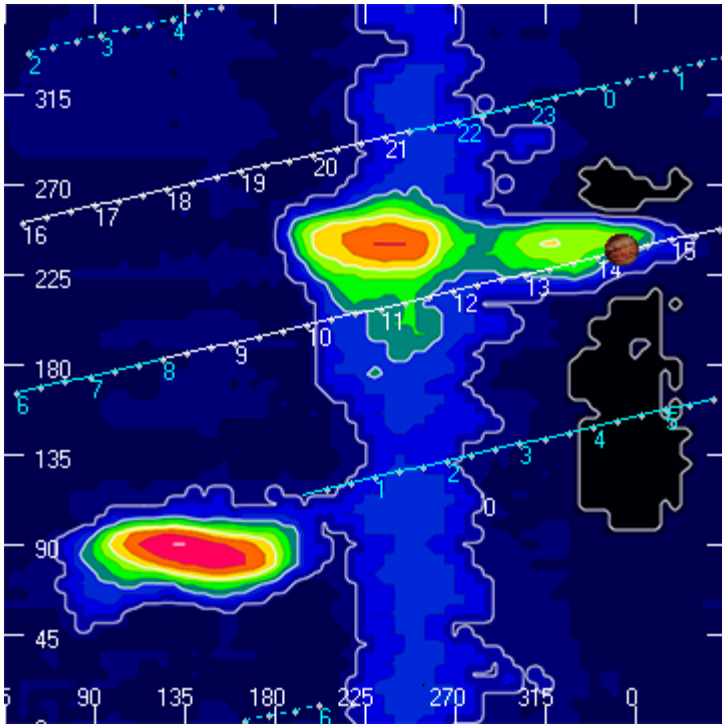
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 40° .

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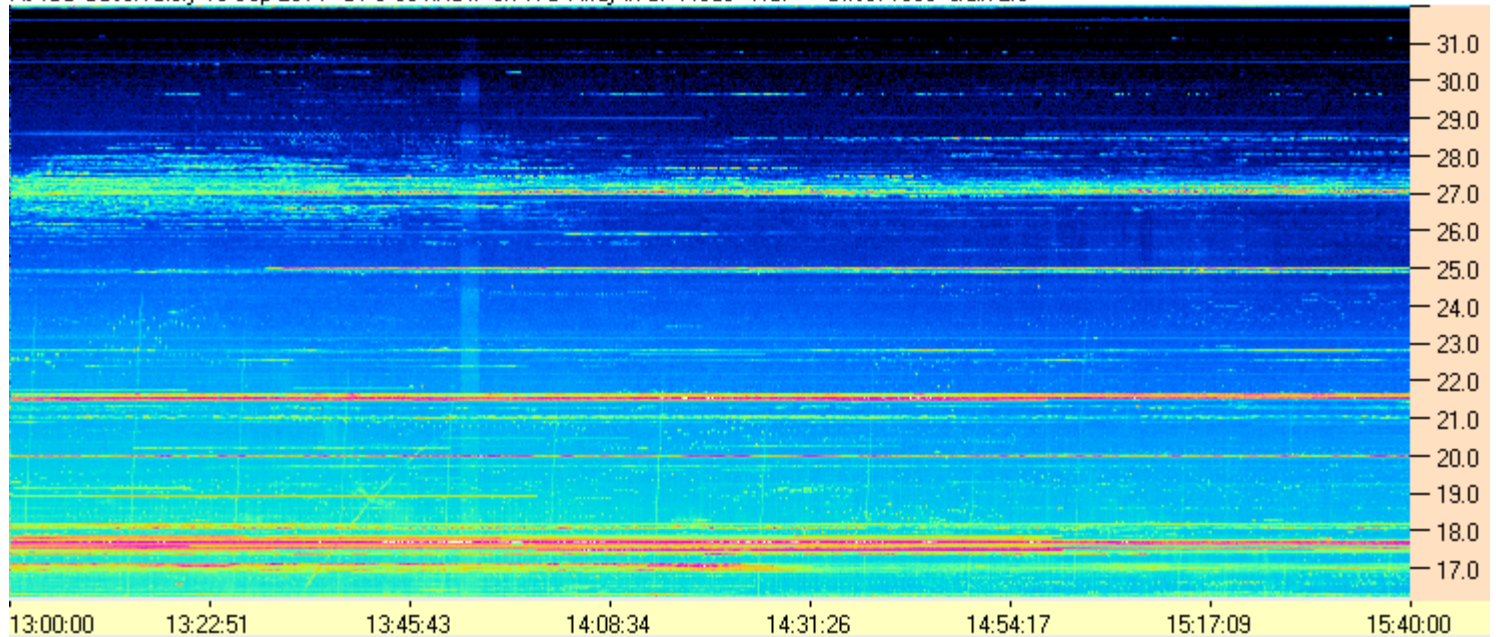

