Interesting LCP dominant L bursting from 16 to 21 MHz. Might be vertex early arcs? No modulation lanes visible.

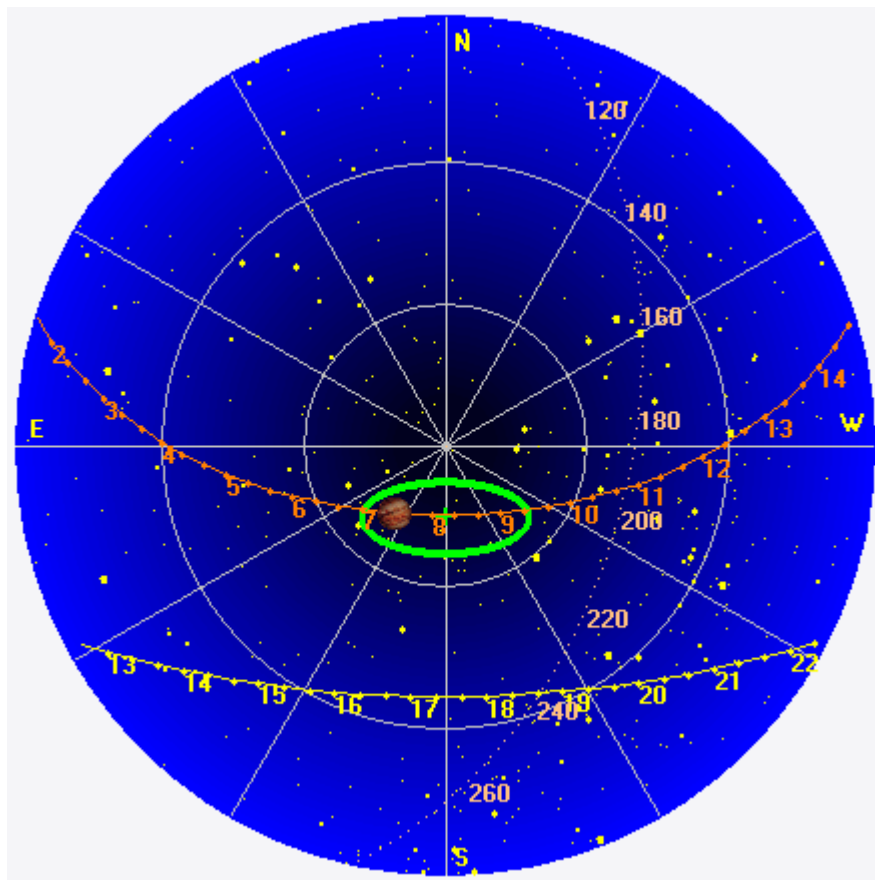
Jupiter was -25° to $+4^\circ$ off axis.

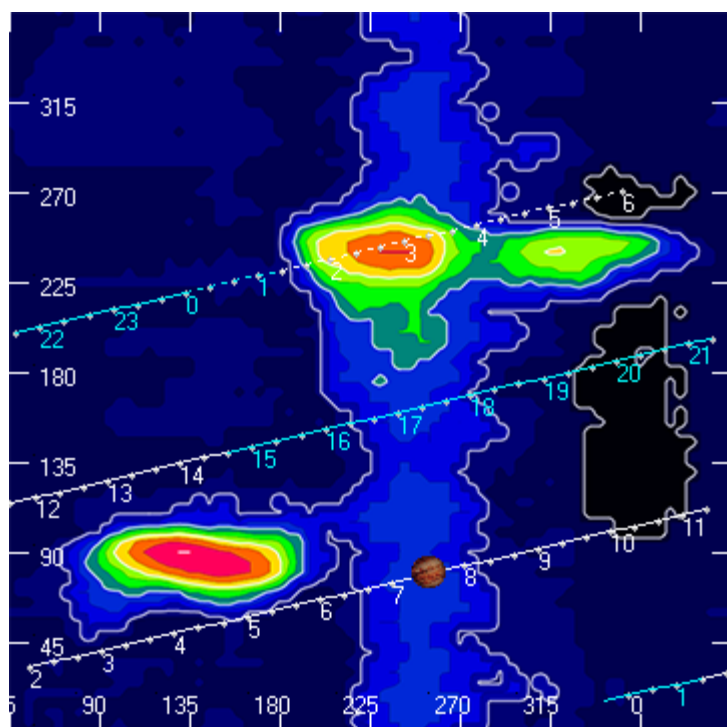
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 142° .

