RCP dominant L bursting observed from 16 to 29 MHz. Widely spaced negative drift modulation lanes visible toward the end of the storm.

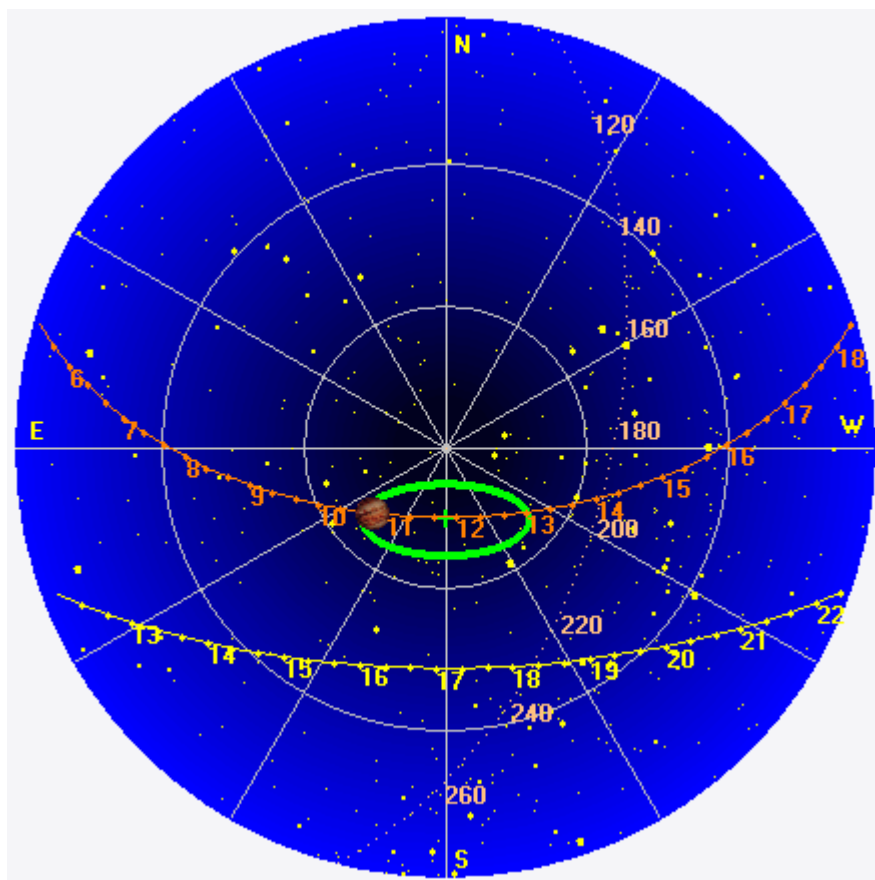
Jupiter was -28° to -2° off axis.

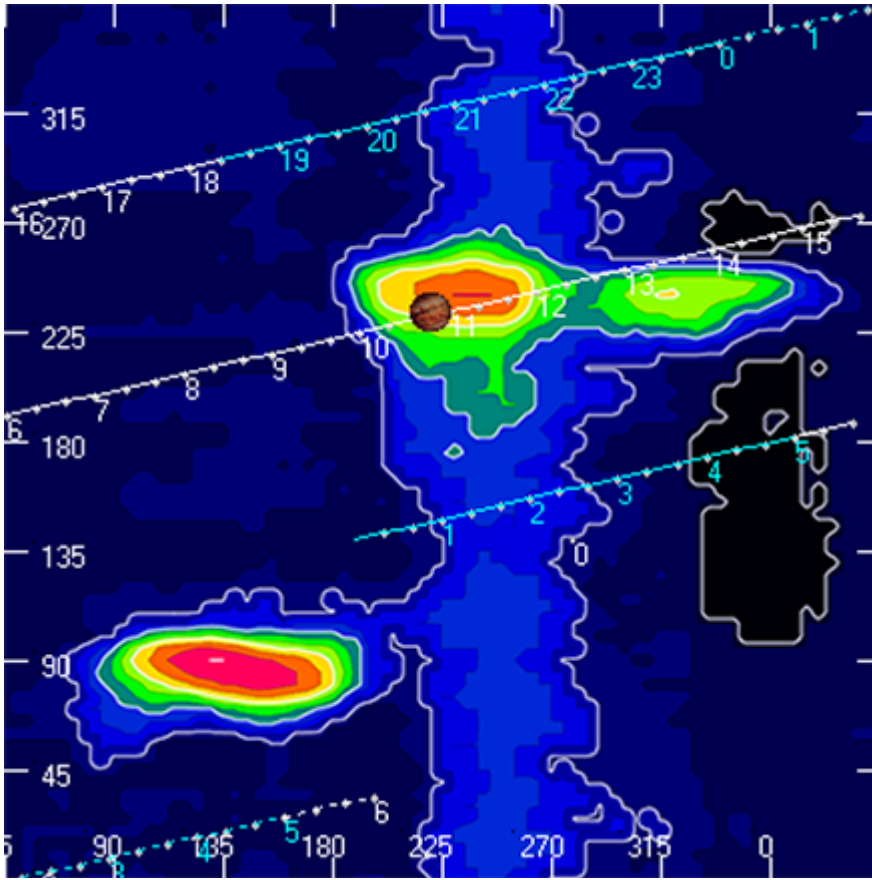
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 86° .

