RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 27 MHz. No visible modulation lanes.

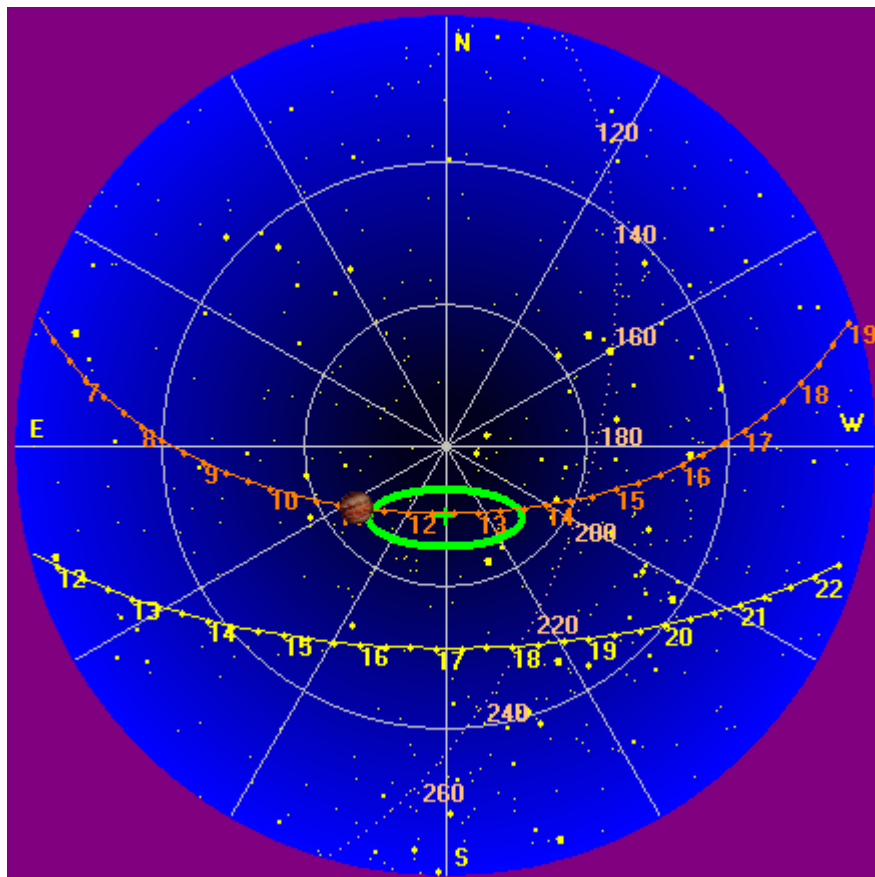
Jupiter was -23° to -14° off axis.

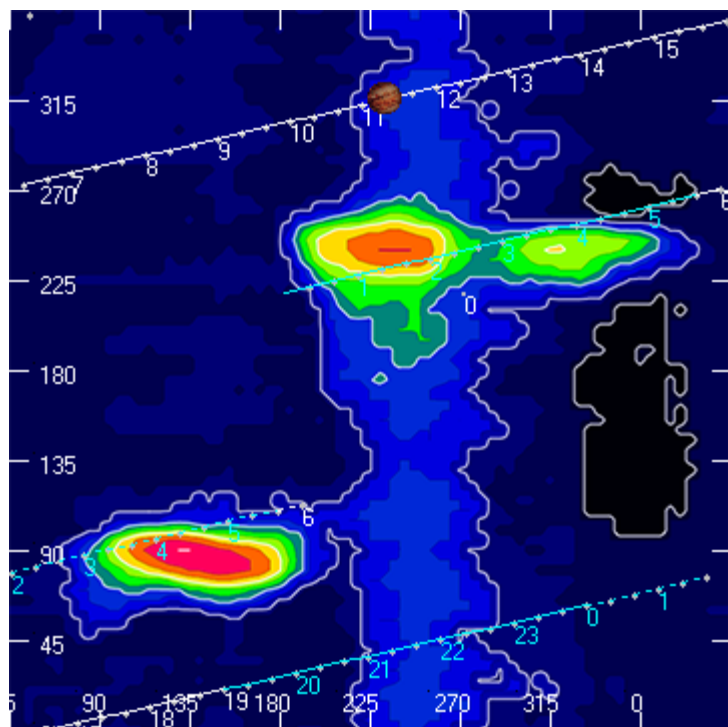
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 75° .

