RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 26 MHz. No modulation lanes evident.

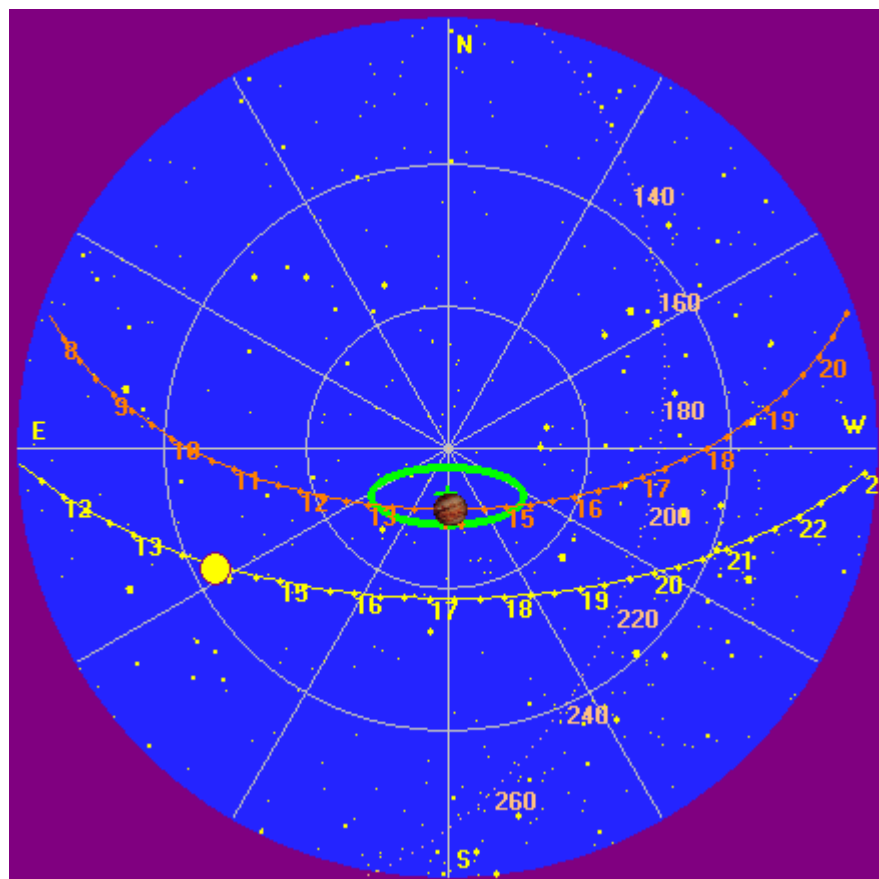
Jupiter was -11° to $+11^\circ$ off axis.

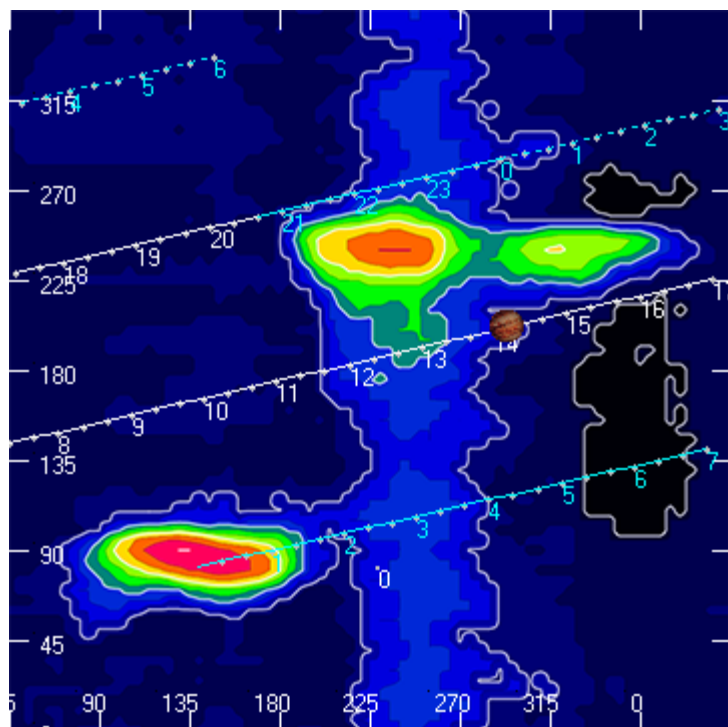
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 51° .