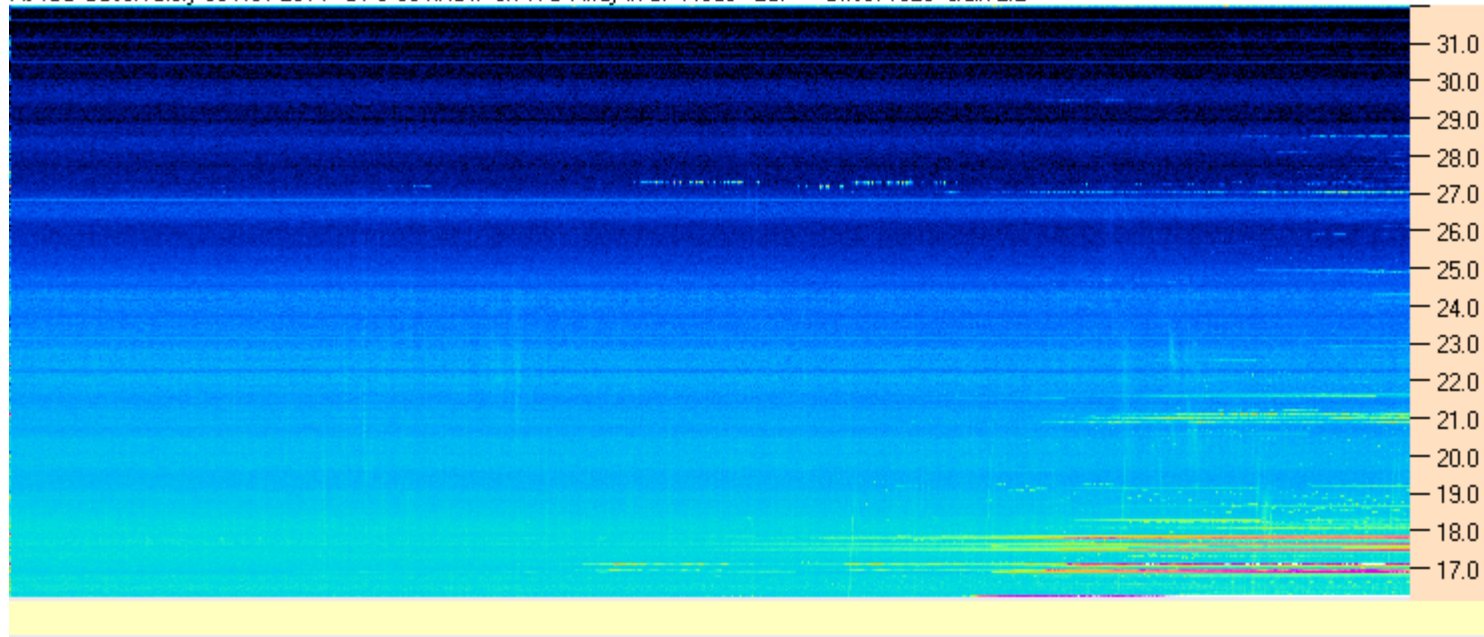




