RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 26 MHz. Brief period of modulation lanes with -xx kHz/sec drift rate.

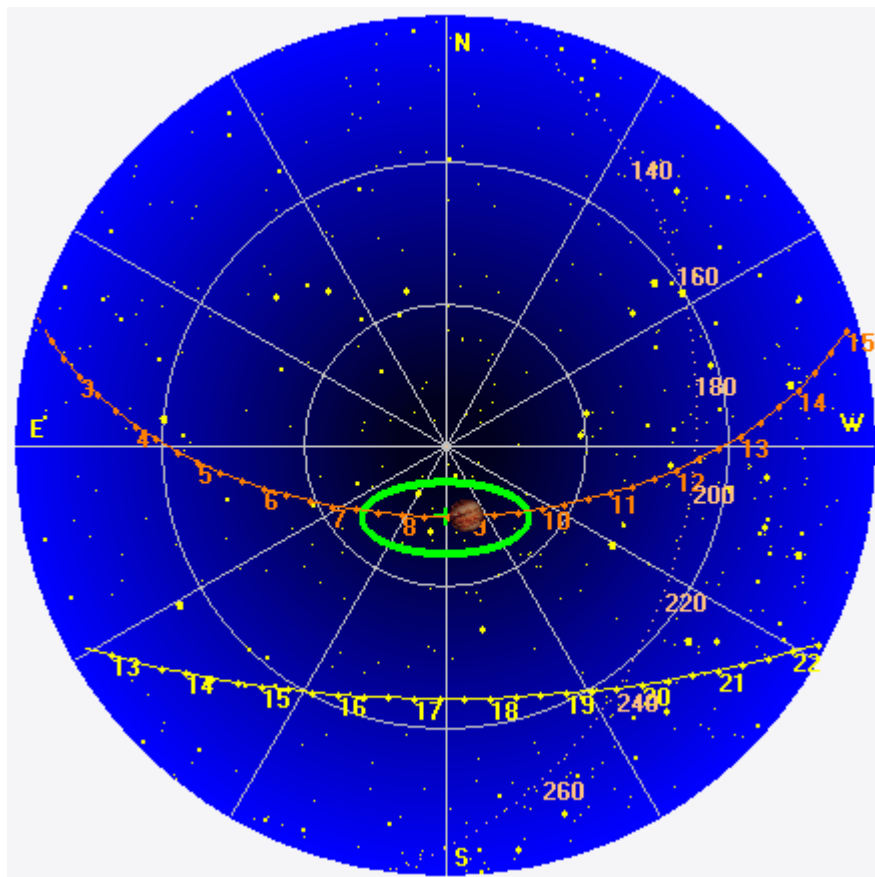
Jupiter was -3° to +12° off axis.

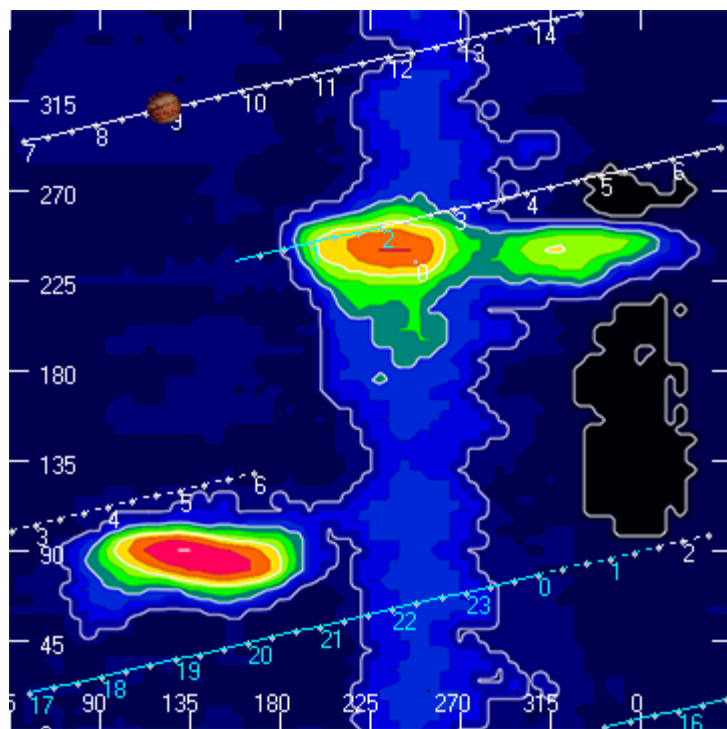
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 136°.