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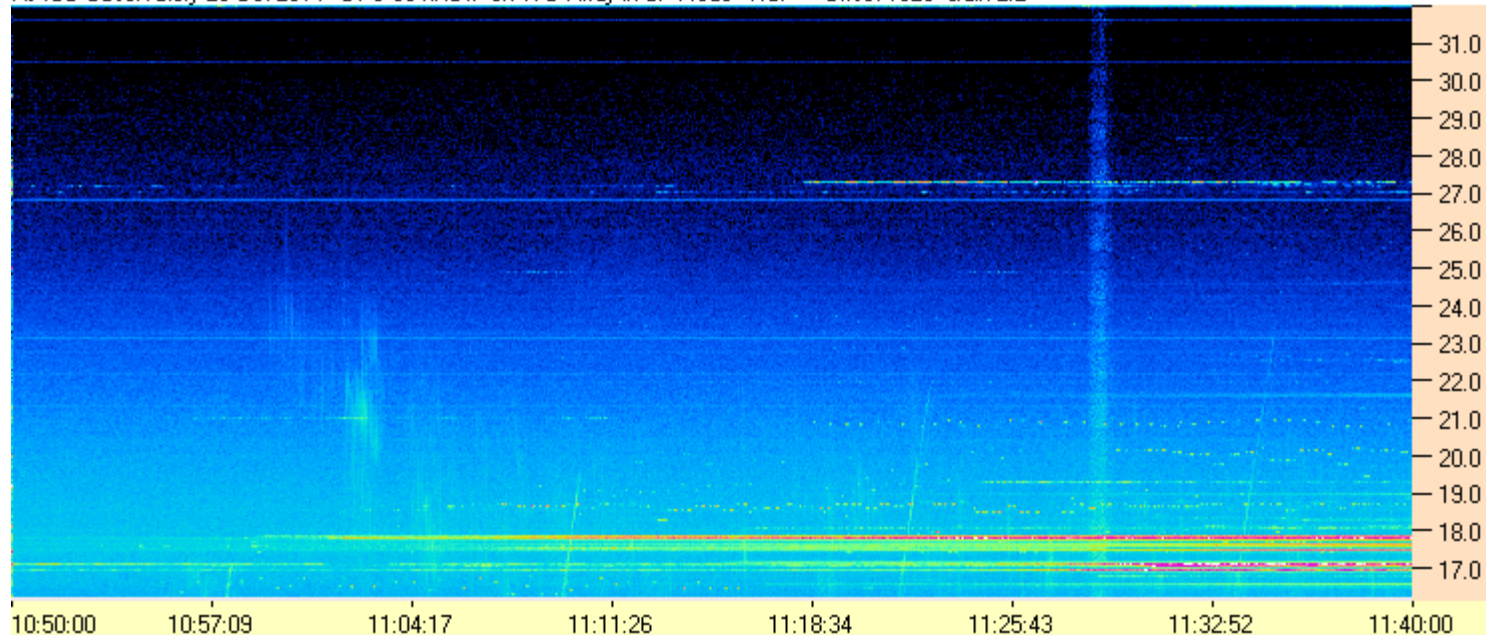