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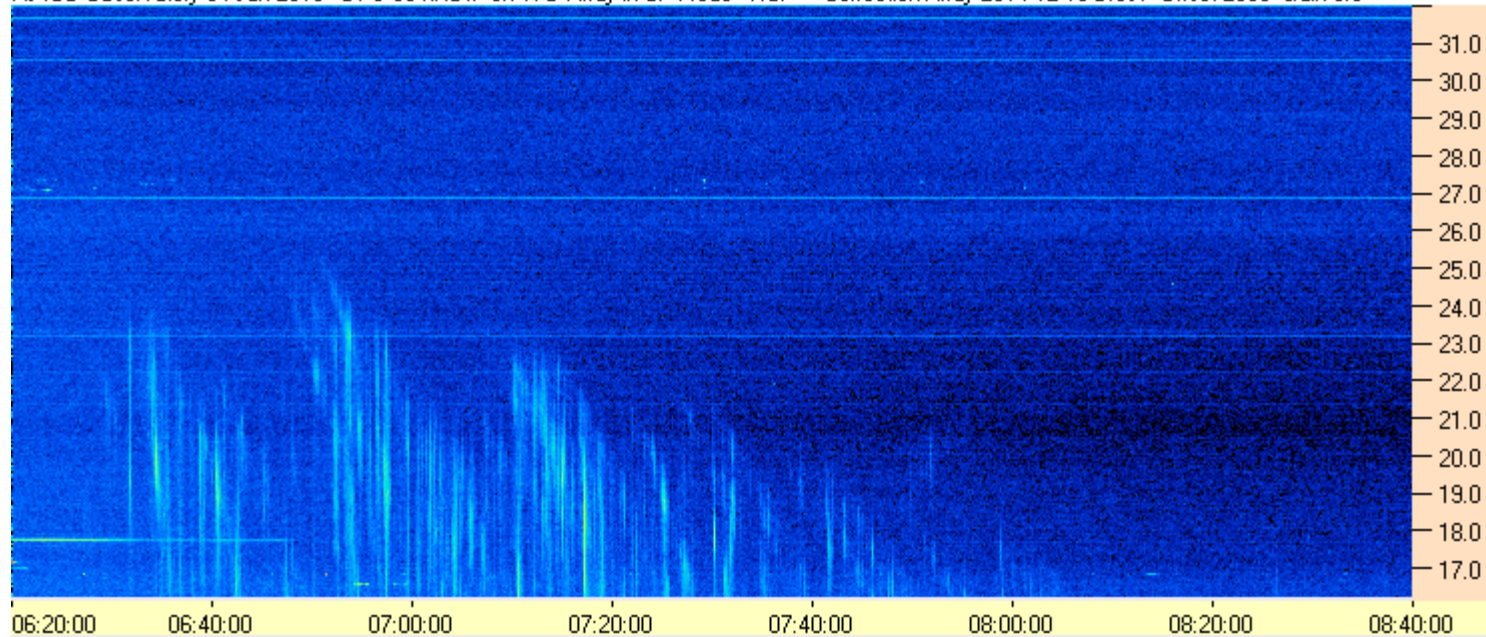

