The first strip chart is useless due to all the RFI. The second doesn't show Jupiter since Jupiter was below 20 MHz at that time.

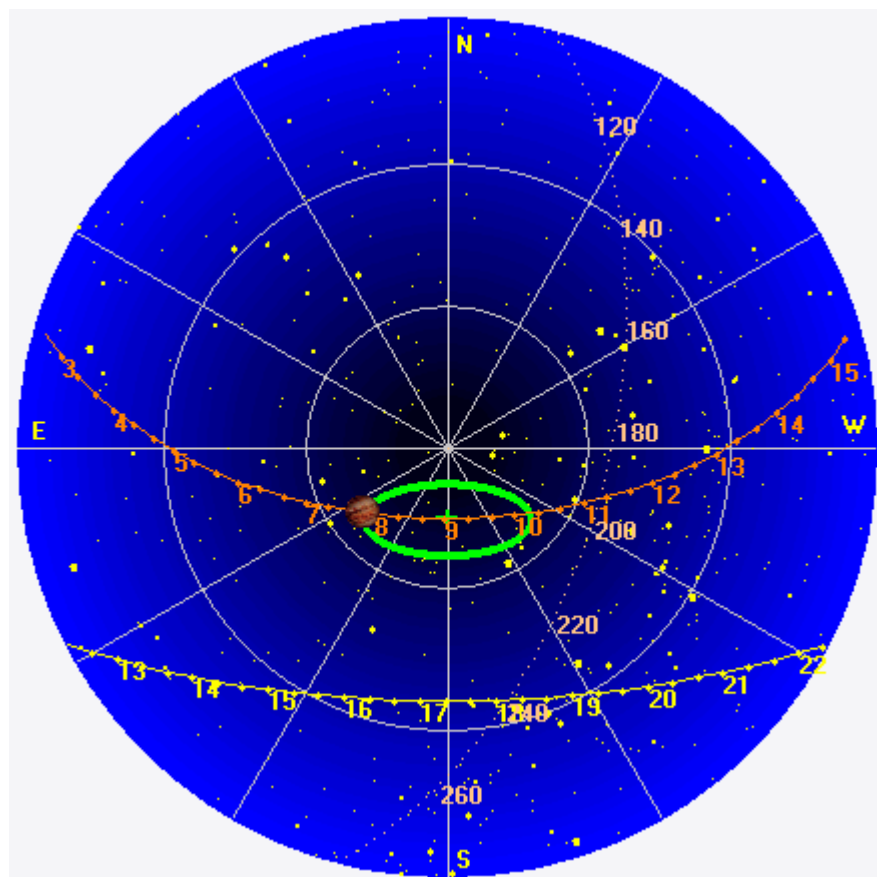
Jupiter was -23° to -11° off axis.

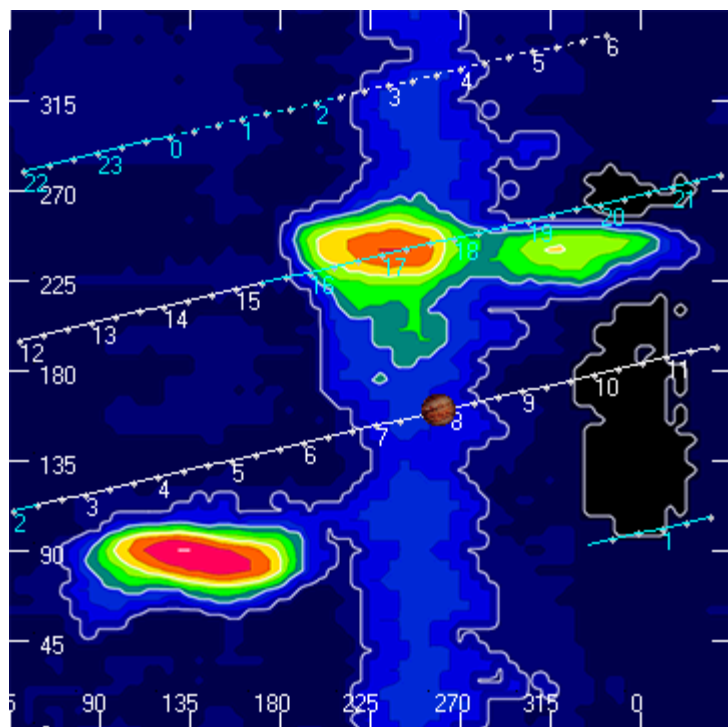
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 129° .