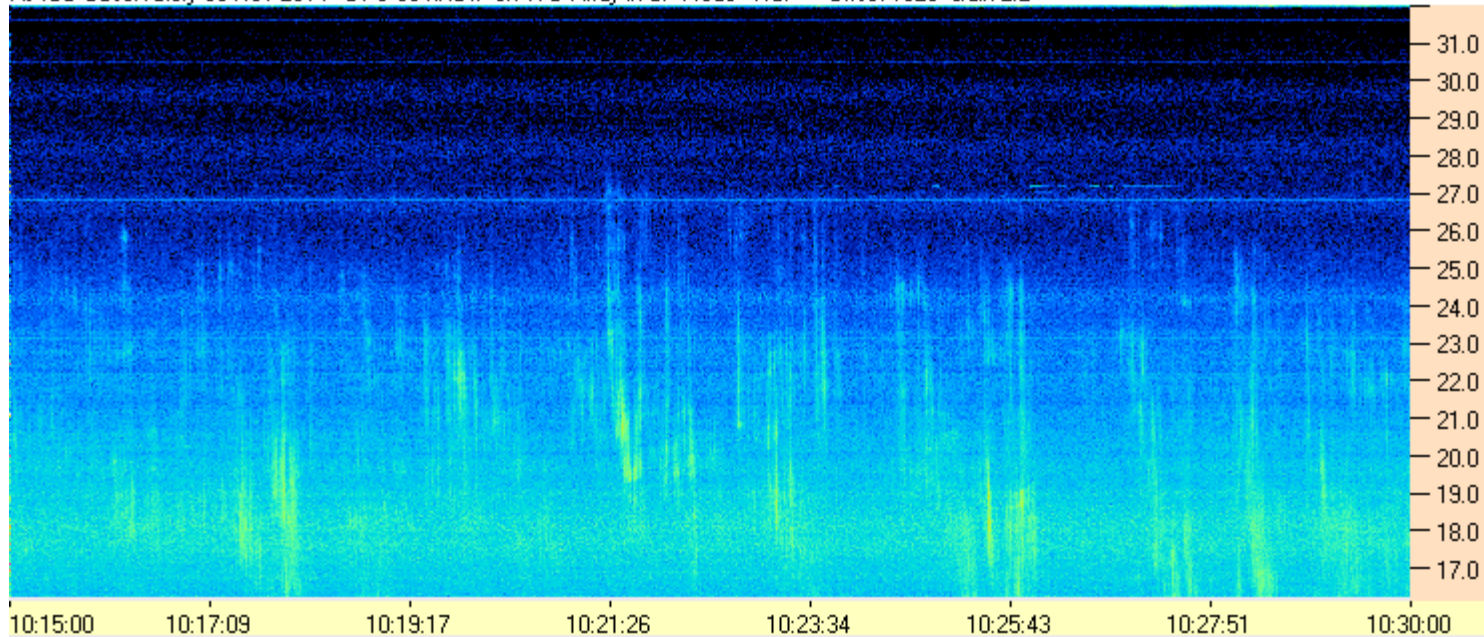