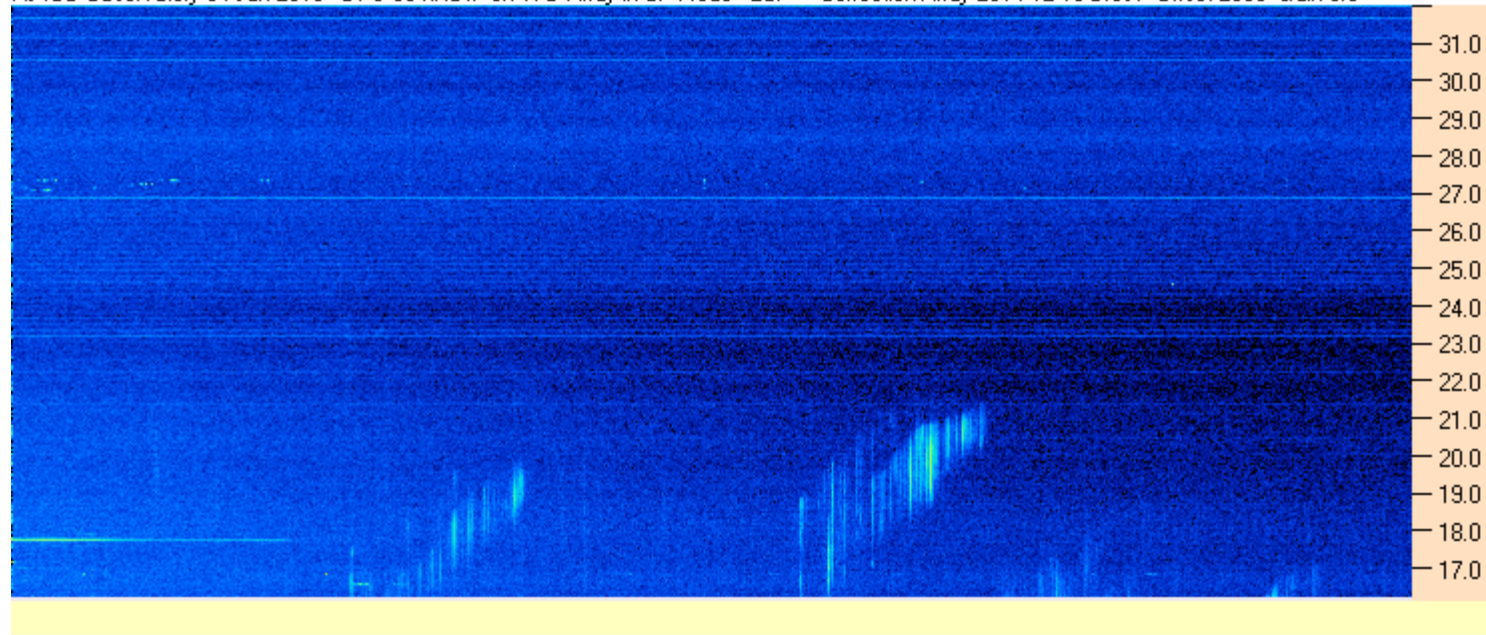

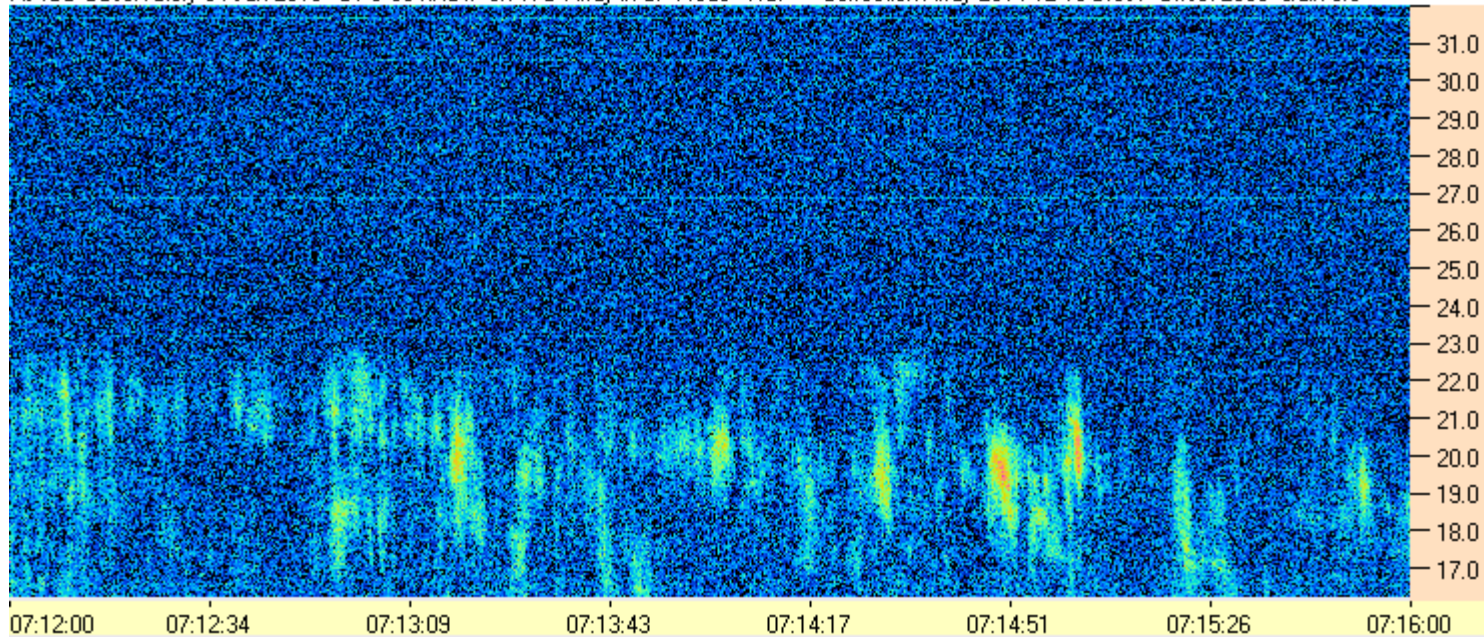

