RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 25 MHz. Brief period of modulation lanes at 0746 UTC with +90 kHz/sec drift rate.

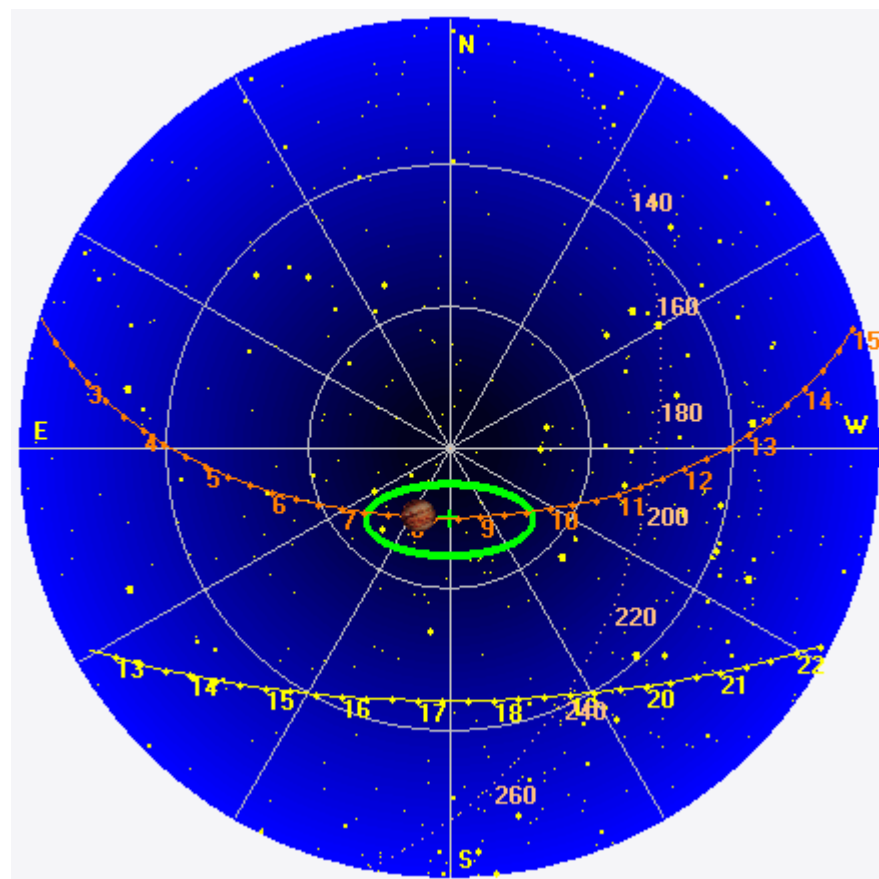
Jupiter was -21° to $+9^\circ$ off axis.

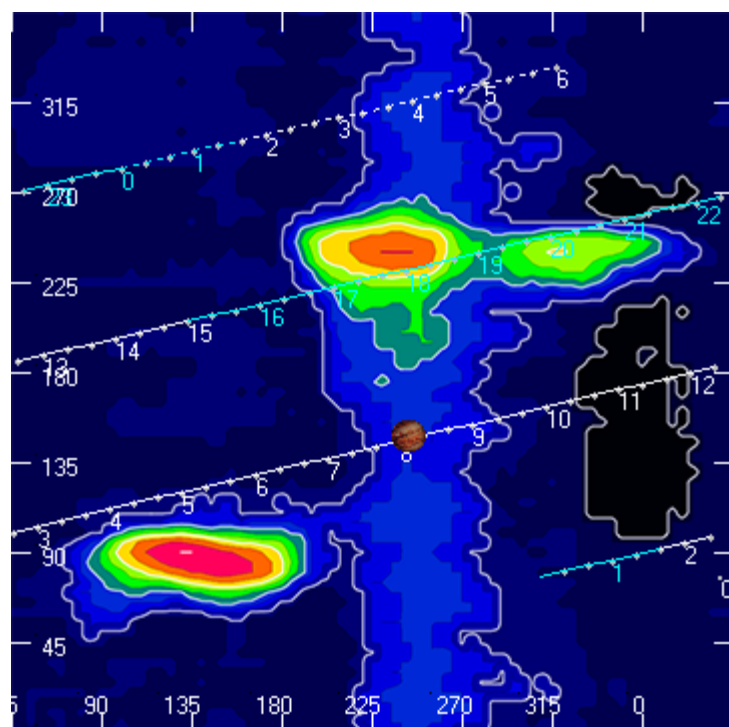
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 137° .

