Adding to Jim & Tom & Wes's nice reports, here's some lo-B and lo-D from Tuesday morning.

RCP dominant L bursting for lo-B from 16 to 32 MHz. Modulation lanes visible at -52 kHz/sec at 21 MHz at 0554. Several hot bursts around 0600, highest around 4 MK.

LCP dominant L bursting for lo-D from 16 to 19 MHz. There were only 13 minutes of it fairly visible, from 0545 to 0558. The burst morphology is different enough to pick it out from the lo-B. No modulation lanes visible.

There was a fair amount of constant line noise in the background. If there was any S bursting, I could not see it; probably hidden beneath the line noise.


Jupiter was -36° to -10° off axis.


Jupiter was leading the Sun by 152°.