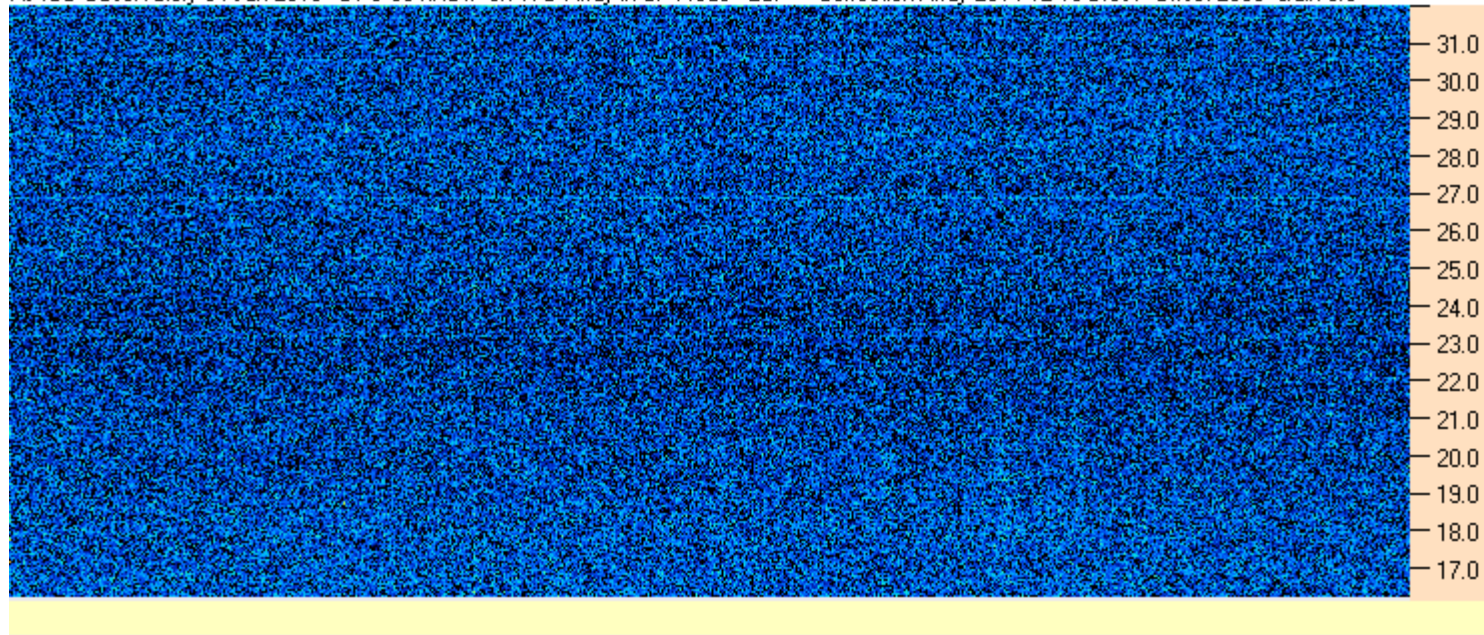