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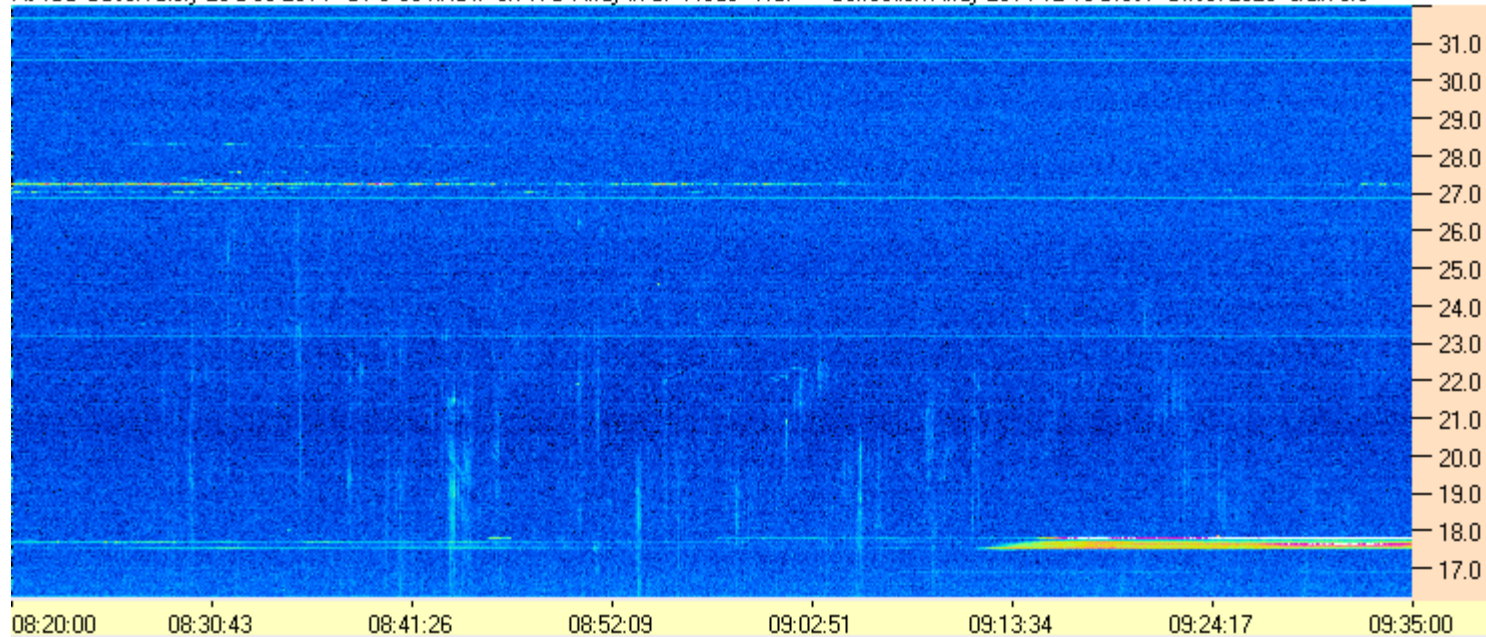

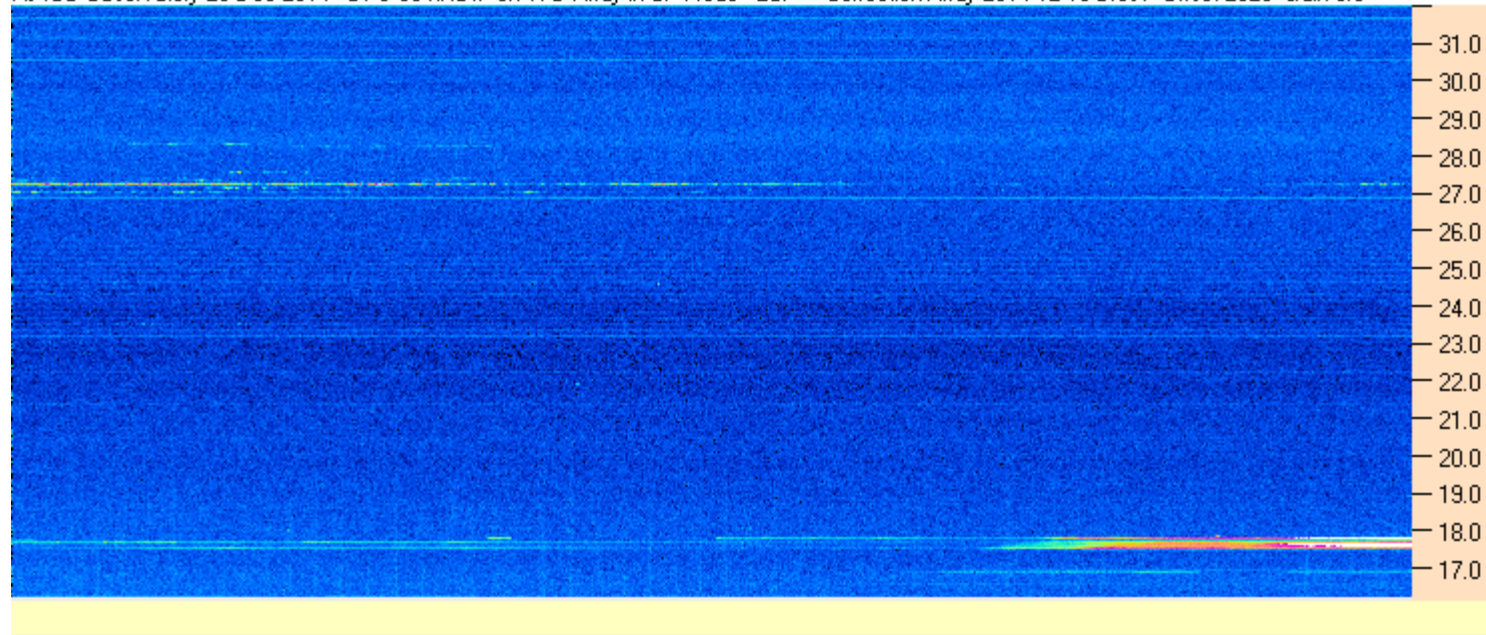