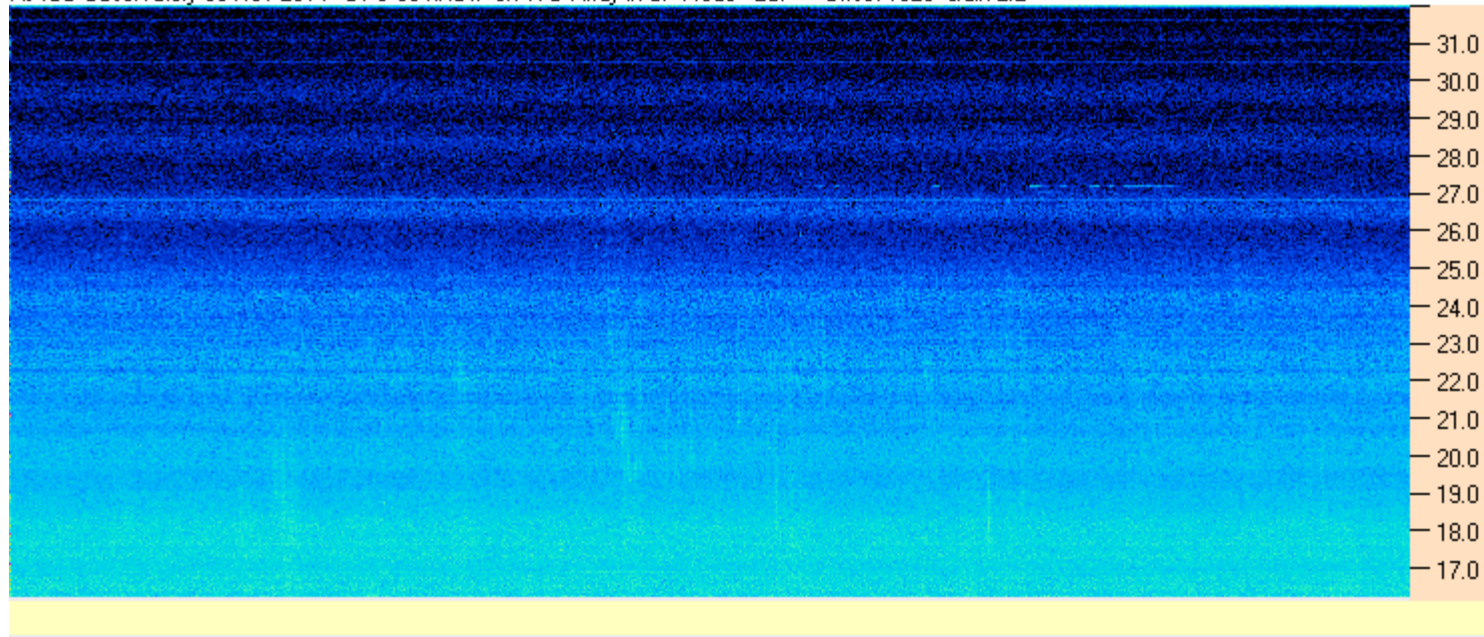

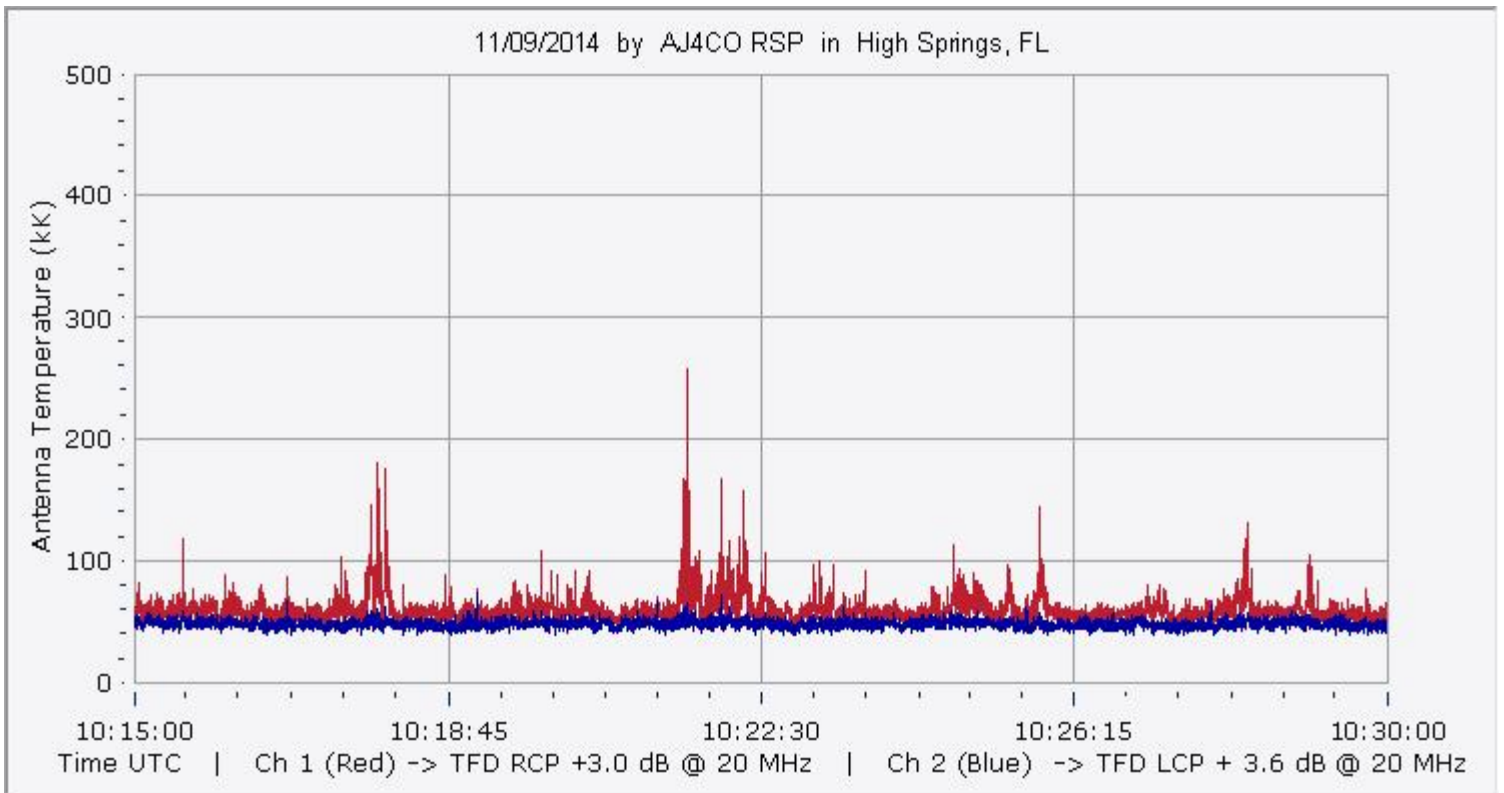

