RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 25 MHz. Positive drift modulation lanes visible, +33 kHz/s.

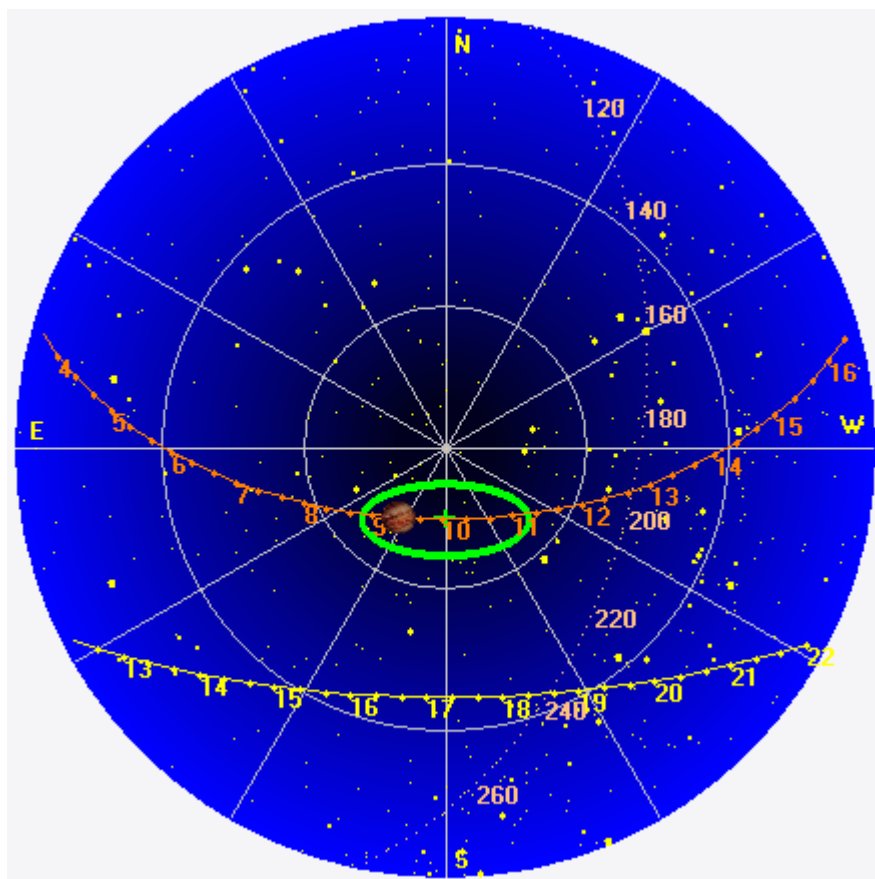
Jupiter was -15° to -4° off axis.

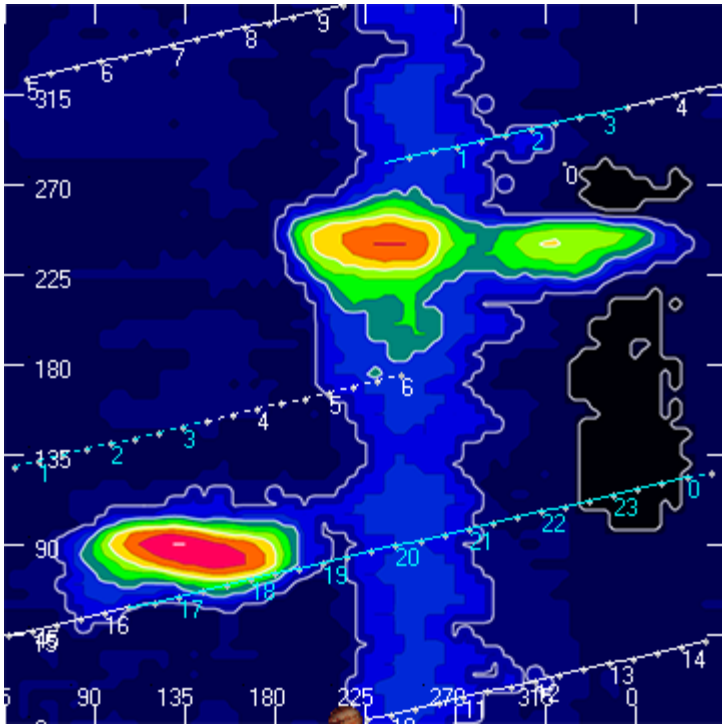
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 114° .