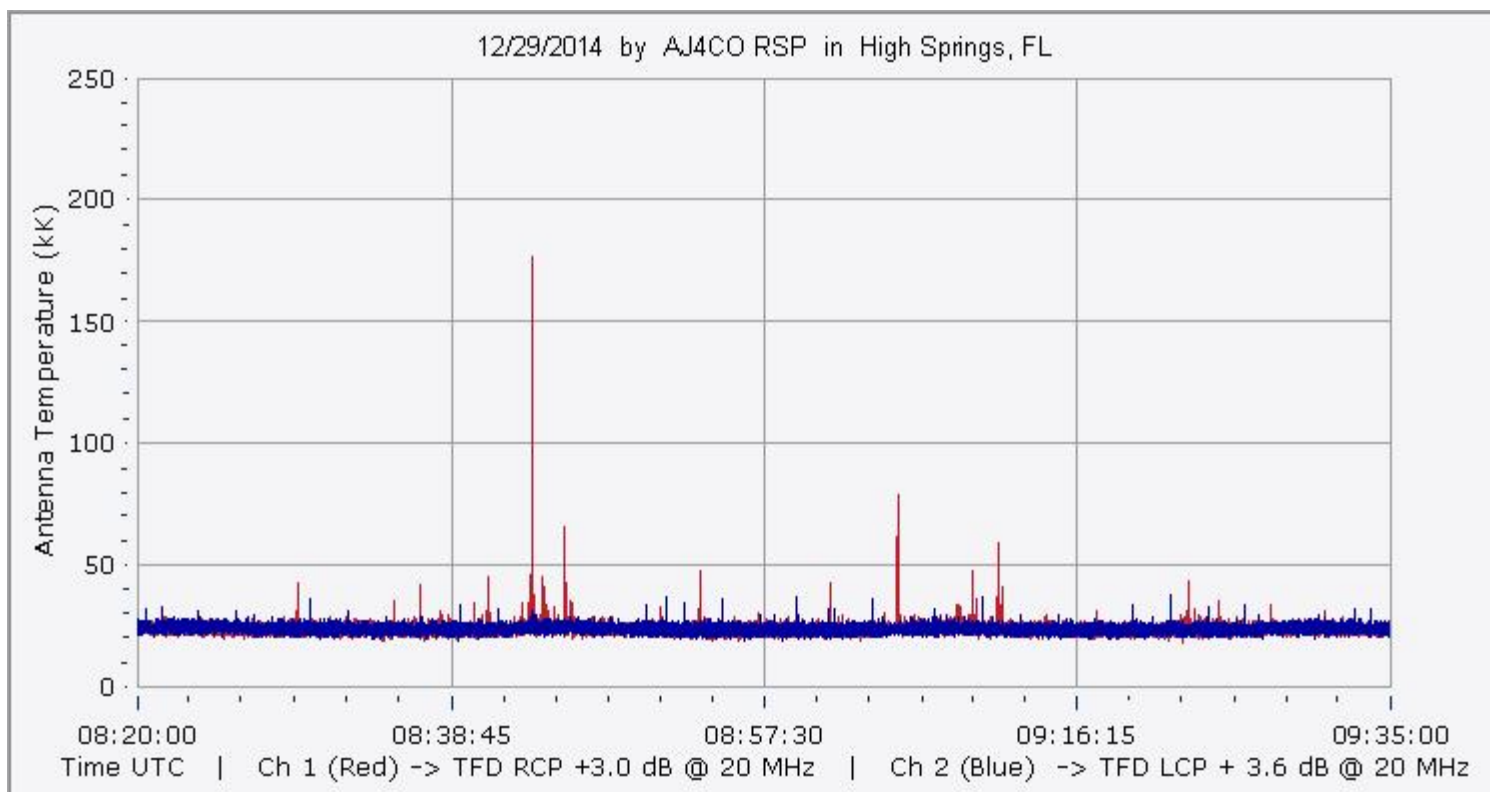

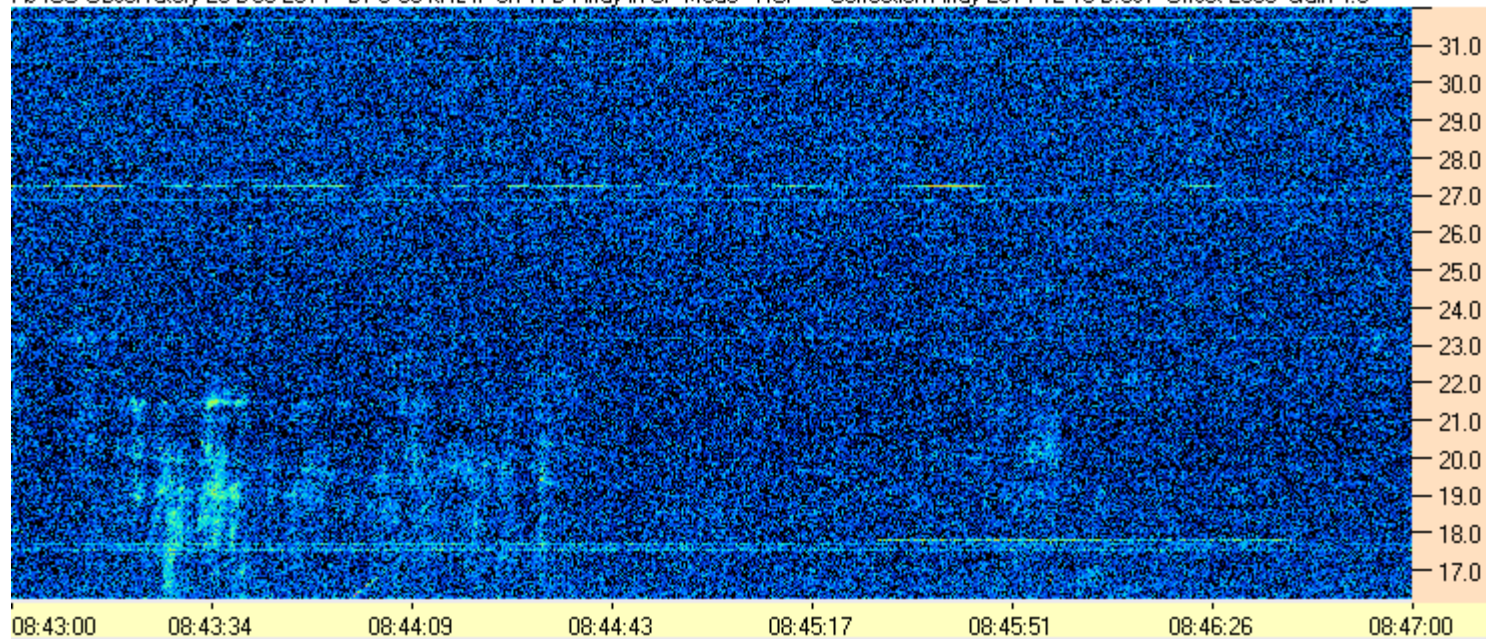