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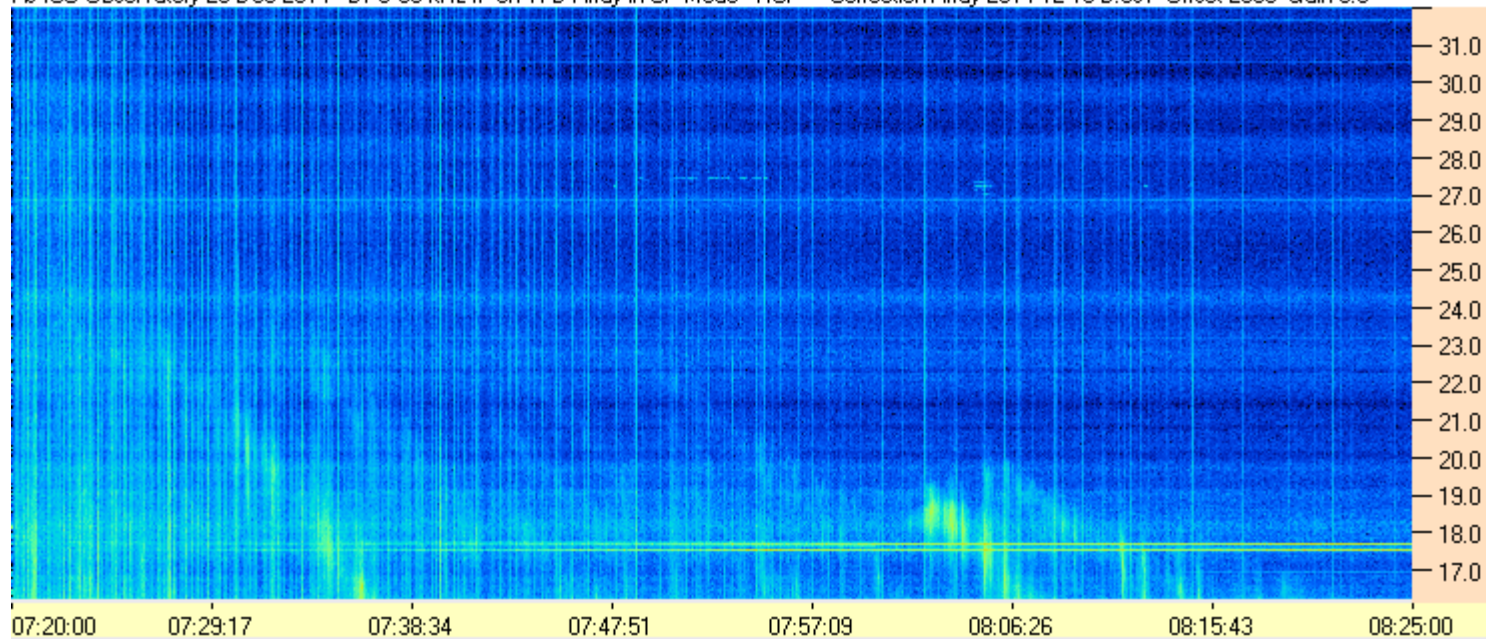

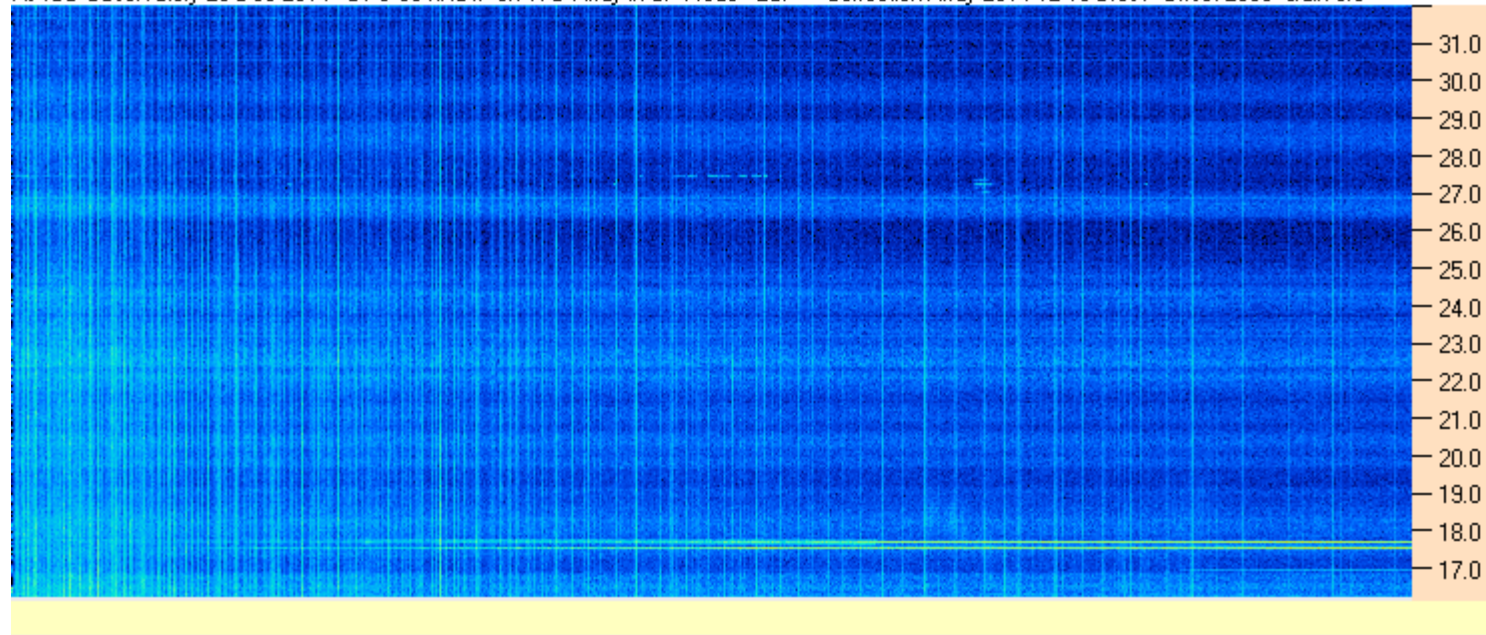


