LCP dominant L bursting for Io-C from 16 to 20 MHz. No modulation lanes visible.

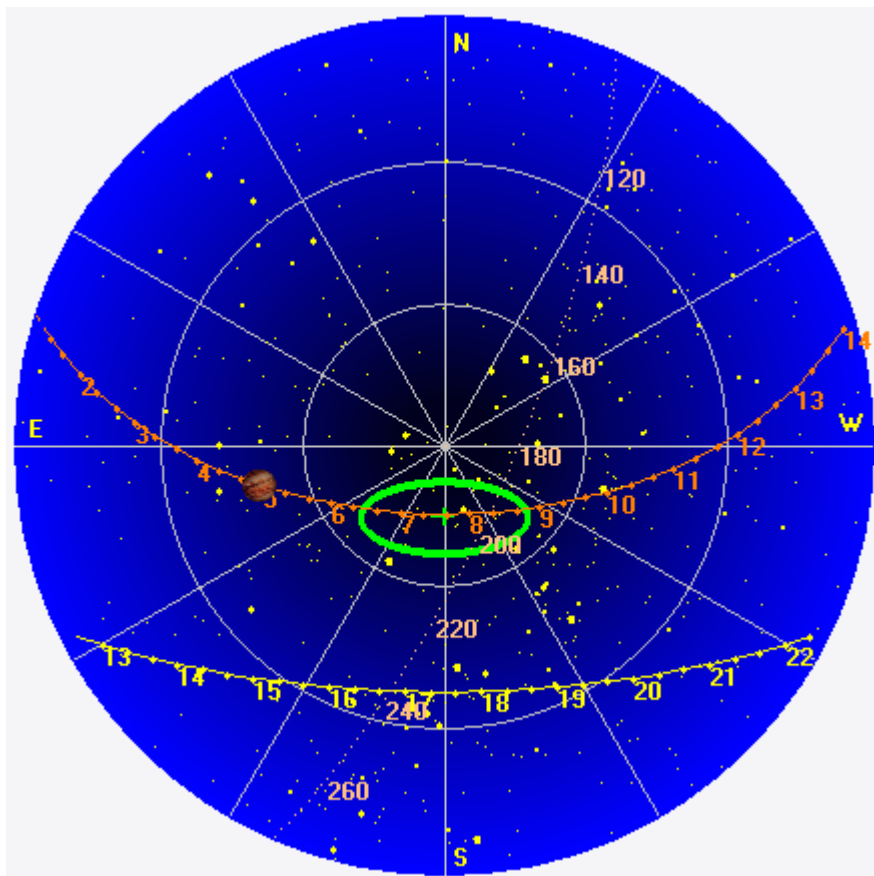
Jupiter was -52° to -26° off axis.

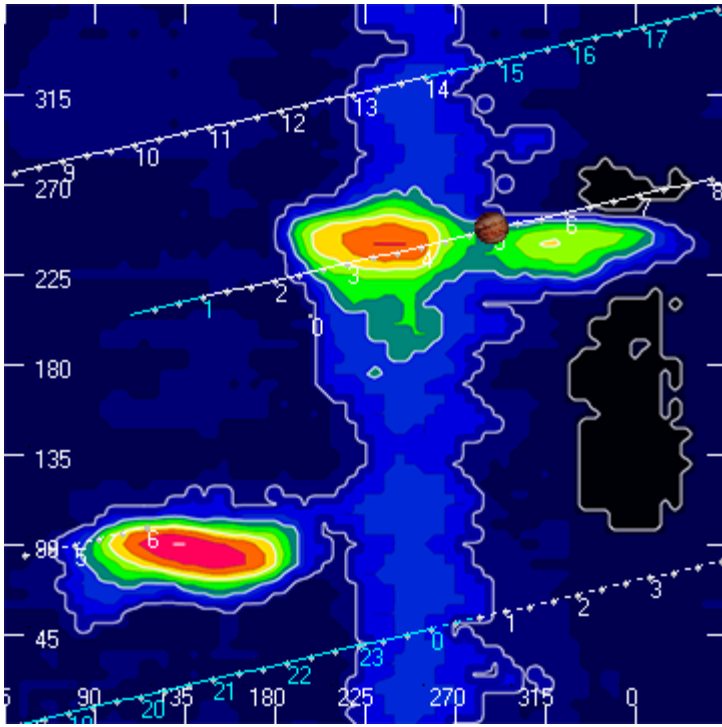
Jupiter was leading the Sun by 151° .

