RCP dominant S bursting from 16 to 21 MHz. No visible modulation lanes.

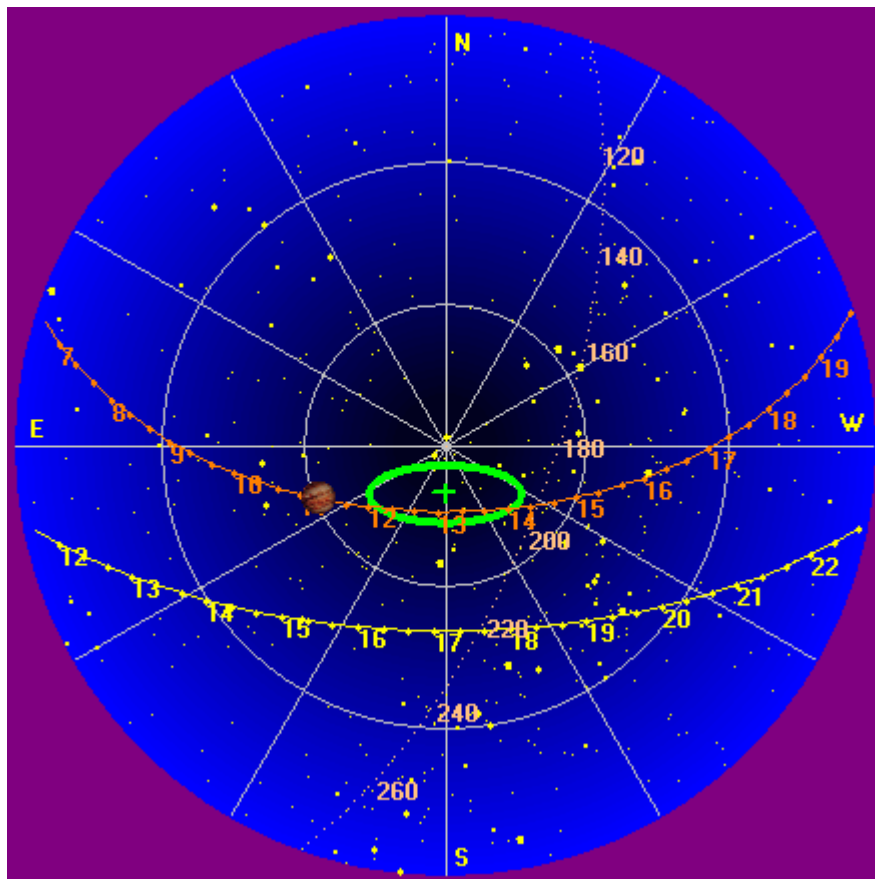
Jupiter was -32° to -21° off axis.

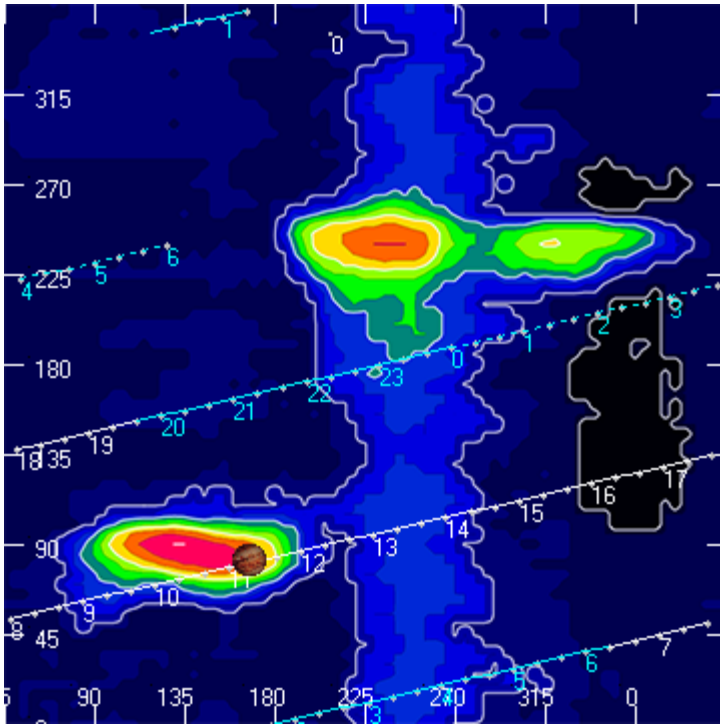
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 66° .

