RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 31 MHz. No modulation lanes visible.

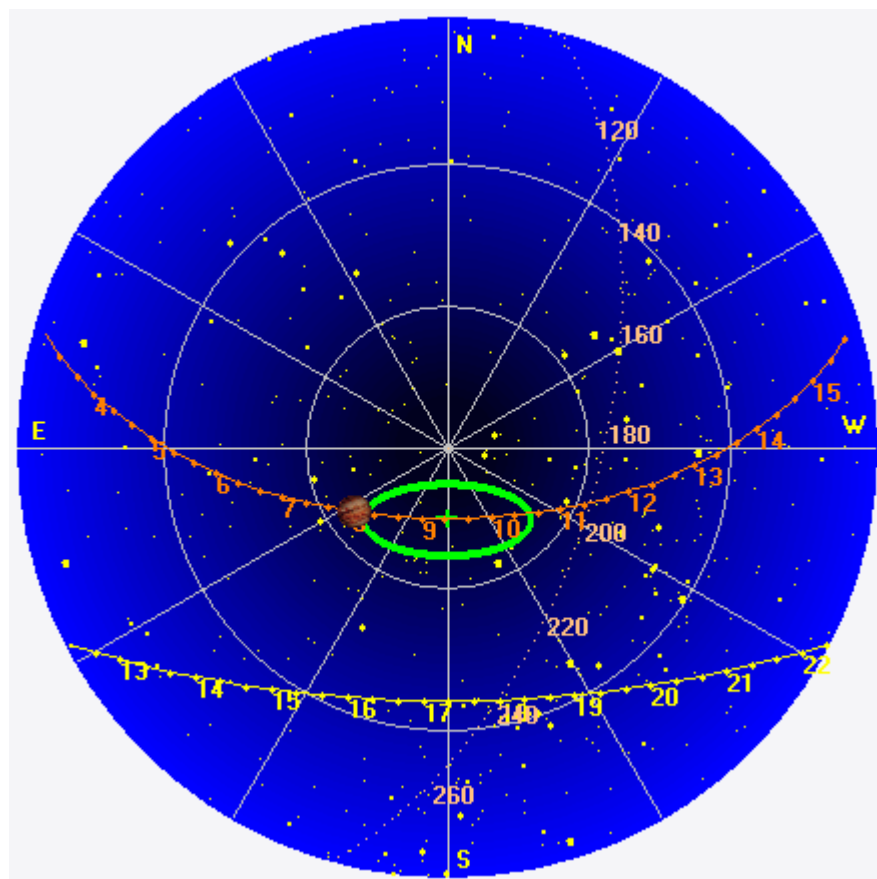
Jupiter was -31° to -7° off axis.

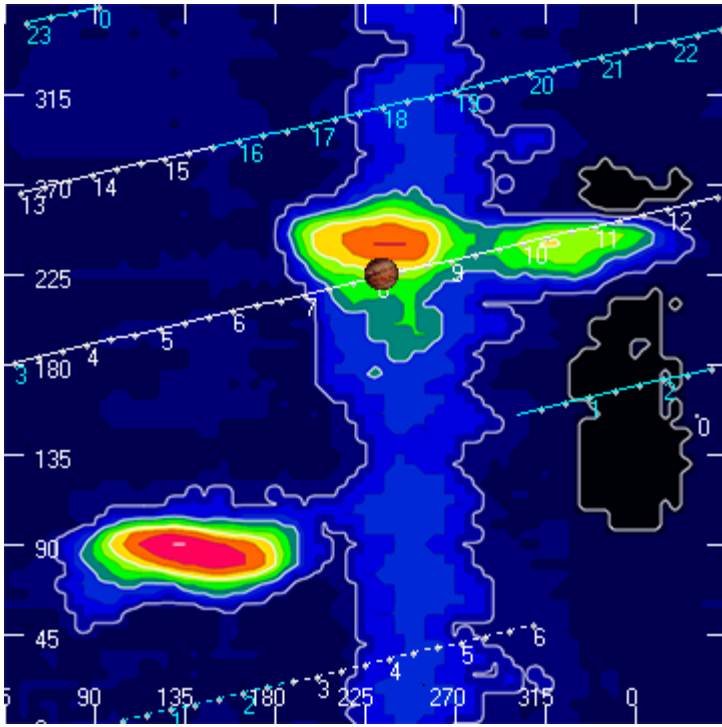
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 124° .

