RCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 24 MHz. No modulation lanes visible.

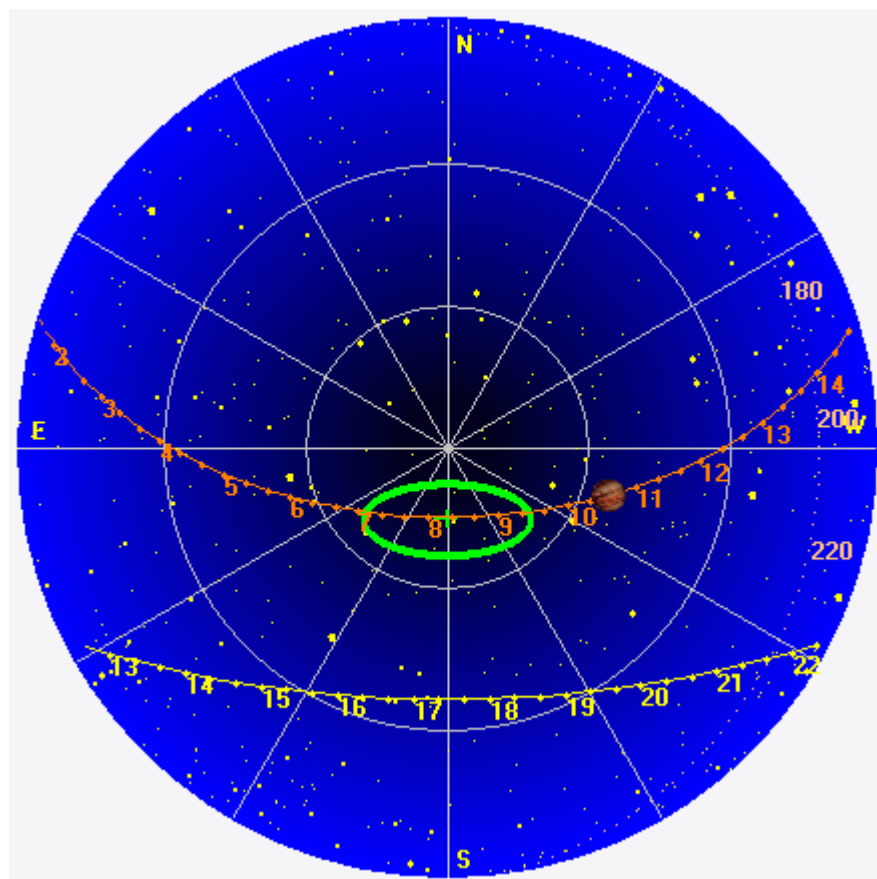
Jupiter was +26° to +40° off axis.

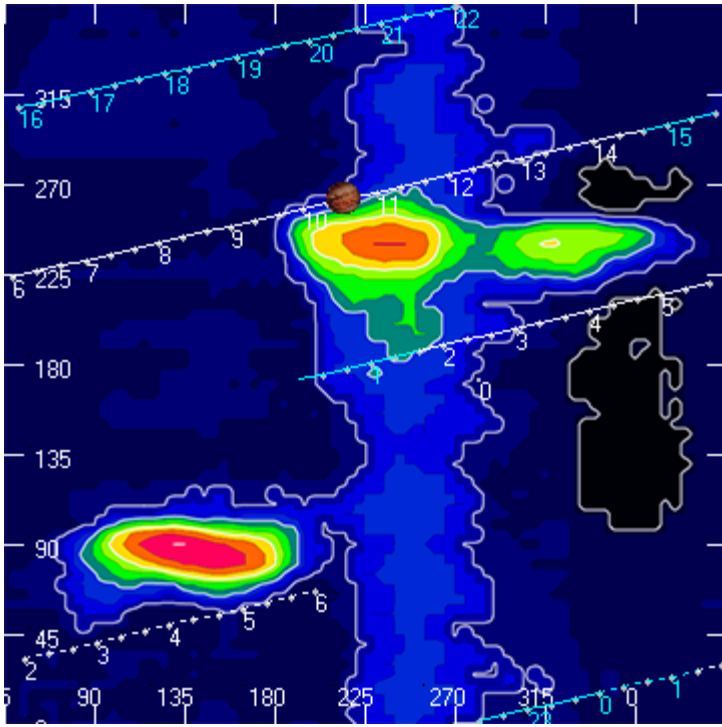
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 141°.

