RCP dominant L bursting observed from 16 to 24 MHz. No modulation lanes visible.

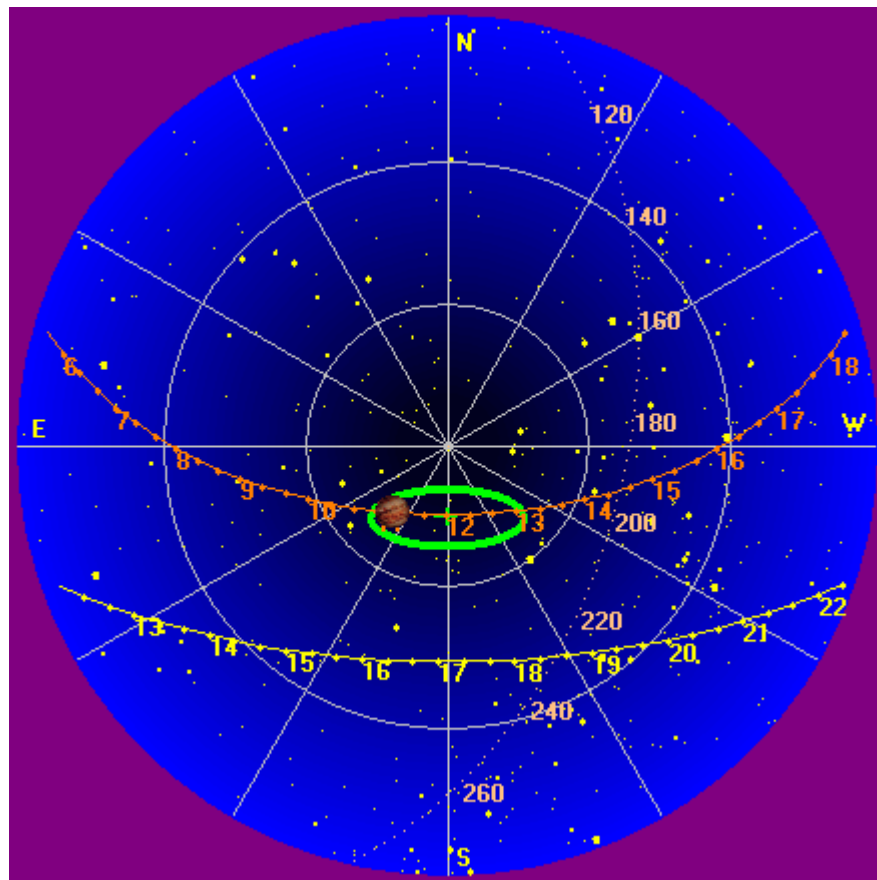
Jupiter was -22° to -1° off axis.

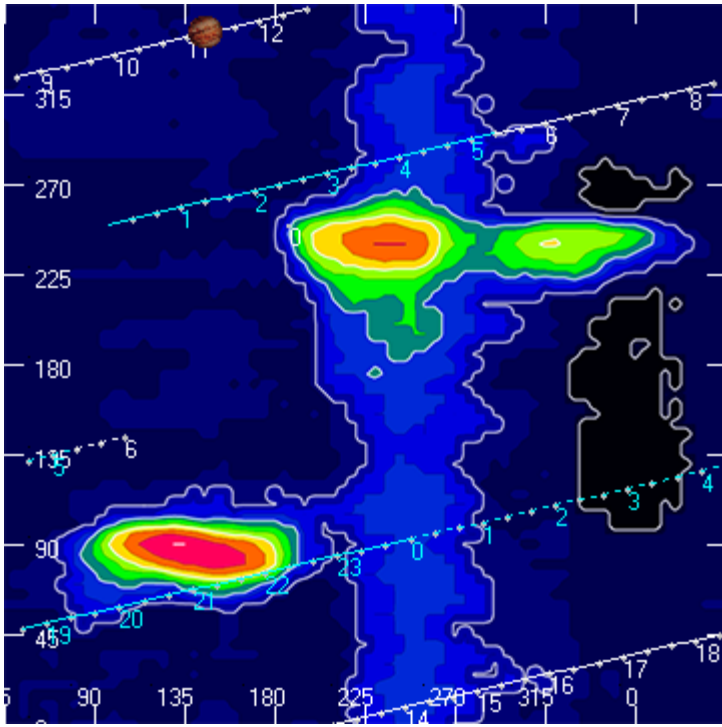
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 83° .