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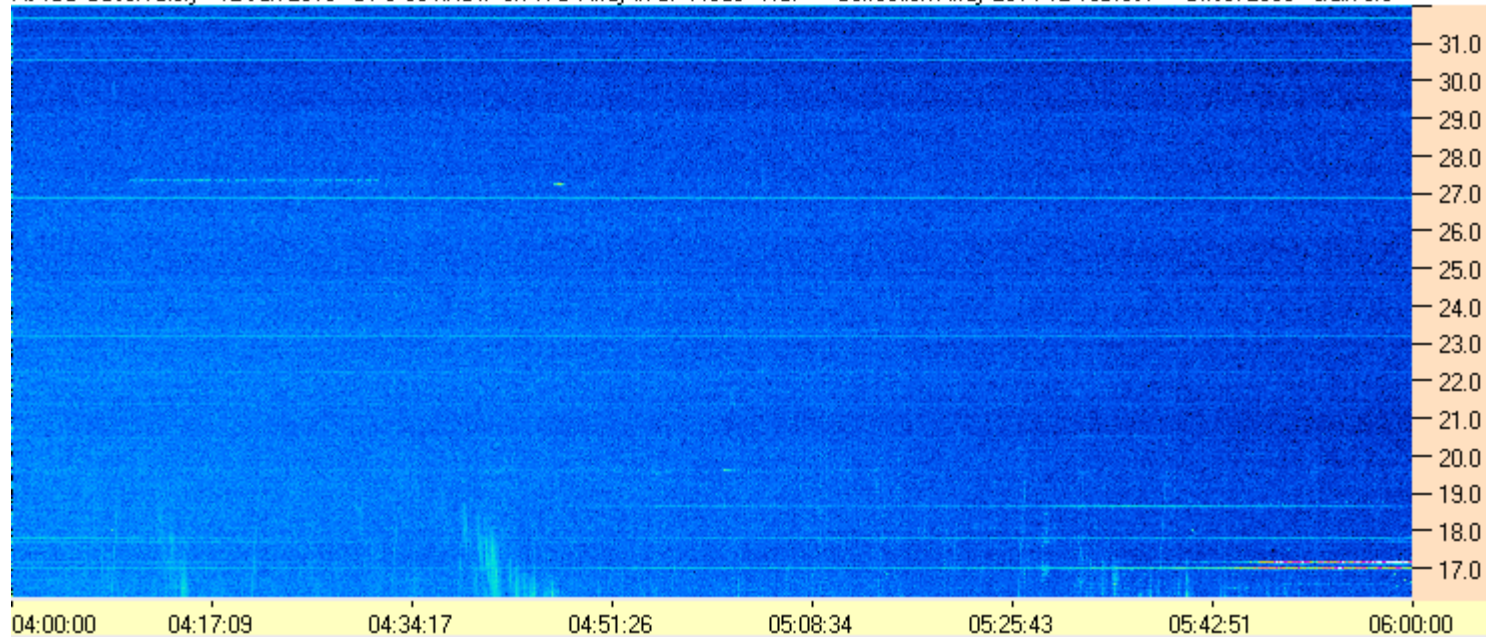

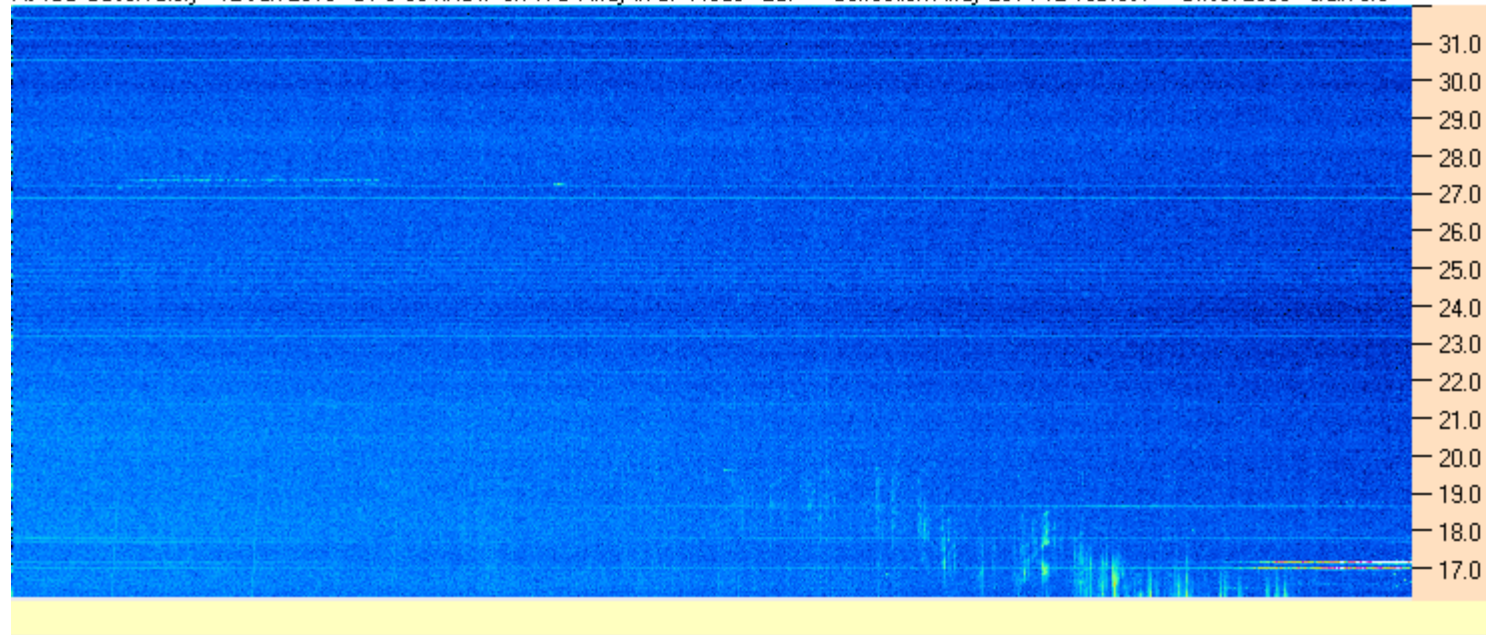




