LCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 20 MHz. No modulation lanes visible. Nothing worth looking at in the 20.1 MHz strip chart.

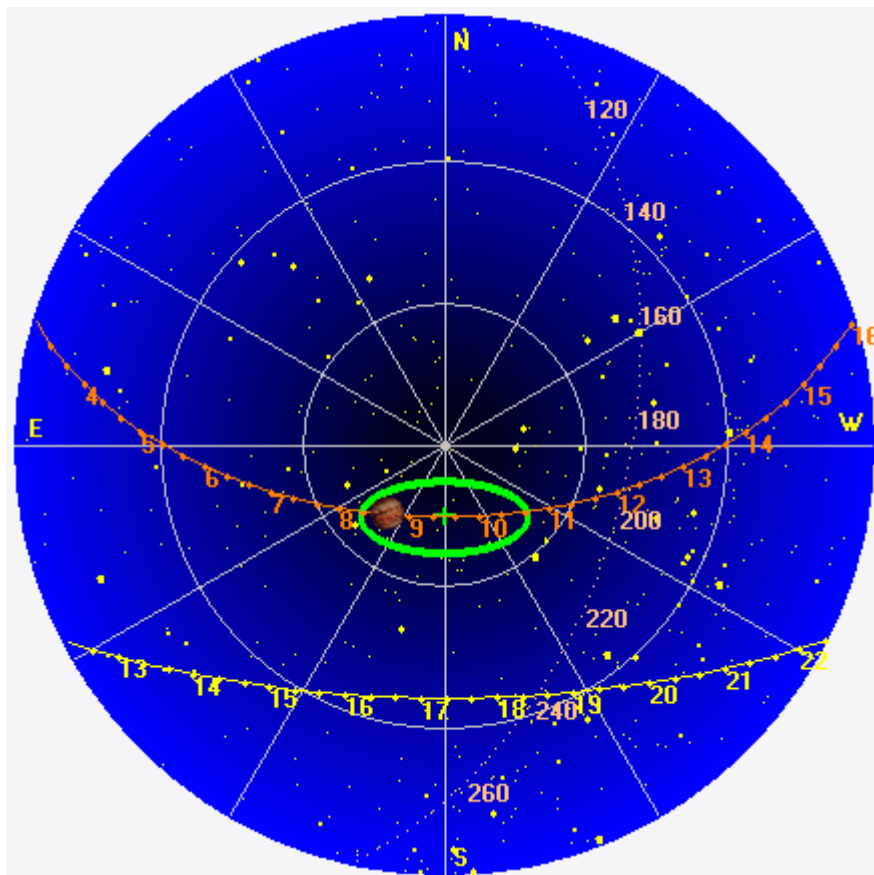
Jupiter was -24° to $+1^\circ$ off axis.

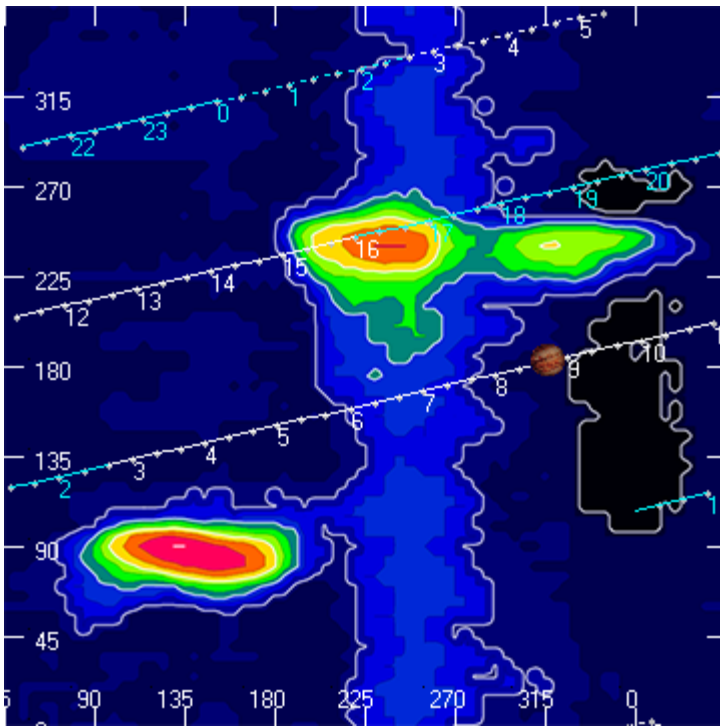
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 122° .