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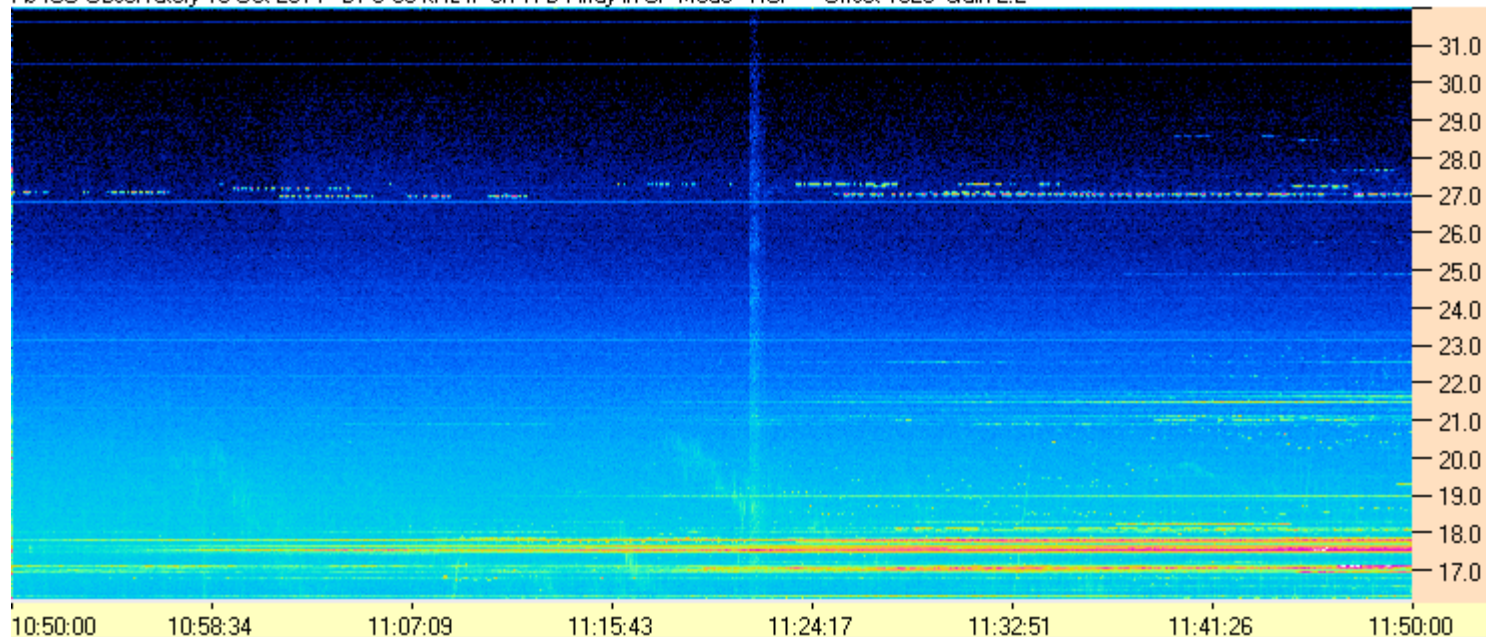