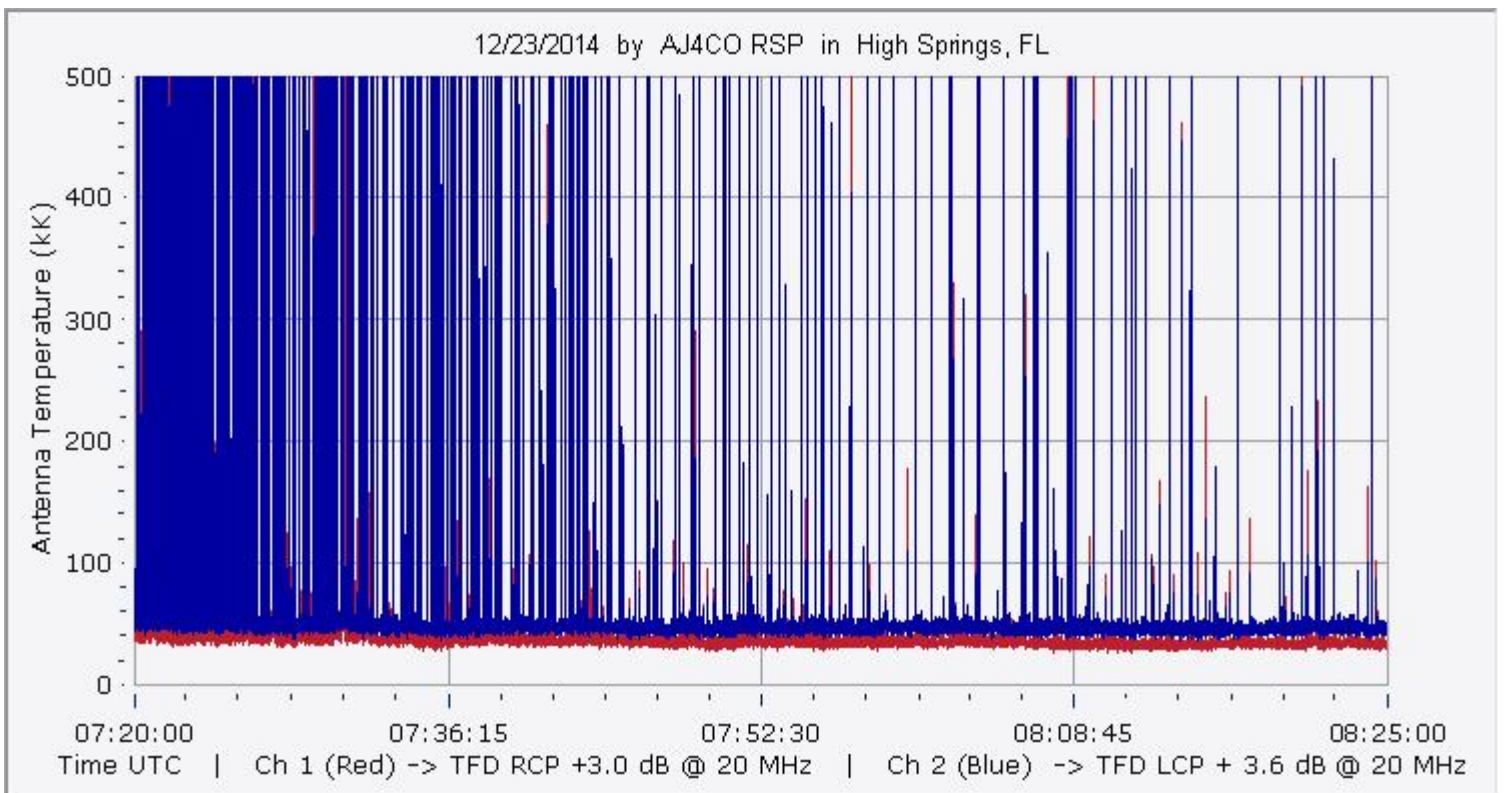

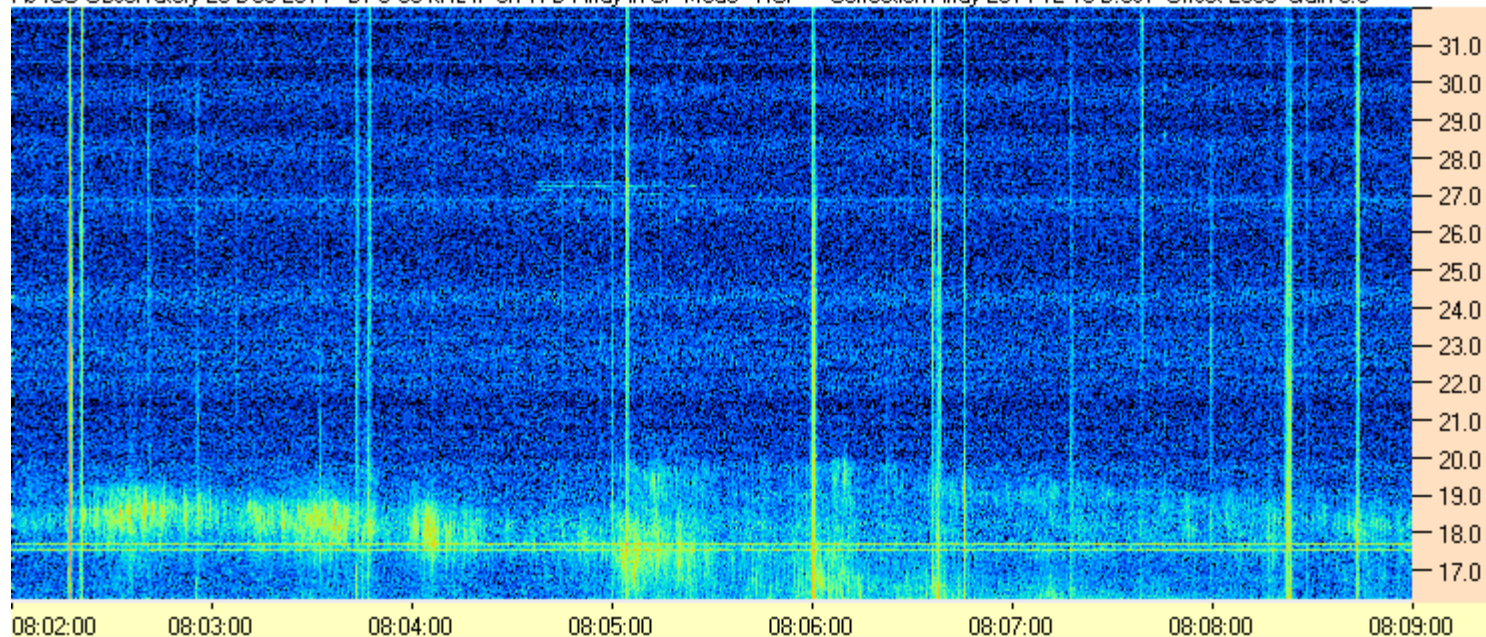