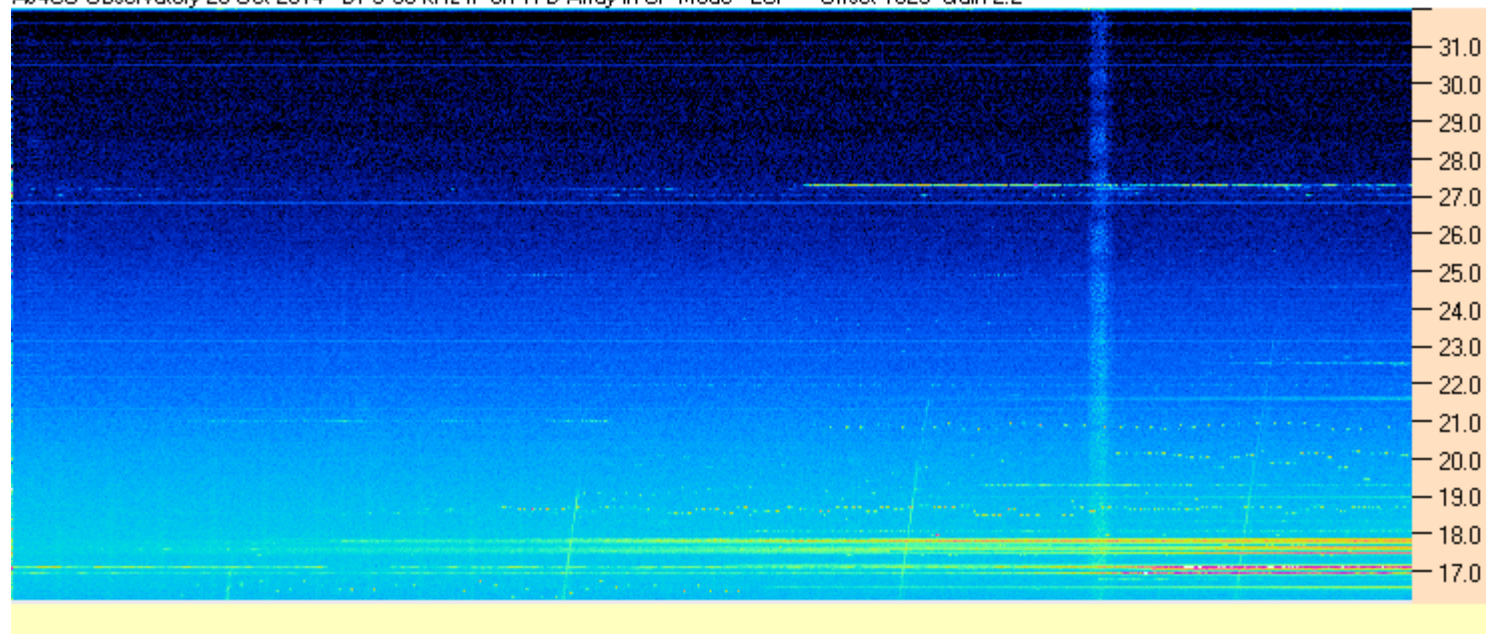