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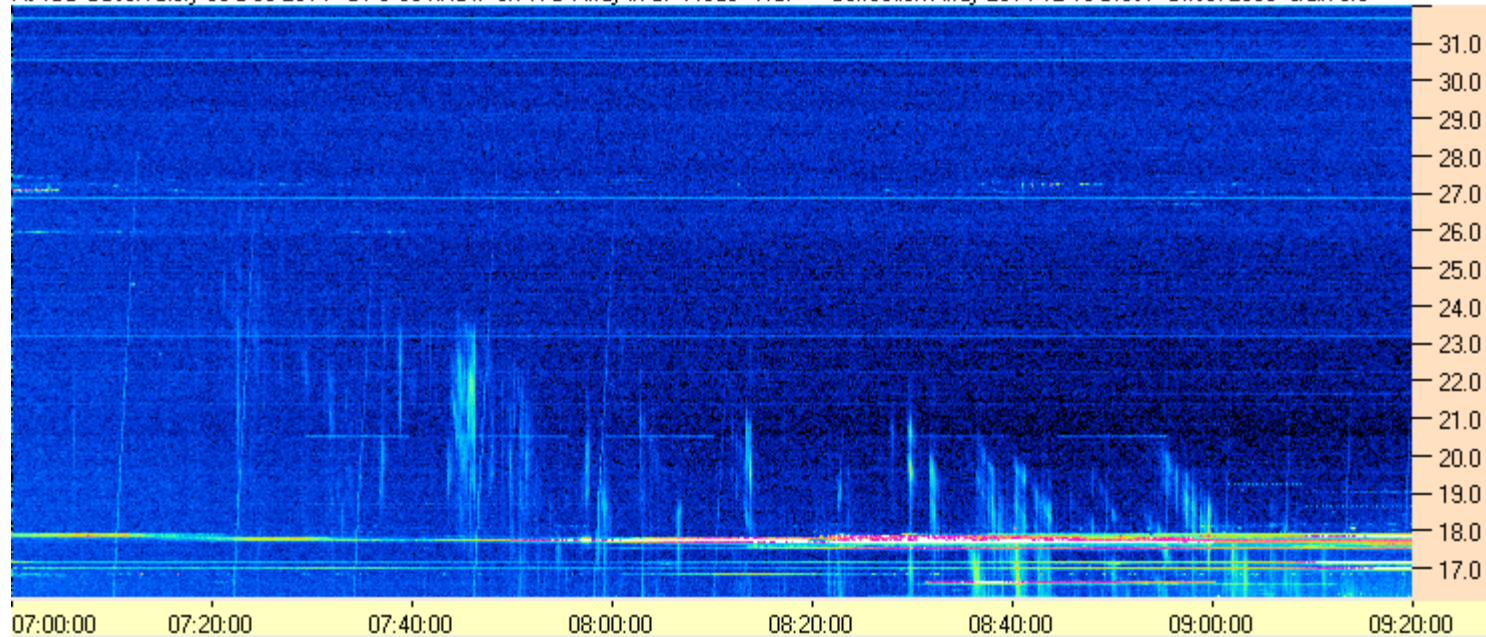

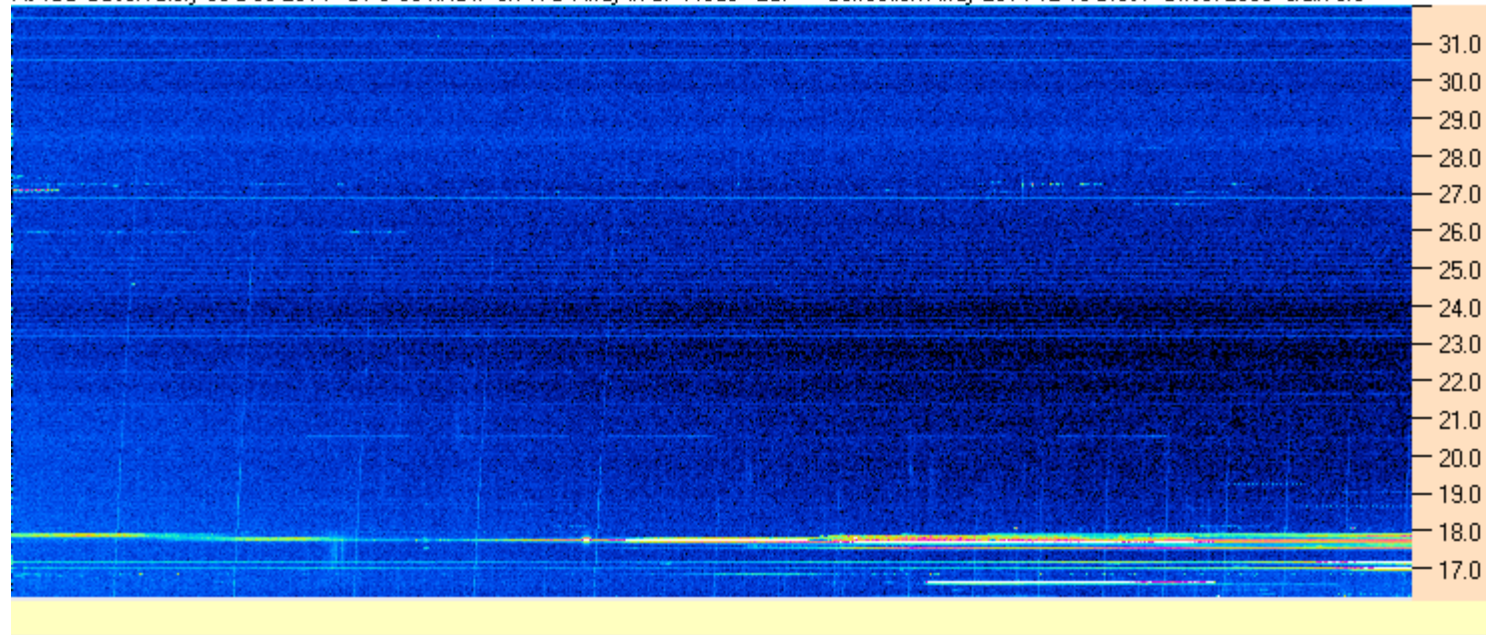