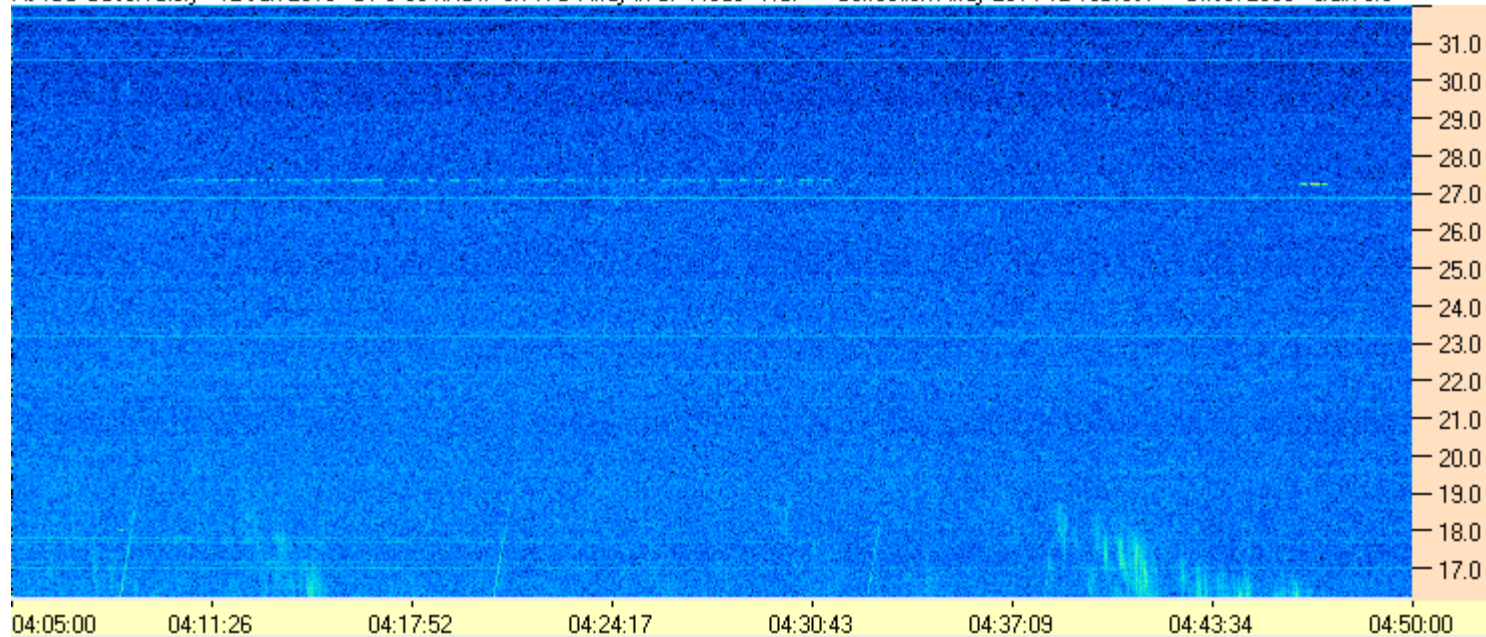