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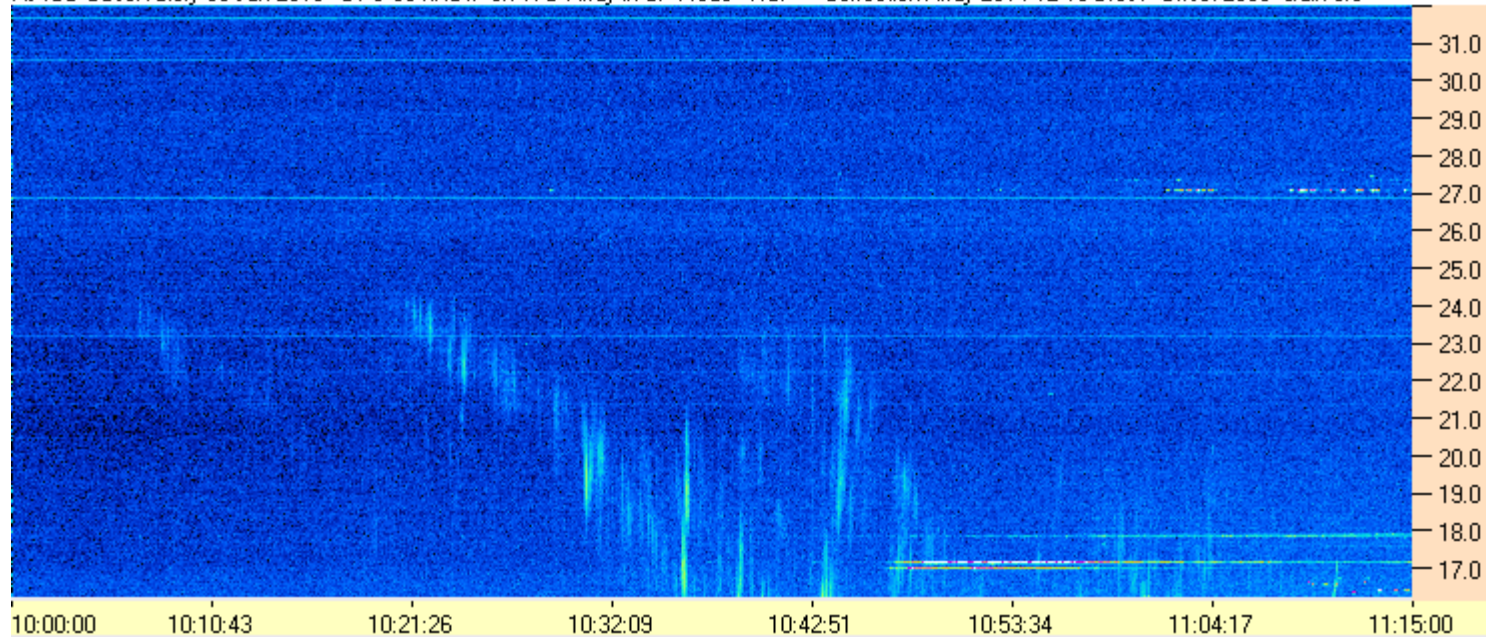