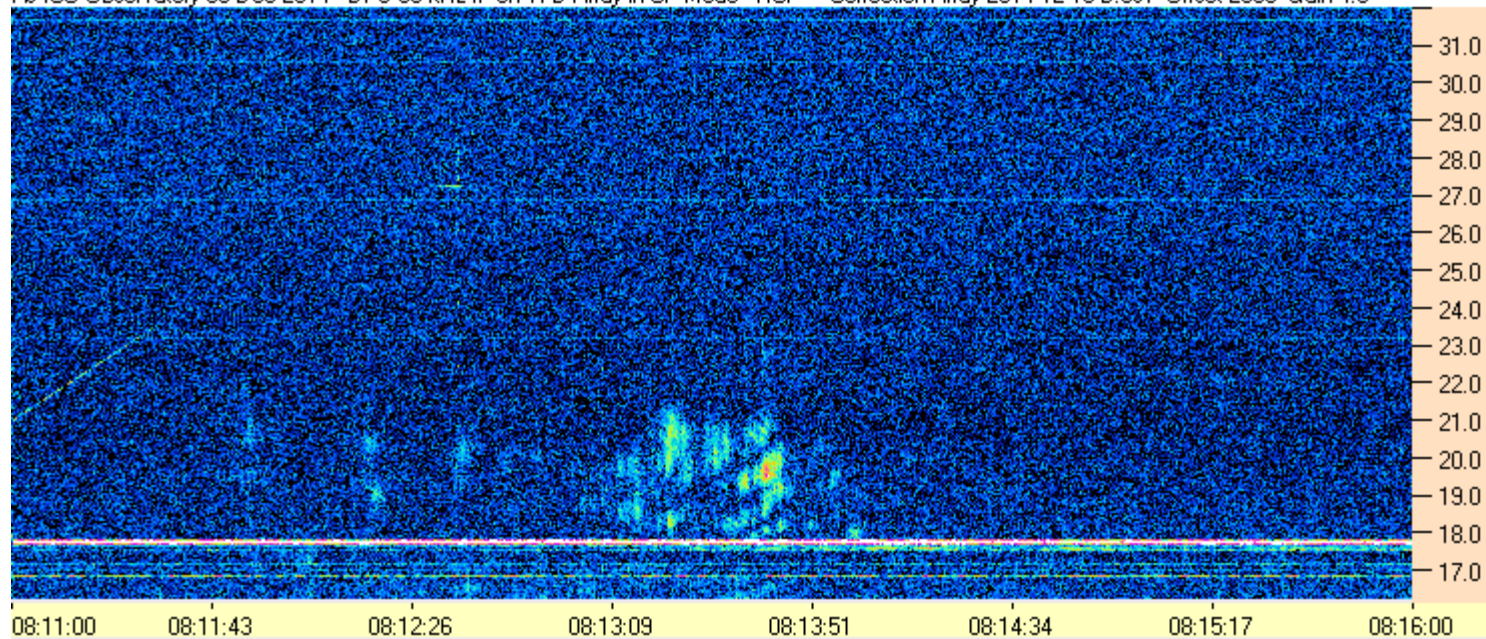