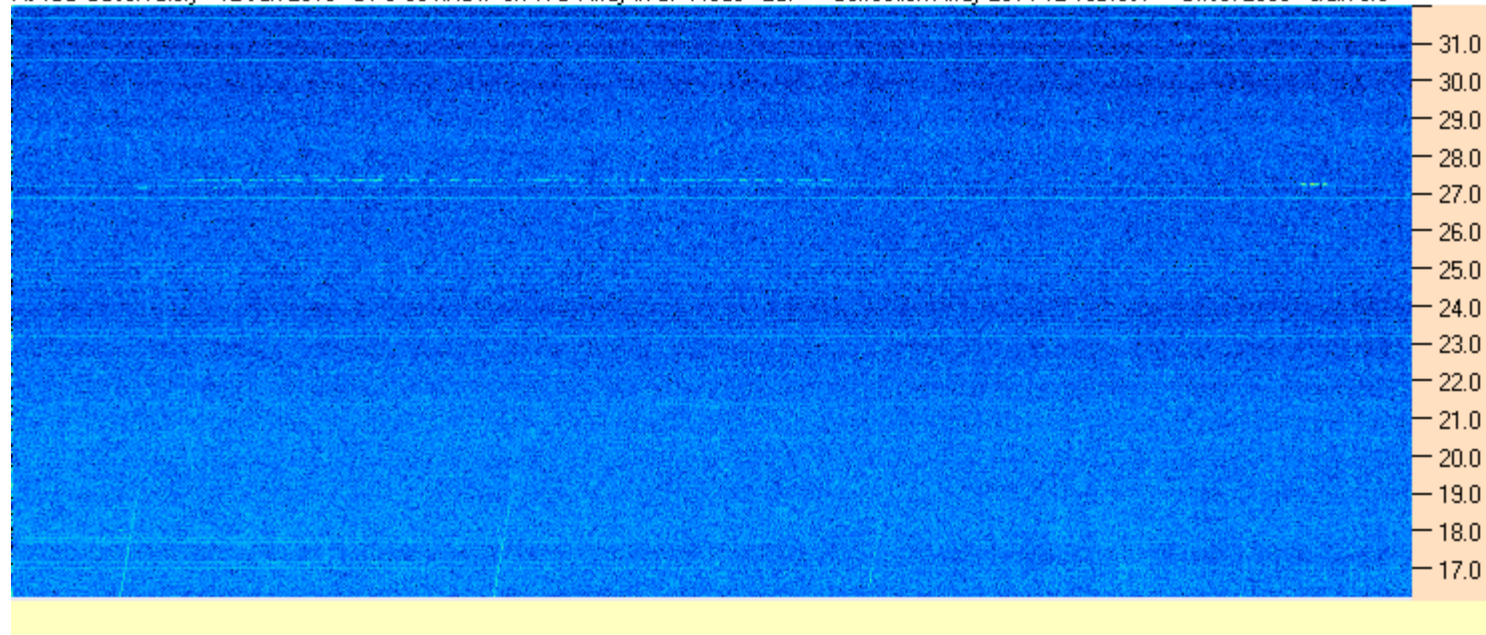

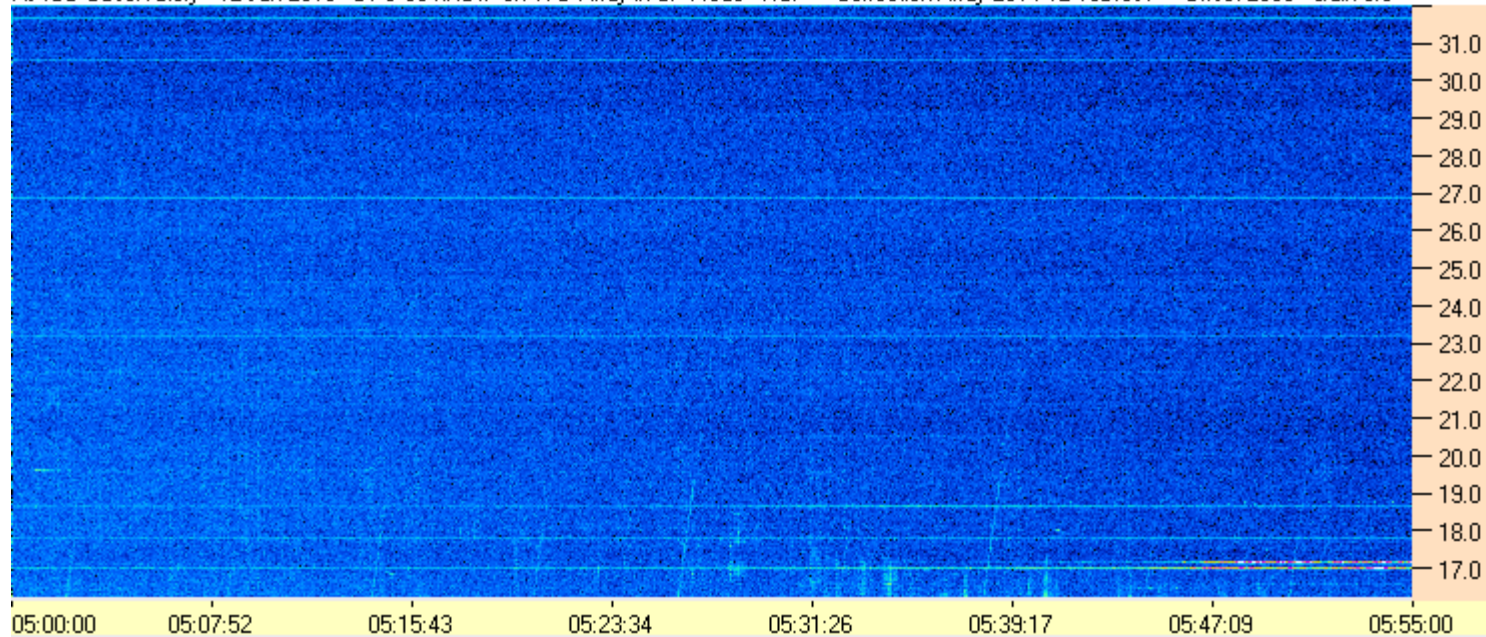