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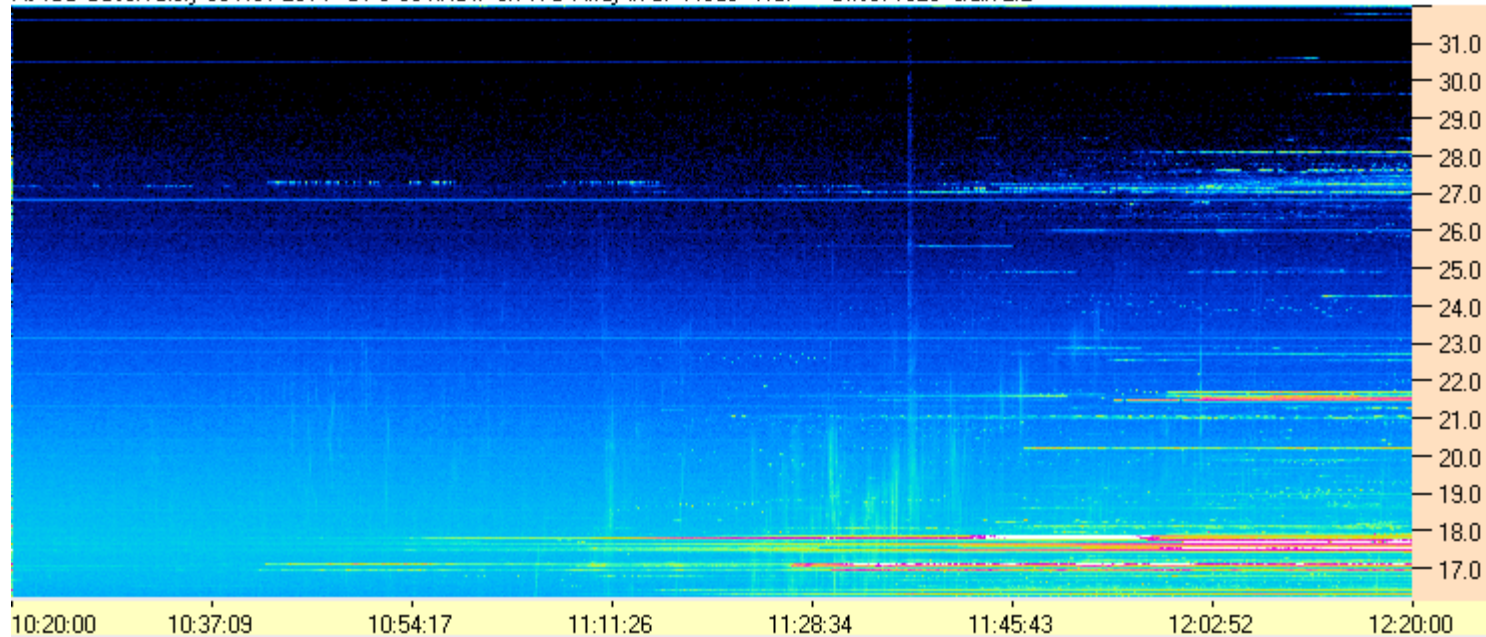

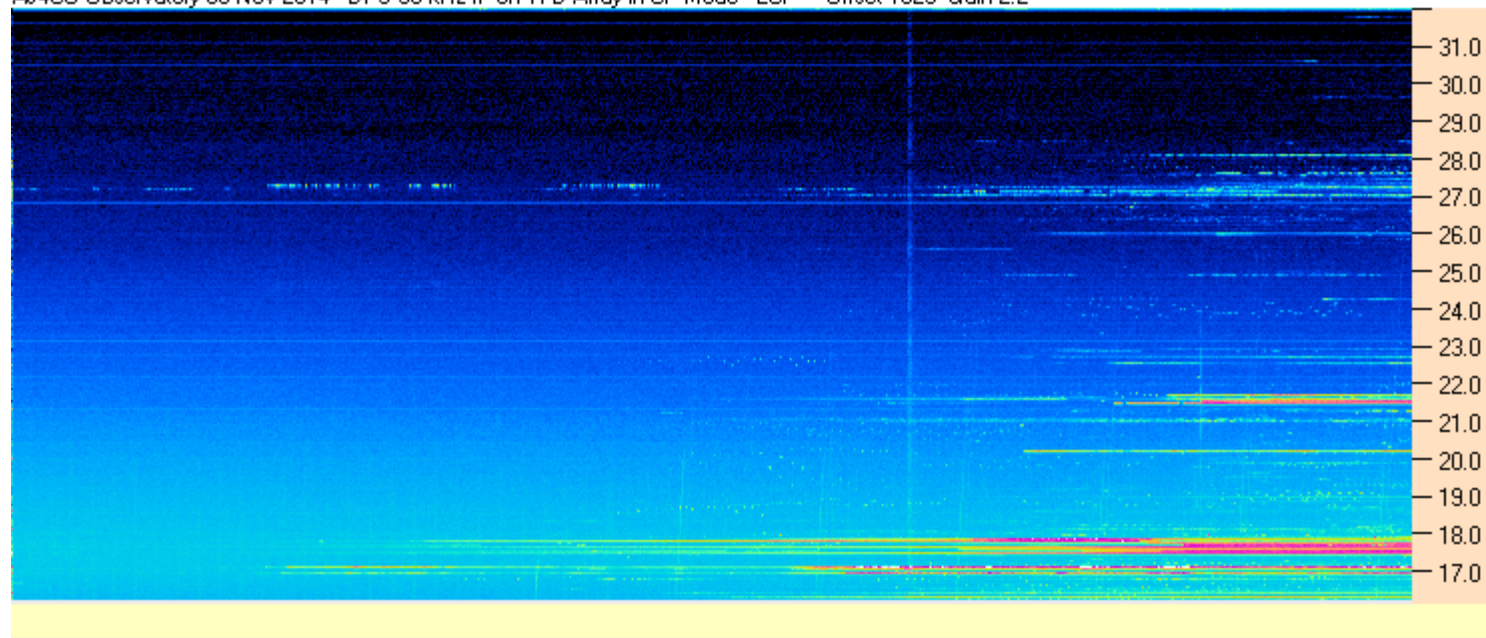