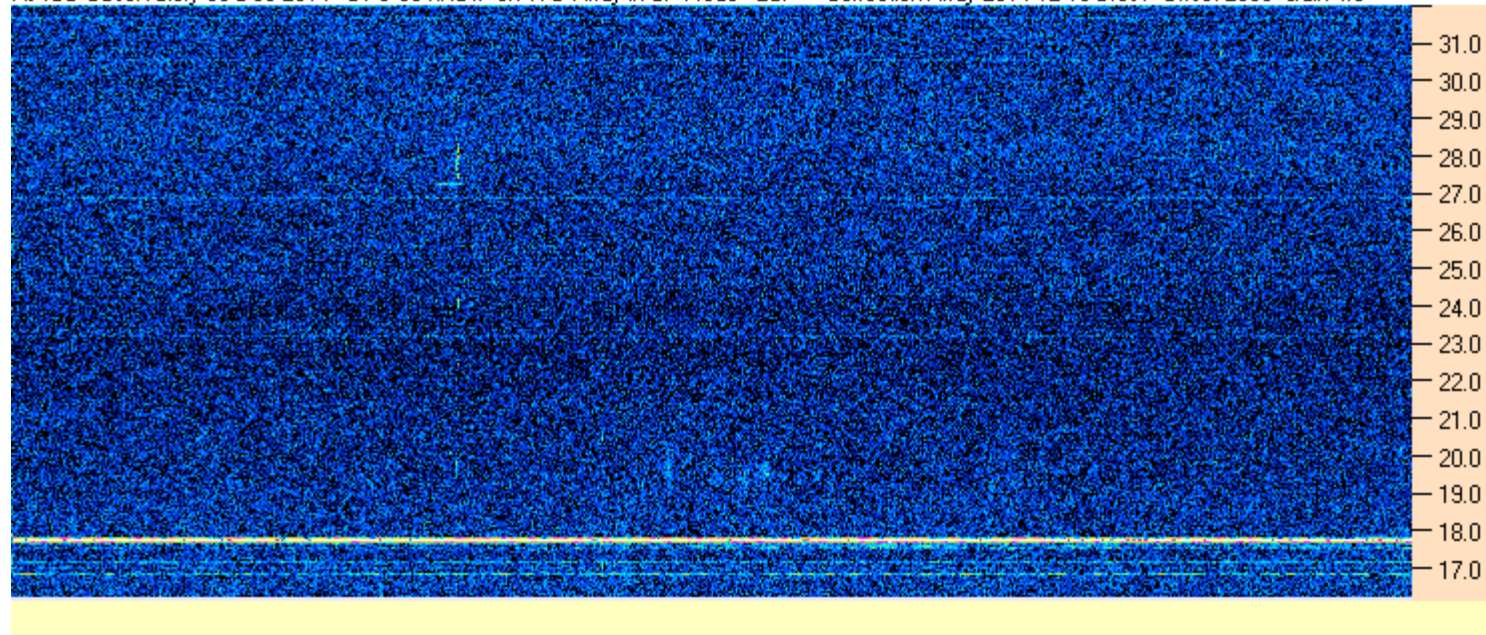

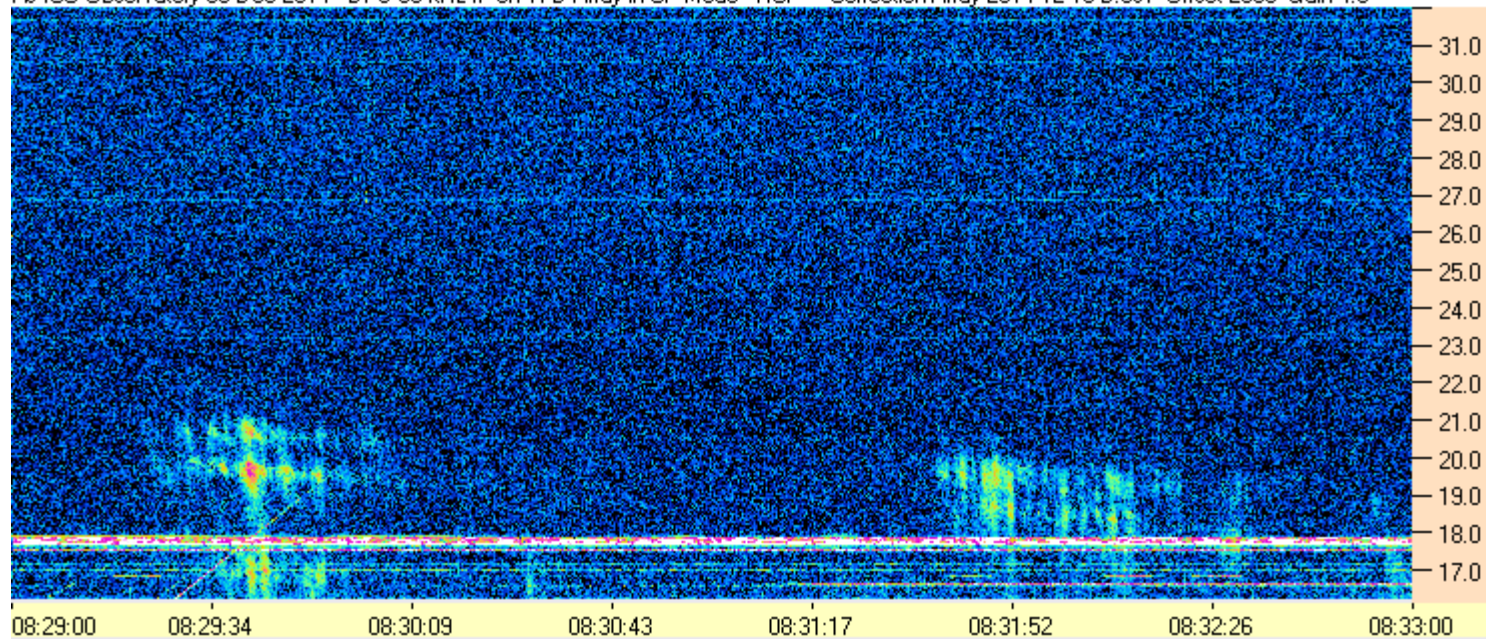