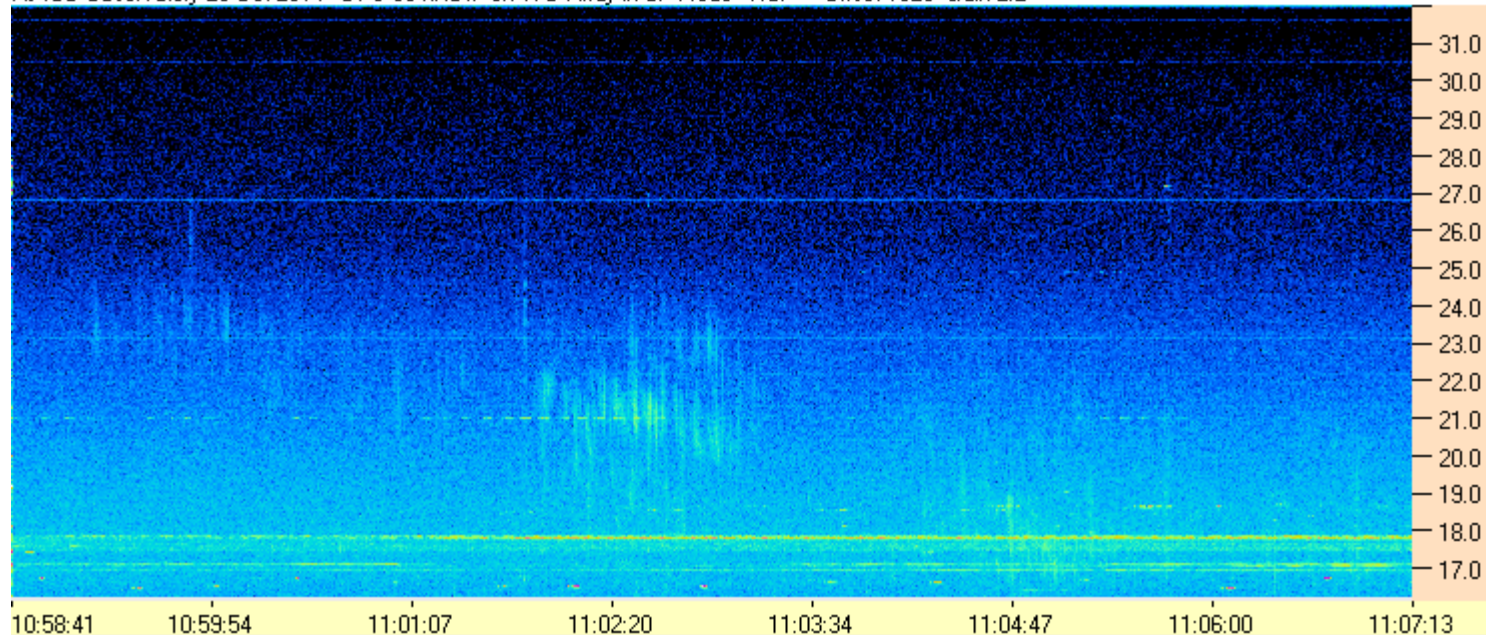

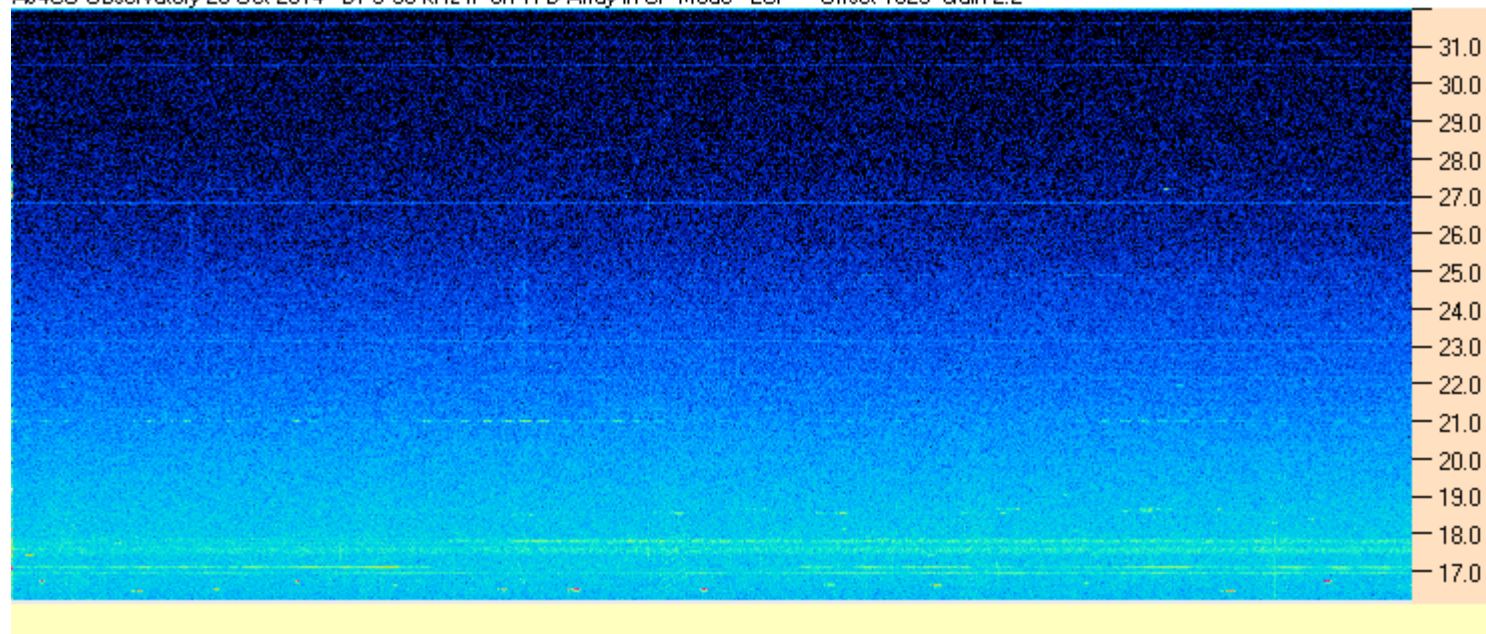