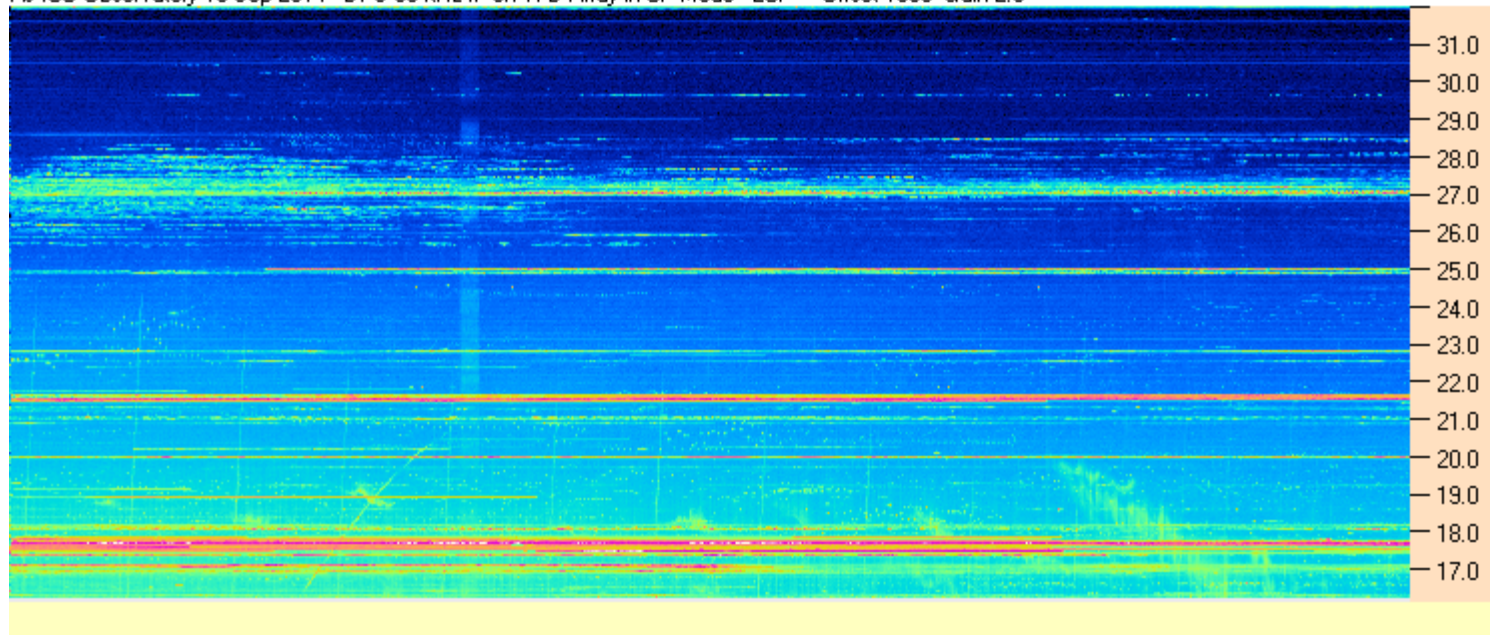




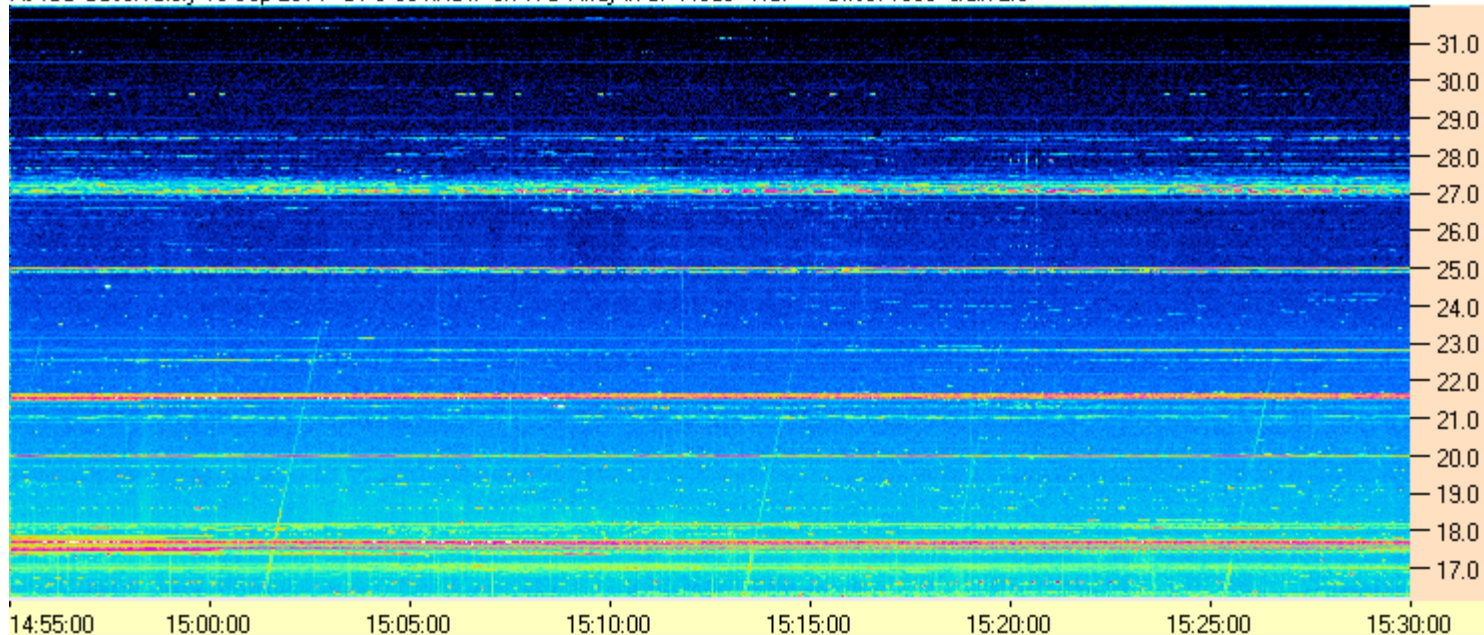