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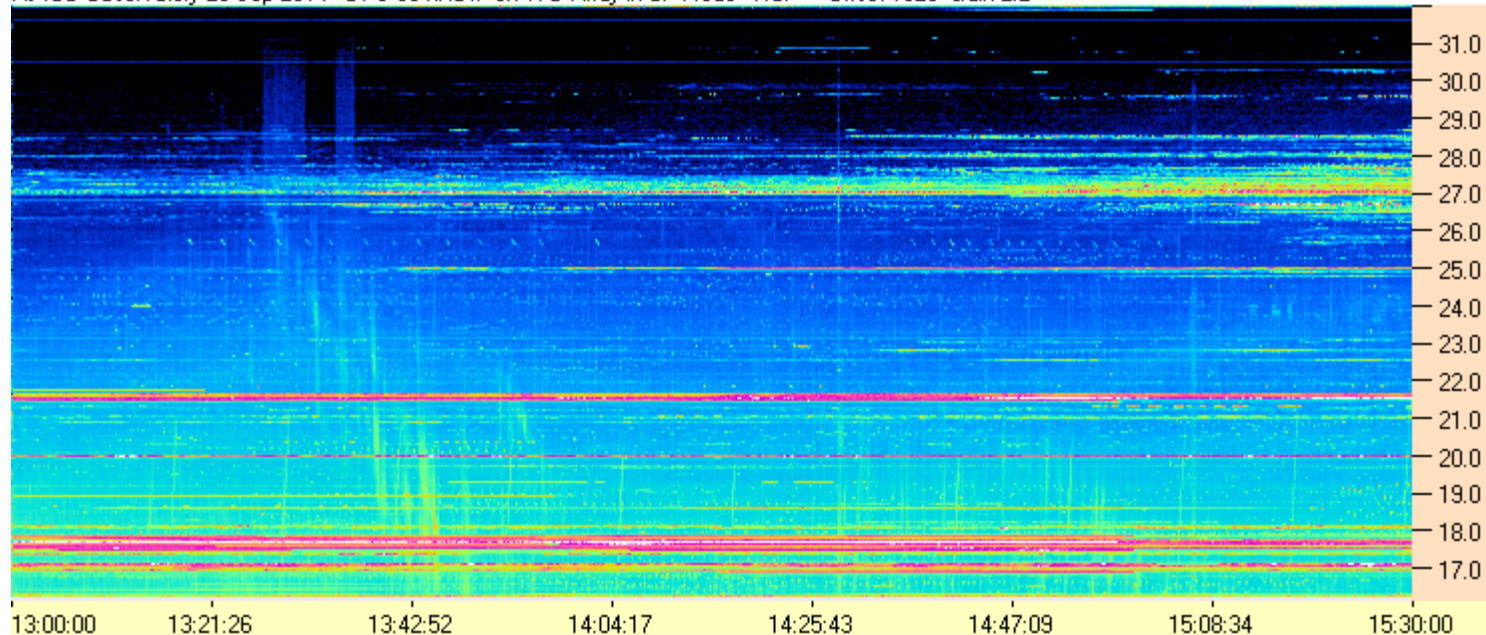