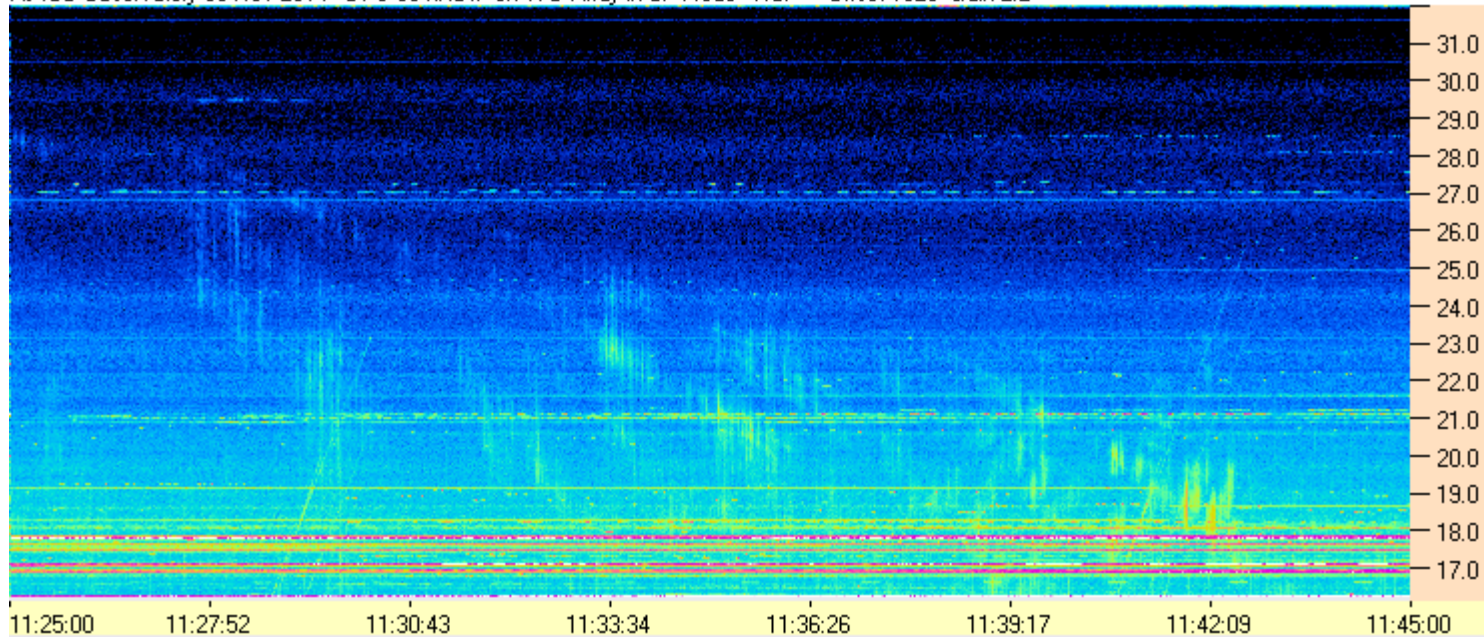