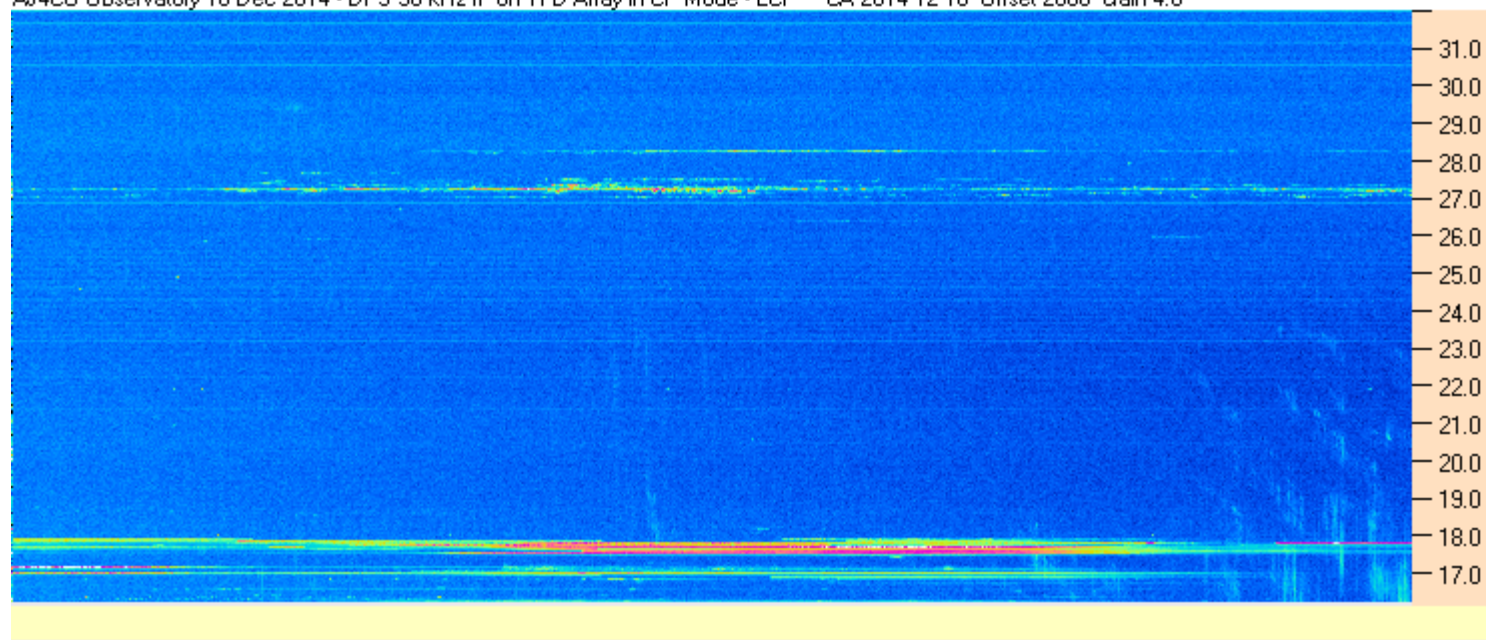