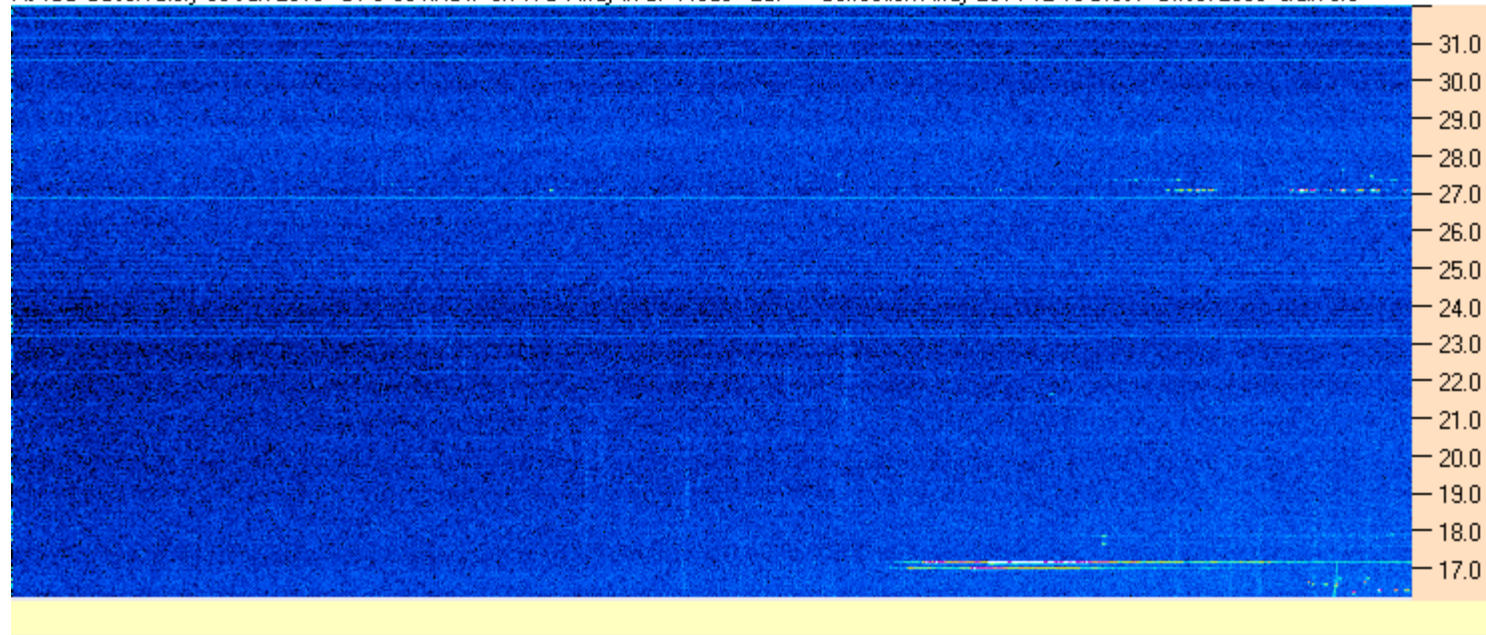




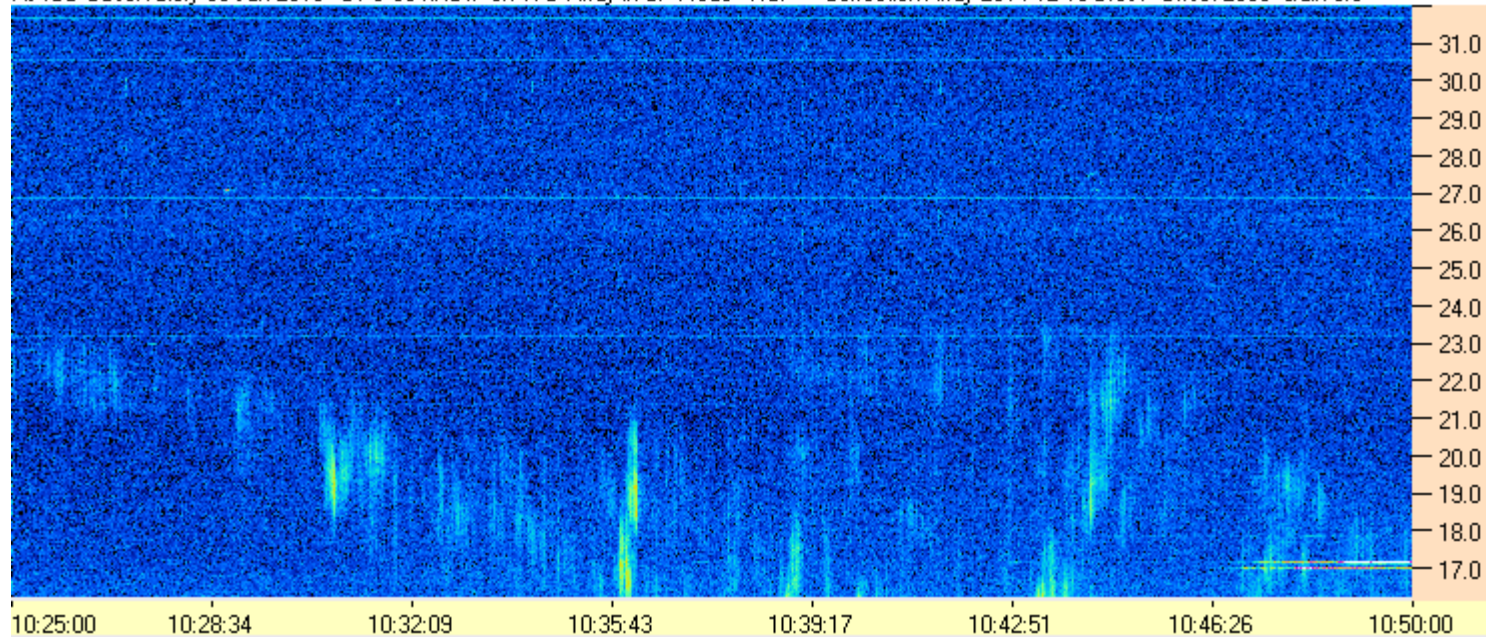