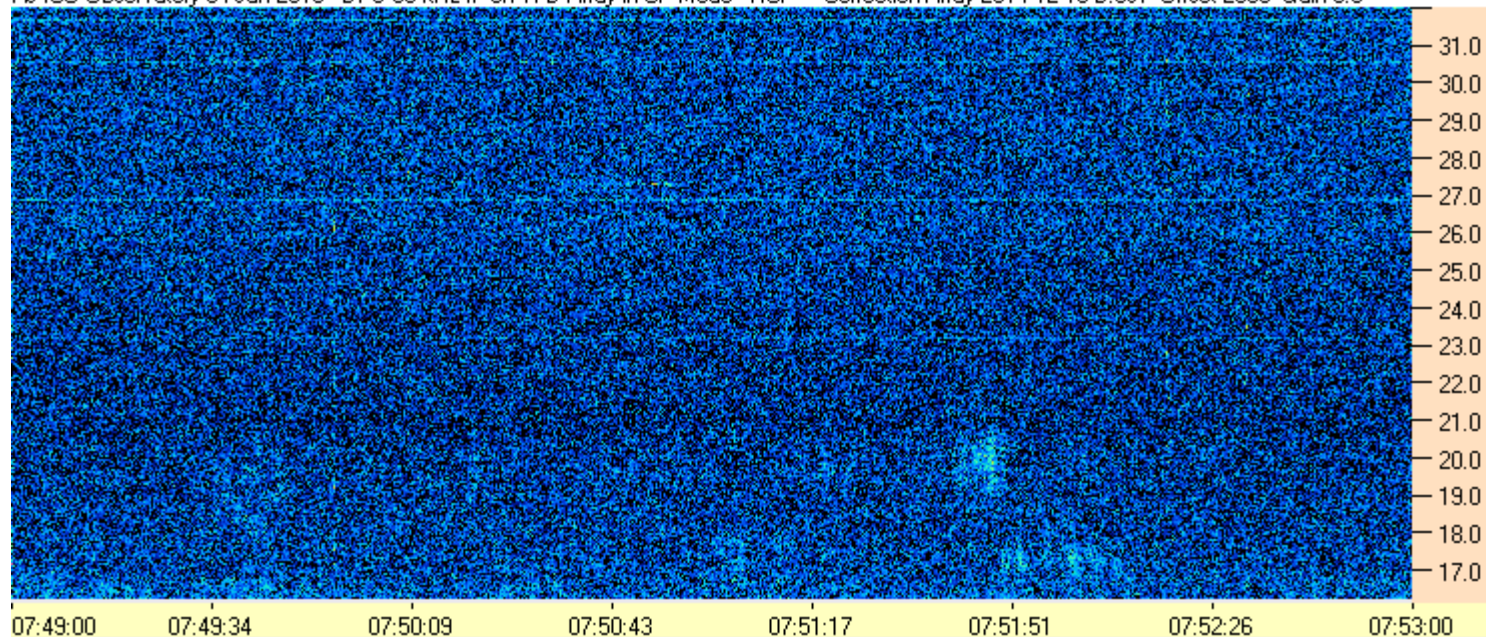


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