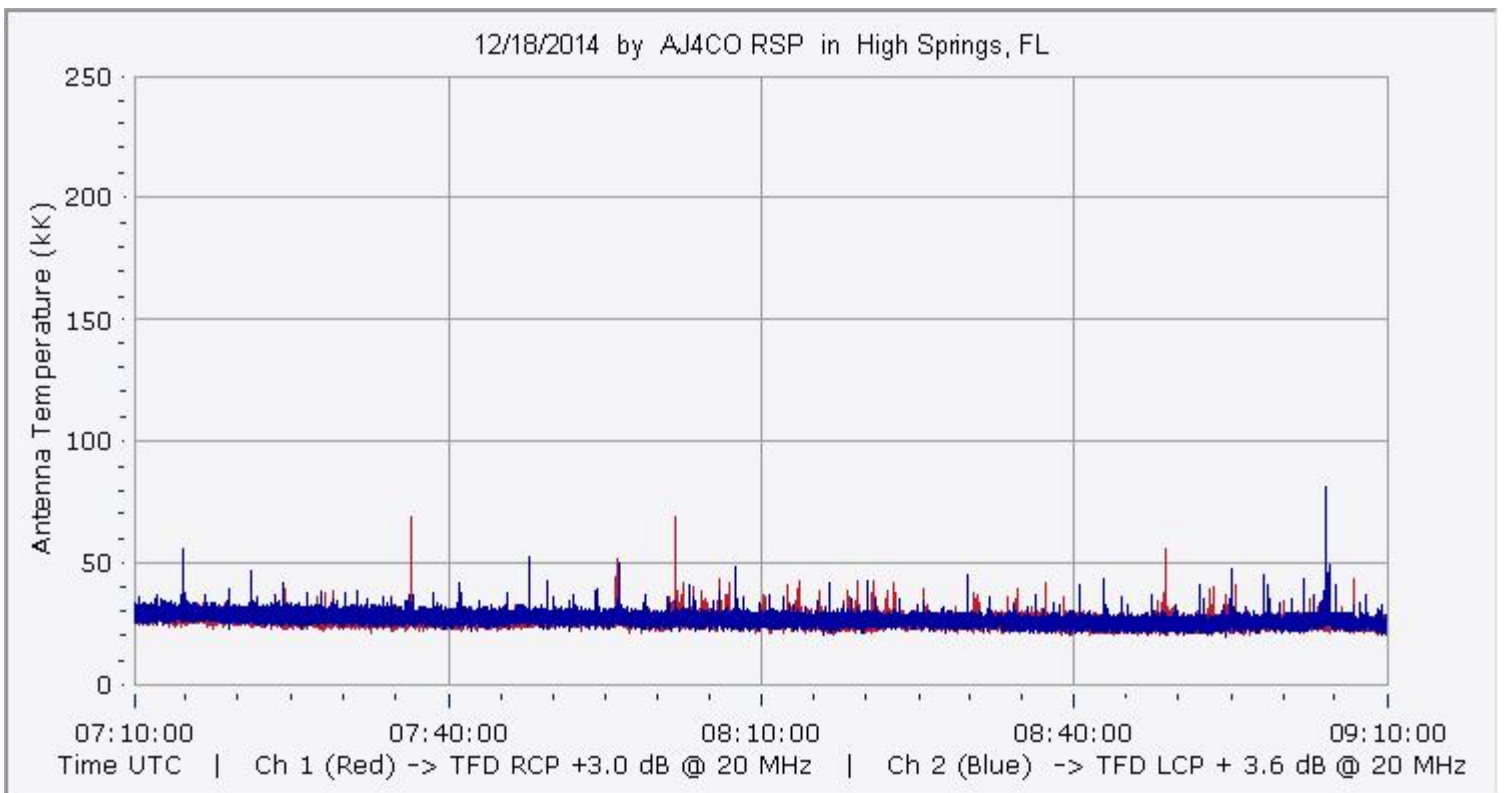

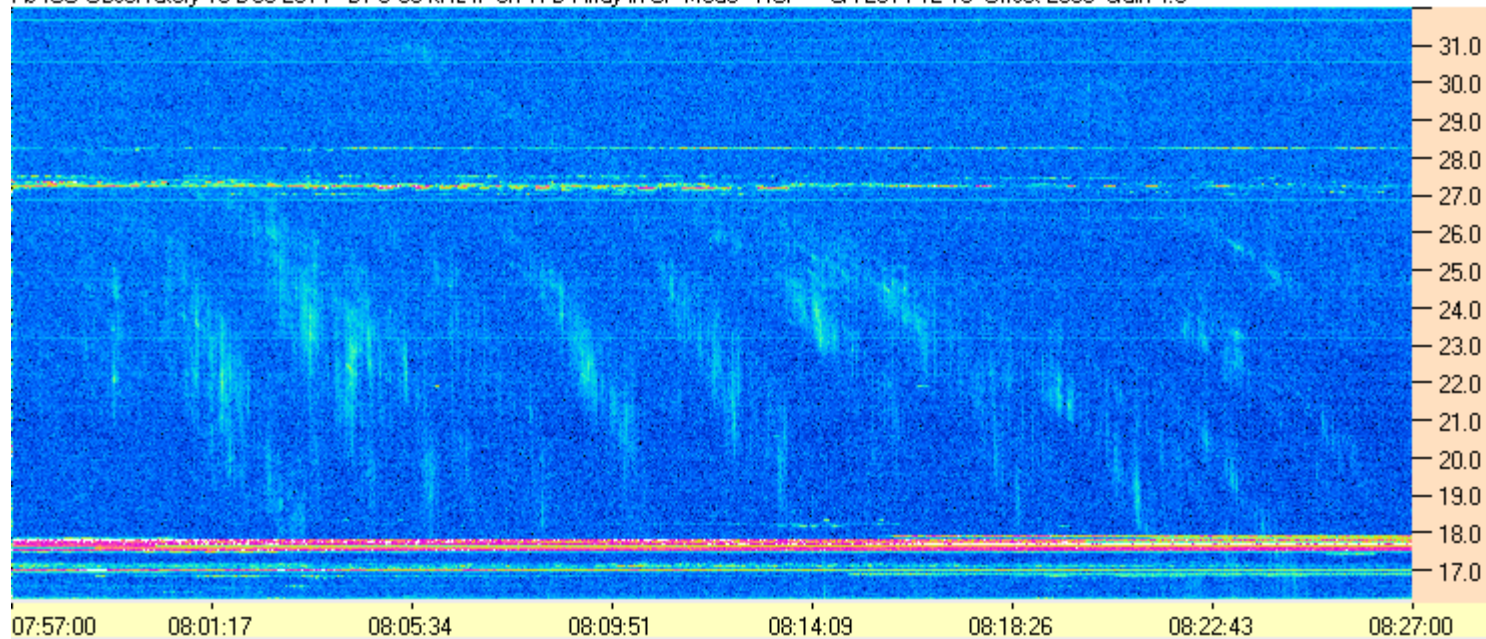