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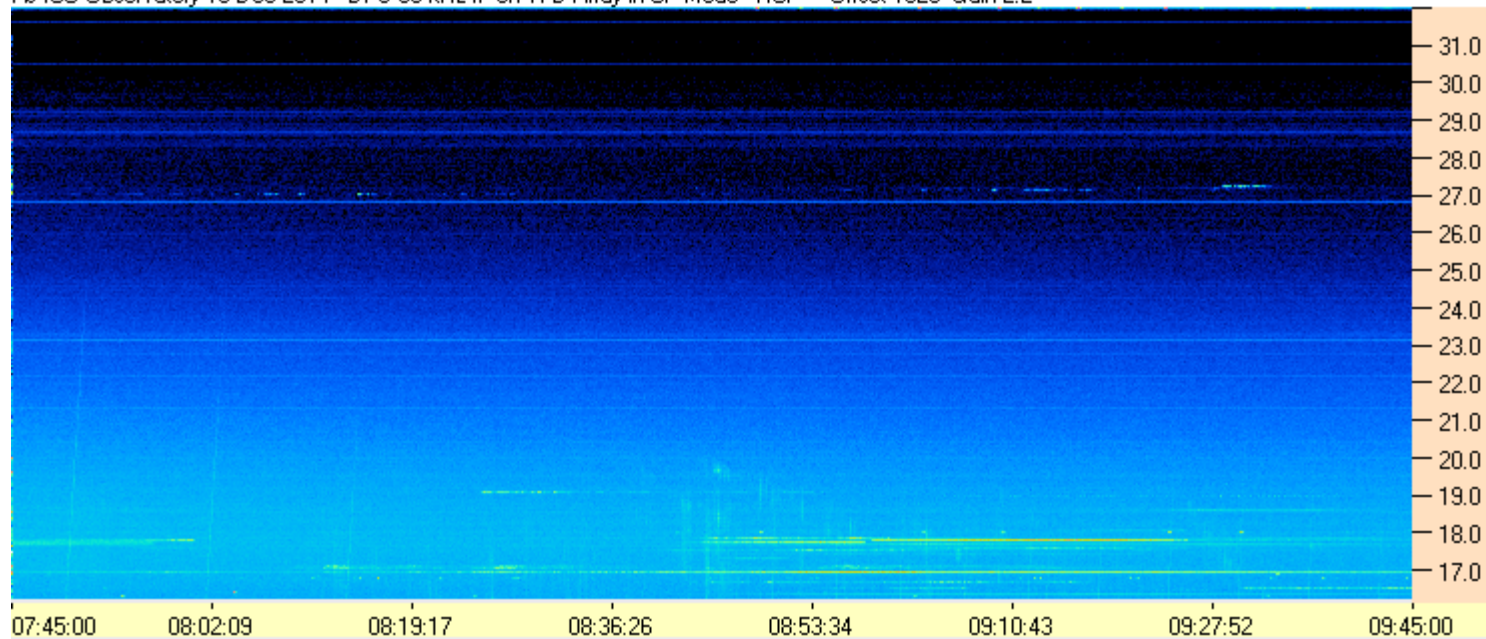