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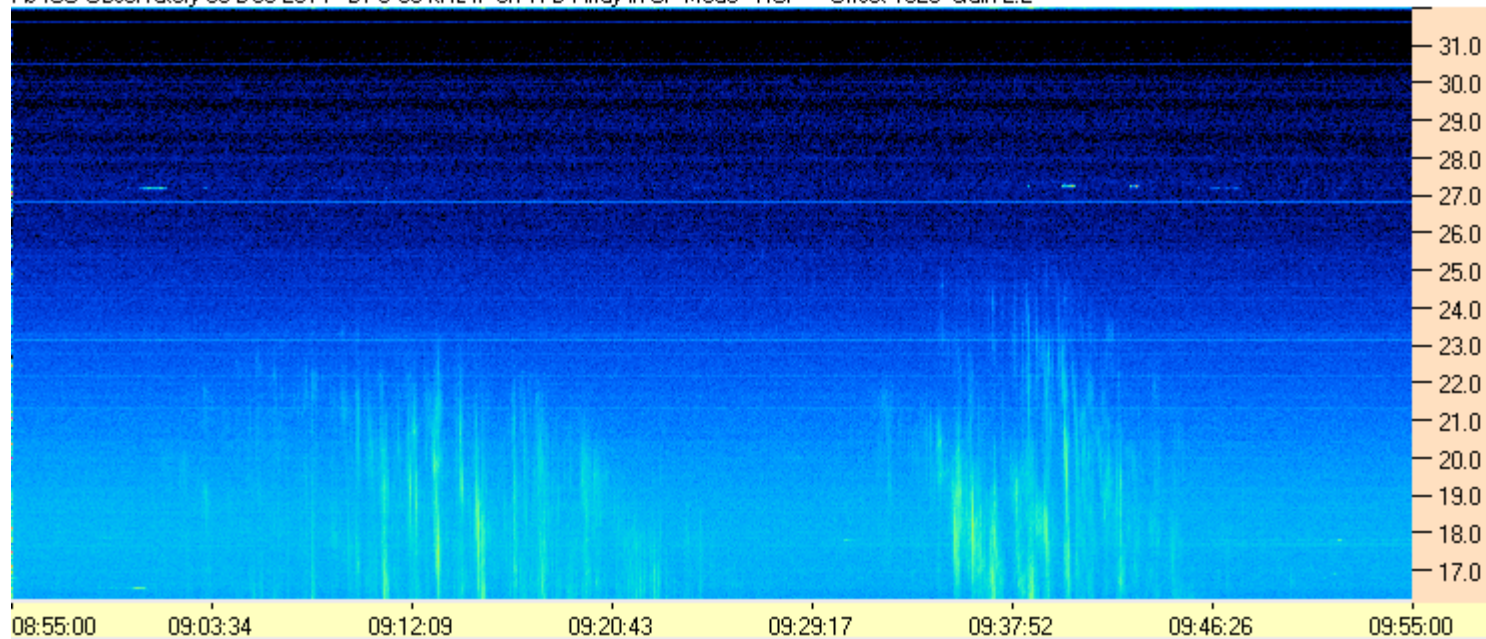

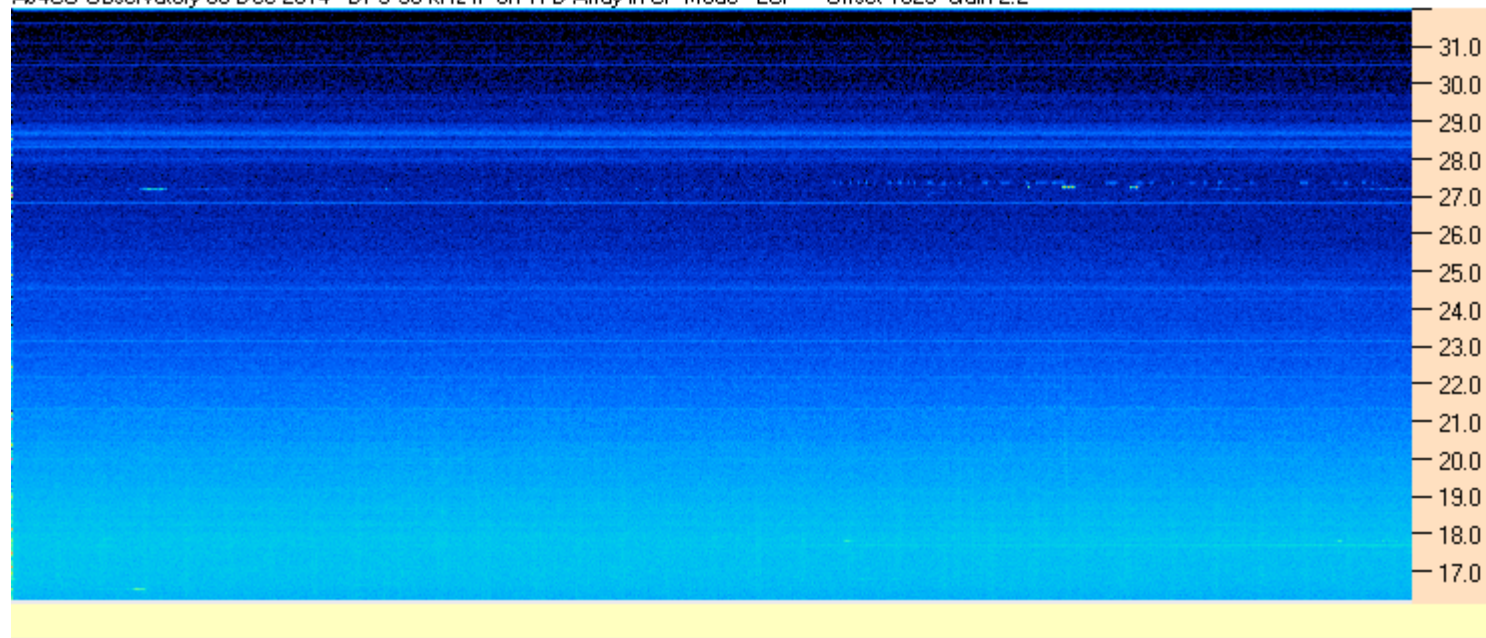