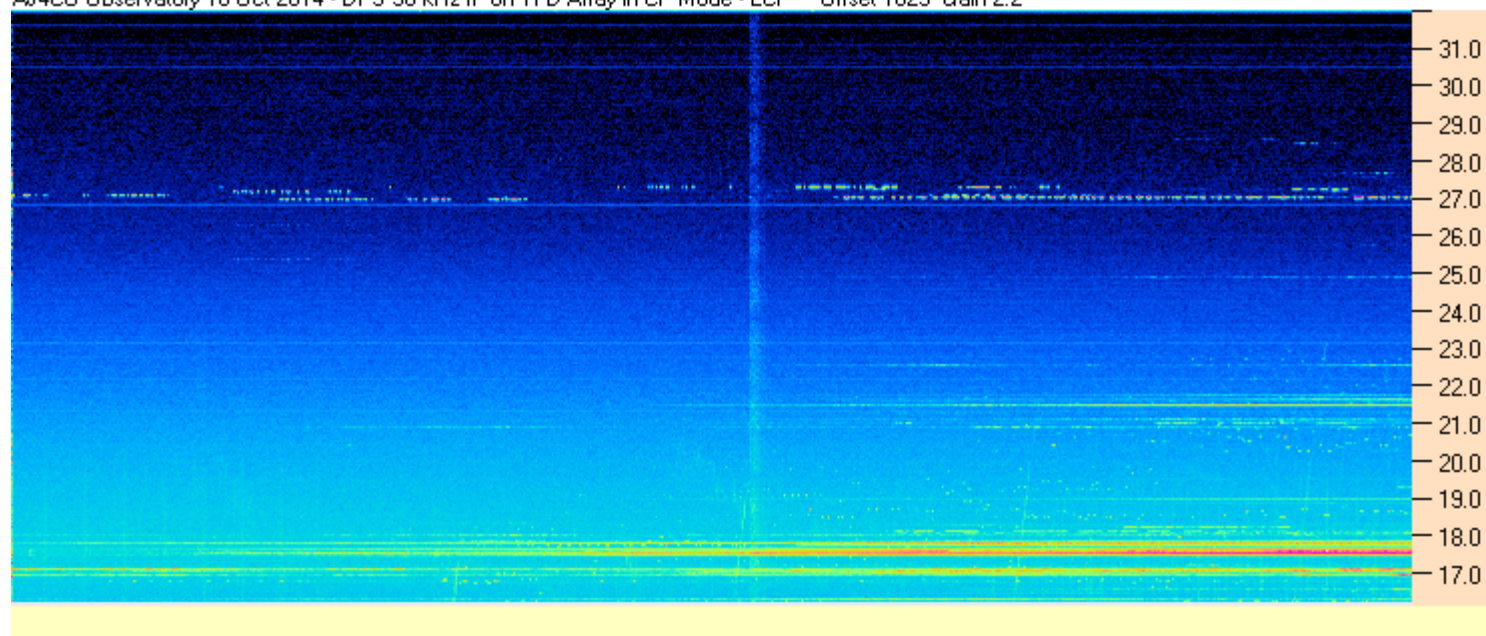




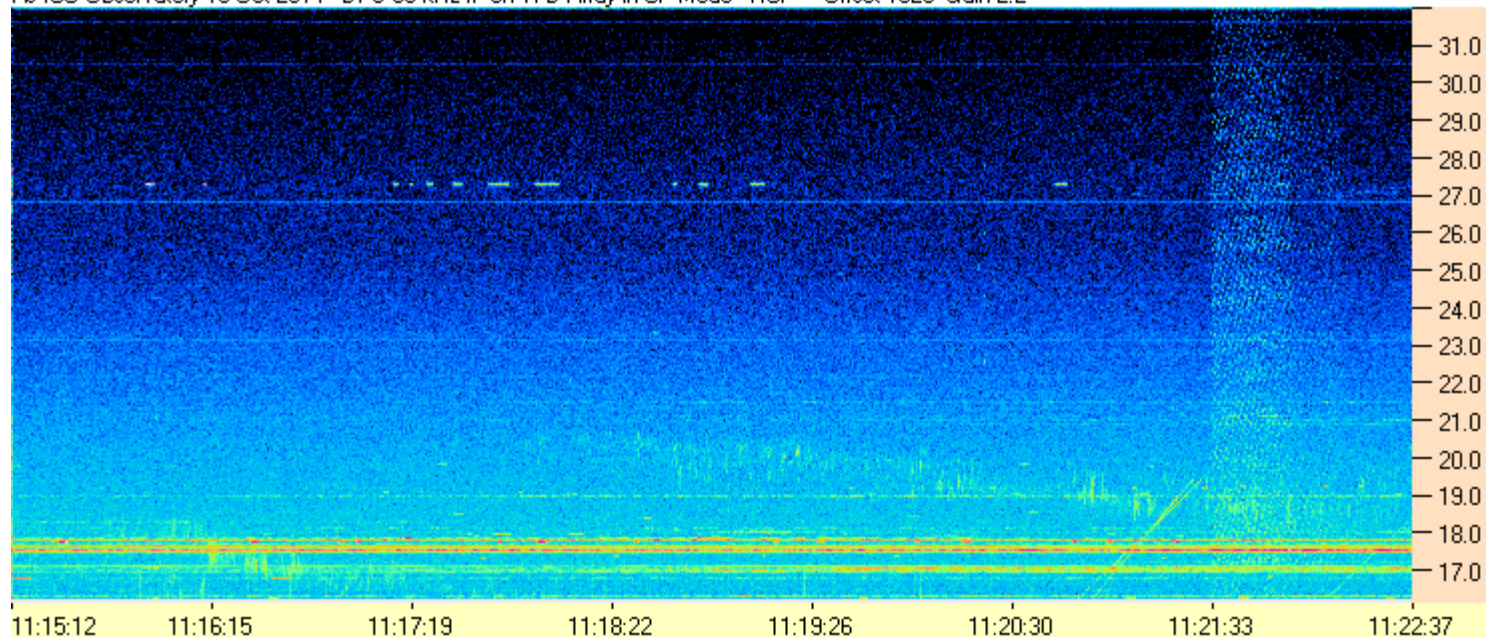