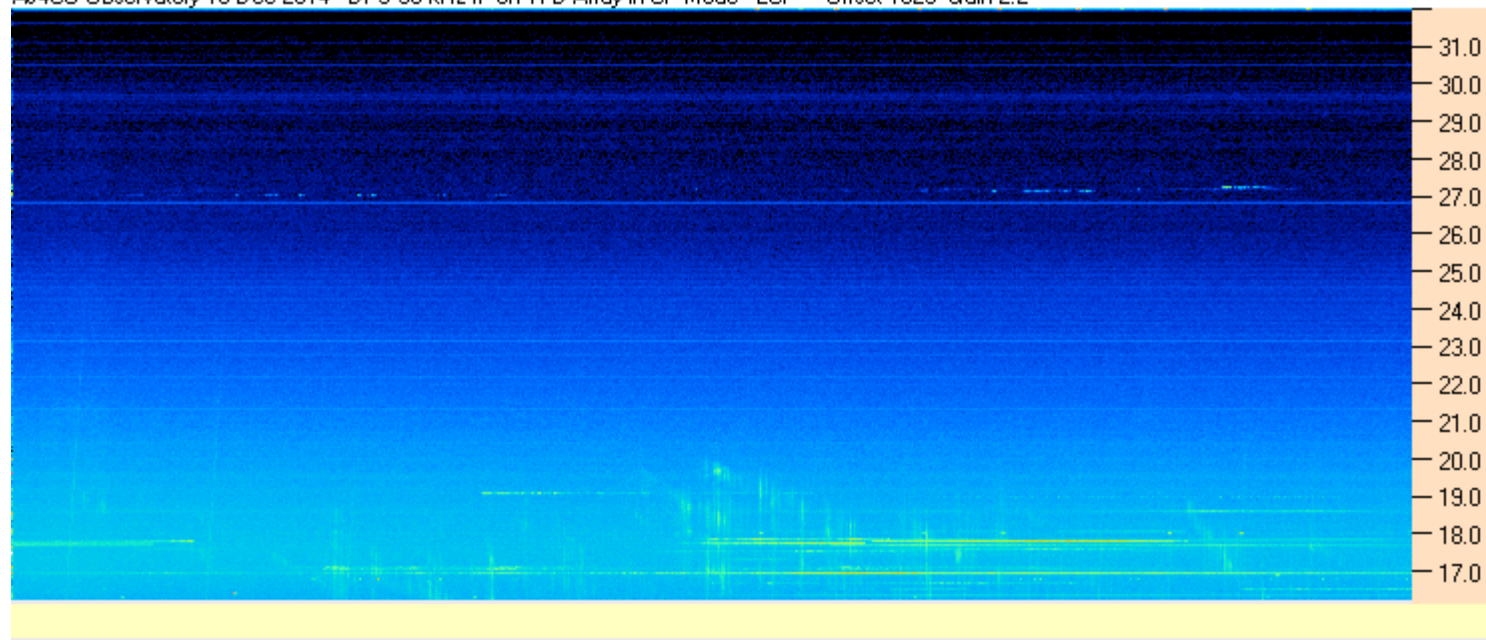




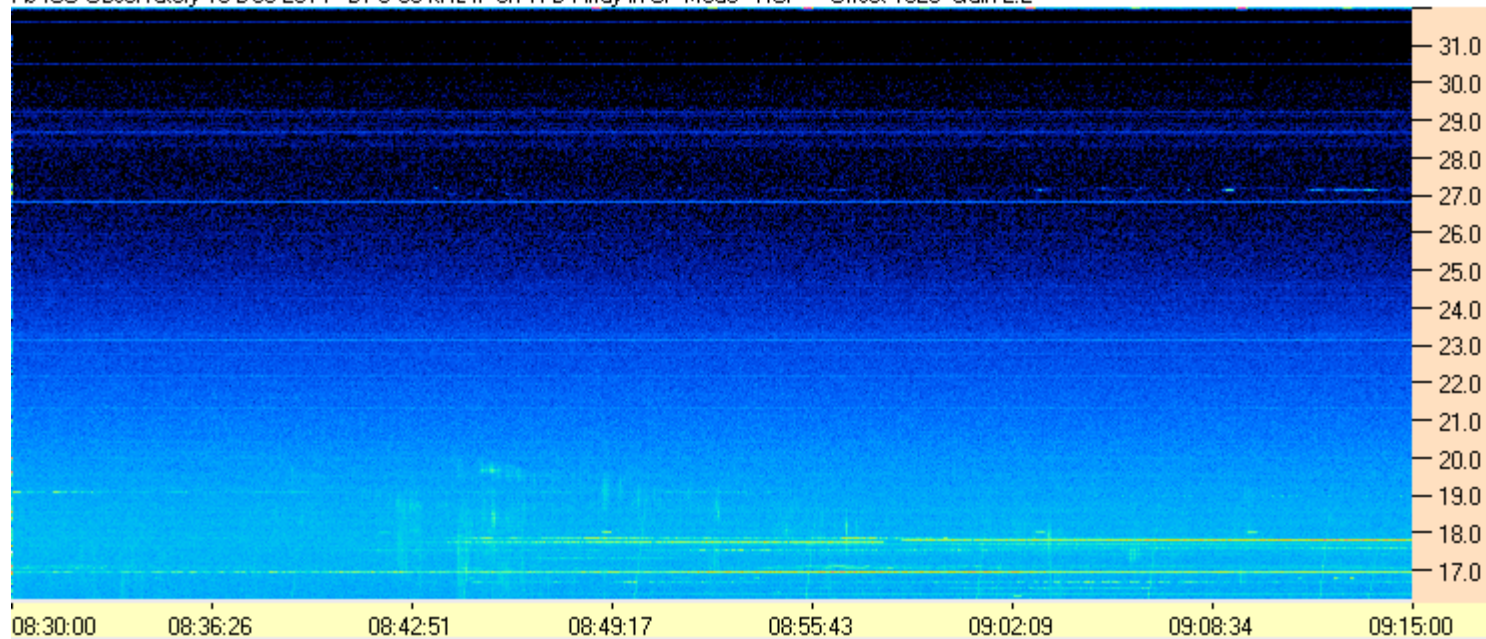