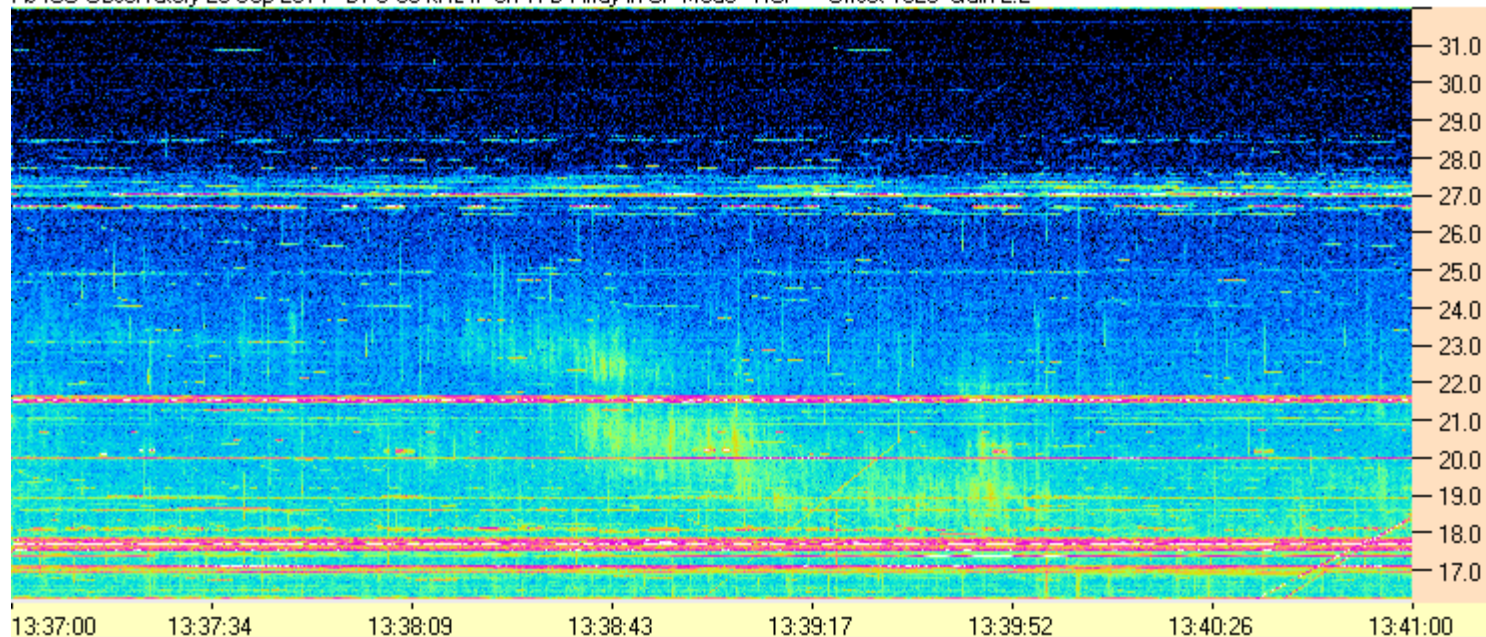

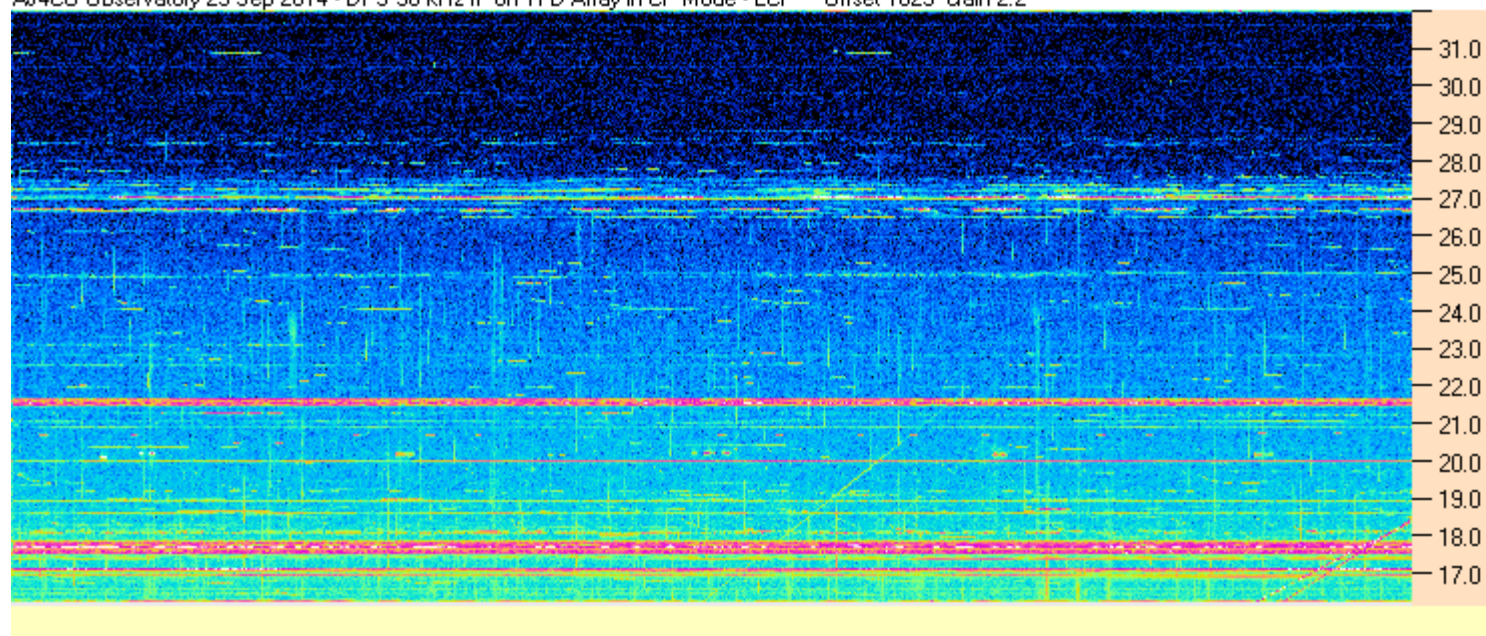