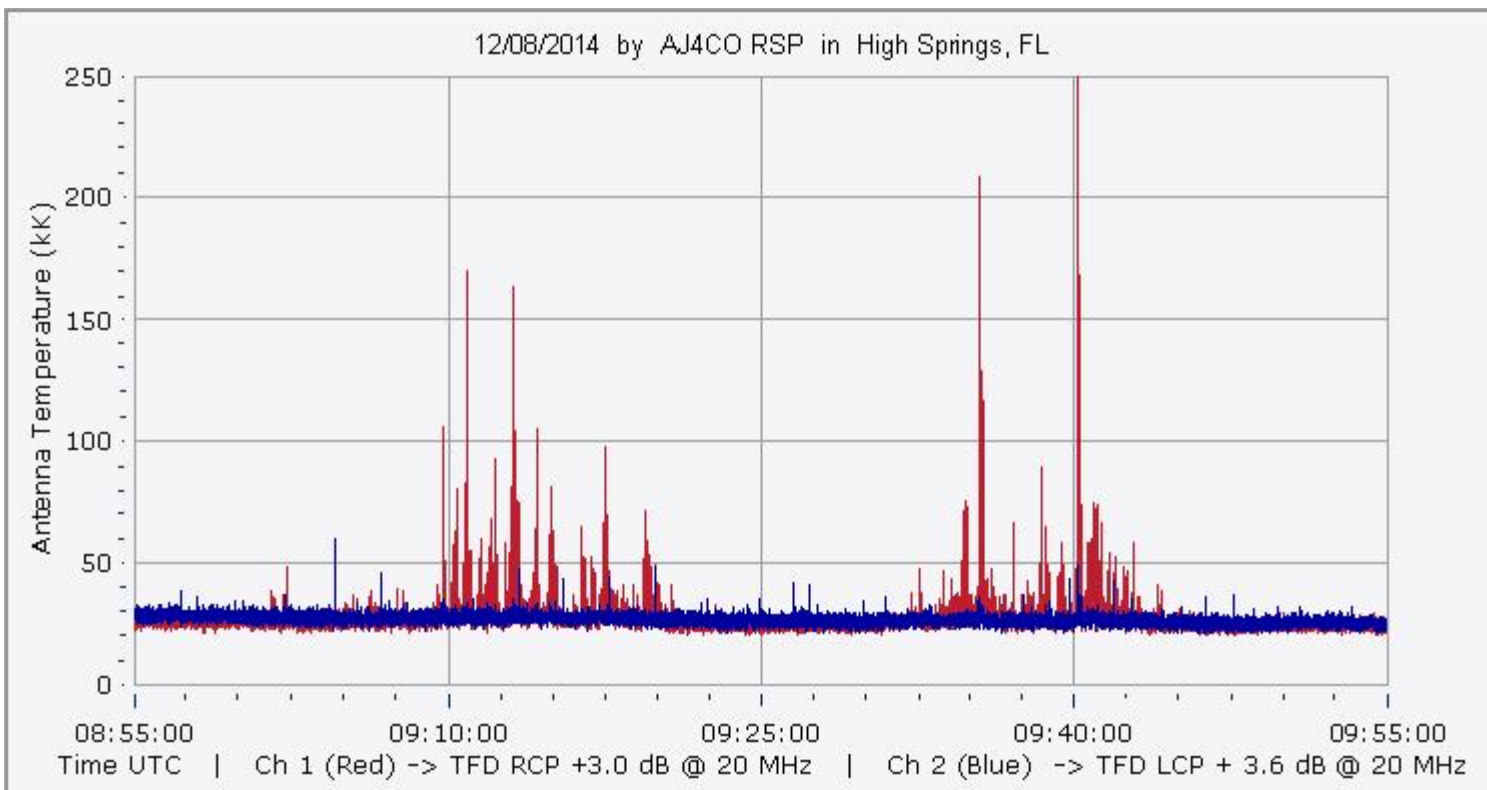

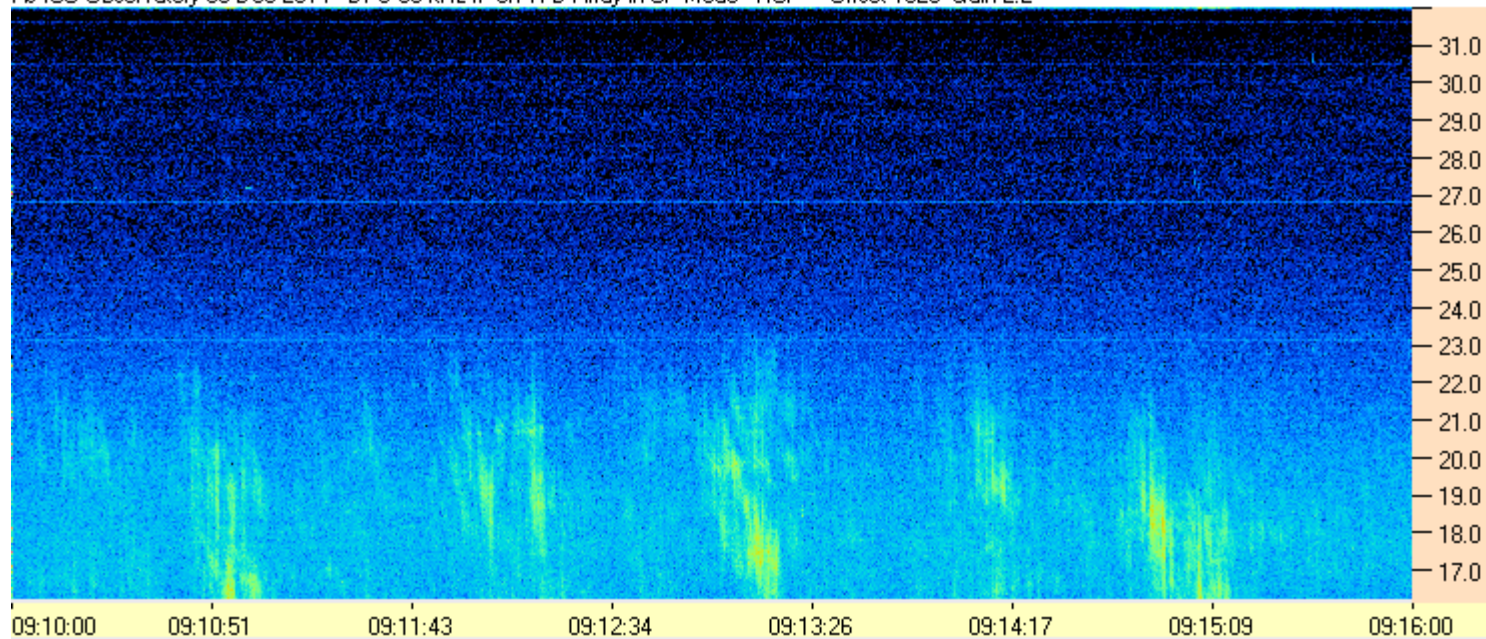
